AND OUT COMES ABEL: Abel's first appearance of 2026 came on March 29 at Baltimore in an 8-6 Twins loss...came in relief of Bailey Ober...entered game in fifth inning and pitched 3.1 innings, giving up five runs (all earned) on eight hits, with four walks and four strikeouts.

SPRING RECAP: Abel made 6 appearances (5 starts) this spring, posting a 1-2 record with a 2.05 ERA (22.0 IP, 5 ER), 4 walks, 27 strikeouts, a .192 (15-for-78) BAA and a 0.89 WHIP.

- Led Twins starters in IP (22.0), K (27), BAA (.192) and WHIP (0.89).
- Did not allow a run through his first three spring starts, going 10.0 innings with five hits allowed while striking out 13 and walking none.

2025 SEASON RECAP: Combined to go 10-6 with a 3.34 ERA (137.1 IP, 51 ER), 56 walks, 153 strikeouts and a .219 BAA (112-for-511) in 28 games (26 starts) between Lehigh Valley, Philadelphia, St. Paul and Minnesota.

- Acquired by Minnesota on July 30, and optioned to Triple-A St. Paul where he made five starts, posting a 1.85 ERA (24.1 IP, 5 ER) with eight walks, 33 strikeouts and a 0.95 WHIP.
- Ended season 3-4 with a 6.23 ERA (39.0 IP, 27 ER), 16 walks, 39 strikeouts and a 1.51 WHIP in 10 major league games (8 starts).

CAREER VS. TAMPA BAY: Mick has never pitched against Tampa Bay and hasn't faced any current Tampa Bay hitters.

- WELCOME TO THE AMERICAN LEAGUE:** Abel made three appearances (2 starts) against AL teams in 2025 (June 4 at Toronto, August 23 at Chicago-AL and September 20 vs. Cleveland)...combined to go 0-1 with a 6.57 ERA (12.1 IP, 9 ER), five walks, 10 strikeouts and a .234 (11-for-47) BAA.

HOME/ROAD SPLITS: In his 11 career appearances (8 starts), Abel holds a 1-3 record with a 8.69 ERA (19.2 IP, 19 ER), 12 walks, 23 strikeouts and a 1.98 WHIP at home, compared to a 2-2 record with a 5.16 ERA (22.2 IP, 13 ER), 12 walks, 20 strikeouts and a 1.41 WHIP on the road.

- FULL CIRCLE:** Abel made his big-league debut on May 18, 2025 for the Phillies as the home team, twirling 6.0 shutout innings with nine strikeouts; on September 27, 2025 returned to Citizens Bank Park as the visitor and finished off his rookie campaign once again throwing 6.0 shutout innings with nine strikeouts, this time in a Twins uniform against his former club.

LEFT/RIGHT SPLITS: Last season, left-handed hitters slashed .284/.351/.545 (25-for-88) in 97 plate appearances off Abel, while righties slashed .261/.338/.362 (18-for-69) in 77 plate appearances.

CAREER NOTES

- In 2025 season, combined to go 10-6, 3.34 ERA (137.1 IP, 51 ER) with 56 walks, 153 strikeouts and a .219 opponent batting average in 28 games (26 starts) between Lehigh Valley, Philadelphia, St. Paul and Minnesota.
- Made start against former organization on September 27 at Philadelphia, striking out nine batters in 6.0 shutout innings, with three hits allowed and one walk, earning the club's final victory of 2025 season.
- Set Saints' franchise record with 11 strikeouts on August 16 vs. Omaha, becoming fourth pitcher in franchise history to strike out double-digit hitters, joining Griffin Jax (May 28, 2021), David Festa (3x in 2024) and Randy Dobnak (June 15, 2024).
- In three starts for Triple-A St. Paul between August 3-16, went 0-0 with a 1.76 ERA (15.1 IP, 3 ER), three home runs allowed, six walks, 23 strikeouts and a 0.85 WHIP...ranked as the Twins No. 6 prospect.
- Acquired by Minnesota on July 30 in exchange for RHP Jhoan Duran, along with C Eduardo Tait...assigned to Triple-A St. Paul.
- Made his major league debut on May 18 vs. Pittsburgh for Philadelphia...in 6.0 scoreless innings, allowed five hits with no walks while striking out nine...tied Curt Simmons (1947) for the most strikeouts in Phillies franchise history in a ML debut.
- Began 2025 season with Triple-A Lehigh Valley...named Phillies Minor League Pitcher of the Month for April, going 3-1 with a 2.15 ERA (29.1 IP, 7 ER) with 11 walks, 32 strikeouts and a 1.09 WHIP in five starts.
- Spent the duration of the 2024 season with Triple-A Lehigh Valley...went 3-12, 6.46 ERA (108.2 IP, 78 ER) with 78 walks (15 BB%) and 117 strikeouts (23 K%) across 24 starts.
- At 22-years-old, was the 2nd-youngest pitcher in the International League to throw at least 50 IP, trailing only Gwynnett's AJ Smith-Shawver.
- Ranked 2nd in the IL in walks (78), issuing three or more free passes in 16/24 starts.
- Had his best month of the season in August, when he produced a 3.86 ERA (9 IP, 21.0 IP) in four starts, including firing 6.0 shutout on August 9 vs. Scranton/Wilkes-Barre.
- Spent the majority of 2023 with Double-A Reading, but made one start for Lehigh Valley, his Triple-A debut, to end the year on September 22.
- In 23 combined starts between both levels, posted a 4.13 ERA (113.1 IP, 52 ER) with 65 walks (13 BB%) and 132 strikeouts (27 K%)...allowed 3 ER or fewer in 18 of his 23 starts & 2 ER or fewer in 17/23.
- Was the starting pitcher for the National League in the All-Star Futures Game at T-Mobile Park in Seattle on July 8...earned the win with a scoreless frame and two strikeouts.
- Named an Organizational All-Star for the Phillies by MiLB.com.
- Ranked as the Phillies No. 2 prospect at the end of the 2024 season by MLB.com.
- Split 2022, his second professional season, between Double-A Reading (5g) and High-A Jersey Shore (18g), combining to go 8-11 with a 3.90 ERA (108.1 IP, 47 ER) with 50 walks (11 BB%) and 130 strikeouts (28 K%) in 23 starts.
- Ranked third among Phillies minor leaguers in innings (108.1) and starts (23) while ranking T-3rd in total strikeouts (130).
- In 2021, made his professional baseball debut...in 14 starts for Low-A Clearwater, posted a 4.43 ERA (44.2 IP, 22 ER) with 27 walks and 66 strikeouts.
- Selected by the Philadelphia Phillies in the 1st round (15th overall) of the 2020 MLB Draft out of Jesuit High School (OR)...became the highest selected high school pitcher in the 1st round by the Phillies since Gavin Floyd (4th overall) in 2001.
- Named the Gatorade Oregon Baseball Player of the Year in 2019 and 2020.
