RAY REPORT—The Rays are 3-3 during a 10-day, three-city road trip through Atlanta (1-2), Minnesota (2-1) and Pittsburgh (3 to play)...have won three of their last four games and five of their last nine...are 11-11 in their last 22 contests on the heels of a season-high six-game losing streak from May 19-25...their 11-17 (.393) record since May 19 is fifth worst in the AL, ahead of the Tigers (11-18/.379), Rangers (10-17/.370), Athletics (9-20/.310) and White Sox (6-24/.200)...prior to that stretch, Tampa Bay posted an 11-4 mark in their previous 15 contests from May 3-18...the Rays are 5-8 so far during a stretch of 19 games in 20 days from June 7-26.

- With yesterday's 7-6, 10-inning win, the Rays earned their first series victory vs. an opponent that entered with a winning record since May 13-16 at Boston, snapping a four-series losing streak against such clubs (KC, BAL x2, ATL).
- Tampa Bay earned its sixth extra-inning victory of the season, tied with Cleveland and Philadelphia for second most in the majors behind Miami (7).
- Four straight and five of the Rays last nine games have been decided in the final at-bat...they are 11-6 in such contests, going 6-1 in their last seven...their 11 last at-bat wins rank third in the AL, one shy of co-leaders Detroit and Seattle (both 12).
- Tampa Bay has scored first in six consecutive games for the first time since Aug. 16-24, 2023 (7G).
- In their two victories against the Twins, the Rays went a combined 4-for-32 (.125) with runners in scoring position...Tampa Bay is batting .202 (21-for-104) with RISP since June 7, the fifth-lowest mark in the majors during that timeframe.
- Tampa Bay has homered in five consecutive games, one shy of its longest run of the season, a six-game streak to open the year (March 28-April 2)...all five games have come on the road, their longest road streak Sept. 17-Oct. 1, 2023 (6G).
- The Rays have swiped four stolen bases in back-to-back games for the fifth time in franchise history, joining May 25-26, 2023; April 30-May 2, 2023; June 7-8, 2007 and Aug. 16-17, 2006.
- Tampa Bay's 13-7 (.650) mark in Interleague play is third best in the majors behind Atlanta (20-10/.667) and New York-AL (12-6/.667).

THE YANDY MAN CAN—Yandy Díaz has reached base safely in a career-high-tying 22 straight games, joining streaks from April 27-May 28, 2023 and July 24-Aug. 16, 2020...during the current streak, he is batting .289 (26-for-90) with 4 2B, 1 3B, 1 HR, 8 RBI, 9 BB and 15 SO...it marks the third-longest active streak in MLB behind BAL Gunnar Henderson (27G) and CLE Steven Kwan (25G).

- Díaz also owns an 13-game hitting streak, tied with Henderson and HOU Mauricio Dubón for the third-longest active run in MLB behind PIT Bryan Reynolds (17G) and Kwan (14G)...it is the second-longest streak of Díaz's career behind a 14-game run from May 3-21, 2021.
- Yesterday marked his third game of the season with 2+ XBH (2B, HR), including his first since May 11 vs. New York-AL (2 2B, HR)...in the 9th inning, he recorded his first home run since May 22 vs. Boston.
- With a hit tonight, he can tie Amed Rosario (April 4-22) for the longest hitting streak by a Tampa Bay batter this season.

NO JUNE SWOON—Randy Arozarena is batting .294 (15-for-51) with 4 2B, 2 HR, 7 RBI, 10 BB, 10 SO and 5 HBP over 17 games in June...his .455 on-base pct. this month ranks fourth in the AL behind CLE Steven Kwan (.552), NYY Aaron Judge (.529) and NYY Juan Soto (.515)...he has hit safely in a season-high six straight games, his longest run since Sept. 11-16, 2023 (also 6G)...he has also recorded an extra-base hit in a season-high-tying three straight contests (also May 5-7)...during the six-game hitting streak, he has reached base safely in 14 of 26 PA (.538 OBP)...Arozarena has produced a 15.2 pct. strikeout rate this month—he entered June at 28.7 pct.

- Amed Rosario is batting .395 (15-for-38) in June, fourth in the AL (min. 35AB)...at an even .300, he is one of six AL hitters batting .300 or better this season (min. 200AB), joining KC Bobby Witt Jr. (.322), LAA Luis Rengifo (.313), NYY Juan Soto (.309), MIN Carlos Correa (.308) and NYY Aaron Judge (.306).
- Brandon Lowe is slashing .273/.364/.561 (18-for-66) with 3 2B, 2 3B, 4 HR, 17 RBI and a .924 OPS over his last 20 games.
- Jose Siri is hitting .269/.319/.627 (18-for-67) with 6 2B, 6 HR and 12 RBI in 19 games since May 29, ranking among AL leaders over that span in doubles (T5th), HR (T5th) and slugging pct. (6th)...he has seven multi-hit efforts during the 19-game run, having entered that stretch with three multi-hit performances in 43 games.
- In 10 appearances this month, Kevin Kelly has produced a 1.93 ERA (9.1IP, 2ER) while allowing five hits with zero walks and 11 strikeouts.

ROAD TRIPPIN'—The Rays are 10-6 over their last 16 road games after a 7-10 start...their .625 road winning pct. in that span (since May 15) is tied with Boston (also 10-6) for third best in the majors behind New York-AL (13-5/.722) and Baltimore (12-6/.667)...the Rays have played 33 road games, second fewest in the majors, ahead of only the Mets (32G)...they are in the midst of a stretch from June 14-July 7 in which 15 of their 21 games take place on the road.

- Isaac Paredes has hit safely in 12 of his last 13 road games since May 18, batting .327 (16-for-49) with 5 2B, 2 HR and 8 RBI.
- Yandy Díaz has a 16-game road on-base streak, tied for the second-longest streak of his career (Aug. 30-G1, 2017-Aug. 13, 2018)...his longest streak is 19 games from July 27-Sept. 13 (G1), 2022.
- Randy Arozarena has hit safely in 10 straight road games, the second-longest streak of his career (12G, Aug. 19-G2-Sept. 16, 2023).

RALLY RAYS—The Rays 21 comeback wins are tied with the Nationals for the major league lead...Tampa Bay has come from behind in 10 of its last 12 wins, including four multi-run comebacks in its last eight victories...the Rays rank among MLB leaders in wins when trailing after six (1st, 10), seven (1st, 7) and eight (T2nd, 4) innings.

CLOSE SHAVES—The Rays 15-6 (.714) record in one-run games leads MLB, ahead of Seattle (17-7/.708) and Minnesota (14-7/.667)...their 26-11 (.703) mark in games decided by two runs or fewer also pace the majors, ahead of Philadelphia (20-10/.667)...since April 29, they are 17-5 in games decided by two runs or fewer and 6-18 in all other contests...Tampa Bay is 11-4 in its last 15 one-run games.

TWO-OUT TROUBLE—Over their last nine games since June 11, Rays pitching has been tagged for a .384 (48-for-125) clip and 9 HR with two outs...both marks are the highest in the majors during that span.

- Rays pitching has allowed a homer in six consecutive road games, one shy of their season-high streak of seven games from April 30-May 17.

SHIVER ME TIMBERS—Tampa Bay and Pittsburgh kick off a three-game set tonight at PNC Park...the Rays have won six straight games against the Pirates, earning series sweeps over Pittsburgh at Tropicana Field from June 24-26, 2022 and May 2-4, 2023.

- This marks Tampa Bay's fourth series in franchise history at PNC Park (June 10-12, 2005; June 27-29, 2008; June 27-29, 2017).
- The two franchises have met only 21 times, with the Rays leading the all-time series, 12-9...Tampa Bay's last victory at PNC Park came on June 27, 2017 (4-2).

- Rays RHP Ryan Pepiot made his MLB debut at PNC Park on May 11, 2022 (ND, 3.0IP, 1H, 0R, 5BB, 3SO).
- Pirates Manager Derek Shelton was the Rays hitting coach from 2010-16...he was the longest-tenured hitting coach in team history before Chad Mottola surpassed him this season...Shelton resides in Treasure Island, FL during the offseason.
- Tyree Hayes, the brother of Pirates 3B Ke'Bryan Hayes, was selected by Tampa Bay in the eighth round of the 2006 First-Year Player Draft...Tyree pitched parts of five seasons (2006-10) in Tampa Bay's farm system.
- OF Joshua Palacios, the older brother of Rays INF/OF Richie Palacios, is currently with Pittsburgh's Triple-A affiliate, the Indianapolis Indians...Joshua hit his first big league homer with the Pirates on June 2, 2023 vs. STL.
- Pittsburgh Third Base Coach/Field Coordinator Mike Rabelo played three seasons at the University of Tampa (1999-2001)...he resides in Tampa during the offseason.
- Pirates 1B Rowdy Tellez made his MLB debut vs. the Rays on Sept. 5, 2018 as a member of the Blue Jays...collected his first hit that night, a double off Jake Faria.
- Pirates LHP Josh Fleming was drafted by the Rays in the fifth round of the 2017 First-Year Player Draft...went 19-13 with a 4.88 ERA in 55 appearances (22GS) with Tampa Bay from 2020-23.
- Rays Senior Director of Baseball Performance Science Joseph Myers graduated from the University of Pittsburgh.
- Tampa Bay Strength & Conditioning Assistant Joey Greany received his master's degree in exercise science at California University of Pennsylvania.
- Pirates outfielders Andrew McCutchen (Fort Meade) and Michael A. Taylor (Fort Lauderdale) both hail from the Sunshine State.

TONIGHT'S START—Pepiot will take the mound for his 13th start of the season, including his fourth on the road...three of his four quality starts have come on the road...was on the 15-day IL from May 6-22 (lower left leg contusion) after being struck by a 107.5 mph comebacker on May 5 vs. NYM...has a 5.81 ERA (26.1IP, 17ER) in five starts since being reinstated compared to 3.93 (36.2IP, 15ER) in seven starts to open the season.

LAST TIME OUT—Pepiot was tagged for five runs and a career-high 3 HR in a 9-2 loss on June 15 at Atlanta (L, 4.2IP, 6H, 5ER, 3BB, 4SO, 3HR)...he held the Braves scoreless through four innings, facing the minimum through two before working around a combined three singles in the 3rd and 4th frames...yielded all 3 HR over a span of four batters with two outs in the 5th (Kelenic, Ozuna, Olson), resulting in all five runs...he has taken the loss in back-to-back outings for the first time in his career.

AHOY, MATEY!—Pepiot will be making his second career start against the Pirates, joining his major league debut on May 11, 2022 at PNC Park (3.OIP, H, OER, 5BB, 3SO)...in that game, he allowed seven baserunners, but stranded all of them...the five walks were the most by a Dodgers pitcher in his MLB debut since **Antonio Osuna** (5) on April 25, 1995 at Florida.

✦ Pepiot is 1-0 with a 1.98 ERA (13.2IP, 3ER) in three career starts against NL Central clubs, most recently on April 29 at Milwaukee (W, 6.OIP, 2H, OR, 7SO)...he issued a career-high five walks in two of those three outings, both in 2022 (at PIT, at MIL).

✦ For his career, he is 8-3 with a 3.17 ERA (93.2IP, 33ER) in 20 games (15GS) against NL opponents and 1-2 with a 4.34 ERA (47.2IP, 23ER) in nine games (7GS) vs. AL clubs.

ROAD WARRIOR—Before yielding five runs in his last road start on June 15 at Atlanta, Pepiot earned the win in each of his first three outings as a visitor, posting a 1.50 ERA (18.OIP, 3ER) with 26 strikeouts against zero walks...he joined **AZ Randy Johnson** (2007) and **NY Mike Mussina** (2001) as the only pitchers since 1901 to record 25+ SO and 0 BB in their first three road starts with a franchise...he also became the first pitcher in franchise history to throw 6.0+ innings and issue zero walks in each of his first three road starts of a season, and the 10th to record three straight quality starts on the road to open a campaign (last: **Tyler Glasnow**, 4, April 5-May 3, 2019).

✦ He threw 6.0+ scoreless innings with no walks in each of his first two road starts, becoming the fifth pitcher since 1901 to accomplish the feat, joining **DET Tarik Skubal** (2024), **MIL Corbin Burnes** (2021), **SF Johnny Cueto** (2018) and **PIT Deacon Phillippe** (1902).

TRAFFIC JAM—He has recorded a 1.44 WHIP over his last three starts, allowing opponents to slash .304/.333/.609 (21-for-69) with 6 HR...entering that stretch, those figures stood at a 0.95 WHIP, .175/.256/.319 (28-for-160) opponent slash line and 5 HR through his first nine starts...from Opening Day through the end of May, the .175 opp. average ranked third in the AL while the 0.95 WHIP was fifth (min. 40.OIP).

✦ Pepiot issued a trio of walks in his last outing on June 15 at ATL after recording 17 SO and no walks in his previous two starts.

HEAT CHECK—Pepiot has held opponents to a 15-for-115 (.130) clip on his four-seamer, recording 45 of his 72 SO (62.5%) on the pitch...the .130 average is the lowest mark on any individual pitch in MLB (min. 90AB ending with pitch), ahead of **CLE Emmanuel Clase's** cutter (.147) and **STL Miles Mikolas's** sinker (.147)...opponents are 9-for-42 (.214) against the four-seamer in Pepiot's last three starts compared to .082 (6-for-73) in his first nine.

✦ He has produced a 35.5 pct. whiff rate on the four-seamer, the highest mark on any MLB starter's fastball (min. 100 swings, starts only), ahead of **NY Luis Gil's** four-seamer (30.8%).

✦ He has yielded 5 HR on the four-seamer, his most on any pitch...three of the last four hits he has allowed against it have been home runs.

WHIFF YOU PLEASE—Pepiot's 30.7 pct. whiff rate ranks fifth in the AL behind **DET Jack Flaherty** (34.4%), **CWS Garrett Crochet** (32.3%), **DET Tarik Skubal** (31.7%) and **KC Cole Ragans** (31.3%) and 10th in the majors...he had a 32.7 pct. whiff rate prior to his IL stint (7GS) compared to 28.2 pct. since his return (5GS).

MEET ME IN THE MIDDLE—He has been at his best in the middle frames of his outings, posting a 1.32 ERA (34.OIP, 5ER) and 0.71 WHIP in innings 2-4 while pitching to an 8.38 ERA (29.OIP, 27ER) and 1.52 WHIP in all other frames.
