<b>RAY REPORT</b> —The Rays conclude the month of June with the finale of a six-game,
seven-day homestand against the Mariners (2-1) and Nationals (1-1, 1 to play) today at
Tropicana Fieldhave won four of six, seven of 10, eight of 12, and 10 of their last 17
gamesafter traveling to Kansas City and Texas from July 2-7, the Rays will conclude
their pre-All-Star break schedule by hosting two of the AL's top three teams in the
Yankees and Guardians from July 9-14according to Elias, they have the hardest
remaining schedule in the majors with a combined opponent winning pct. of .534 the
Rays have not been above 500 since entering play on May 21 (25-24)

Tampa Bay yielded six runs in the 7th inning of last night's 8-1 loss to Washington, its most in any frame since June 3, 2023 at Boston (6R, 6th inn.)

The Rays were out-hit, 13-2 (-11), in the loss, their worst hit margin since July 29, 2023 at Houston (-11/18-7) and worst at home since May 23, 2023 vs. Toronto (-21/27-6)...entering the contest, they had not been out-hit in any of their previous eight games, their longest streak of the season.

Tampa Bay saw its streak of 17 straight games holding a lead snapped yesterday... it was the club's longest streak since an 18-game run from May-June 2021.

Rays pitching has yielded a home run in 13 of the last 14 games and 22 of 25 games in June...they have permitted a major league-leading 114 HR this season.

The Rays 16-9 (.640) mark in Interleague play remains the best in the AL and is fourth in MLB (LAD/PHI - .650; ATL - .647)...they are 8-3 against NL clubs at home.

WHAT'S AT STAKE—With a win today, the Rays would:

Claim a fourth straight series win, securing their longest streak since winning six consecutive sets from Aug. 11-30, 2023.

Improve to 7-2-0 in series play against NL opponents (4-0-0 at home).

Record a series win over the Nationals at Tropicana Field for the first time since sweeping a two-game set from June 25-26, 2018.

Earn three straight home series victories for the first time since a six-series streak from Aug. 11-Sept. 21, 2023.

Win their fifth straight rubber match, improving to 8-4 in such contests...it would mark their longest streak since Aug. 16-Sept. 21, 2023 (6G) and signal their ninth time winning 5+ consecutive rubber games in a single season (Elias)

Record a winning record in June for the second straight year, marking their second time accomplishing the feat in back-to-back seasons, joining 2008-09.

REWRITING RECORD BOOKS—Yesterday, Yandy Díaz saw his franchise-record 20-game hitting streak and career-high 29-game on-base streak come to an end despite recording a trio of hard-hit balls (97.8, 105.5, 109.0)...during the hitting streak, he slashed .360/.374/.494 (32-for-89) with 3 2B, 3 HR and 11 RBI, ranking among AL leaders during that span (June 7-28) in mulit-hit games (T1st, 11), hits (2nd, 32) and average (5th)...the hitting streak is the fourth longest in the majors this season, while the on-base streak is fifth longest.

His streak of eight consecutive games with an RBI was halted in Friday's series opener...it matched the club record shared by Rocco Baldelli (2004), Carlos Peña (2008), Evan Longoria (2009) and Ben Zobrist (2009) and is tied with BOS Wilyer Abreu (April 18-27) for the second-longest streak in the majors this season behind LAD Shohei Ohtani (10G, June 16-26).

Díaz has collected 36 hits in June, fourth most in the majors behind BAL Gunnar Henderson (39), MIN Carlos Correa and BOS Jarren Duran (both 38).

The 36 hits are tied with Delmon Young (2007) for fourth most in the month in Rays history...Randy Winn (2002) holds the club record with 42 hits, followed by Carl Crawford (40, 2009) and Julio Lugo (37, 2006)...it matches August 2023 for the most hits in any calendar month of Díaz's career.

RED-HOT RAYS—Jose Siri is slashing .281/.349/.604 (27-for-96) with 7 2B, 8 HR and 16 RBI over his last 27 games since May 26, ranking among AL leaders in that span in homers (T5th), slugging pct. (6th) and OPS (10th, .953)...entering that stretch, he hit .164/.257/.270 (20-for-122) with 4 2B, 3 HR and 13 RBI in his first 42 games to open the season.

Randy Arozarena is batting .302/.436/.512 (13-for-43) with 3 2B, 2 HR, 7 RBI, 7 BB and 4 HBP during a 13-game on-base streak, his longest since a career-best 20-game run from April 17-May 9, 2023.

Josh Lowe is 11-for-33 (333) with 5 XBH a 1.072 OPS over his last nine games...he entered that stretch batting .189 (14-for-74) with a .594 OPS in his first 23 contests.

Isaac Paredes is riding an 11-game on-base streak, posting a .333 OBP in that span.

Ben Rortvedt is batting .333/.378/.643 (14-for-42) with 4 2B, 3 HR and 14 RBI over his last 12 games...the 14 RBI since June 13 are tied for fifth most in the AL.

SOUTHPAW SUCCESS—The Rays are 13-7 (.650) when opposed by left-handed starting pitchers, the fourth-best mark in the majors behind the Guardians (17-5/.773), Dodgers (23-8/.742) and Twins (15-8/.652)...they have won eight of 10 and nine of their last 12 such games after splitting their first eight (4-4)...the Rays are averaging 4.8 runs per game in 20 contests opposed by LH starters compared to 3.7 in 63 games vs. RH starters.

Yandy Díaz is batting .364 (20-for-55) vs. LHP since April 17, seventh highest in the AL over that timeframe (min. 50AB)...Jose Siri is batting .421 (8-for-19) against lefties in his last 22 games...Amed Rosario is 9-for-26 (.346) vs. LHP in June.

When facing left-handed starting pitchers, José Caballero is 11-for-31 (.355) with a 1.010 OPS while Brandon Lowe is 5-for-8 (.625).

Randy Arozarena is 3-for-6 (.500) lifetime vs. today's Nationals starter, LHP Patrick Corbin...Taylor Walls is 2-for-4 (.500) with 1 2B and 1 BB.

START YOUR ENGINES—Since posting a 10.13 ERA (16.0IP, 18ER) over four games from June 14-18, the Rays rotation has permitted 2 ER or fewer in six straight nine of the last 10 games, turning in a 2.85 ERA (53.2IP, 17ER) in that span, second in the AL behind the Royals (2.54)...the six-game streak is their longest since June 3-9, 2023 (8G).

CLOSE SHAVES—The Rays own the majors' best record in one-run games (16-7/.696) and games decided by two runs or fewer (29-12/.707)...among AL clubs, only the Athletics (43G) have played in more games decided by two runs or fewer than the Rays (41G)... since April 29, they are 20-6 in such contests and 8-20 in games with a margin of 3+runs...this includes a 12-4 record in one-run games over that timeframe...seven of their last nine wins have come by two runs or fewer.

The Rays 22 comeback wins are tied with five other clubs (BAL, CLE, KC, NYY, WSH) for second in the majors, trailing the Brewers (24)...Tampa Bay has come from behind in six of 10 and 12 of its last 17 victories.

Tampa Bay ranks among MLB leaders in last at-bat wins (T3rd, 12), wins after the opponent scores first (T4th, 17) and walk-off wins (T5th, 5)...the Rays have the most wins in the majors when trailing after six (10) and seven (8) frames.

DC. DEALINGS—The Rays and Nationals conclude their lone series of 2024 today, their first meeting at Tropicana Field since a two-game split from June 8-9, 2021...last season, the Rays recorded a three-game sweep at Nationals Park from April 3-5 as part of their modern era-record-tying 13-game season-opening winning streak...Tampa Bay posted a +13(23-10)run differential in the series, plating 6+runs in each contest...since the franchise moved to the nation's capital in 2005, the Rays are 9-4 against them at Tropicana Field.

The Rays are 4-1 against the Nationals since 2023...from 2020-22, they went 2-6. Tampa Bay is 7-3 against NL East opponents, including 4-1 at home.

TODAY'S START—The right-hander will make his 10th start of the season this afternoon, including his seventh at home...owns a 0.81 ERA (22.11P, 2ER) in his last four home starts...has worked 5.0+ innings in eight of his nine starts...opened the season obefore his May 10 reinstatement. opened the season on the 15-day IL (right pectoral strain)

LAST TIME OUT—Did not factor into the decision on June 24 vs. Seattle worked 5.1 innings, allowing one run on two hits and a season-high four walks while striking out eight batters...marked his fourth start this season working 5.0+ IP while allowing one run or fewer.

Struck out six of the first seven batters he faced...allowed his first hit in the 3rd inning, a two-out single by J.P. Crawford...allowed his lone run of the game in the 4th inning, a one-out homer by Cal Raleigh.

**NEW TEAM, WHO DIS?**—Bradley is set to make his first career start against Washington...is 0-1 with a 5.40 ERA (10.0IP, 6ER) in two career starts against NL East opponents, both of which came last season (May 18 at NYM & July 8 vs. ATL)...is 2-3 with a 3.66 ERA (32.0IP, 13ER) in six career Interleague starts.

Made his lone Interleague start this season on June 13 vs. CHC and earned the victory (7.0IP, 3H, 2R, 0ER, 2BB, 11SO).

STRING OF SUCCESS—He has worked 5.0+ IP and allowed 2 ER or fewer in each of his last four starts, posting a 1.54 ERA (23.1IP, 4ER) during that stretch...he is the first Rays starter to throw 5.0+ IP and allow 2 ER or fewer in four straight starts since Tyler Glasnow (6GS, July 7-Aug. 14, 2023).

DOME SWEET DOME—Bradley has turned in a 0.81 ERA (22.1IP, 2ER) across his last four home starts, producing a 0.85 WHIP and .120/.224/.200 (9-for-75) opp. slash line while yielding 2 XBH (2HR)...5 of the 8 ER he has allowed at home came on May 20 vs. Boston—in his other five starts at Tropicana Field, Bradley has pitched to a 0.95 ERA (28.1IP, 3ER).

Min 35.0 IP, his 2.04 home ERA is sixth lowest in the AL behind CWS Erick Fedde (1.64), DET Tarik Skubal (1.74), BAL Corbin Burnes (1.78), NYY Nestor Cortes (1.84) and SEA Bryce Miller (1.99).

THE RIGHT ANSWERS—Over his last four starts, Bradley has limited right-handed hitters to a .162/.225/.243 (6-for-37) line, allowing 1 XBH (HR by MIN Royce Lewis)...min. 90 BF, his .185 AVG against righties on the season is 10th lowest among AL pitchers.

Bradley has limited righties to a .194 (7-for-36) AVG on his four-seam fastball, compared to a .326 (15-for-46) mark vs. lefties.

STRIKEOUT ARTIST—Bradley's 189 SO are fourth most in a pitcher's first 29 starts after joining the Rays, trailing Charlie Morton (219, 2019), Tyler Glasnow (197, 2018-20) and Drew Smyly (191, 2014-16)...Morton (223) also holds the mark through 31 starts, followed by Glasnow (206) and Smyly (198)...Bradley's 189 SO are the most by a Ray in his first 30 career starts, outpacing Shane McClanahan (183, 2021-22).

On June 13 vs. CHC, he tossed a career-high-tying 7.0 IP and fanned a career-high-tying 11...became the first Rays pitcher to throw 7.0+

IP, strike out 11+ and allow 0 ER since McClanahan on May 11, 2022 at LAA (7.0IP, 3H, 0R, 1BB, 11SO).

**SUCCESS WITH THE SPLIT**—He has utilized his split-finger 27.9 pct. of the time and limited opponents to a .152 (10-for-66) AVG on the offering...of his 61 SO, 32 have come via the splitterr (52.3%).

Over his last four starts, he has limited the opposition to a 5-for-35 (.143) clip with 17 SO on the split-finger.

Last season, Bradley deployed his split-finger 13.6 pct. of the time, his lowest usage of any pitch in his arsenal...the offering was also successful a year ago, as he posted a .190 (12-for-63) AVG with 26 SO and a 41.0 pct. whiff rate on the pitch.
