HERE'S THE STORY: The D-backs have won 4 straight games vs. Dodgers...last won 5 straight from April 2-14, 2018.

- The D-backs are 6-3 in their last 9 games and 16-8 in their last 24 games.
- The D-backs' 16 wins since July 9 are third most in MLB, behind the Red Sox (21) and Braves (17).
- **Merrill Kelly**, in 4 starts vs. NL West this season, is 4-0 with a 2.17 ERA (7 ER in 29.0 IP), opponent .186 AVG (19-for-102), 5 walks and 17 strikeouts.
 - Is 1 of 4 starters with 4 wins vs. NL West this season, along with Brandon Pfaadt/AZ, Shohei Ohtani/LAD and Cristopher Sánchez/PHI.
- **Ketel Marte** has reached base safely in 17 straight home starts vs. Dodgers, batting .319 (22-for-69)/1.064 OPS with 8 doubles, 6 homers, 11 RBI and 6 walks.
- **Ryan Waldschmidt** has hit safely in 12 of his last 15 games at a .396 clip (19-for-48)/.942 OPS with 4 doubles, 1 homer and 4 RBI.
- **Brandyn Garcia** is scoreless in 20 of his last 21 games, going 0-0 with a career-best 3 saves, 1.04 ERA (3 R-2 ER in 17.1 IP), opponent .119 AVG (7-for-59)/.344 OPS, 0.63 WHIP, 4 walks and 25 strikeouts.

LAST GAME: The D-backs lost 5-1 vs. Padres last night and split the 4-game series.

- **Gabriel Moreno** went 3-for-4 with a double and RBI.
- **Lars Nootbaar** singled and has reached base safely in his first 3 games as a D-back (2 H, 3 BB/.385 OBP).

ROSTER MOVES: The D-backs recalled RHP **Kade Strowd** from Triple-A Reno and optioned LHP **Kohl Drake** to Reno following last night's game.

HEART AND HUSTLE: Today, **Nolan Arenado** was named the D-backs' 2026 Heart and Hustle Award winner, announced by the Major League Baseball Players Alumni Association (MLBPAA)...Arenado will be presented his award tomorrow in a pregame ceremony.

- The annual award is given to active players who exemplify a true passion for the game and who best embody the values, spirit, and traditions of the game.

WILD CARD RACE: The D-backs currently hold the third NL Wild Card spot, 6.0 games behind the Cubs (WC1) and 1.0 game behind the Phillies (WC2), and 1.0 game ahead of the Padres.

HOME SWEET HOME: The D-backs' .579 home win pct. (33-24) is sixth in the NL, behind the Braves (.661, 39-20), Brewers (.650, 39-21), Marlins (.596, 34-23), Cubs (.593, 35-24) and Dodgers (.589, 33-23).

- The D-backs are 6-3 in their last 9 home games since July 18...in that span, they rank among the Majors in OPS (2nd, .851), SLG (2nd, .485), OBP (2nd, .366) and AVG (4th, .293).

SERIES-LY SPEAKING: The D-backs have won or split 7 of their last 8 series (2-2 @ Padres, 3-0 @ Dodgers, 2-1 vs. Cardinals, 2-1 vs. Athletics, 1-2 @ Nationals, 2-1 @ Pirates, 2-1 @ Guardians, 2-2 vs. Padres)...does not include the 1-game makeup win on July 23 @ Cardinals.

BATS AFTER THE BREAK: Since July 26, the D-backs' 100 hits are third in the NL, behind the Cubs (113) and Padres (108), while their 144 times on base rank fourth.

STARTING PITCHERS: D-backs starting pitchers, in their last 10 bids, own a 2.50 ERA (20 R-16 ER in 57.2 IP), opponent .249 AVG (54-for-217), with 17 walks and 42 strikeouts.

'PEN SPOTLIGHT: **Brandyn Garcia** is scoreless in 19 homes game, going 0-0 with an opponent .115 AVG (6-for-52)/.298 OPS, 3 walks and 14 strikeouts.

- Since being acquired in July of 2025, has not allowed an earned run in 24 home games (1 R-0 ER in 21.1 IP), going 0-1 with an opponent .143 AVG (10-for-70)/.335 OPS, 3 walks and 20 strikeouts.
- **Taylor Clarke** is scoreless in 9 of his last 10 games with a 0.00 ERA (1 R-0 ER in 11.2 IP), opponent .146 AVG (6-for-41)/.313 OPS, 1 walk and 7 strikeouts.
- **Juan Morillo** is scoreless in 10 of his last 11 games with a 0.77 ERA (1 ER in 11.2 IP), opponent .162 AVG (6-for-37)/.436 OPS, 3 walks and 12 strikeouts.

WINNING VS. NL WEST: The D-backs' .639 division win pct. (23-13) ranks third in MLB, behind the Braves (.676, 25-12) and Brewers (.667, 22-11).

- The D-backs are 13-7 (.650) at home vs. NL West, tied for NL's second-best division home win pct. with the Dodgers and tied for sixth-best in the Majors.

VS. DODGERS: The D-backs are 5-2 in their last 7 meetings...swept their last 3-game series @ Dodgers from July 10-12.

- With a win, would be the sixth time in franchise history with 5+ straight wins vs. Dodgers (also: franchise-high 8 from July 2-Sept. 29, 2005 and July 6-Aug. 31, 2012, 6 from Aug. 29-Sept. 6, 2017 and 5 from April 14-June 10, 2013).

- **Tim Tawa**, in his last 4 games vs. Dodgers, is hitting .500 (8-for-16)/1.500 OPS with 2 doubles, 2 homers and 7 RBI, including a pair of 3-hit performances.
 - **Geraldo Perdomo** has reached base in 11 of his last 13 home games vs. Dodgers, hitting .349 (15-for-43)/.788 OPS with 3 doubles, 5 RBI and 2 walks.
 - **Corbin Carroll**, in his last 7 home games vs. Dodgers, is hitting .333 (9-for-27)/1.067 OPS with 3 doubles, 2 homers, 3 RBI and 3 walks.

NEXT STARTER: RHP BRANDON PFAADT (6-1, 3.66)

- The D-backs are 7-0 in his last 7 starts.
- In his last 7 starts, is 6-0 with a 1.55 ERA (8 R-7 ER in 40.2 IP), opponent .237 AVG (37-for-156)/.573 OPS, 5 walks and 21 strikeouts.
- Has not allowed an earned run in his last 2 bids, going 1-0 with a 0.00 ERA (1 R-0 ER in 13.2 IP), opponent .216 AVG (11-for-51)/.520 OPS, 2 walks and 7 strikeouts.
- Won his last start vs. Dodgers on July 11, allowing 2 runs over 5.1 innings (6 H, 0 BB, 2 K).
