THE TWINS: After completing their six-game roadtrip with a record of 2-4 (0-3 at Cleveland, 2-1 at Washington), the Twins began their seven-game homestand with consecutive wins over the Rangers on Friday night and Saturday afternoon...Minnesota will continue the homestand today with the three-game series finale vs. Texas...the homestand will continue tomorrow afternoon with the first of four against the Royals through Thursday.

☞ Minnesota has gone 21-10 in their last 31 games since April 22, tied with Kansas City (21-10) for the third-most wins in baseball since that date, trailing Philadelphia (24-7) and New York-AL (22-10).

☞ The Twins are 13-11 at home this season, including a record of 11-5 in their last 16 here.

I'LL TAKE GAME WINNING HOMERS FOR THREE RUNS, ALEX: The Twins beat the Rangers yesterday afternoon by a score of 5-3, securing the series victory, making them 9-6-2 in series play...Chris Paddack was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing two runs on four hits in 5.0 innings pitched, with no walks and three strikeouts...Cole Sands (2-0) was named the winner, pitching 2.0 perfect innings of relief, while Jhoan Duran earned his sixth save with a perfect ninth inning...the offense recorded seven hits, including two from Alex Kirilloff, who hit the go-ahead three-run jimmy jack in the bottom of the eighth inning...the attendance was announced at 30,957, marking the Twins' third time this season passing the 30k mark.

MAX PRODUCTION: Max Kepler is hitting .360 (32-for-89) with 12 doubles, four home runs, 10 walks, 18 RBI, a .426 on-base percentage, a .629 slugging percentage and a 1.055 OPS in his last 28 games, dating back to April 22...since that date, he ranks second in baseball in batting average, fourth in OPS, and sixth in slugging percentage, and on-base percentage.

☞ Kepler has 10 doubles this month, trailing only Aaron Judge (12) for the most in baseball.

☞ He is hitting .317 (19-for-60) with a .388 OBP and a .921 OPS in 18 home games this season.

TEXAS TWO STOMP: The Twins are 7-2 against the Rangers since the start of 2023, outscoring them 55-38...the next meeting between these two will be in four games at Globe Life Field from August 15-18.

☞ Since the start of 2021, 19 of 23 games between these two have been decided by three runs-or-fewer, while 11 games have been decided by one run.

☞ Since the start of 2019, the Twins have scored 5.5 runs-per-game in 30 games against the Rangers...marks the second most against any AL club in that span, trailing Seattle (5.9).

☞ Carlos Correa has 21 career home runs vs. the Rangers (107 games), his most against any opponent...21 homers are the fourth most among actives, trailing Mike Trout (44), Jose Altuve (34) and George Springer (28).

☞ Max Kepler is hitting .351 (20-for-57) with a .913 OPS in his last 17 games vs. Texas.

☞ Ryan Jeffers is hitting .343 (12-for-35) with two doubles, three home runs, 13 RBI and a 1.072 OPS in 11 career games vs. Texas.

☞ The Twins have gone 8-1 vs. AL West opponents, going 3-0 at Los Angeles, 3-1 vs. Seattle and 2-0 vs. Texas.

COWBOY JACKS: The Twins have homered in nine consecutive games against the Rangers, their second-longest active homer streak against any team...their current long is 10 against Washington...during this nine-game stretch, the Twins have homered 17 times off Texas pitching.

FASHIONABLY LATE: The Twins scored four of their five runs yesterday afternoon after the sixth inning...Minnesota has scored 98 of their 228 runs from the seventh inning-or-later, accounting for 43% of their runs scored...the 98 runs scored are tied with San Francisco for most in baseball...Minnesota has scored 38 runs in the seventh inning, 21 runs in the eighth inning and eight in extra innings.

MIRANDA WATCH!: Jose Miranda is hitting .325 (26-for-80) with seven doubles, three home runs, nine RBI, a .357 on-base percentage, a .525 slugging percentage and an .882 OPS in his last 23 games.

SWEEPING SUCCESS: Minnesota is seeking its fourth sweep of the season today...they are 3-2 when entering the final game with a chance to sweep...their other three sweeps were four games against Chicago-AL from April 22-25, three games at Los Angeles-AL from April 26-28 and three games at Chicago-AL from April 29-May 1...Twins had six sweeps in 2023.

☞ Minnesota's last sweep of Texas came in three games at Globe Life Field from June 18-20, 2021...their last sweep of Texas in Minneapolis came in three games from September 3-5, 2010.

ROYCE ON REHAB: Royce Lewis played in his first game on rehab assignment last night for Triple-A St. Paul in Buffalo, going 1-for-4 with a single, stolen base, strikeout and run scored as the club's designated hitter...St. Paul plays in Buffalo today at 12:05 pm (CT)...Lewis was injured on Opening Day, March 28 at Kansas City, while running the bases and has missed the club's last 50 games with a right quad strain.

KEASCHALL AND CULPEPPER GET THEIR ROLL ON: High-A Cedar Rapids infielder Luke Keaschall and right-handed pitcher C.J. Culpepper have been named Twins minor league Player and Pitcher of the Week.

☞ Keaschall, 21, played in six games for theernels, hitting .500 (12-for-24) with two doubles, three home runs, seven RBI and a 1.545 OPS...the Watsonville, California native was selected by the Twins in the second round (49th overall) in the 2023 First-Year Player Draft out of Arizona State University...he is ranked as the club's ninth-best prospect, per MLB.com.

☞ Culpepper, 22, made the start for the kernels on Thursday at Peoria, pitching 6.0 perfect innings, with eight strikeouts, retiring all 18 batters he faced...the Upland, California native was selected by the Twins in the 13th round of the 2022 First-Year Player Draft out of California Baptist University...Culpepper is ranked as the club's eighth-best prospect, per MLB.com — fourth among pitchers.

LAST TIME OUT: Last pitched May 20 at Washington, opposite Mitchell Parker, and took the loss in Minnesota's 12-3 defeat...allowed seven runs on eight hits (2 HR) in 5.0 innings with one walk and five strikeouts...allowed first two runs on a second-inning home run by Luis García Jr....struck out the side in a 1-2-3 third...Jesse Winker added a solo shot in the fourth...Washington scored four more runs on five hits and a walk in the fifth inning.

- ☞ Seven runs tied for his most allowed in a start with Minnesota (7/15/23 at OAK).
- ☞ Induced nine whiffs on 44 swings (20.5%)...his 28.7 percent whiff rate ranks in MLB's 73rd percentile.
- ☞ Allowed six hard-hit balls (95.0+ mph); Washington went 2-for-6 with two home runs on those swings...ranks in MLB's 45th percentile with a 38.8 percent hard-hit rate.

TWO STARTS AGO: Started May 15 vs. New York-AL, opposite Marcus Stroman, and took his third loss of the season as the Twins were shut out, 4-0...allowed three runs on a season-high 10 hits in 6.1 innings with no walks and three strikeouts...first run came on Aaron Judge's first-inning solo home run – the longest (467 ft.) and hardest-hit (113.0 mph) ball off López this season...Anthony Volpe added a run on a second-inning sacrifice fly, and Giancarlo Stanton on a third-inning RBI single...eight of 10 hits off López came in innings 1-3.

- ☞ Induced 10 whiffs on 52 swings (19.2%).
- ☞ Allowed eight hard-hit balls; Yankees went 5-for-8 with the Judge home run and three doubles on those swings.

TRACK RECORD VS. TEXAS: Has made two career starts vs. Texas, going 0-1 with a 9.00 ERA (10.0 IP, 10 ER), four walks and 10 strikeouts...first faced Texas with Miami on July 21, 2022, allowing five runs on five hits in 5.0-inning loss...second matchup came August 24, 2023, when he allowed five runs on 10 hits – including a career-high-tying three home runs – in 5.0-inning no-decision.

- ☞ Has surrendered home runs to Marcus Semien, Corey Seager, Adolis García and Leody Taveras; all four remain on Texas's active roster.

HOME/ROAD SPLITS: Making sixth home start of 2024...has gone 2-2 with a 3.49 ERA (28.1 IP, 11 ER), 1.16 WHIP and 9.21 strikeouts-per-9.0 innings at home, compared to 2-2 with a 6.00 ERA (27.0 IP, 18 ER), 1.07 WHIP and 11.3 K/9 in five road starts...has allowed a .338 batting average on balls in play at home, compared to .270 on the road.

- ☞ Has allowed nine home runs – two at home and seven on the road.

LEFT/RIGHT SPLITS: On May 20, Washington's left-handed hitters went 5-for-15 with a double, two home runs and three strikeouts vs. López, while its righties went 3-for-8 with two strikeouts...through 10 games vs. López, lefties have hit .248 (29-for-117) with a .698 OPS, 26.0 percent strikeout rate and 4.0 percent home run rate, while righties have hit .250 (24-for-96) with a .739 OPS, 30.1 percent strikeout rate and 3.0 percent home run rate.

- ☞ Has allowed a 33.7 percent hard-hit rate to lefties, 45.5 percent to righties.
- ☞ Of the 70 right-handed pitchers who've thrown 750-or-more total pitches this season, López's 30.1 percent strikeout rate vs. right-handed hitters ranks ninth highest.

- ☞ On May 20, Washington went 2-for-9 with four strikeouts – and six whiffs on 13 swings – vs. López's sweeper...pitch has a 35.2 percent whiff rate this season.
- ☞ Sweeper's .277 batting average against compares to .216 expected batting average...its .511 slugging percentage compares to .328 expected slugging.
- ☞ Sweeper is averaging 11.7 inches of glove-side horizontal break, compared to 13.2 inches in 2023...opponents hit .173 vs. the pitch last season.
- ☞ In two-strike counts, opponents have hit .106 (5-for-47) with 25 strikeouts vs. López's 4-seamer.
- ☞ Right-handed hitters have hit .143 (1-for-7) with a 38.9 percent whiff rate vs. López's changeup.

FEW FREE PASSES: Among qualified MLB pitchers, his 1.46 walks-per-9.0-innings are tied with Zack Littell for seventh lowest...owns a career-best 4.0 percent walk rate; compares to 6.0 percent in 2023 and 2024 MLB average of 8.4 percent...has issued two total walks in four starts this month...has the third-highest strikeout-to-walk-ratio (5.21) of the 25 pitchers to start 40-or-more games since the beginning of 2023, trailing only George Kirby (9.16) and Zach Eflin (8.21).

- ☞ Acquired from Miami on January 20 along with prospects José Salas and Byron Chourio.
- ☞ Threw 5.1 scoreless innings and won Opening Day start March 30 at Kansas City.
- ☞ Signed four-year extension April 21, keeping him under contract through 2027 season.
- ☞ Tossed first career complete-game shutout with 12 strikeouts vs. Kansas City on July 5.
- ☞ Selected to first All-Star team, pitching a scoreless ninth inning with two strikeouts.
- ☞ Set another career-high with 14 strikeouts September 10 vs. New York-NL, throwing eight scoreless frames in a 2-0 loss.
- ☞ Ranked in 98th percentile in baseball in pitching run value (26), 95th percentile in chase percentage (34.3%), 93rd percentile in xERA (3.00).
- ☞ Earned first Cy Young Award votes of his career and finished seventh in AL voting.
- ☞ Won Game 1 of ALWCWS vs. Toronto on October 3 at Target Field, throwing 5.2 innings as Minnesota snapped an 18-game Postseason losing streak.
- ☞ Threw 7.0 shutout frames in Game 2 of the ALDS at Houston, earning Minnesota's only win of the series.

TOMORROW'S STARTER - RHP JOE RYAN (2024: 3-3, 3.15 ERA // CAREER: 29-22, 3.92 ERA)

Joe Ryan is scheduled to start tomorrow afternoon's series opener vs. Kansas City...last pitched May 21 at Washington and earned the win in Minnesota's 10-0 victory, allowing three hits in 7.0 shutout innings, with two walks and six strikeouts...has made seven career starts vs. Kansas City, going 5-0 with a 1.52 ERA (41.1 IP, 7 ER), 11 walks and 46 strikeouts...the five wins are his most vs. any opponent...faced Kansas City in his 2024 season debut March 30 at Kauffman Stadium, allowing one run on three hits in 5.1-inning no-decision; Twins won, 5-1.
