**BUELLER?... BUELLER?...**: After a historic series opener yesterday in which SF scored 18 runs, the Giants will look to build on their momentum today to try to clinch their second straight series win here at Wrigley Field (went 2-1 here on May 5-7 of last season).

- ▶ SF enters today winners of four of its last six games and are averaging 9.2 runs per game in the six games...prior to this stretch, the Giants had dropped each of their previous five games and nine of their previous 11.
- ▶ Giants batters are slashing .348/.385/.616 with 27 doubles, 16 homers, 64 runs scored and a 1.001 OPS through the first eight games of this road trip...the last time SF has hit .348 or better on a road trip of six or more games was in 1999, when they hit .366 in six games from June 11-26.
- ▶ After losing their first two games of the road trip, SF has won four of six to put them at 4-4 so far on the road trip.
- ▶ A victory today would give SF its first four-game winning streak of the year...they have won three straight games on four separate occasions this season.

**HERE'S WHERE CAMERON GOES BERSERK:** The Giants' offense put on a historic performance yesterday, homering seven times on their way to a 18-3 victory over the Cubs...the seven homers were their in a game since April 3, 2023 at CWS, when they also homered seven times.

- ▶ Paired with their 12-9 win at Milwaukee on Thursday, SF has now scored 30 runs over their last two games, their most in a two-game span since scoring 30 runs in a doubleheader on April 30, 1944 at the Brooklyn Dodgers.
- ▶ Looking ahead, the most consecutive games in Giants history with 12+ runs is three, last done nearly 132 years ago, on June 12-14 1893 (*Elias*).

**FERRIS BUELLER, YOU'RE MY HERO:** Yesterday, **OF Jonah Cox** lined his first career homer off Carson Kelly to become just the second player since 1900 to have hit both his first career hit and homer off a position player, joining PHI's Mitch Walding, who homered off Miami's catcher Bryan Holaday on Sept. 14, 2018 for his first career hit...Cox, who doubled off Rockies catcher Brett Sullivan on Sunday for his first career hit, is the only player to ever do it in separate at-bats.

- ▶ Cox' homer traveled 446 ft, the second-furthest home run by a Giant this season behind **IF Bryce Eldridge** (453 ft on Sunday at Coors Field).
- ▶ The rookie also recorded two singles in the 6th inning to become the first Giants rookie to have two hits in an inning since **Aramis Garcia** did so on August 31, 2018 vs. NYM.

**LIFE MOVES PRETTY FAST: IF Matt Chapman** homered twice yesterday, including the fourth grand slam of his career, on his way to a record a career-best eight RBI... Chapman's eight RBI are tied for third-most by a Giants player in a game since RBI became official in 1920, trailing only **Phil Weintraub** (11 on April 30/, 1944) and **Irish Meusel** (nine, Sept. 2, 1925).

- ▶ Chapman had a total of seven RBI in 27 games in May.
- ▶ Paired with Thursday's grand slam by **C Eric Haase**, it was just the seventh time in Giants history they've hit a grand slam in consecutive games (second this season).
- ▶ Lastly, the grand slam was SF's sixth in their last 18 games/20 days...it marked the shortest span the club has hit six grand slams in franchise history and made them one of just six teams in MLB history to have hit six grand slams in 20 days or less (*Stats, LLC*).

**SCHMITT'S DAY OFF: IF Casey Schmitt** lined his 14th and 15th career home runs yesterday as part of a four-hit day, the fifth such game of his career...Schmitt's 15 homers are a career-high and the most by a Giant in their first 56 games of a season since **Barry Bonds** (18 HRs in 2004) ...back to back sequence...how many multi-hits in one inning.

- ▶ Schmitt also hit twice in the 6th inning, marking the fourth instance a Giants player has hit twice in an inning since Sunday (Also: **Cox** yesterday and **OF Jung Hoo Lee**, twice).
- ▶ With Chapman's two homers and **IF Willy Adames** also homering twice, it marked just the third time in franchise history the Giants had three different players with multi-homer games, also done on July 2, 2002 (**Damon Minor, Reggie Sanders & Tsuyoshi Shinjo**) and July 8, 1956 (**Willie Mays, Daryl Spencer and Wes Westrum**) (*Elias*).

# LANDEN ROUPP RHP #65

2026 RECORD: 5-5, 3.30 ERA

**ROUPPER:** Roupp is in his third season with San Francisco...the 27-year-old was the Giants' 12th round pick in 2021 out of UNC Wilmington.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Roughed up for a career-high eight earned runs on June 1 at Milwaukee, surrendering seven runs in the 2nd inning...allowed eight hits and five walks over 4.0 innings...his five walks in the game also tied a career-high.

**VS. CHICAGO-NL:** Is slated to make his second career start vs. the Cubs...pitched here at Wrigley Field last season (May 5), receiving the loss after allowing four runs (two earned) on five hits while striking out four in 5.0 innings...CHC's Ian Happ took Roupp deep while Dansby Swanson had two hits (one double) and two RBI.

**MAY DAY:** Roupp has struggled since the start of May after finishing April as one of MLB's best pitchers...since May 2, Roupp is 0-5 with a 6.28 ERA (20er, 28.2ip), 35 strikeouts and a 1.81 WHIP in six starts...he has completed 5.0 innings in just three of those six starts...the 6.28 ERA since the start of May is fourth-highest in MLB over that span (min. 28.0ip in that time frame).

**WHERE'S THE K COUNTER LOCATED?:** Roupp has 72 strikeouts in 64.0 innings this season with his 26.6% strikeout rate currently standing as a career-best (21.7% rate in 2024 and a 21.4% rate in 2025)...the 26.6% strikeout rate is ninth-best in the NL among qualified pitchers.

**WHAT'S THE COUNT?:** Roupp's 17.8 pitches per inning is the fourth-highest mark in MLB among pitchers with at least 60.0 innings pitched this season (teammate **LHP Robbie Ray** is third with 18.3 pitches per inning)...his 4.20 pitches per batter faced is second highest in MLB (min. 60.0ip) behind only Ray's 4.24 mark.

**NO EAR PLUGS NEEDED:** The righty's 30.0% hard hit rate this season is the second lowest in the Majors (min. 150 batted ball events) behind only PHI's Jesús Luzardo (29.6%)...Roupp's 50.0% ground ball rate in 2026 is eighth-highest in MLB (qualified pitchers).

**SINK OR SWIM:** His sinker has been his most-used pitch (37.3 usage rate) and has a +3 run value this season per *Baseball Savant*, which is a +9 improvement over the -6 run value the pitch had in 2025.

**CALLING CARD:** Since entering the Majors in 2024, Roupp's go-to out pitch has been his curveball...this season, opponents are batting .203 (15x74) vs. the pitch with 36 strikeouts, a 38.8% whiff rate and a 31.6% putaway rate...the Cubs' .464 OPS vs. curveballs this season is lowest in the Majors.

**CHANGING THE PACE:** His changeup has a .174 opposing batting average (8x46) with 12 strikeouts and a 31.5% whiff rate this season...the .174 opponent batting average is the 11th-lowest in MLB among all changeups (min. 200 changeups thrown).

**WE LOVE TO SEE IT:** Roupp averages 13.2 seconds between pitches with the bases empty, which is tied for the 11th-fastest in MLB...the league average in 2026 is 16.1 seconds with the bases empty.

**NICE AND EASY:** There is over a 200 point difference in OPS, and a 50 point difference in batting average depending on the result of Roupp's first pitch in a plate appearance...if the opponent swung at the first pitch, they are batting .200 (13x65) with four doubles, a triple and a .513 OPS...if the opponent takes the first pitch, they are batting .251 (44x175) with 10 doubles, a triple, three homers and a .723 OPS.

**DAY MAN:** Roupp has seen the majority of his success come in day games this season...in three day game starts, Roupp is 2-1 with a 2.41 ERA (5er, 18.2ip), 19 strikeouts, a 0.80 WHIP and a .498 opposing OPS...in nine night game starts, Roupp is 3-5 with a 4.96 ERA (25er, 45.1ip), 53 strikeouts, a 1.52 WHIP and a .731 opposing OPS.

- After the Giants won each of McDonald's first three outings after he was recalled on May 4, SF has lost each of his last three (0-3, 7.20 ERA, 14h, 13r, 12er, 6bb, 14k).

**Pitch Arsenal:** 4-Seam FB, Slider, Curveball, Sweeper  
**Last Game:** 6/4 at MIL; 1.0ip, h, r, er, hr (12 pitches)

- ▶ Recalled from Triple-A Sacramento on Sunday (second stint with SF)...has surrendered seven runs in 3.0ip in three games since his recall and has a 10.50 ERA in five appearances (6.0ip) for SF so far.
- ▶ Had gone 2-1 with a 3.91 ERA (10er, 23.0ip) in 17 relief outings for the River Cats this season.
- ▶ Appeared in 31 games for SF last season, working in a bulk innings role...recorded at least four outs in 18 of the 31 games.
- ▶ Batters were 9x64 (.141) with 18 strikeouts off his sweeper in '25... left-handed batters hit .202 (20x99) with 18 strikeouts off him.

### #34 JT BRUBAKER ▶ RHP *(BROO-baker)*

**Pitch Arsenal:** 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Slider, Cutter, Changeup  
**Last Game:** 6/4 at MIL; 2.0ip, 2h, 2r, 2er, hr, 2bb, k (46 pitches)

- ▶ Allowed two runs in 2.0ip last in Milwaukee...still has a 1.88 ERA (3er, 14.1ip) in his last eight games.
- ▶ Has a 1.62 ERA (3er, 16.2ip) in 12 road games...has a 4.70 ERA (8er, 15.1ip) in nine games at Oracle Park.
- ▶ Issued at least one walk in 12 of 21 contests (4.8 BB/9.0ip).
- ▶ Opponents are hitting .212 (7-for-33) off his slider, .224 (11-for-49) off his sinker and .267 (4-for-15) off his changeup.

### #31 SAM HENTGES ▶ LHP *(HENT-chiss)*

**Pitch Arsenal:** Curveball, 4-Seam FB, Slider, Sinker  
**Last Game:** 6/4 at MIL; 0.2ip, bb, k (15 pitches)

- ▶ Has made 10 appearances with SF, logging 8.2 innings and allowing two runs on four hits with 11 walks and 10 strikeouts.
- ▶ Righties are 0-for-16 off him.
- ▶ Returned from rehab and reinstated from the 15-day IL on May 10.
- ▶ Is pitching in the Majors for the first time since July 2024.
- ▶ Missed the entire 2025 season while recovering from left shoulder surgery, performed by Dr. Neal ElAttrache in Los Angeles on September 18, 2024...also developed some right knee soreness during his rehab and underwent arthroscopic surgery in August 2025.
- ▶ Signed one-year deal with SF on December 3, 2025.

### #45 CALEB KILIAN ▶ RHP *(kill-EE-en)*

**Pitch Arsenal:** 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Slider, Curveball  
**Last Game:** 6/4 at MIL; 1.0ip, h, k (13 pitches)

- ▶ Allowed 12 runs (10 earned) in 12.0 innings in May...had allowed one run in 14.0 innings in 13 March/April games.
- ▶ Left-handed batters are 11-for-57 (.193) with no XBH against him while right-handers are 8-for-42 (.190) with five homers.
- ▶ Returned to the Giants organization on a minor league deal with a spring invite this past offseason...dealt with a right shoulder strain for most of 2025 with the Cubs organization.
- ▶ Originally drafted by the Giants in the eighth round of the 2019 draft and was one of the organization's top prospects when he was dealt to the Cubs at the trade deadline in 2021 along with OF Alexander Canario in exchange for IF/OF Kris Bryant.

### #68 ERIK MILLER ▶ LHP

**Pitch Arsenal:** Slider, 4 Seam FB, Sinker, Changeup  
**Last Game:** 6/3 at MIL; 0.1ip, h, bb (11 pitches)

- ▶ Reinstated from the 15-day IL on May 16 after missing 14 games with a low back strain.
- ▶ Has allowed 14 walks in his 17.2ip (7.13 BB/9.0).
- ▶ Has allowed just one home run in his last 62.2 innings pitched dating back to August, 2024.
- ▶ Right-handers are 6-for-32 (.188) off him while left-handers are 6-for-32 (.188).
- ▶ Holding opponents 2-for-23 (.087) off his slider and 5-for-32 (.156) off his sinker.

### #77 CARSON SEYMOUR ▶ RHP

**Pitch Arsenal:** 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Curveball, Slider, Changeup  
**Last Game:** 6/5 at CHC; 3.0ip, 6h, 3r, 3er, hr, bb, k (45 pitches)

- ▶ Recalled from Triple-A Sacramento yesterday.
- ▶ Was 3-2 with a 4.04 ERA (22er, 49.0ip) and 23 strikeouts in 11 games (nine starts) with the River Cats this season.
- ▶ In his last three starts with Sacramento leading up to his recall, Seymour was 1-0 with a 1.69 ERA (3er, 16.0ip) and 15 strikeouts.
- ▶ Had a 3.38 ERA (10er, 26.2ip) in 13 games out of the bullpen for SF in 2025...also made three starts, posting a 8.68 ERA (9er, 9.1ip) and .325 BAA as a starter.
- ▶ His most effective pitch last season was his four-seamer...batters were 5-for-31 against it (.161) with eight strikeouts.

### #66 DYLAN SMITH ▶ RHP

**Pitch Arsenal:** 4-Seam FB, Sweeper, Splitter, Sinker  
**Last Game:** 6/5 at CHC; 1.0ip, 2k (12 pitches)

- ▶ Recalled from Triple-A Sacramento Tuesday, his second recall of the season...has made two appearances so far for SF, throwing 1.2 scoreless innings with a walk and two strikeouts.
- ▶ Had a 3.98 ERA (9er, 20.1ip) .205 BAA and 23 strikeouts in 15 games with the River Cats.
- ▶ Acquired from Detroit on March 30 in exchange for cash.
- ▶ Drafted by Detroit on the third round in 2021 out of the University of Alabama...had spent the past five seasons in the Tigers organization.
