Olson Extra Bases

Matt Olson reached base two more times yesterday afternoon, drawing a walk in the first and doubling in the third.

Olson has five extra-base hits over the first three games of this series, and his seven total extra-base hits on the season are tied with Houston's Christian Walker for most in the majors.

Since he joined Atlanta prior to the 2022 season, Olson's 308 total extra-base hits are by far the most in the National League, and trail just Shohei Ohtani (337) and Aaron Judge (326) in baseball. Freddie Freeman, with 289, ranks second in the NL. Olson's 441 total RBI over those five seasons also rank third in the majors.

Olson has already accumulated 0.8 bWAR through Atlanta's first nine games, fifth most by a position player in the majors. His 21.5 total bWAR since that 2022 season rank 10th in all of baseball, and are the most by any primary first baseman.

TODAY'S GAME: The Braves and D-backs today conclude a four-game weekend series with what is the fourth of seven scheduled meetings between the clubs this season...The two are set to meet next with three games at Truist Park in Atlanta, August 14-16.

- A* The Braves yielded a pair of unearned runs in yesterday's second inning and ultimately dropped the third game of this series, 2-1...A win today would clinch the series for Atlanta.
- A* Atlanta went just 2-4 against Arizona last season, dropping the season series for the first time since 2019...The Braves won both of the first two games before losing each of the last four.
- A* Both of Atlanta's wins over Arizona last season came here at Chase Field, and the club is 56-43 (.566) all-time here since the facility opened in 1998...The Braves' .566 winning percentage here is the second best of any NL team behind just St. Louis (53-40, .570), while Atlanta's 3.84 ERA in this building is the best of any team in baseball.

A RH Brandon Pfaadt has made four starts versus Atlanta in his career, and is a perfect 2-0 with a 5.66 ERA (13 ER/20.2 IP) against the club... The 6-foot-4, 220-pound Louisville native faced Atlanta twice last season and allowed nine total runs over 9.0 innings between the turns, although Arizona won both games...The right-hander was tagged for six hits and five runs over 6.0 innings in a no-decision in his first start this season, March 31 vs. Detroit.

MARTÍN PÉREZ: Set today to make his first start and second appearance of the season...Made his Braves debut last Tuesday versus the A's and pitched 4.1 scoreless innings in relief...He celebrated his 35th birthday yesterday.

- A* Atlanta signed him to a minor league contract with an invite to major league spring training on February 4, and selected him to the roster last Monday.
- A* The 2026 season marks his 15th in the majors... The left-hander owns a 91-93 record with a 4.40 ERA across 326 career games, including 279 starts, between the Rangers (2012-18, '22-23), Twins (2019), Red Sox (2020-21), Pirates (2024), Padres (2024) and White Sox (2024)...He earned the lone All-Star selection of his career in 2022 while with Texas, and helped guide the Rangers to a World Series title a year later.
- A* The Venezuela native appeared in 11 games and made 10 starts for the White Sox last season, pitching to a 3.54 ERA (22 ER/56.0 IP) and leading Chicago pitchers with a 1.11 WHIP and a .198 batting average against (40-for-202)...He made two separate stints on the injured list with elbow and shoulder injuries.
- A* He has never beaten Arizona in three career starts, going 0-2 with a 6.43 ERA (10 ER/14.0 IP)...All three starts have come here at Chase Field.

LONG SERIES: Atlanta plays the final game of its first four-game series of the season this afternoon, and looks to take three-of-four with a win...The Braves have either won or split six of their last seven series of at least four games dating to May of last year.

- A* Atlanta's only lost series in that span was a four-game set at Philadelphia last August (1-3).
- A* The Braves have six four-game series scheduled for the remainder of the season, including four games at the Nationals next road trip.

PITCHING: In three starts here versus Arizona, Atlanta has combined to allow just 12 hits and two earned runs over 26.0 innings, good for a 0.69 ERA...Just 19 total D-backs have reached base across the three games.

- A* The Braves currently lead the majors with a 1.46 ERA (13 ER/80.0 IP)...In baseball's live-ball era, which dates to 1920, just one Braves club in franchise history has owned a better team ERA through nine games...The 1958 Milwaukee Braves pitched to a 1.29 mark in that span.
- A* Atlanta fell to Arizona, 2-1, last night despite allowing zero earned runs...It was just the seventh defeat for the Braves since 2000 in which they didn't allow an earned run, and their first since a 1-0, 10-inning loss to Kansas City last July.
- A* The Braves have pitched three shutouts through their first nine games, and allowed zero earned runs in another...In total, Atlanta has allowed no earned runs in 44% of its total games this year.
- A* Braves starters are currently tied for the major league lead with six "quality" starts, and their 1.78 ERA ranks best in the National League and behind just the Yankees (1.47) in baseball.
- A* Atlanta's bullpen leads MLB in ERA (0.92), the lowest by the Braves bullpen through the first nine games since 1937 (0.00) and the only pen in baseball with an ERA under 1.00...Atlanta is also the first team to walk three or fewer in relief over the first nine games since Oakland and Chicago in 2016.

WILD WEST: In each of the previous three seasons, Atlanta has faced a multi-run deficit in the seventh inning or later here at Chase Field and rallied to win...No other visiting team in baseball even has two such wins.

- A* The Braves trailed, 6-2, entering the seventh on April 26 of last year before rallying to win, 8-7, in extra innings...Michael Harris II lined a go-ahead, two-run double with two outs and two strikes in the eighth to take the lead, and then won it in 10.
- A* Atlanta was losing, 3-1, entering the top of the ninth on July 8, 2024 when Sean Murphy drove a two-out, two-run homer to knot the score...The Braves would go on to win, 5-4, in 11 innings.
- A* The Braves entered the seventh on June 4, 2023 trailing, 5-3, before a run in the seventh and a ninth-inning grand slam by Eddie Rosario earned a victory, 8-5.

Today's Game

- A Makes his first start as a Brave and 280th career start today...It will be his 327th career major league appearance.
 - A Is 0-2 with a 6.43 ERA (10 ER/14.0 IP) in three career starts against Arizona, all on the road.
 - A Has not faced the Diamondbacks since September 17, 2024, when he allowed eight runs on eight hits over 3.2 innings with San Diego.
 - A Has never won a start at Chase Field.
- A Celebrated his 35th birthday yesterday (April 4)...Is in his 15th major league season, having debuted with Texas on June 27, 2012.
- A Has not earned a win since his Chicago (AL) debut on March 31, 2025 vs. Minnesota...Is winless in his last 11 appearances (0-6) dating to April 6, 2025.
- A Made his first appearance with Atlanta on March 31 vs. the Athletics, tossing 4.1 scoreless innings of relief behind José Suárez...Allowed just two hits with no walks and three strikeouts on 47 pitches (31 strikes) in the Braves' 5-2 loss.
- A Had his contract selected by Atlanta from Triple-A Gwinnett on March 30...Signed a minor league deal with the Braves on January 30.
- A Went 0-0 with a 2.84 ERA (4 ER/12.2 IP) with 10 strikeouts in four Grapefruit League appearances (one start) this spring...Allowed one earned run over 3.0 innings in his spring debut on February 28 at Baltimore.
- A Was limited to 11 appearances (10 starts) with Chicago (AL) in 2025 due to left elbow inflammation and a left shoulder strain, going 1-6 with a 3.54 ERA (22 ER/56.0 IP)...Made one relief appearance with the White Sox upon returning from injury on August 13 before making nine additional starts.

2025

- A Earned the win in his White Sox debut on March 31 vs. Minnesota, throwing 6.0 hitless innings with a career-high-tying nine strikeouts...Joined Hideo Nomo (2001 with Boston) as the only pitchers since 1901 to throw 6.0-plus hitless innings with nine-or-more strikeouts in a debut with a new team (STATS).
 - A Was the 12th pitcher since 1901 to throw 6.0-plus hitless innings in his debut with a new club, and the second in White Sox history, joining Wilson Álvarez (no-hitter) on August 11, 1991 at Baltimore.
 - A Became the fourth pitcher in White Sox history to strike out nine-or-more batters in his debut with the club, joining Freddy García (nine) on June 30, 2004 at Minnesota, Bump Hadley (10) on April 15, 1932 vs. St. Louis and Bob Weiland (nine) on September 30, 1928 vs. Philadelphia.
- A Posted a no-decision in his second start on April 6 at Detroit despite allowing one run on four hits over 6.0 innings...Left with a 3-1 lead before the Tigers rallied for three runs in the ninth.
- A Left his start on April 18 at Boston with discomfort in his left elbow after giving up four runs on five hits over 3.0 innings...Was placed on the 15-day injured list on April 19 with left elbow inflammation and transferred to the 60-day injured list on April 21.
- A Made one start each at Triple-A Charlotte (August 2) and Double-A Birmingham (August 8) before being reinstated from the injured list on August 13.
- A Made his first appearance in nearly four months on August 13 vs. Detroit, allowing one run on three hits with four strikeouts over 3.1 innings in relief.
- A Suffered the loss on August 20 at Atlanta despite holding the Braves to one unearned run on three hits with no walks and five strikeouts over 5.1 innings.
- A Threw 7.0 scoreless innings on August 26 vs. Kansas City, allowing just one hit with no walks and five strikeouts, but did not factor in the decision...Became the first pitcher in the modern era to throw 7.0-plus scoreless innings with one or no hits allowed, leave with a four-plus run lead and not earn the victory (STATS).
- A Made his fifth quality start in a loss on September 12 at Cleveland, allowing three runs on four hits over 6.2 innings, his second-longest start of the season.
- A Left his last start on September 17 vs. Baltimore after 3.2 innings with left shoulder soreness...Was placed on the 15-day injured list on September 19 with a left shoulder strain and missed the rest of the season.

- Appeared in 42 games in his second season as a Brave in 2025, pitching to a 3-2 record and a 3.81 ERA (23 ER/54.1 IP) with 51 strikeouts and a 1.25 WHIP, his lowest since 2020... Was placed on the injured list on August 24 due to left shoulder inflammation and missed the remainder of the season.
- Ranked in the 99th percentile in baseball with a barrel rate of just 3.2% in 2025... His nine total barrels and 2.9% barrel rate allowed since joining the Braves in 2024 are both the best in the majors (min. 400 batters faced).
- Opponents hit ground balls off him 55.8% of the time last season (league average 42.4%)... Since his debut in 2017, Bummer's career ground ball rate of 64.0% is highest in the majors (min. 350 games).
- Tossed his curveball a career-high 35.1% of the time in 2025, the most of any major league pitcher with at least 900 total pitches last season... Utilized a curveball for the first time in 2024 at a 2.3% clip.

- In his third full season with Atlanta, appeared in a career-high 70 games and went 29-for-34 in save opportunities... Pitched to a 3.21 ERA (24 ER/67.1 IP)... Ranked fourth in the NL and tied for ninth in the majors in saves.
- Among active pitchers with as many appearances since his Braves debut on August 5, 2022 (225 apps.), Iglesias owns the best ERA (2.31, 57 ER/221.2 IP), WHIP (0.93) and strikeout-to-walk ratio (4.95, 208 K/42 BB).
- Ranked second among Braves pitchers in franchise history (min. 100 G) in WHIP and ERA+ (182), fourth in strikeout-to-walk ratio (4.90) and hits-per-nine-innings (6.5) and fifth in ERA and saves (97).
- Did not allow a run in 42 of 45 appearances from June 9 until the end of the season... Led major league pitchers in this span (min. 40.0 IP) in hits-per-nine-innings (4.15) and saves (21), tied for the most fWAR among relievers (1.5) and ranked second in ERA (1.25, 6 ER/43.1 IP) and WHIP (0.69).
- Was named the NL Reliever of the Month for August for the third consecutive season after converting all 10 of his save opportunities and allowing a 0.69 ERA (1 ER/13.0 IP) in the month.

- Pitched to a 5-0 record with a 0.72 ERA (2 ER/25.0 IP), a 0.68 WHIP and 22 strikeouts in 24 outings with Atlanta to conclude the 2025 season.
- Allowed a run in his third appearance with the Braves, August 5, and then allowed one additional tally over his final 21 games... Strung together a career-high scoreless streak of 19.1 innings between runs.
- From his Braves debut on July 31 until the end of the season, Kinley led major league pitchers (min. 25.0 IP) in ERA and ranked third in WHIP and opponent's batting average (.126).

- Set a career high and led the team with 74 appearances, going 2-4 with a 3.29 ERA (25 ER/68.1 IP) and matching a career high with 76 punchouts... Collected the first two saves of his major league career.
- Did not allow a run in 31 of his first 38 appearances through June 29, tying for the sixth-lowest ERA (1.67, 7 ER/37.2 IP) among major league pitchers in that span (min. 35.0 IP).
- Ranked in the 90th percentile or better in baseball in expected ERA (91st, 2.91), walk percentage (92nd, 5.3%), hard-hit percentage (93rd, 33.5%), and whiff percentage (95th, 33.6%).
- Threw his slider 612 times and surrendered just 22 hits on it... Among pitchers that threw as many on the season, those 22 hits were the fewest in MLB... His slider carried a run value of 10, also ranking in the 95th percentile.
- Dating to his first full season in 2022, Lee's 2.70 ERA ranks third among all left-handed relievers in baseball to make at least 175 appearances... Among those pitchers, Lee's rate of 4.88 strikeouts-per-walk is best in the majors.
