**RECENT REDBIRDS:** The St. Louis Cardinals begin the second city of their road trip to Arizona and Oakland with the first of a three-game series against the Oakland Athletics in what could be their final visit to the Oakland Coliseum. The Cardinals were shutout by the Diamondbacks 5-0 yesterday and have lost their last two games.

**FLIGHT PATTERN:** The Cardinals open today's schedule in 5th place in the National League Central, 4.0 games out of first place behind Milwaukee (10-4) and Pittsburgh (11-5). The four-game deficit is the largest of the season for the Cardinals. St. Louis has spent one game over .500 on April 6 (5-4).

**CARAY ON, MY WAYWARD SON:** Today marks the first time since 2008 that two members of the Caray family lineage will broadcast on the same day and the first time since 2003 that two members of the Caray family will broadcast the same game as part of opposing organizations. The Caray Family has been broadcasting games every year in Major League Baseball since World War II, when **Harry Caray** began his broadcasting career with the St. Louis Cardinals in 1945. Harry's son, "**Skip**" began his career with the Atlanta Braves broadcast team in 1976. Current Cardinals broadcaster "**Chip**" began his career with the Atlanta Braves in 1991. On Friday, **Chris Caray** became the 4th generation of Caray's to broadcast in Major League Baseball with the Athletics.

**CALIFORNIA DREAMIN':** This year, the St. Louis Cardinals will play road series at all five California-based organizations. The 'Birds opened the season with the Los Angeles Dodgers (March 28-31), then drove down the Golden State Freeway to play the San Diego Padres (April 1-3). Today starts a series with the Oakland Athletics. May 13-15, the Cardinals will travel to Orange County with a series with the Los Angeles Angels. Finally, the Cardinals conclude the 2024 regular season across the Bay at the San Francisco Giants (Sept. 27-29).

**BROKEN WINGS:** The Cardinals currently are dealing with several players on the Injured List.

- OF **Tommy Edman** (right wrist sprain) will start taking dry swings today and hit off a tee tomorrow.
- OF **Dylan Carlson** (left shoulder AC sprain) will hit off a tee today and progress to soft toss this week.
- RHP **Keynan Middleton** (right forearm flexor strain) started playing catch yesterday.
- RHP **Riley O'Brien** (right forearm flexor strain) will begin a throwing program this week.
- INF **Matt Carpenter** (right oblique strain) is currently traveling with the team and was taking infield practice in Arizona.

**MLB HONORS THE LEGACY OF JACKIE ROBINSON:** Major League Baseball, in coordination with the Robinson Family, MLB Clubs and various partners, has announced Baseball's efforts to celebrate the legacy of Jackie Robinson through the MLB Together platform (www.MLBTogether.com) on Jackie Robinson Day – Monday, April 15th. On April 15, 1947, **Jack (Jackie) Roosevelt Robinson** played his first Major League game at Ebbets Field in Brooklyn, N.Y., integrating the Major League game. Players, managers and coaches will once again wear Robinson's iconic number on April 15th, with all teams using Dodger blue "42" jersey numbers (regardless of their primary team colors). Additionally, Players, coaches, managers, and umpires will have New Era caps with a "42" side patch. Nike's Breaking Barriers t-shirts also will be worn during batting practice.

**I DON'T KNOW ABOUT YOU, BUT I LIKE WEARING '42':** Since the inception of Jackie Robinson Day (April 15) in Major League Baseball in 2004, the Cardinals are 10-4 on the day and 7-2 on the road. St. Louis won their first five Jackie Robinson Day games (2005-09). Their only Interleague Game was in 2017, losing 3-2 to the New York Yankees in the Bronx.

**SONNY'S 100:** Cardinals pitcher **Sonny Gray** could become the 13th active pitcher in MLB to achieve 100 career wins with a victory tonight. Gray is returning to his old stomping grounds at the Oakland Coliseum. Among active pitchers at the ballpark, Gray is tied for first in wins (26), first in innings pitched (396.1) and second in strikeouts (328). All-time, Gray ranks 20th in wins and 14th in strikeouts at the Coliseum.

**A CASE OF THE WILLIES:** With a 4th inning double yesterday, Cardinals catcher **Willson Contreras** extended his career-high for on-base streak with 20. Dating back to September 6, 2023, Contreras' mark ranks T-3rd in MLB trailing only **Christian Yelich** (MIL, 23) and the suspended **Noelvi Marte** (CIN, 22). Yelich has sat out the last two games.

**CARDINALS REMEMBER HOLTZMAN:** The St. Louis Cardinals would like to send their condolences to the Holtzman family in remembrance of the passing of St. Louis native and former Oakland Athletics two-time All-Star pitcher **Ken Holtzman**. Holtzman, who attended University City High School in Missouri, was a 20-game winner on the 1973 World Champion Athletics and played 15 seasons in the Major Leagues with the Cubs, Athletics, Orioles and Yankees.

**Sonny Gray** was selected by Oakland in the 1st round (#18) of the 2011 MLB Draft...pitched parts of his first five seasons with the Athletics (2013-17) before traded to the Yankees with international bonus slot money for **Dustin Fowler**, **James Kaprielian**, and **Jorge Mateo** (July 31, 2017).

**Andrew Kittredge** made his MLB Debut vs. the Athletics (July 18, 2017 at Oakland)...fanned **Jacob Brugman** (swinging) for his first batter faced.

**Brandon Crawford** was born in Mountain View, Calif., moved to Pleasanton in his youth and was a 2005 graduate of from Foothill High School.

**Tommy Edman** played college baseball at Stanford University (2014-16).

**Daniel Descalso** was born in Redwood City, Calif...graduated from Saint Francis High School in Mountain View in 2004...played college baseball at University of California, Davis (2005-07)...resides in Danville, Calif.

**Willie McGee** played 29 games for the Athletics in 1990 and a member of their AL Championship

squad...traded by St. Louis to Oakland for **Daryl Green**, **Félix José**, and **Stan Royer**...was born in San Francisco, Calif...graduated from Harry Ells High School in Richmond...played college baseball at Diablo Valley College in Pleasant Hill...worked as an assistant coach for Contra Costa College in San Pablo...resides in Hercules.

**Dean Kiekhfer** pitched in four games for Oakland during the 2018 season.

**T.J. McFarland** pitched in 66 games over two seasons for the Cardinals (2021-22).

Former 1999 Athletics 2nd round draft pick **Ryan Ludwick** and **Jason Istringhausen**, who pitched for the Athletics (1999-2001), are both Cardinals Player Development Special Advisors.

Athletics First Base coach **Mike Aldrete** was the Cardinals assistant hitting coach (2008-11) and bench coach (2012-14)...member of the Cardinals 2011 World Championship team and 2013 National League pennant winner...his son, **Michael Aldrete**, was selected by St. Louis in the 39th round of the 2012 Draft.

Cardinals Video Coordinator **Chad Blair** previously served in a similar role with the Athletics from (1988-95)...is a native of nearby Santa Rosa, Calif.

**Brandon Allen** played in 44 games for the Athletics from 2011-12 & was the A's Opening Day 1st baseman in 2012.

Athletics Assistant Athletic Trainer **Brad LaRosa** spent three years in the same role with the Cardinals Springfield (AA) affiliate.

Hall of Famer **Dennis Eckersley** pitched nine seasons with Oakland (1987-95) and two with St. Louis (1996-97)...converted 386 of his 390 career saves between the Athletics (320) and Cardinals (66).

Cardinals Manager of Player Development & Performance **Emily Wiebe** grew up in nearby San Francisco, Calif...attended University High School.

Hall of Fame Manager **Tony La Russa** was a manager of the Athletics (1986-95) and Cardinals (1996-2011)...is only manager to win multiple pennants in both leagues and one of two (Sparky Anderson) to win a World Series in both.

**TONIGHT'S GAME**

- Makes his 2nd start of the season, and his first on the road this year.
- Is seeking his 100th career win. Would become the 13th active pitcher to reach the 100 win milestone, joining teammates **Lance Lynn** (136, 5th) and **Kyle Gibson** (105, 10th).
- Is making his 6th career start against his original drafting team (1st round - 2011).
- Spent 5 seasons (2013-17) with Oakland before being dealt to the Yankees on July 31, 2017. Was 44-36 with a 3.42 ERA in 114 games/112 starts for the Athletics.
- Is seeking to post consecutive winning decisions for the first time since April 24 & April 30 of last season when he had 16 no-decisions while pitching for the Twins. His run support average (3.91) last season was 5th lowest in MLB.
- Had 4+ runs of support in just 7 of his 32 starts last season; one run or less in 11 starts.
- He is one of three free-agent starters (**Lance Lynn & Kyle Gibson**) that the Cardinals signed this past off-season.
- Had been named the team's Opening Day starter for 2024 before suffering injury in his 2nd Grapefruit League start on March 4. Was 0-0 with a 0.00 ERA (3.2 IP) in his two Grapefruit League starts this spring.
- He worked in minor league training games at the Cardinals Jupiter complex and in a simulated game against the Springfield Cardinals (AAA) on April 3 while rehabbing his injury and building up his pitch count.
- Has joined his fifth Major League team: Athletics (2013-17), Yankees (2017-18), Reds (2019-21), Twins (2022-23) and Cardinals (2024).

**LAST TIME OUT**

- Made his Cardinals regular season debut last Tue. (4/9) vs. Philadelphia after beginning the season on the 15-day I.L. with right hamstring injury. It was his first game pitched in front of fans since his last Grapefruit League start on March 4 when he was removed with two outs in the 2nd inning after suffering hamstring strain.

- Pitched his second season with the Twins organization and his first season making 32 or more starts since a career-high 33 with Oakland in 2014.
- Finished 2nd in the 2023 American League Cy Young Award voting behind Gerrit Cole (NYY) who received 30 unanimous 1st place votes. Also ranked 18th in AL MVP voting.
- Led all Major League pitchers with an 0.39 HR/9 IP ratio in 2023, allowing just eight home runs over 184 innings pitched.
- Ranked 2nd in the American League with a 2.79 ERA (3rd in MLB) and was the lowest by a Twins pitcher since Johan Santana posted a 2.77 mark in 2006. Was 20th lowest qualifying ERA in Twins franchise history.
- Tied for first on the Twins staff in games started (32), ranked 2nd in innings pitched (184.0) and 3rd in strikeouts (183).
- Named to the 2023 American League All-Star team. Threw one scoreless inning with a walk and two strikeouts (Ronald Acuña, Jr. & Mookie Betts) in his first All-Star Game appearance, as he did not pitch in his previous two selections in 2015 and 2019.
- Started the Twins Home Opener vs. HOU (4/7) and struck out a career-high 13 batters over 7.0 innings. Set the Twins Home Opener record for strikeouts passing the previous mark of 10 shared by Bert Blyleven vs. CWS in 1974 and Francisco Liriano vs. CLE in 2019.
- Fired a season-high 16.0 inning scoreless streak (4/18-30). Hurlled a season-high 107 pitches vs. NYY (4/24) over 7.0 scoreless innings of three-hit ball.
- Received two runs of support or less in 21-of-32 starts, ranking 3rd-lowest among American League pitchers at 3.91 run support average.

**CAREER**

- Selected by the Oakland Athletics in the 1st round (18th overall) of the 2011 Major League Draft out of Vanderbilt University.
- Is one win shy of 100 career. Is seeking to join the 12 other active MLB pitchers with 100 or more wins, including current teammates Lance Lynn and Kyle Gibson.
- His 3.46 career ERA ranks 6th among active pitchers & 1,526 strikeouts rank 15th.
- Has made seven career starts at Busch Stadium, with four of those being Quality Starts.
