THE GRAPEFRUIT GANG: The defending Grapefruit League champion St. Louis Cardinals are preparing for their 133rd season of play in the National League and are conducting their 27th Spring Training at Roger Dean Chevrolet Stadium (1998-2024) ... The Cardinals play their 5th of seven Spring matchups tonight against the Miami Marlins in the stadium that both teams call home during Spring Training.

CARDINALS MANAGER OLIVER MARMOL SIGNED THRU 2026: The St. Louis Cardinals announced today that the team has signed Manager Oliver "Oli" Marmol to a contract extension through the 2026 season.

- Marmol, 37, has piloted the team over the past two seasons (2022-23), earning an NL Central title in his first season with a Cardinals team that won 93 games.
- It was the team's first division title since 2019, and at age 36. Marmol became the voungest manager to lead his team to the postseason since 1948 when Lou Bou**dreau** led Cleveland to a World Series title at age 31.
- Marmol has been a member of the Cardinals organization since 2007, first as a player, and then as a coach and manager at the minor league level.

- Since 2006, St. Louis is 17-12-4 overall in Spring Training night games, including a 4-2-0 mark at Roger Dean Chevrolet Stadium.
- · Starting tonight, four of the next eight Cardinals spring games are night games (March 15-20).
- · The Cardinals only play two day games on Fridays during the regular season, both against the division-rival Cubs at Wrigley Field: June 14 and August 2.

BIRD SEED: Alec Burleson leads the Grapefruit League in batting (.400) and OBP (.471) while ranking 2nd in OPS (1.038), T-3rd in hits (12), and 4th in slugging (.567) ... Victor Scott II ranks among league leaders in batting (.367, 2nd), OBP (.457, T-2nd), OPS (.890, 6th), runs scored (T-3rd), and stolen bases (4, T-2nd) ... Zack **Thompson** leads the circuit with a .125 average against and shares the league lead in WHIP (0.75) with Mets RHP Tvlor Meaill.

TONIGHT'S PITCHERS

#32 • Steven Matz • RHP • 32 yrs

- Makes his 3rd start of the season and 2nd straight in Jupiter. Threw 3.0 innings in his last start vs. NYM (3/9).
- Joined the Cardinals on a four-year contract (2022-25) after previously pitching for the New York Mets (2015-20) and Toronto Blue Jays (2021) organizations.
- In 2023, made 25 appearances (17 starts) between the starting rotation and bullpen. Limited lefthanded batters to a .215/295/304 slashline (17-79) with three extra-base hits.
- Since joining the Cardinals, has gone 9-10 with a 4.29 ERA in 40 appearances (27 starts).
- 2023 Darryl Kile Award recipient, voted on by teammates.
- \bullet Finished 6th in the 2016 NL Rookie of the Year voting (9-8, 3.40 ERA, 1.21 WHIP in 22 starts).
- In 2015, became the first Mets pitcher to allow 2 runs or fewer in each of his first five MLB starts. His 1.80 ERA was the lowest for any Met in team history after five career outings (min. 30.0 IP).
- Started his career 11-1 in his first 14 regular season starts. Became the first Met in franchise history to win 11 of his first 12 MLB decisions, and joined Kazuhisa Ishii (2002 Dodgers) as the only two left-handers in MLB history to win 11 of their first 14 MLB starts.

#29 • Nick Robertson • RHP • 25 yrs

- Making his team-leading 7th appearance of the season. Last three appearances were scoreless after allowing a run in each of his first three.
- Acquired by the St. Louis Cardinals along with minor league RHP Victor Santos in exchange for OF Tyler O'Neill on December 8, 2023.
- Was originally drafted by the Los Angeles Dodgers in the 7th Round of the 2019 draft out of James Madison University.
- Traded to the Boston Red Sox for OF Enrique "Kike" Hernandez at the 2023 MLB Trade deadline.

#38 • Drew Rom • LHP • 24 yrs (pronounced rahm)

- Making his 3rd Spring appearance. Has not allowed a run over 5.0 innings and only one hit with
- Enters 2024 as the No. 26 prospect in the Cardinals organization by Baseball America.
- Made MLB debut on Aug. 21, 2023 at Pittsburgh with St. Louis after being acquired from Baltimore on Aug. 1, 23 with infielder César Prieto and RHP Zack Showalter in exchange for RHP Jack Flaherty.
- Has a 34-15 record through 101 appearances (89 starts) in the minor leagues
- Combined to go 19-4 across two levels combined in 2021-22 while pitching at three different levels in the Baltimore system.
- Led 2022 Orioles minor leaguers in starts (25), innings (120.0), and strikeouts (144), all of which were career highs.

#47 • John King • LHP • 29 yrs

- Making his team-leading 7th Spring Training appearance.
- Acquired by the Cardinals in a five-player trade with the Texas Rangers on July 30, 2023. Was the only player of all the Cardinals 2023 deadline acquisitions who immediately was added to the St. Louis roster.
- Ranked 2nd among National League pitchers (Colin Holderman, 11, PIT) with 10 Holds following his acquisition by the Cardinals on July 30.
- Ranked 3rd on the Cardinals with 20 appearances after the trade, posting a 1.45 ERA, 2nd on the team only to Ryan Helsley (0.77) from August 1 to the end of the season. His 1.45 ERA ranked 5th in all of MLB of pitchers with 20 or more appearances during that time period.
- Did not allow an extra base hit to a left-handed batter after August 7.
- Stranded 6 of 7 inherited runners with the Cardinals after stranding 10 of 16 with the Rangers.
