BIRD WATCHING: The St. Louis Cardinals have reached the final leg of their longest road trip of the season (11 games in 10 days) as they make their lone series visit of the season to Philadelphia...the Cardinals dropped a 7-6 decision in 10 innings last night in the series opener, evening their season series with the Phillies at 2-2...the Cardinals will need wins both tonight and tomorrow to extend their season-high series winning streak to six...their last series loss came at Toronto July 31-Aug. 2...the Redbirds have gone 5-4 in the 1st nine games of this trip (2-1 at CHC, 3-2 at CIN, 0-1 at PHI)...including tonight's game, the Cardinals have 32 regular season games remaining with 15 at home & 17 on the road.

FLIGHT PATTERN: St. Louis entered play today in 3rd place in the National League Central, 14.5 games behind 1st place Milwaukee; 3.0 games ahead of 4th place Pittsburgh and 3.5 games out of the final National League Wild Card position...the Cardinals are 6-4 in their last 10 games, 12-8 in last 20 and 15-15 in last 30...they are 33-35 vs. teams that are currently above .500 and 33-29 vs. the sub .500 teams.

SEVEN STARTERS: Rookie LHP **Quinn Mathews** will be added to the active roster today and make the start tonight in the rotation spot that was held by **Andre Pallante** (right elbow inflammation) who was placed on the 15-day I.L. prior to last night's game...outside of an "opener" start by **Matt Svanson**, the Cardinals have used just seven starting pitchers this season...the start for Mathews is the 3rd of his young career, with all three coming on the road (at TOR, at CIN, at PHI).

SUITCASE STARTER: With a third consecutive road start to begin his career tonight, **Quinn Mathews** becomes the first Cardinals pitcher (6th all-time) to make his first three starts on the road...the most recent to do so was **Howie Pollet** in 1941 (Aug. 20-28). - *Elias*

BUSY BULLPEN: Starting with a doubleheader on Monday, the Cardinals relief corps has been the busiest in the NL this week, logging 22.2 IP, just shy of the White Sox 25.0 IP in that span...the Cardinals have an MLB co-leading five relievers (Bruhl, Graceffo, O'Brien, Soriano & Stanek) who have appeared in 50 or more games this season, matching the Cleveland Guardians...the Cardinals had a franchise high six relievers appear in 50+ games in 2006, 2010 & 2017.

BANK SHOTS: 2026 MLB HR Derby Champion **Jordan Walker** made his first visit to Citizens Bank Park since All-Star week last night and delivered a 3-hit game that included his 1st career HR at this ball park...the HR was his 3rd in three days and his 27th of the season, matching his career HR total prior to the 2026 season.

UNIQUE FEAT: With his HR last night off of Jesús Luzardo, **Jordan Walker** has now hit each of his first 54 career home runs off of 54 different pitchers - that's the most HR's off of different pitchers to begin a career since **Willy Adames** (2018-21) hit his first 57 career HR's off 57 different pitchers. - *Elias*

POWER SURGE: **Jordan Walker** has homered in three consecutive games for the third time this season, one shy of **Alec Burleson's** team-high four game HR streak...he's the first Cardinal since **Matt Carpenter** (2018) to have had a trio of three-game HR streaks that all took place in road games.

BEWARE OF JWALKERS ON THE ROAD: **Jordan Walker** belted his team-leading 27th HR last night, his 4th HR on the current road trip...JWalk ranks 1st in the NL in Road RBI (66), 2nd in SLG (.569), T-3rd in HR (17) and 4th in OPS (.927).

PHILADELPHIA CONNECTIONS

Jordan Walker won the 2026 Home Run Derby at Citizens Bank Park in Philadelphia with home runs on each of his final six swings to defeat Phillies OF Kyle Schwarber in the finals, 12-11...Walker, **Iván Herrera**, **Riley O'Brien** & **Oliver Marmol** all represented the Cardinals in the 2026 All-Star Game at Citizens Bank Park.

Cardinals President of Baseball Operations **Chaim Bloom** was born in Philadelphia...graduated from Jack M. Barrack Hebrew Academy.

Brant Brown enjoyed a three-homer game on June 18, 1998 vs. the Phillies at Wrigley Field.

Ryne Stanek earned his first career MLB save on Aug. 25, 2019 vs. Philadelphia (with Miami).

Cardinals Assistant Pitching Coach **Kyle Driscoll** is a native of nearby Toms River, N.J.

Gordon Graceffo played college baseball at nearby Villanova Univ. (2019-21)...Graceffo and **Aaron Nola** were teammates on Team Italy in the 2026 WBC.

Jonathan Bowlan's father, **Mark Bowlan**, was selected by St. Louis in the 19th round of the 1989 MLB Draft and played two minor league seasons.

Adolis García signed with St. Louis as an international free agent in 2017 and played in 21 games for the Cardinals in 2018.

Edmundo Sosa signed with the Cardinals as an international free agent (July 2, 2012)...played parts of five seasons in St. Louis (2018-22)...traded to Phillies for JoJo Romero (July 30, 2022).

Bryce Harper received a 2021 Stan Musial Award from the St. Louis Sports Commission for his "graciousness, empathy and sportsmanship" after he was struck in the face by a pitch from St. Louis LHP **Génesis Cabrera** (April 28, 2021 at Busch).

Zack Wheeler underwent thoracic outlet decompression surgery on Sept. 23, 2025 in St. Louis.

Cardinals Hall of Famer and 2026 Buck O'Neil Lifetime Achievement Award winner **Bill White** played three seasons w/ Philadelphia (1966-68)...traded to the Phillies in 1965 and back to St. Louis in 1969.

Phillies Amateur Scouting Director **Brian Barber** was a 1st-round (#22) selection in the 1991 MLB draft by St. Louis from Dr. Phillips (Fla.) High School, same school as **Oliver Marmol**...pitched in 10 games for St. Louis (1995-96).

Hall of Famer **Steve Carlton** signed with St. Louis as an amateur free agent in 1963 and pitched in 190 games (172 starts) for St. Louis for seven seasons from 1965-71 with three All-Star selections ('68, '69, '71)...traded to the Phillies in exchange for **Rick Wise** on Feb. 25, 1972.

Hall of Famer **Scott Rolen** was originally selected by the Phillies in the 2nd round of the 1993 MLB draft...made his MLB debut vs. St. Louis on Aug. 1, 1996(1) and played parts of seven seasons with Philadelphia (1996-2002)...traded to St. Louis with **Doug Nickle** & cash for **Placido Polanco**, **Bud Smith**, & **Mike Timlin** (July 29, 2002).

Phillies Club Ambassador **Milt Thompson** played in 514 games for the Cardinals from 1989-92.

Phillies Visiting Clubhouse Manager **Kevin Steinhour** began his career as a batboy & clubhouse worker for Springfield (A) in the Cardinals organization (1981-87) before serving as Louisville Redbirds (AAA) Equipment Manager (1988-89).

Phillies Senior Advisor, International Scouting **Sal Agostinelli** was selected by St. Louis in the 20th round of the 1983 MLB draft ... played six seasons (1983-88) in the Cardinals minor league system.

Phillies Director, Baseball Strategy **Trey Baur** is a St. Louis native.

Tonight's Starting Pitcher:

- Called up to make his 3rd Major League start, all three have been on the road (8/1 at TOR; 8/17 at CIN-G1).
- Is the first Cardinals pitcher (6th all-time) to make his first three starts of the road. Most recent was Howie Pollet in 1941 (Aug. 20-28). - *Elias Sports Bureau*
- Was appointed as the 27th player in his last start at Cincinnati (8/17-G1).
- Looking for his first Major League win. Hurled 95 pitches over 4.0 innings at CIN (8/17-G1) in a no decision the Cardinals won 2-1.
- Cardinals 4th round draft pick out of Stanford University in 2023.
- 2024 Cardinals and Baseball America Minor League Pitcher of the Year.
- Posted a 5-3 record with a 3.13 ERA over 19 starts at Memphis (AAA), striking out 111 batters over 92.0 innings pitched and a 1.14 WHIP.
- Led the International League in strikeouts (111) and opponent BA (.170); and ranked in the Top 10 in ERA (3.13, 2nd), games started (19, 2nd), innings pitched (92.0, 5th) and WHIP (1.14, 4th) when he was first called up.
- Since the start of 2024, ranks 2nd in all of Minor League Baseball with 437 strikeouts, trailing only the Mets' Jonah Tong (448). Tied for the MiLB lead with 71 starts and ranks 4th in qualifying ERA (3.19).
- Led all of Minor League Baseball with 202 strikeouts in 2024; T-7th most in a single season by any Cardinals minor league pitcher (since 1962).

Last Time Out: Monday, August 17 at Cincinnati: ND, W, 2-1; 4.0 IP, 2 H, 1 R, 1 ER, 3 BB, 7 SO, HR - 95 pitches

- Struck out a career-high 7 over 4.0 innings while throwing a season-high (majors or minors) 95 pitches in a game the Cardinals won 2-1.
- His two hits allowed were both to Dane Myers, a single and a home run.

2026 Season:

When You're Always Right: Has faced 38 plate appearances vs. right-handed batters (7-31, HR, .226) as opposed to 3 PA vs. left-handed batters (1-3, .333).

OH, CANADA!: Was the first Cards starting pitcher to make his Major League debut in Canada since ***Rick Ankiel*** on August 23, 1999 at Montreal's Olympic Stadium vs. the Expos.

Hatched: Became the 8th Cardinal and 5th Cardinals pitcher to make his debut this season.

Walking in Memphis: Began the season in the Memphis (AAA) rotation.

Bull-Ying Durham: Struck out a season-high 10 batters over 7.0 innings in a 7-3 Redbirds win vs. Durham (7/24) the start before his MLB debut.

Summer Loving: Since May 28, has a 4-1 record with a 1.99 ERA and 76 strikeouts over 63.1 innings pitched (10.8 K/9 IP) including a 1.01 WHIP.

Six for the Fix: Made four scoreless starts with three of them 6.0 innings or more with a season-high 7.0 IP, two-hitter at Gwinnett (Braves).

Three Hits in the Fountain: Held his opposition to three hits or less in 15-of-21 starts.

- * Bridged the game to the game to the 9th inning with 2.0 scoreless innings last night; his first app. at CBP since May 2022.
- * His 63.2 innings in relief by a Cardinals LHP are most since **Genesis Cabrera** (70.0) in 2021.
- * **Leads Cardinals and ranks T-4th among MLB LHP with 14 scoreless appearances of four outs or more.**
- * Allowed 2 runs on 3 hits Wed. at CIN, the 2 runs match his total from his previous 12 appearances (12.0 IP) dating back to July 26.
- * Snapped a season-high 6-game scoreless streak since 8/5 at NYY when he allowed a walk-off 2B to **Elly De La Cruz** Mon. in Game 2 at CIN.
- * Suffered his first losing decision at CIN (8/17-G2) with St. Louis (3rd career) and his first since 4/23/22 at SD w/LAD.
