THIS DATE IN ASTROS HISTORY AUG. 4
1991 - The Astros turn their eighth triple play in franchise history in a 2-1 walkoff win in 10 innings vs. the Dodgers... LHP Jim Deshaies is the beneficiary after inducing a foul pop up to SS Alfredo Griffín ...two Dodgers are thrown out advancing on the play to end the 5th inning... Houston wins on a walkoff single by C Craig Biggio in the 10th.

TONIGHT'S GAME: The first-place Astros, who had their six-game winning streak snapped last night, will look to begin a new streak tonight in the middle game of their three-game series against the Blue Jays...**RHP Hayden Wesneski** (1-0) will make his second Major league start of the season in his return from Tommy John surgery, this time opposite **RHP Trey Yesavage** (5-5) and the Blue Jays.

BIG WES: After missing 14 months with injury, **RHP Hayden Wesneski** made his return to a big league mound his last time out, on July 29 at LAA (3ER/5.2IP), earning the win over the Angels...this solid start continued a strong run for Wesneski, who was great in his rehab appearances, posting a 2.25 (5ER/20IP) combined ERA in five minor league rehab starts.

WINNING WAYS: Even with last night's loss, the Astros have won 11 of their last 13 games...the Astros are two games over .500, and lead the AL West by 2.5 games over the Rangers and Mariners, who both enter tonight with identical 55-58 records.

THE TURNAROUND: After a slow start to the season, the Astros are 38-25 since May 22, which is the second-best record in the AL in that span...on that date, the Astros were 20-31, 11 games under, which is their low water mark for the season.

THAT'S OFFENSIVE: The Astros rank second in the AL in home runs (155) and third in runs scored (529), just behind the Twins (532) and White Sox (531)...also among AL clubs, the Astros rank first in slugging (.416) and in OPS (.737), and second in batting average (.246), OBP (.321) and hits (946).

LOS ASTROS: Space City Home Network will televise this series in English and Spanish with the Spanish broadcast being televised on SCHN2... **Enrique Vasquez** and **Gene Flores** will be on the call on the Spanish telecast this series.

AYA IN ACTION: The Astros Youth Academy had two teams qualify for the Nike RBI World Series, which will be played in Vero Beach, FL, beginning today...the Astros Junior Baseball Team is seeking its first Nike RBI World Series Championship, while the Astros Softball Team is seeking its sixth Nike RBI World Series Championship.

ASTROS-JAYS: The Astros have played just 89 games against the Blue Jays in their franchise history, which are their fewest against any single opponent...their .562 all-time winning percentage against the Blue Jays is their third-highest against any opponent, bested only by their record against the Angels (144-92, .610) and Tigers (57-44, .564).

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Astros had their six-game winning streak snapped last night in a 3-1 loss to the Blue Jays, despite outhitting the Jays 10-7...**2B Jose Altuve**, **C Yainer Díaz** and **RF Cam Smith** all went 2x4 on the night...**RHP Cristian Javier** (3ER/6IP) started for Houston, receiving the loss after tossing the quality start.

YESTERDAY'S MOVES: The Astros made one trade yesterday, acquiring **OF Daulton Varsho** and cash from the Blue Jays in exchange for **RHP Spencer Arrighetti**...the Astros activated Varsho last night and optioned **OF Lucas Spence** to Triple A.

JULY HONORS: Announced yesterday, **DH Yordan Alvarez** was named the AL Player of the Month for July...this marks the fourth career AL Player of the Month Award for Alvarez and his second in 2026...in July, Alvarez hit .360 (31x86) with nine HR, 22 RBI, a .467 OBP, a .721 SLG, and a 1.188 OPS in 23 games.

MVP-CALIBER: **Yordan Alvarez** leads the AL in all three Triple Crown categories, ranking first in batting average (.330), HR (35), and RBI (84)...additionally, he leads MLB in OPS (1.091), OBP (.443), SLG (.648), extra-base hits (59), and TB (263)...in the AL, he ranks first in hits (134) and runs (77), and tied for second in walks (79)...AL leaders below:

HEAVY TRAFFIC: **DH Yordan Alvarez** has reached base safely in 19 straight games (since July 10), batting .433 (29x67) with 15 runs, eight doubles, six home runs, 17 RBI, 20 walks, a .568 OBP and a 1.389 OPS during the streak...Alvarez also has on-base streaks of 25 games (May 22-June 19) and 22 games (April 4-28) this season.

GOOD INTENTIONS: **DH Yordan Alvarez** has been intentionally walked 23 times this season, by far the most in the Majors...Alvarez's 23 intentional walks are the third-highest total in a single season by an Astros player in club history, trailing only seasons produced by **1B Jeff Bagwell** (27 IBB in 1997) and **OF Rusty Staub** (24 IBB in 1968).

STREAKING: **SS Jeremy Peña** is on a career-high 15-game hitting streak, in which he's hit .422 (27x64) with three doubles, one triple, seven homers, 15 RBI and a 1.292 OPS...Peña's streak is the longest active streak in the Majors, and is the longest streak by an Astro since **3B Alex Bregman** had a 16-game streak from May 28-June 15, 2024.

WHAT A RELIEF: **LHP Josh Hader**, who is 15-for-15 in save chances with a 1.17 ERA, recorded his 77th career save as an Astro on Saturday, moving him past **RHP Fred Gladding** (76) for fifth place in saves all-time among Astros relievers...he now trails **RHP Ryan Pressly** (111) for fourth on that all-time list.

STALKING 500: **RHP Bryan Abreu** has 499 career strikeouts, needing just one strikeout to reach 500 for his career...he would become just the fourth reliever in franchise history to record 500 strikeouts with the club, joining **LHP Billy Wagner** (694), **RHP Brad Lidge** (557) and **RHP Dave Smith** (529).

MINOR LEAGUE HONORS: Earlier today, **IF Waner Luciano** and **RHP Bryce Mayer** were named the Astros minor league Player and Pitcher of the Month for July...Luciano, 21, hit .316 (24x76) with 20 RBI, nine stolen bases and a 1.021 OPS in 22 games in July with Class A Fayetteville...Mayer, 24, the Astros top pitching prospect, went 2-0 with a 0.47 ERA (1ER/19IP) in July with Double A Corpus Christi.

LAST START, JULY 29 at LAA: In his Major League start of the season, he allowed 3 runs on 7 hits and 2 walks with 4 strikeouts in 5.2 innings...also earned the win after the Astros defeat the Angels, 7-4 at Angel Stadium.

ABOUT WESNESKI: For his career he's recorded a 4.03 ERA (102ER/227.2IP) with 216 strikeouts, a 1.17 WHIP and a .230 opponent batting average in 75 appearances, including 29 starts....was reinstated from the 60-day IL on July 29.

RETURN OF THE WEZ: Underwent Tommy John surgery on May 23, 2025...returned to the mound to begin his rehab appearances on June 30, 2026, with the FCL Astros (3IP)...advanced to Double A Corpus Christi for 1 start, then made 3 starts for Triple A Sugar Land...combined to post a 2.25 ERA (5ER/20IP) in his 5 rehab appearances...struck out 21 in his 20.0 innings, allowed a .211 opponent average, and posted a 1.00 WHIP...walked just 4 hitters across his 5 rehab starts.

AGAINST THE JAYS: Has made only 1 relief appearance against Toronto in his career...the relief appearance occurred on Aug. 13, 2023, where he allowed 1 hit and 2 walks with 3 strikeouts in 2.0 scoreless innings.

WESNESKI IN 2025: Began last season in the Astros starting rotation and went on to make 6 starts, going 1-3 with a 4.50 ERA (16ER/32IP) prior to his injury...had a couple strong starts, tossing a career-high-tying 7.0 innings on April 7 at SEA, and fanning a career-high 10 hitters on April 13 vs. LAA.

TRADE WINDS: Acquired by the Astros from the Cubs on Dec. 13, 2024 as part of the return for All-Star **OF Kyle Tucker**...the Astros received Wesneski, **3B Isaac Paredes** and **RF Cam Smith** in that trade.

HOUSTON'S OWN: Wesneski was born in Houston, TX, and raised in Cypress, TX, which is about a 25-mile drive northwest of downtown Houston...grew up an Astros fan with **RHP Roy Oswalt** as his favorite player...he graduated from Cy Fair HS, then went onto nearby Sam Houston State, where he pitched for 3 seasons...was selected by the Yankees in the 6th round of the 2019 MLB draft...was traded twice after his selection, first by the Yankees to the Cubs, then by the Cubs to the Astros.

WHAT'S A BEARKAT ANYWAY?: Is one of the most-accomplished pitchers in Sam Houston State history...went 25-9 with a 3.56 ERA and 224 strikeouts (288.0 IP) in 3 years with the Bearkats (2017-19)...his 224 career strikeouts rank 4th all-time in program history...other notable Bearkats include Astros radio broadcaster **Steve Sparks** and Astros 2024 first-round pick **C Walker Janek**.

LAST APPEARANCE (8/2 vs. TEX): Notched his 3rd win of the season, working a scoreless 0.2 of an inning with 1 walk and 2 strikeouts on Sunday vs. TEX...struck out IF Nicky Lopez looking to end the 7th inning with runners at 1st and 2nd and the game tied at 3-3.

MILESTONE MARKERS: Is currently at 499 career strikeouts and is seeking to become the 4th reliever in Astros history to record 500 strikeouts with the club, joining LHP Billy Wagner (694), RHP Brad Lidge (557) and RHP Dave Smith (529)...logged his 349th career appearance on July 1 vs. MIN, surpassing LHP Joe Sambito for the 5th-most relief appearances in Astros history.

HEAT OF THE SUMMER: Over his last 15 appearances (since June 20), he's posted a 1.17 ERA (2ER/15.1IP) with 18 strikeouts, a .137 opponen batting average and a 0.78 WHIP...ranks 11th among AL relievers in opponent batting average in that span (min. 15 IP).

TURNING THE PAGE: Since May 3, he has gone 3-1-6 with a 2.08 ERA (7ER/30.1IP)...has also recorded 35 strikeouts, a 1.05 WHIP and a .176 opponent batting average during the stretch...within these apps., he logged 9 consecutive scoreless outings (8.2 IP) from May 3-28...his 9-game scoreless streak is T-3rd-longest by an Astro this season, behind LHP Steven Okert's (14-game streak and 10-game streak)...prior to May 3, Abreu had a 12.54 ERA in his first 11 apps. of the season.

VS. TOR: In 14 career appearances vs. the Blue Jays, he's posted a 1.76 ERA (3ER/15.1IP) with 20 strikeouts, a .185 opponent batting average and a 0.98 WHIP...has been scoreless in 9 of his last 10 appearances vs. the Blue Jays (since April 18, 2023).

AT DAIKIN: Has made 178 career appearances at Daikin Park...is 1 app. from tying RHP Ryan Pressly (179 apps.) for the 3rd-most in the venue's history...his 262 strikeouts at Daikin Park trail only RHP Brad Lidge (287) for the most by a reliever in the venue's history...also has 191.2 IP in his career at Daikin Park, recently surpassing Octavio Dotel (190.1) for the 3rd-most innings pitched by a reliever in the venue's history.

CAREER: In 360 career games with the Astros, he's recorded a 2.85 ERA (117ER/369.1IP) with 499 strikeouts, a 1.20 WHIP, a 12.16 K/9 and a 0.78 HR/9...since 2019, he ranks 1st in strikeouts and 2nd in appearances among AL relievers.

LAST APPEARANCE (8/2 vs. TEX): Recorded his 1st career save, working a perfect 1.1 innings with 1 strikeout to finish out Sunday's sweep vs. TEX...also stranded both of his inherited runners and his 18.2% inherited runners scored rate this season ranks 9th in the AL (min. 50 IP).

CENTURY MARK: Surpassed 100 career innings in his outing on Fri. night vs. TEX...his 69.2 innings this season are the most by an Astros reliever through their first 42 apps. of a season since RHP Chris Devenski tossed 82.1 innings in that span in 2016.

TWO STRONG: Ranks T-1st among MLB relievers with 12 scoreless outings of 2.0+ innings this season...they are also the most scoreless appearances of 2.0+ innings in a single season by an Astros reliever since RHP Chris Devenski logged 15 such appearances in 2016.
