RECENT REDBIRDS: The defending 2019 National League Central Division Champion St. Louis Cardinals continue a 10-day, 13-game road trip through Milwaukee (5G, 2-3), Pittsburgh (5G, 3-1) and Kansas City (3G) playing the last of a five game series at Pittsburgh this afternoon...entering play today, the Cardinals are 25-24 and reside in 2nd place place, 4.5 games behind first place Chicago and one game ahead of Cincinnati and Milwaukee, both tied for 3rd place.

COMEBACK CARDS: During the nine games on this road trip, the Cardinals have won five with all five in come-from-behind fashion. The Cardinals last six wins are come-from-behind and 13 of their 25 victories this season.

BUCC-ING THE TREND: A win today would give the Cardinals the season series over the Pirates, needing to win their season-high fourth straight game. The Cardinals have won the last five season series against Pittsburgh dating back to 2014. The last time the two teams split the season series was the strike-shortened season of 1994 when the series was 5-5.

BREAKING LATE: Despite being no-hit for six innings by the Pirates' top prospect entering the 2020 season, **Mitch Keller**, the Cardinals unloaded an attack of their own when the Bucs bullpen showed up. St. Louis scored five runs in the 7th to overcome a 4-0 deficit en route to a 5-4 win. The comeback win was the Cardinals largest of the season and biggest since a four-run comeback against the Pirates on Aug. 11, 2019, in which St. Louis rallied from an 8-4 deficit with five runs in the 7th inning courtesy of a **Lane Thomas** grand slam en route to an 11-9 win.

GETTING JACK BACK ON TRACK: In his last start, **Jack Flaherty** allowed a career-high nine runs at Milwaukee, snapping a streak of 22 straight regular season starts in which he didn't allow more than three runs, the longest in Cardinals history (**Bob Gibson, 1968 & Lance Lynn, 2014, T-2nd, 19**). **Jacob deGrom** holds the longest streak among non-openers with 31, while his teammate **Zack Wheeler** holds the longest streak among active non-openers at 15.

FAMOUS FIRSTS: The Cardinals had 13 players make their Major League debut this season, second only to the Miami Marlins (18). Three of those were pitchers who earned their first Major League win including last night's victor, **Jake Woodford**. The 23-year old rookie was a Cardinals 1st round pick in 2015 and earned his first win last night, joining **Génesis Cabrera** (8/15 at CWS; made MLB debut in 2019), **Seth Elledge** (8/20 vs. CIN) and **Kwang Hyun Kim** (8/22 vs. CIN) as Cardinals pitchers earning their first win this season.

DID SOMEONE CALL A CAB?: **Génesis Cabrera** earned his first save of the 2020 season and second career save with a five-out rescue last night. The five-out save was the first by a Cardinals pitcher this season after posting three in 2019 (Martínez 2, Cabrera 1). Both of Cabrera's two saves have been five outs or more.

MULTI-WHACKS: **Tyler O'Neill** broke up the Pirates no-hit bid with a bases loaded 2-RBI double in the 7th inning last night. The Canadian slugger, who is tied for the team lead in home runs (7), has a team-leading eight multi-RBI games this season and his 19 RBI rank T-5th on the squad with **Paul Goldschmidt**. O'Neill has 7 RBI on this current road trip with three multi-RBI games.

VICTORY BLUES: Last season, it seemed the Cardinals couldn't win a road game in their "Victory Blue" Saturday road uniforms, earning only one win heading into September. The Cardinals won a road Saturday game at PNC Park on Sept. 7, 2019, and another at Wrigley Field on Sept. 21. Since that Sept. 7, 2019, the Cardinals have not lost in the "Victory Blue" uniforms, posting six straight wins including a doubleheader sweep at Wrigley Field on Sept. 5.

SHOOT THE BULL: The last three games, the Cardinals bullpen hasn't allowed a run, firing 9.0 scoreless innings with only two hits allowed. Cardinals relievers have tossed scoreless outings in three consecutive games two other times this season, with the last time posting four more from Sept. 7-13, 2019, when they had six (16.0 IP, 6 H).

PITTSBURGH CONNECTIONS

Paul DeJong was originally selected by the Pirates in the 38th round of the 2014 MLB Draft, but did not sign.

Yadier Molina (June 3, 2004), **Austin Gomber** (June 2, 2018) and **Junior Fernandez** (August 11, 2019) made their Major League debuts against Pittsburgh.

Harrison Bader previously committed to play at the University of Pittsburgh and University of Maryland before receiving a partial scholarship from Florida.

Miles Mikolas spent one month as a Pirate during the 2013 offseason...traded by San Diego with infielder **Jaff Decker** to Pittsburgh for outfielder **Alex Dickerson** (Nov. 25, 2013), then traded by Pittsburgh to Texas in exchange for infielder **Chris McGuiness** (Dec. 30, 2013).

Andrew Knizner's uncle, **Matt Knizner**, was a quarterback at Penn State Univ. and was on the 1986 National Championship Nittany Lion squad.

Pitching coach **Mike Maddux** signed with the Pirates in April 1995 and pitched in eight games before being released in May.

Bench coach **Oliver Marmol** was originally selected by the Pirates in the 31st round of the 2004 MLB draft, but did not sign.

Pirates Manager **Derek Shelton** was born in Carbondale, Ill...caught four seasons (1989-92) at nearby Southern Illinois University.

Pirates Baseball Operations Special Assistant **David Eckstein** played three seasons at shortstop with St. Louis (2005-07), where he was a two-time NL All-Star (2005-06) and member of the 2006 World Series Champions.

Pirates Hitting Coach **Rick Eckstein** previously served as the 2007 hitting coach for the Memphis Redbirds (AAA).

Pirates Baseball Operations Senior Advisor **Nick Leyva** was drafted by St. Louis in the 24th round in 1975...played three minor league seasons in the Cardinals system (1975-77)...managed six minor league seasons in the Cardinals organization (1978-83)...served as St. Louis' First Base Coach (1984-85) and Third Base Coach (1986-88).

Cardinals Administrator of Baseball Information & Media Services **Chris Tunno** graduated from nearby Canfield (Ohio) High School.

Pirates Director of Business Communications & Social Media **Terry Rodgers** previously worked as a Public Relations Specialist in the Cardinals Communications department (2010-11).

TODAY'S GAME

- Makes his eighth start of 2020 and second against the Pirates this season. Today marks his 75th career appearance and 74th start.
- Needs 2.0 innings to amass 400 career.
- Is 3-0 with a 2.05 ERA in four home starts and 0-2 with a 15.95 ERA in three road starts.
- Has yet to eclipse 100 pitches in a start this season after posting 14 such starts in 2019.
- Has allowed two runs or fewer in five of his seven starts this season.
- Sports a 1.70 ERA (84.2 IP/16 ER) in 15 day game starts dating back to last season, allowing zero or one run in ten of those starts.
- Enters today with a .203 opponent BA since his MLB debut on Sept. 1, 2017, 7th-lowest in MLB over that period (Josh Hader, 1st, .145)

LAST TIME OUT

- Allowed a career-high nine runs on eight hits in three innings of work as the Brewers jumped out to an early 11-1 lead through the first four frames en route to an 18-3 loss.

2020 SEASON

- Had a streak of 22 consecutive regular season starts holding his opposition to three runs or less snapped at MIL (9/15), when he surrendered a career-high nine runs. The 22-game streak was the longest in Cardinals history out-distancing Bob Gibson (19) in 1968 and Lance Lynn (19) in 2014. It came up nine games short of the MLB record by a non-opener held by the Mets' Jacob deGrom (31).
- Has held his opposition to three runs or less in six of his seven starts.
- Threw a career high 43 pitches in the 1st inning at CHI (9/4), the most by a Cardinals pitcher in the 1st inning this season and the most since Daniel Ponce de Leon hurled 41 vs. CLE (8/28).
- The Cardinals are 4-3 in his starts this season with two losses coming when he received zero runs of support.
- Pushed his mark to 9-1 with a 0.99 ERA in 14 career starts in August, making him the MLB leader in August ERA and opponent BA (.139) since the Live Ball Era (1920).

 - Finalist for the Rawlings Glove Glove award. Was one of eight NL pitchers (and three Cardinals) to record a perfect fielding percentage.
 - Established single-season career highs in wins (11), innings pitched (196.1), strikeouts, quality starts and starts.
 - His 231 strikeouts ranked 6th in franchise single-season history, trailing only Bob Gibson (1964, 1965, 1968, 1969, 1970).
 - Set Cardinals single-season records in strikeouts/ 9 IP (10.59) and percentage of swings that missed (30.7) (in data since 1988). His .192 opponent batting average was 2nd to only Bob Gibson (.184) in 1968.
 - Struck out 231, walked 55 and recorded a 2.75 ERA. Since 1885, became only the third pitcher younger than 24-years old to record a season of at least 230 strikeouts, while permitting 55-or-fewer walks to go along with an ERA of 2.75-or-better, joining Clayton Kershaw (2011) and Mark Prior (2003).
