## PITTSBURGH PIRATES (11-5) vs. NEW YORK METS (7-8)

APRIL 15, 2024 at Citi Field, Queens, NY - 7:10 EDT - GAME #17/ROAD #12 LHP MARTÍN PÉREZ (1-0, 1.89 ERA) vs. RHP ADRIAN HOUSER (0-1, 5.40 ERA)

THE PIRATES:...are 2-2 on their current seven-game road trip to Philadelphia and New York to face the Mets...Beat the Phillies 9-2 yesterday after being walked off in nine innings Saturday afternoon (have yet to lose back-to-back games on the road this season)...Began the season 5-0 for the first time since 1983...Swept a season-opening fourgame series on the road for the first time since doing so in 1903 in Cincinnati. **BUCS WHEN...** 

**CONGRATS, CUTCH:** Andrew McCutchen connected for the 300th home run of his career yesterday in Philadelphia...McCutchen is one of just 13 players in MLB history to have 2000 hits, 400 doubles, 45 triples, 300 home runs and 200 stolen bases...McCutchen has hit 216 of his 300 career home runs as a member of the Pirates...The only three players to hit more home runs in the organization's history are Hall-of-Famers Willie Stargell (475), Ralph Kiner (301) and Roberto Clemente (240).

ABOUT THOSE 300 HOMERS: Andrew McCutchen has hit his 300 home runs off 225 different pitchers in his career...McCutchen has taken Johnny Cueto deep more than any other pitcher (five times)...The 37-year-old McCutchen has homeed in 29 different ballparks (98 of those 300 have come at PNC Park) for five different teams...McCutchen has three career homers at Citi Field (his last one came on June 16, 2016, off Addison Reed).

**FROM 1 TO 2055:** Andrew McCutchen comes into today fourth among all active players with 2055 career hits behind Joey Votto (2135), Freddie Freeman (2134) and Jose Altuve (2073)...McCutchen's first career hit came on June 4, 2009, in his big league debut when he singled off Mike Pelfrey of the Mets leading off the game at PNC Park.

ABOUT TONIGHT'S STARTER: Martin Pérez comes into today with a 1.89 ERA (19.0ip/4er) after allowing one run in 8.0 innings in his last outing Tuesday

against Detroit...The only lefthanders in MLB to record a lower ERA (minimum 15.0ip) coming into today are Shota Imanaga (0.00), Reid Detmers (1.04), Cody Bradford (1.40), Tyler Anderson (1.47), Carlos Rodon (1.72) and Steven Matz (1.80).

**START ME UP:** Pittsburgh's starting pitching staff has allowed 17 earned runs in 63.0 innings in the last 10 games (2.43 ERA)... Pittsburgh's 3.48 starting rotation ERA (93.0ip/36er) is the fifth-lowest among all teams in MLB...The only four starting rotations to record a lower ERA are the Red Sox (2.05), Royals (2.46), Yankees (2.99) and Phillies (3.09).

ROTATION RANKINGS: Pittsburgh's starting rotation ranks fourth in all of MLB in walks per 9.0 innings (2.23)...The only three starting rotations averaging fewer walks per 9.0 innings are the Mariners (1.71), Orioles (2.05) and Royals (2.18)...Pittsburgh's starting rotation also has the 10th-lowest batting average against (.242) in all of MLB.

ON THE ROAD: The Pirates are 8-3 on the road after sweeping the Marlins in four games to begin the season, winning two of three at Washington from April 1-4, and splitting their four-game series this past weekend at Philadelphia...It's Pittsburgh's best start on the road since the 2003 team was also 8-3 after 11 games...Pittsburgh's eight road wins are tied with the Yankees for the most in MLB.

THE BATTLING BUCCOS: The Pirates bring the third-best record (11-5) in all of Major League Baseball coming into today...The only two teams to produce a better record are the Yankees (12-4) and Brewers (10-4)...This is Pittsburgh's best start to begin a season since the 2018 team was also 11-5 after 16 games...A win tonight would give Pittsburgh its best start since the 2002 team went 12-5 to begin the season.

**ON THE OFFENSE:** The Pirates rank seventh in all of Major League Baseball with an average of 5.44 runs per game...The only six teams averaging more runs per game are the Braves (6.50), Brewers (6.50), Reds (6.00), Diamondbacks (.5.56), Orioles (5.47) and Cubs (5.47).

JACK'S JACKS: Jack Suwinski connected for his second career grand slam yesterday (his other one came on April 29, 2023, in game two of a doubleheader against the Nationals).. Since the beginning of last season, Suwinski's 28 home runs as an outfielder are the sixthmost among National League players (tied for 10th in MLB among outfielders) behind Ronald Acuna Jr. (41), Juan Soto (32), Fernando Tatis Jr. (30), Kyle Schwarber (29) and Lane Thomas (29).
