**NATIVE AMERICAN RECOGNITION DAY:** Today's Native American Recognition Day kicks off the 25th annual D-backs Inter-Tribal Youth Baseball & Softball Tournament, both presented by Talking Stick Resort, and features pregame parade 1,100 young baseball and softball players, Salt River Pima-Maricopa Indian Community President Martin Harvier throwing the ceremonial first pitch, recognitions of Arizona's Tribal Royalty Contingent, former Miss Salt River Isabella Dockerty singing the National Anthem and the Salt River Fire Department Honor Guard serving as Color Guard along with extravagant performances from drum groups, dancers and vocalists as well as art displays and educational exhibits.

**INTER-TRIBAL YOUTH BASEBALL & SOFTBALL TOURNEY:** The D-backs one-of-a-kind 25th Annual Inter-Tribal Youth Baseball & Softball Tournament presented by Talking Stick Resort, and generously supported by Resolution Copper and Nike, is tomorrow, June 2-Thursday, June 5 at Salt River Fields at Talking Stick.

• The only tournament of its kind in Major League Baseball brings emerging talent from rural tribal communities to the big stage as 1,100 athletes across 75 teams representing 20 tribes spanning across Arizona, New Mexico, California and Oklahoma compete over 4 days.

LAST GAME: The D-backs lost 11-7 vs. Nationals last night.

- The D-backs scored 7 unanswered runs from the fourth inning on.
- Josh Naylor went 2-for-4 with 1 double, 1 homer and 2 RBI to extend to a 9-game hitting streak...has 2 hits in each of his last 4 games.
- **Randal Grichuk** had his first 3-hit game, going 3-for-4 with 1 homer and 2 RBI.
- **Pavin Smith** recorded his first triple since Sept. 7, 2021 (sixth career) with 2 RBI.
- Jeff Brigham (2.0), Ryne Nelson (4.0), Kendall Graveman (1.0) and Shelby Miller (1.0) combined for 8.0 scoreless innings with 0 walks and 4 strikeouts.

**BULLPEN PERFORMANCE:** Yesterday marked the fourth time in franchise history where the D-backs bullpen tossed 9.0 innings and allowed 3 runs or fewer in a 9.0-inning game (last: April 30, 2024 vs. Dodgers).

**ROSTER MOVES:** The D-backs recalled RHP **Cristian Mena** from Triple-A Reno and optioned RHP **Scott McGough** to Reno following last night's game.

**VS. NATS:** The D-backs are 9-5 in their last 14 games since June 6, 2023, slashing a combined .323/.379/.493 and outscoring them 90-60.

- At home, are 7-4 in their last 11 games.
- Lourdes Gurriel Jr., in his last 13 games since May 6, 2023, is batting .420 (21-for-50)/1.113 OPS with 2 doubles, 3 homers, 7 RBI and 4 walks, including 8 multi-hit efforts.
- **Corbin Carroll** has hit safely in 14 of his 17 career games at a .368 clip (21-for-57)/1.250 OPS with 4 doubles, 2 triples, 5 homers, 11 RBI and 10 walks.
- **Ketel Marte** has hit safely in 11 of his last 13 games since May 7, 2023 at a .346 clip (18-for-52)/1.012 OPS with 3 doubles, 1 triple, 3 homers and 11 RBI.
- Geraldo Perdomo, in his last 12 games, is batting .341 (15-for-44)/.821 OPS with 3 doubles, 8 RBI and 6 walks.

**STREAKING SNAKES:** Josh Naylor has a season-best-tying 9-game hitting streak, batting .351 (13-for-37)/.973 OPS with 2 doubles, 1 triple, 2 homers and 8 RBI.

• Lourdes Gurriel Jr. has a season-high 7-game hitting streak, batting .429 (12-for-28)/.916 OPS with 1 double and 3 RBI.

**TRENDING HOME BATS:** Josh Naylor has reached base safely in his last 12 home games, hitting .356 (16-for-45)/.939 OPS with 3 doubles, 2 homerS, 7 RBI, 2 walks and 2 stolen bases, including multi-hit efforts in his last 4 games.

- **Ketel Marte** has reached base in 9 of his last 10 home games, hitting .324 (11-for-34)/1.183 OPS with 1 double, 4 homers, 7 RBI, 7 walks and 3 hit-by-pitches.
- **Eugenio Suárez**, in his last 18 home games, is hitting .333 (20-for-60)/1.225 OPS with 4 doubles, 8 homers, 19 RBI and 9 walks.

WITH SNAKES ON: Josh Naylor, in his last 12 home games with runners on base, is hitting .476 (10-for-21)/1.331 OPS with 1 double, 2 homers, 7 RBI and 2 walks.

- **Pavin Smith**, in his last 9 home games with runners on base, is hitting .444 (8-for-18)/1.196 OPS with 3 doubles, 1 triple and 4 RBI.
- Lourdes Gurriel Jr., in his last 15 home games with runners on base, is hitting .429 (12-for-28)/1.237 OPS with 2 doubles, 1 triple, 2 homers and 12 RBI.

**Gabriel Moreno**, in his last 13 home games with runners on base, is hitting .346 (9-for-26)/.970 OPS with 3 doubles, 1 homer, 9 RBI and 2 walks.

**HITS IN BUNCHES:** D-backs have recorded 10+ hits in 5 of their last 7 games (since May 24).

• Since May 13, the D-backs' 10 games with 10+ hits are most in MLB, ahead of 6 clubs tied for second with 8.

**IT STARTS UP TOP:** D-backs' 1-4 batters combined .476 SLG and .826 OPS rank fourth in the Majors, behind the Dodgers (.579 SLG/.971 OPS), Yankees (.531 SLG/.902 OPS) and Cubs (.482 SLG/.836 OPS).

**TURNING IT OVER:** D-backs' 6-9 batters combined .410 SLG and .731 OPS rank second in the Majors, behind the Cubs (.448 SLG/.788 OPS).

**SNAKES POWER TANDEM:** The D-backs are the only team in the Majors with multiple players with 15+ homers in **Corbin Carroll** (16) and **Eugenio Suárez** (15).

• Carroll and Suárez are the third duo in franchise history with 15+ homers in the team's first 58 games to start a season [also: 2001-Luis Gonzalez (22) and Reggie Sanders (16); 1999-Jay Bell (17) and Matt Williams (16)].

 Carroll is the eighth D-back ever with 16+ homers in the first 58 games (last: Paul Goldschmidt, 16 in 2015).
 ON DECK - BRAVES: After today's game, the D-backs begin a

6-game road trip starting with 3 games @ Braves.
The D-backs took 1 of 3 games in their first series April

25-27 @ Chase Field.

#### NEXT STARTER: RHP ZAC GALLEN (3-2, 2.72)
