BIRDLAND BITES: The Orioles dropped the series opener against the Rangers last night, 5-2 at Oriole Park...**Gunnar Henderson** tallied his first home run and multi-hit game of the year after going 2-for-4...He also drove in his first two runs of the year...**Rico Garcia** tossed 2.0 perfect innings with three strikeouts in relief...**Adley Rutschman** added his third double of the year, one of eight players across the league with at least two-baggers this season.

👉 Baltimore is 1-1 in series openers this season...The club went 26-26 a year ago in the first game of a series.

👉 The O's have thrown 181 pitches in each of the last two games...Their 362 pitches over the last two days are the most in consecutive nine-inning games since they needed 375 pitches on April 20-22, 2025.

EF-G: **Zach Eflin** is scheduled to make his season debut tonight...He re-signed with the Orioles in the offseason after being acquired in a trade from the Tampa Bay Rays on July 26, 2024...Eflin had three stints on the Injured List last year, including two for low back discomfort, before undergoing successful lumbar microdiscectomy on August 18.

👉 Eflin did not allow a run in 7.1 Grapefruit League starts while surrendering two hits and one walk with 10 strikeouts...He also threw 2.0 scoreless innings on March 15 vs. New York-AL before rain canceled the game.

STRIKE A POSE: Orioles pitching has struck out 42 batters to begin the season, tied for the second-most strikeouts through the first four games of a season with 2016, trailing 2024 (44 K)...Baltimore's 42 punchouts this year are tied for sixth in MLB after the club finished 18th in MLB with 1,351 strikeouts a year ago.

HIGH HEAT: **Ryan Helsley** is averaging 99.7 mph on his four-seamer, one of eight pitchers averaging at least 99.0 mph on a four-seam fastball this season (min. 10 pitches thrown), along with SD's Mason Miller (101.8 mph), LAD's Edgardo Henriquez (100.7 mph), PHI's Jhoan Duran (99.9 mph), COL's Victor Vodnik (99.8 mph), CHC's Daniel Palencia (99.7 mph), SD's Adrian Morejon (99.6 mph), and LAA's José Soriano (99.1 mph).

👉 Helsley threw a 102.1 mph ball to Josh Bell in Sunday's save against Minnesota...Entering play today, it is the fourth-hardest pitch thrown of the MLB season, trailing Mason Miller (102.5 mph - 2x & 102.3 mph).

👉 He's the third Oriole in the *Statcast* era (since 2015) to hit at least 102.1 mph, joining Félix Bautista (2022 & 2023) and Shintaro Fujinami (2023)...In his career, Helsley has hit at least 102.0 mph 101 times, including a career-high 104.2 mph on September 27, 2022.

👉 O's relievers are averaging 95.2 mph on their fastballs this season (4-seam, 2-seam, cutter), the highest average in the AL and sixth-highest in MLB.

WELCOME TO BIRDLAND: Eight players on the Opening Day roster will be making their O's debut or have already: **Blaze Alexander**, **Pete Alonso**, **Chris Bassitt**, **Shane Baz**, **Ryan Helsley**, **Anthony Nunez**, **Leody Taveras**, and **Taylor Ward**...Nunez made his major league debut on Saturday.

👉 Alonso, Bassitt, Helsley, and Taveras signed as free agents, Alexander (AZ), Baz (TB), and Ward (LAA) were acquired via trade during the offseason, while Nunez (NYM) was acquired via trade at last year's trade deadline.

FOR THE BOYS: **Craig Albarnaz** became the eighth Orioles manager, full-time or interim, to win his debut with the team on Thursday...He was hired to be the 22nd manager in Orioles history and 19th full-time manager on October 27, 2025..."Alby" joins Baltimore from the Cleveland Guardians where he served as bench coach (2024) and associate manager (2025) under Stephen Vogt, who won American League Manager of the Year both seasons...Albarnaz also worked under Gabe Kapler with the San Francisco Giants as bullpen coach from 2020-23 after spending his first five seasons as a minor league coach in various roles in the Tampa Bay Rays organization.

👉 New to the coaching staff is **Jason Bourgeois** (First Base Coach), **Miguel Cairo** (Infield Coach), **Hank Conger** (Bullpen Coach), **Donnie Ecker** (Bench Coach), **Dustin Lind** (Hitting Coach), **Brady North** (Assistant Hitting Coach), and **Joe Singley** (Field Coordinator/Catching Coach).

👉 **Buck Britton** (Third Base Coach), **Drew French** (Pitching Coach), **Ryan Klimek** (Pitching Strategy Coach), and **Mitch Plassmeyer** (Assistant Pitching Coach) all return to the staff.

RANGER DANGER: The Birds and Rangers are meeting this week for the first three of six matchups this season...Baltimore travels to Globe Life Field for a three-game set from August 7-9.

👉 The Orioles are 281-228 (.552) against the Rangers since they moved to Texas in 1972, marking the O's fourth-highest winning percentage against any club during that period, trailing the Pirates (20-12, .625), Reds (14-10, .583), and Brewers (208-166, .556).

👉 Texas Lead Hitting Coach **Justin Vele** was drafted out of Santa Clara University (CA) by Baltimore in the 37th round of the 2013 First-Year Player Draft and played a total of three seasons in the O's organization from 2013-14, reaching as high as Class-A Delmarva.

👉 O's First Base Coach **Jason Bourgeois** was selected by the Rangers in the second round of the 2000 First-Year Player Draft out of Forest Brook (TX) High School.

👉 Baltimore's **Grant Wolfram** was selected by Texas in the 18th round of the 2018 First-Year Player Draft...He was previously selected by the Tigers in the 17th round of the 2015 First-Year Player Draft, but did not sign.

ANOTHER ONE: Eflin is scheduled to make his first start of the season and 189th of his career tonight vs. Texas at Camden Yards...Over two Grapefruit League starts this spring, the 31-year-old right hander didn't allow a run over 7.1 innings with two hits, one walk, and 10 strikeouts.

📌 Made 14 starts in 2025, going 6-5 with a 5.93 ERA (47 ER/71.1 IP)...Following the season, signed a one-year major league contract with a mutual option on December 28, 2025.

📌 Had three stints on the 15-day Injured List last year and was transferred to the 60-day IL on August 17, 2025, undergoing successful lower back lumbar microdiscectomy surgery the next day, which ended his season.

📌 On March 27, 2025 at TOR, became the 44th Opening Day starter in Orioles history (since 1954).

TEXAS HOLD 'EM: Eflin is 1-1 with a 6.97 ERA (8 ER/10.1 IP) in two career starts vs. Texas but seven of those earned runs came in a single outing on May 17, 2017 in Arlington...He turned in a quality start in his last outing against the Rangers on April 2, 2024, picking up the win for Tampa Bay with 6.1 innings of one-run ball on five hits, one walk, and five strikeouts.

📌 Eflin's 15 career games (14 GS) against the AL West are his fewest vs. any division, going 7-3 with a 3.91 ERA (34 ER/78.1 IP)...Two of the three teams Eflin has pitched the fewest innings against in his career are from the AL West: Texas and Houston (1.0 IP)...The other is his former team, Philadelphia (7.0 IP).

WALK DON'T RUN: Since making his debut in 2016, Eflin's 4.9 percent walk rate is third lowest among all qualified MLB pitchers during that period behind Miles Mikolas (4.4%) and Zack Greinke (4.8%)...Issued two walks or fewer in 51 consecutive starts from 6/14/22-7/10/24, the eighth-longest streak by any MLB starter since 1901 behind Carlos Silva (99 GS, 2003-07), Cy Young (85 GS, 1904-06), George Kirby (68 GS, 2023-25), Phil Hughes (64 GS, 2014-16), Brad Radke (62 GS, 2003-04), Carl Hubbell (61 GS, 1933-35), and David Wells (59 GS, 2004-07).

BIRDLAND BITES: Eflin was acquired by the O's along with cash considerations from Tampa Bay on July 26, 2024 in exchange for RHP Jackson Baumeister, OF Matthew Etzel, and OF Mac Horvath...He began his Orioles career by winning his first five starts from July 29 to September 1, joining Jack Harshman (1958) as the only Orioles to win each of their first five appearances with the club...Eflin went 5-2 with a 2.60 ERA (16 ER/55.1 IP) in nine starts with the O's following the trade in 2024 and started Game 2 of the ALWCs vs. KC, allowing one run on four hits, one walk, and one hit batter with three strikeouts across 4.0 innings.

📌 Over 23 career starts with Baltimore, Eflin is 11-7 with a 4.48 ERA (63 ER/126.2 IP) and 13 quality starts, but he's dropped his last three decisions with the club dating back to June 16, 2025.

QUICK HITS: Selected by the Padres in the first round (33rd overall) of the 2012 First-Year Player Draft out of Paul J. Hagerty (FL) High School...Committed to the University of Central Florida before signing with San Diego...Has played for three organizations in his career, including Philadelphia (2016-22), Tampa Bay (2023-24), and Baltimore (2024-pres.)...Won 16 games with Tampa Bay in 2023, which tied for the American League lead with fellow Orioles teammate Chris Bassitt...Finished sixth in AL Cy Young voting that season and won the Rays' Paul C. Smith Champion Award, given to the player who best exemplifies the spirit of true professionalism on and off the field.
