TONIGHT'S GAME: The Braves and White Sox open a three-game series tonight with the first of three games between the teams this season...This marks the teams' first meeting since 2016 in Chicago, where the Braves won two-of-three games...After the Braves won the first four match-ups between the teams, the Sox have won eight of the last 11.

- The Braves and White Sox have met 15 times previous, tied for the fewest games Atlanta has played against any one franchise...They have also played 15 games against Oakland, Los Angeles (AL), Cleveland and Kansas City.
- This series also marks Chicago's second trip to Atlanta in franchise history...The White Sox visited Turner Field in 2002, and got swept in three games...The Braves outscored the White Sox, 27-5, over those three games.
- LHP Max Fried has never faced Chicago (AL)... The lefty is 6-3 with a 3.67 ERA (28 ER/68.2 IP) in 12 starts at home this season, and has not lost here since July 6 vs. Miami.
- RHP Iván Nova is set to pitch against Atlanta for the fifth time in his career and for the first time since last August 21 while with Pittsburgh...The righty is 3-1 with a 1.98 ERA (6 ER/27.1 IP) in his career against Atlanta, but took the loss on that August 21st start at PNC Park...Nova went 6.0 innings and allowed two runs, earned, in a 6-1 defeat.

BACK HOME: The Braves returned home yesterday and are set to open a nine-game homestand tonight vs. Chicago (AL)...The Braves went 4-2 on their road trip, sweeping New York (NL) in three games, losing a make-up game in Colorado and splitting a two-game set in Toronto.

- The Braves are 39-27 at SunTrust Park this season, and these nine games will be their penultimate homestand of the season...They have six games with Philadelphia and San Francisco, September
- The Braves have won five straight in Atlanta, two off their longest home winning streak of the season...They took seven straight at SunTrust Park, June 1-June 14.

SURGING: The Braves have won 12 of their last 16 games and nine of 11 after Wednesday's 9-4 win in Toronto.

- Over their last 11 games, the Braves have compiled a 2.20 ERA (25 ER/102.1 IP), allowing just eight home runs and limiting the opposition to a .637
- The bullpen over these 11 games has not given up a lead, compiling four saves and seven holds.. They have a 1.70 ERA (7 ER/37.0 IP) with 40 strikeouts and 10 walks.

LEADING OFF: OF Ronald Acuña Jr. drove home two runs on Wednesday night, giving him 91 RBI for the season, 69 of which have come from the leadoff spot... Acuña is now five away from the franchise single-season record for the most RBI batting first since RBI became an official statistic in 1920.

- The only two Braves with more such RBI than Acuña were Ray Powell, who had 74 in 1921, and Marquis Grissom, who had 73 in 1996.
- Powell batted first 148 times in 1921, while Grissom did it for 157 games in 1996...Tonight will be Acuña Jr.'s 98th game hitting leadoff.
- Acuña Jr. moved to the top of the batting order on May 10...Since that day, the Braves are 63-34 (.649) and Acuña Jr. has 29 home runs, tied for the second most in the National League with teammate 1B Freddie Freeman.

INTERLEAGUE: The Braves are set to play their 14th interleague game of the season to night, and they are 7--6so far against the American League...The Braves are in the middle of a seven-game stretch against the American League.

- The Braves have not had a winning record against the AL since going 11-9 in 2013.
- Over the last five seasons, the Braves have won two series in Atlanta against the American League, with both coming against Detroit...They won twoof-three to close out Turner Field over the Tigers in 2016, before beating them two-of-three, May 31-June 2 of this season...Overall, the Braves are 13-32 against the AL in Atlanta over this stretch, and have gone 2-11-5 in series play.

JOYCE IMPRESSES: OF Matt Joyce finished 3-for-5 with a home run and two RBI on Wednesday night, and in 13 starts since Nick Markakis went to the 10-day injured list on July 27, Joyce is batting .356 (16-for-45) with two home runs, a .442 on-base percentage and a .533 slugging percentage (.976 OPS).

Joyce also ranks third in the majors with 13 pinchhits this season.

FRIED WINS: Atlanta has won each of LHP Max Fried's last seven starts dating to July 15, during which Fried is 5-0, a new career-long winning streak... The lefty had won three straight twice before.

- Fried is 5-0 with a 3.35 ERA (14 ER/37.2 IP) during the run, with wins over Milwaukee, Philadelphia, Cincinnati, Minnesota and the Mets... The stretch spans seven total starts.
- A The run of team wins in his starts is the third such streak by Atlanta this season, after the Braves won eight straight starts by Mike Soroka from June 1 to July 14, and have won each of Mike Foltynewicz's last eight starts as well...The Braves are the only NL to have three such streaks of at least seven games this season.

- Makes his first career appearance against the White Sox...Is just his third career game against a team from the American League.
 - Is 2-0 with a 1.54 ERA (2 ER/11.2 IP) in his career in Interleague Play, with both games coming this season.
 - ★ Held Cleveland to two runs over 6.1 innings on April 21, before striking out
 10 Twins over 5.1 innings on August 7.
- \mathcal{A} Is 2-0 this season against the Cubs.
 - Just one Atlanta pitcher has beaten both the Cubs and White Sox in a single season...Tim Hudson earned victories over both Chicago clubs in 2013.
- His 14 wins are most in the National League by a left-hander, and second most in the majors among lefties...BOS's Eduardo Rodríguez has won 16 games.
 - Fried's 14 wins are most by an Atlanta left-hander since 2003, when Mike Hampton also did so...No Braves lefty has won more in a season since Tom Glavine won 18 games in 2002.
 - ★ Atlanta is 19-8 in his starts as a team, including 12-2 in his last 14 turns.

2019 Recap

- Started against the Dodgers, 8/18 at SunTrust Park, and allowed eight hits and three runs in 5.0 innings...Did not factor in the decision.
 - Surrendered all three runs in the first inning and allowed the first two hitters to reach in the second, before retiring 11 of the next 13 hitters, including the final eight he faced.
 - Picked A.J. Pollock off first base in the opening inning, his fifth pickoff of the season...His five pickoffs are tied for second most in the majors.
- Tallied his second career 10-strikeout game, fanning 10 batters in just 5.1 innings on August 7 at Minnesota.
- - Was his second career stint on the Braves' injured list due to a blister...Missed from July 6 to July 29 of last season with a blister on his left third finger.
- ★ Appeared in 20 games before the All-Star break, and set full-season career highs in wins (9), games (20), starts (18), innings (98.2) and strikeouts (97).
 - Went 9-4 with a 4.29 ERA (47 ER/98.2 IP) before the break...His nine wins were the most by a Braves lefty before the All-Star break since 2013, when both Paul Maholm and Mike Minor had nine...No Braves left-hander has won more since Tom Glavine had 11 wins at the break in 2002.
 - Æ His nine wins were second most by a left-hander in the National League...

 Only the Dodgers' Hyun-Jin Ryu won more (10 wins).
- Made his third career start against the Cubs, 6/25, and allowed two hits and two
 runs over 6.0 innings to earn the win... Walked a career high five and fanned eight.
 - Is 3-0 in his career against Chicago, winning all three of his starts...Is the first Braves starter to earn the win over Chicago in consecutive starts since LH Mike Minor, who won six straight over the Cubs from 8/22/10 to 7/12/14.
- - ⚠ Doubled and walked in Atlanta's nine-run sixth inning, becoming the first Braves pitcher to reach base safely twice in an inning since Greg Maddux on 4/8/99...The double Fried hit was his first extra-base hit of his career.
- Allowed seven hits and two runs over 6.0 innings, 4/16 vs. ARI... Walked one and struck out three.
 - Opened the season with 16.2 innings without allowing an earned run, before Arizona scored twice in the fourth...It was the longest streak without an earned run to open the season by a Braves pitcher since 2013 (Paul Maholm, 25.1 IP).

- Is 1-0 with 4.05 ERA (12 ER/26.2 IP) in 36 games with Atlanta...Twenty-nine of his 36 appearances have been scoreless, including 16 of his last 20.
- Converted his first save chance of the season, 8/14 vs. NYM...Was the seventh save of his career.
- Celebrated 10 years of major league service time on July 27.
- Has a 27.00 ERA (6 ER/2.0 IP) against LAD this season...Has a 2.19 ERA (6 ER/24.2 IP) against all other teams.
- Twenty of his 36 appearances have been less than 1.0 inning.
- Holding left-handed batters to a .167 (8-for-48) average with 16 strikeouts...Righties are 13-for-52 (.250).
- Atlanta acquired him from the Oakland A's on 4/28 in exchange for cash considerations...Was designated for assignemnt by Atlanta on 5/14 and re-signed to a major league contract on 5/18.

- Is 0-1 with a 5.11 ERA (7 ER/12.1 IP) in 14 games with the Braves, and 0-3 with a 2.15 ERA (12 ER/50.1 IP) in 52 games on the season...He has converted 22 of 27 save opportunities.
- Has eight consecutive scoreless appearances spanning 8.0 innings, allowing just four hits and striking out 10.
- Allowed runs in four of his first six appearances with the Braves, and allowed all four inherited runners to score. Made his Braves debut on 8/3 vs. CIN, allowing a run in the ninth inning to blow a save.
- Acquired from Detroit on 7/31 in exchange for LHP Joey Wentz and OF Travis Demeritte...Prior to joining the Braves ranked fourth in the American League with his 22 saves, while his 1.18 ERA was the second lowest in baseball to San Diego's Kirby Yates among qualifying relievers.
- Was 0-2 with 22 saves and a 1.18 ERA (5 ER/38.0 IP) with 43 strikeouts and 12 walks in 38 games out of the bullpen for the Tigers this season.

- Is 8-2 with a 3.41 ERA (24 ER/63.1 IP) in 60 games this season...Has converted 18 of his 25 save chances after logging just one career save prior to 2019...His seven blown saves are tied for third most in the majors.
- Has eight wins in relief this season, the most by a Braves reliever since Oscar Villarreal also had eight in 2006.
- Per Statcast, has an expected batting average of just .202 and an average exit velocity of 87.3 mph...Opponents are officially batting .259 (64-for-247)
- Earned his 18th save, 8/11 at Miami...Has four saves of at least 1.1 innings.
- Left-handers have just 16 hits in 93 at-bats (.172) against him...Righties are hitting .312 (48-for-154).
- Has fanned 85 batters in 63.1 innings for a career-best 12.07 SO/9.0 IP ratio.
- Recorded his second consecutive two-inning save, 5/15 vs. STL, to become the first Braves closer with back-toback two-inning saves since Hall of Famer John Smoltz in 2002

- Is 1-3 with a 3.62 ERA (20 ER/49.2 IP) in 51 games on the season, including a 5.40 ERA (7 ER/11.2 IP) in 13 games with Atlanta...Has a 2.18 FIP with the Braves.
- Allowed one run on two hits, 8/26 at COL, to snap a five-appearance scoreless streak...Had retired 15 of 17 batters faced, striking out five...Earned his third hold with the Braves, 8/24 at NYM.
- Acquired from Texas on 7/30 in exchange for LHP Kolby Allard...Made his Braves debut on 8/2 vs. CIN with a perfect eighth inning.
- Went 0-2 with a 3.08 ERA (13 ER/38.0 IP) in 38 games out of the bullpen for Texas this season with 43 strikeouts and just four walks.
- Before joining Atlanta, had a rate of 0.95 BB/9 which ranked fifth best among qualifying relievers in the majors.
