♣ Minnesota has gone 21-10 in their last 31 games since April 22, tied with Kansas City (21-10) for the third-most wins in baseball since that date, trailing Philadelphia (24-7) and New York-AL (22-10).

♣ The Twins are 13-11 at home this season, including a record of 11-5 in their last 16 here.
