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BIRDLAND BITES:

Baltimore has won both games out of the All-Star break in Houston to extend its season-high winning streak to six games while winning nine of the last 12...Following today's finale with the Astros, the Orioles open a three-game series in Boston on Monday...The club has an off day on Thursday before beginning a three-game series with Atlanta at Camden Yards on Friday...The O's are 9.0 games behind Tampa Bay in the AL East and 2.0 games back in the Wild Card.

🦅

The six-game winning streak matches the longest in 2025 (5/30-6/5) and 2024 (6/7-12)...The 2023 squad won at least six straight games three times, all at least seven games (7 G, 9/2-9; 8 G, 7/5-16; 7 G, 4/16-24).

🦅

After opening the year 13-23 (.361) on the road through June 19, the Orioles are 7-3 away from Camden Yards.

🦅

Baltimore improved to 3-4 in extra innings this season while snapping a three-game losing skid in extras yesterday...Saturday marked the second extra-inning victory on the road this year, joining April 20 at Kansas City (7-5 in 12).

🦅

Cam Sanders earned the save on Saturday after tallying the win on Friday...Since saves became an official statistic in 1969, he's the fourth Oriole to earn a win and a save in his first two pitching appearances with the team, joining Craig Kimbrel (2024), Mickey Weston (1989), and Doyle Alexander (1972).

🦅

Jeremiah Jackson came off the bench yesterday to deliver a go-ahead sacrifice bunt in the 10th inning, his first professional sacrifice bunt in his 693rd career game between the majors and the minors...He's the first Oriole with a go-ahead sacrifice bunt since Richie Martin in the fourth inning on September 23, 2021 vs. Texas, and the eighth Oriole (9th occurrence) since 1954 with a go-ahead sacrifice bunt in extra innings, last done on Jeff Fiorentino's 11th-inning walk-off on October 4, 2009 vs. Toronto.

BRAD TO THE BONE:

The O's agreed to terms on a five-year contract with right-handed pitcher Kyle Bradish yesterday, extending him through 2031...He finished fourth in the AL Cy Young voting in 2023 before undergoing right elbow reconstruction with internal brace on June 19, 2024...Among pitchers with at least 300.0 innings since the start of 2023, Bradish's 3.03 ERA ranks 11th in the majors.

PEN PALS:

The Orioles bullpen has not allowed an earned run in the last five games (18.1 IP)...The only run that has scored during that time was the automatic runner in the 10th inning yesterday.

🦅

Since June 4, O's relievers have combined for a 2.90 ERA (40 ER/124.0 IP) in 37 games...During that period, only the Yankees (2.18), Astros (2.45), and Tigers (2.67) have a better bullpen ERA.

🦅

Andrew Kittredge has not allowed an earned run in 10 games (9.1 IP) since June 24...Since May 18, he's posted a 1.37 ERA (3 ER/19.2 IP) in 22 appearances.

MAKING THEIR PITCH:

The O's have posted a 3.49 ERA in 48 games since May 24, the fourth-best ERA in the majors during that time behind the Tigers (3.15), Red Sox (3.40), and Yankees (3.46).

🦅

The rotation has posted a 3.59 ERA during that period, the fourth-best starter ERA in the AL and sixth best in the majors.

CATCH THIS:

The Orioles have received 71 RBI from players at catcher, the most by a team in the majors this year ahead of the Brewers (64) and Royals (62)...The club's catchers have combined to rank among all MLB team's catchers in slugging percentage (3rd, .478), home runs (T-3rd, 19), doubles (4th, 21), hits (T-4th, 95), and batting average (5th, .259).

🦅

Defensively, the O's lead the majors with 24 catcher caught stealings while posting a 69.2 percent stolen base percentage against (no pitcher CS) behind the Brewers (67.3%).

WALKING IT OUT:

Baltimore has drawn at least one walk in 90 straight games since April 6, the longest active streak in the majors ahead of the Mets (31 G)...The Orioles have drawn multiple walks in a season-high 19 straight games, their longest run since a 21-game stretch from July 20-August 10, 2024.

🦅

Taylor Ward has drawn a free pass in eight straight games, the longest active streak in MLB...He also drew a walk in nine straight earlier this season from April 20-30, which trails only ATH's Nick Kurtz (20 G) for the longest such streak in the majors this year.

🦅

Ward has 77 walks this season, 15 more than an Oriole had in 2025 and one fewer than the team leader had in 2024...The last O's player with more than 78 walks in a season was **Adley Rutschman** (92 BB) in 2023...An Oriole has not reached 100 free passes in a season since Albert Belle (101) in 1999.

🦅

The Birds have been held without a free pass only once this season (4/5 at PIT).

🦅

Overall, the O's lead the AL and rank fourth in MLB with 381 walks.

FOR PETE'S SAKE:

Pete Alonso is tied for third in the AL and is tied for eighth in the majors with 66 RBI...He is batting .271/.364/.514 (68-for-251) with 10 doubles, 17 homers, 43 runs, 53 RBI, 36 walks, and three hit-by-pitches in 68 games since May 1.

🦅

Alonso became the 21st player (28th occurrence) in Orioles history to hit at least 20 homers before the All-Star break and the first since **Gunnar Henderson** (28) and Anthony Santander (24) in 2024.

🦅

He also became the 24th player (31st occurrence) in O's history to drive in 60 runs before the All-Star break and the first since **Gunnar Henderson** (63) in 2024...His 65 RBI pre-break were the most by an Oriole since Manny Machado (65) in 2018.

🦅

Alonso played in his 500th consecutive game on June 27 vs. Washington and he has played 515 straight games, trailing ATL's Matt Olson (879 G) among active players...According to the *Elias Sports Bureau*, he is one of 39 players since 1900 to play in at least 500 consecutive games.

PHILLY PHILLY:

Adley Rutschman was named to the 2026 All-Star Game, earning his third career selection (2023 & 2024)...He entered in the seventh inning as a defensive replacement, grounding out in the eighth inning in his only at-bat.

🦅

Rutschman is the fourth catcher in Orioles history (since 1954) to earn multiple All-Star Game selections, joining Matt Wieters (4), Gus Triandos (3), and Andy Etchebarren (2).

🦅

According to the *Elias Sports Bureau*, Rutschman is one of six catchers in MLB to earn at least three All-Star Game selections in their first five full seasons since 1990, joining Brian McCann (4), Mike Piazza (4), Ivan Rodríguez (4), Jason Kendall (3), and Salvador Perez (3).

THIS DATE IN O'S HISTORY

July 19, 1991 -Playing in his 1,500th consecutive game, Cal Ripken, Jr. hits his 20th home run of the season in a 4-1 win over Seattle at Camden Yards. Ripken becomes only the eighth player to hit 20 or more homers in his first 10 big league seasons.

July 19, 2008 - Luke Scott's one-out blast in the 10th inning becomes the first walk-off homer to land on Eutaw Street in the 16-year history of the ballpark.

QUICK HITS: Young is set to make his 16th start of the season and the 28th of his career today in the series finale at Houston...Was recalled from Triple-A Norfolk for the second time this year on April 23... Was optioned to minor league camp on March 7 after making two Grapefruit League appearances...Signed with the Orioles as a non-drafted free agent on June 14, 2020.

LAST TIME OUT: Didn't factor into the decision of a 5-3 win on July 10 vs. Kansas City after allowing three runs on eight hits, a season-high-tying two home runs (also 4/30 [G2] vs. HOU), and one walk in 7.0 innings pitched with five strikeouts...Marked his seventh quality start...Threw 85 pitches, 59 strikes.
⚡ Completed 7.0+ innings for the third time in his career (last: 6/10/26 vs. SEA).
⚡ Has struck out at least five batters in four consecutive outings since June 21 for the first time in his career.

HOMETOWN KID: Young is 1-2 with a 5.71 ERA (11 ER/17.1 IP) over three career starts opposite Houston, which is located approximately 100 miles southwest from his hometown of Lumberton, Texas...Last faced the Astros on April 30 (G2) at Camden Yards and suffered the loss, allowing a career-high 10 runs (4 ER) on nine hits (2 HR) and two walks in 4.0 innings pitched with two strikeouts.
⚡ In his lone start at Daikin Park on August 15, 2025, earned his first career win, tossing a career-high 8.0 scoreless innings, allowing one hit with zero walks and six strikeouts...He was perfect through 7.2 frames before Ramón Urías tallied an infield single, marking the longest perfect-game bid by an Oriole since Mike Mussina threw 7.2 perfect innings on August 4, 1998 vs. Detroit.
⚡ Over eight career starts against the AL West, Young is 2-6 with a 5.88 ERA (27 ER/41.1 IP) and three quality starts...The 5.88 ERA is his second-highest mark vs. any division ahead of the NL East (5.92).

HERE, THERE, AND EVERYWHERE: Young's 34.8 percent chase rate is a 7.0 percent increase from 2025 (27.8%)...It's the ninth-best mark in MLB (min. 75.0 IP) and the third-best rate in the AL behind TEX's Nathan Eovaldi (36.8%) and DET's Tarik Skubal (36.3%).

PLATOON: Young has allowed a .226/.268/.302 (12-for-53) slash line to righties over his last six starts since June 10 with four doubles, three walks, and 15 strikeouts...Prior to that, right-handed hitters slashed .309/.352/.420 (25-for-81) with three doubles, two home runs, six walks, and 20 strikeouts off Young over his first nine starts of the season.
⚡ However, lefties have slashed .349/.404/.674 (15-for-43) over his last three starts since June 27 with three doubles, one triple, three home runs, four walks, and 12 strikeouts...Held left-handed batters to a .209/.294/.331 (31-for-148) slash line over his first 12 starts of the year with six doubles, four home runs, 18 walks, and 20 strikeouts.

SWEET VICTORY: Baltimore is 12-3 (.800) in games started by Young this season after going 3-9 (.250) in 2025...That included a seven-game winning streak from May 6-June 10, over which he went 3-0 with a 2.59 ERA (12 ER/41.2 IP) and five quality starts.
⚡ Young is 7-2 (.778) in 15 starts this season...The .778 winning percentage is the third-highest mark among AL starters (min. 75.0 IP) behind BOS' Sonny Gray (11-1, .917) and TB's Nick Martinez (8-2, .800).

VELO UPTICK: Young's average fastball has climbed to 94.1 mph in 2026, up 1.6 miles per hour from 2025 (92.5 mph)...The 1.6 mph increase is the fifth-highest year-over-year increase by any pitcher in MLB this season, trailing LAA's Ryan Zeferjahn (+2.2 mph), SD's Adrian Morejon (+1.9 mph), CWS' Sean Newcomb (+1.8 mph), and ATH's Hogan Harris (+1.7 mph).
⚡ He has limited the opposition to a .197/.301/.354 (25-for-127) slash line with five doubles and five home runs on his four-seam fastball this season...In 2025, opponents slashed .277/.336/.396 (28-for-101) on the pitch with six doubles and two home runs.

THEM CHANGES: Young is averaging 83.1 mph and 1,368 revolutions per minute (RPM) on his split finger over his last nine starts since May 24 (G1), during which opponents are hitting .239 (11-for-46) with one double, one triple, and one home run...Over his first six starts of the season his splitter averaged 87.7 mph and 1,501 RPM, with opponents hitting .476 (10-for-21) off it with three doubles.
⚡ Last season opponents hit .281 (18-for-64) off his split finger with six doubles and five home runs...Threw the pitch 17.8 percent of the time in 2025 compared to 20.0 percent this season, marking a 2.2 percent increase in usage.
⚡ However, has thrown his splitter just 11.8 percent of the time (22 pitches) over two starts this month with opponents going 5-for-6 (.833) on the pitch with a triple and home run.

His 61.3 percent ground ball rate is fifth lowest in MLB (min. 30.0 IP)

His 33 total bases allowed are tied for third fewest among all AL relievers (min. 30 G) with BOS' Aroldis Chapman and CLE's Erik Sabrowski behind CLE's Colin Holderman (25 TB) and TB's Bryan Baker (31 TB)

Allowed a season-high-tying two earned runs on 6/29 vs. CWS (also 5/29 vs. TOR), marking his only earned runs allowed since the start of June...Gave up 4+ hits for the first time since 9/26/25 at NYY (also 4 H)

Holding hitters to a .169 (10-for-59) average on his sinker, the lowest of his career below his previous best in 2023 (.243)
