AROUND THE HORN

RECORD-SETTING 50/50: The D-backs Give Back 50/50 Raffle supported by Avnet Cares generated a record jackpot of \$712,332 on Saturday, surpassing \$560,331 on Father's Day 2025...this season's 50/50 Raffle jackpots totaled \$5.0 million with \$2.5 to winning fans and \$2.5 to charity.

RACE AGAINST CANCER THIS SUNDAY: This Sunday, Sept. 27, the D-backs Foundation will host their 13th annual Race Against Cancer, presented by Dignity Health Cancer Institute...the charitable 5K, which begins and ends at Chase Field, brings together community members in support of Arizona nonprofit organizations dedicated to cancer screening, treatment, and support for individuals and families affected by all types of cancer.

HERE’S THE STORY: The D-backs are 7-1 in their last 8 road games and 10-4 in their last 14 road games.

- The D-backs have a season-high-tying 5-game winning streak (also: May 17-21, May 23-27)...their last 6-game winning streaks were in 2024: Aug. 9-14 and Aug. 19-25.
- D-backs starting pitchers**, in their last 5 games (5-0), are 3-0 with a 3.55 ERA (11 R-10 ER in 25.1 IP), an opponent .245 AVG (24-for-98)/.712 OPS, 5 walks and 19 strikeouts.
- Nolan Arenado** has reached base safely in 18 straight games, batting .388 (26-for-67)/1.244 OPS with 3 doubles, 8 homers, 18 RBI and 7 walks.
 - His 8 home runs in September are tied for third in the Majors.
- Gabriel Moreno** has hit safely in 16 of his last 18 games at a .366 clip (26-for-71)/1.066 OPS with 4 doubles, 5 homers, 14 RBI and 8 walks.

LAST GAME: The D-backs won 12-8 @ Rockies for their eighth all-time road sweep @ Rockies and sixth 3-game road sweep @ Rockies (last: June 8-10, 2018).

- This season, it was their sixth sweep, fourth on the road.
- Eduardo Rodriguez's** career-best 19th quality start (6.0 IP, 2 R, 9 H, 0 BB, 3 K) tied for the third-most in a season by a D-backs starter since 2017 while his 16th win was his second-most in a season behind 19 in 2019.
- Gabriel Moreno** had a first-inning, 3-run homer and **James McCann** had a solo homer in the sixth inning.
- Geraldo Perdomo** reached base 4 times with 2 singles, 1 triple and 1 walk.
- Nolan Arenado** had 3 hits and 3 RBI, with a first-inning 2-run homer and a fifth-inning RBI single.

ROSTER MOVES: The D-backs placed RHP **Corbin Burnes** on the 15-day injured list (right shoulder inflammation) retroactive to Sept. 22 and recalled RHP **José Cabrera** (No. 53) from Triple-A Reno.

WILD CARD RACE: The D-backs are fourth in the NL Wild Card race, 2.0 games behind the Phillies (WC 3, tied 3-3), 3.0 games behind the Cubs (WC 2) and 4.0 games behind the Padres (WC 1)...the Cubs and Padres have clinched Wild Card berths.

CHEERS TO THE SOD POODLES: Double-A Amarillo won the Texas League Championship, 2-games-to-1 over Springfield, with a 6-4 road victory on Wednesday.

- The Sod Poodles have won the Texas League 3 times in 7 seasons.

11 GAMES OVER .500: The D-backs' 85-74 record has them 11 games over .500 for the first time since Sept. 29, 2024, when they were 89-73 to end the season.

IN THE LAST 5 GAMES: The D-backs’ 37 runs in their last 5 games are tied for their third-most over a 5-game span this season (also: July 21-25) behind 38 runs from July 22-26 and 41 runs from July 19-23.

RISPY BUSINESS: Among all teams with runners in scoring position since Sept. 11, the D-backs are second with a .936 OPS (.989 Brewers), third with a .314 AVG (.351 Brewers, .315 Padres) and tied for fifth with 45 runs.

THE THREE AMIGOS: In September, of the team’s 91 runs scored, a combined 46 RBI have come from the trio of **Nolan Arenado** (18 RBI), **Corbin Carroll** (14 RBI) and **Gabriel Moreno** (14 RBI).

GABI EYEING THE NL BATTING CROWN: **Gabriel Moreno’s** .308 AVG is second in the NL, behind Luis Arráez/SF-PHI (.310) and ahead of Otto López/MIA (.304) and Nick Gonzales/PIT (.301).

- His .308 AVG is third in the Majors to Yordan Álvarez/HOU (.315) and Luis Arráez/SF-PHI (.310).
- The last catcher to win the NL batting title was Buster Posey/SF in 2012 when he hit a Major-League-leading .336 (114 G at C, 29 G at 1B, 3 G at DH, 5 as PH).

CATCHERS HITTING .300: **Gabriel Moreno** looks to become the first catcher qualified for the NL batting title (min. 81 games at catcher and min. 502 PA) to hit .300+ since 2017 when Buster Posey/SF hit .320 (5th in NL, 7th in MLB).

DOMO HEATING UP: **Geraldo Perdomo**, in his last 10 games, is hitting .421 (16-for-38)/1.026 OPS with 2 triples, 4 RBI and 6 walks.

- Has reached base safely in 15 of his last 16 games, hitting .351 (20-for-57)/.880 OPS with 1 double, 2 triples, 6 RBI and 9 walks.

CARROLL AND THE IRON HORSE: Courtesy Sarah Langs, **Corbin Carroll** (60 2B, 104 HR) joins Lou Gehrig (62 3B, 120 HR) as 1 of 2 players all-time with 60+ triples and 100+ home runs in their first 640 career games.

STRONG SEPTEMBER ‘PEN: The bullpen’s 2.82 ERA (32 R-28 ER in 89.1 IP) in September leads the NL and is fourth in the Majors to the Guardians (1.96), Red Sox (2.11) and Blue Jays (2.71).

- In 20 games in September, have a .217 AVG (62-for-306)/.579 OPS with 26 walks and 84 strikeouts.

BG SLINGING ZEROES: **Brandyn Garcia** has held road foes scoreless in 6 of his last 7 games (1 ER in 6.1 IP, 2 H, 1 BB, 10 K) and 10 of his last 12 outings (3 ER in 10.1 IP, 3 H, 3 BB, 18 K).

MORILLO TOUGH ON ROAD FOES: **Juan Morillo** has held opponents scoreless in 13 of his last 14 road games (2 ER in 13.1 IP) with opponents hitting .188 (9-for-48)/.563 OPS with 2 walks and 17 strikeouts.

VS. PADRES: The D-backs split the 4-game set @ Padres from July 6-9 with an 8-0 win on July 6, 4-1 loss on July 7, 10-4 loss on July 8 and 3-1 win on July 9.

- This is the 10th time the D-backs face the Padres in the season’s final series, going 15-12.
