THE TWINS: After returning home with a 2-1 series win in Toronto over the weekend, the Twins began their six-game, seven-day homestand last night with a win over the Red Sox...tonight, Minnesota will play the second of three against Boston and complete the series tomorrow afternoon...they will enjoy an off-day on Thursday, then host the Reds for three games over the weekend.

☞ Today marks day 14 of a stretch of 15-straight days with a game for Minnesota...their next off-day will be on Thursday.

☞ Twins have 10 wins through 17 games...in 2025, Minnesota didn't earn its 10th win until game 26 on April 25.

☞ Twins have won three-straight, seven of their last eight and nine of their last 12.

BEANTOWN BEAT DOWN: The Twins beat the Red Sox last night at Target Field by a score of 13-6, scoring 11 runs in the first two innings (4 in the 1st and 7 in the 2nd)...Bailey Ober (2-0) was the starter and winner, allowing four runs on seven hits in a season-high 6.0 innings pitched, with one walk and seven strikeouts...the offense scored a season-high in runs on 11 hits and five walks...Ryan Jeffers went 3-for-4 with a home run (2) and three RBI (10)...Byron Buxton (1), Victor Caratini (1) and Ryan Kreidler (1) all added home runs.

☞ The Twins sent at least nine men to the plate in both the first and second innings, their first time doing so in consecutive innings since May 18, 2019, at Seattle when they did so in the second and third innings of an 18-4 win.

☞ 13 runs marked Minnesota's most over Boston since scoring 15 against them on May 8, 2013 at Fenway Park (15-8 win).

TARGET RUN: Twins have gone 6-2 at home this season for a .750 winning percentage...only Detroit has a higher winning percentage, posting an .833 at Comerica Park (5-1)...Minnesota has won five-straight at Target Field, their longest home winning streak since April 25-May 19, 2025, when they won 10-straight here.

WATCH THE THRONE: Byron Buxton hit his 85th career home run at Target Field last night, passing Max Kepler for the most in the ballpark's history...below are his Target Field rankings in a few offensive categories:

DIRTY WATER: The Twins and Red Sox are playing the second of six meetings in 2026...their next series will be at Fenway Park for a weekend series from May 22-24.

☞ Twins have gone 9-6 in their last 15 games against Boston, dating back to June 21, 2023.

☞ Ryan Jeffers is hitting .375 (18-for-48) with five doubles, three home runs and a 1.054 OPS in his last 13 games against the Red Sox, dating back to June of 2023.

☞ Byron Buxton has hit safely in 10-straight games against the Red Sox, hitting .372 (16-for-43) with one double, five home runs, seven RBI and a 1.144 OPS in that span...additionally, he has reached base safely via hit or walk in 15-straight against Boston, dating back to April of 2021 (.385 OBP / 1.046 OPS).

☞ Victor Caratini is hitting .367 (11-for-30) with seven walks, a .500 on-base percentage and a .967 OPS in 13 career games against the Red Sox.

RUN THE WORLD: Twins have scored 92 runs on the season, second-most in the AL and fifth-most in baseball, trailing Houston (95), Los Angeles-NL (95), Atlanta (94) and Washington (94)...through 17 games in 2025, the Twins had scored 56 runs, ranking 26th in baseball.

LEARNING TO FLY: The Twins have homered 11 times in their last five games and have hit 21 on the season, tied with Atlanta and Los Angeles-AL for second-most in baseball, trailing Los Angeles-NL (29).

TWINS GO FOR THE MEATLOAF - TWO OUT OF THREE AIN'T BAD: With a victory today and/or tomorrow, the Twins can earn their third series win of the season and third consecutively...they have gone 2-3-0 in series play (series results in the right margin)...last time they won three consecutive series came July 4-13, 2025, taking two of three from Tampa Bay, Chicago-NL and Pittsburgh.

☞ Minnesota's last series win over the Red Sox came May 2-4, 2025, taking two of three at Fenway Park...their last series win over Boston at Target Field came May 3-5, 2024, taking two of three.

FULL HOUSE: The Twins are hitting .382 (13-for-34) with the bases loaded, including four doubles, one grand slam, 33 RBI and four walks...they lead baseball in bases loaded at-bats, hits, doubles and RBI...the next closest team in RBI is Milwaukee with 21.

☞ Notable individuals with the bases loaded this season: Victor Caratini is 1-for-1, Ryan Jeffers is 1-for-1, Trevor Larnach is 1-for-1, Tristan Gray is 3-for-4, Josh Bell is 2-for-3, Luke Keaschall is 1-for-2, Brooks Lee is 3-for-7 and Matt Wallner is 1-for-3.

THIS AND THAT:
☞ Twins lead baseball in batting average with runners in scoring position at .306 (45-for-147).
☞ Twins hitters rank fourth in the AL in walk percentage on the season at 11.8%.
☞ Twins lead baseball in ABS challenges at 57, 10 in front of second-place Miami (47)...they have gone 14 of 29 on the hitting side and 19 of 28 on the fielding side.
☞ Over their last eight games, the Twins have scored multiple runs in 13 of their 67 total innings at-bat...in those eight games, they have scored four-plus runs in an inning seven different times.

- In his last start on April 9 vs. Detroit, Abel pitched 6.0 scoreless innings with four hits allowed, three walks and six strikeouts...did not factor into the decision, but the Twins went on to beat the Tigers 3-1 to finish off a four-game sweep, while Mick recorded his first quality start of the season and third of his career.
- Tonight will be Abel's third straight home start to open the season...last year he did not make any starts at Target Field (two relief appearances).
