**HERE'S THE STORY:** The D-backs are 2-1 on a 9-game, 11-day road trip @ Mariners (2-1), Dodgers (Sept. 13-15) and Astros (Sept. 17-19).

- ♦ Arizona is looking to win its third straight road game for the first time since a season-high 4-game stretch from April 18-22.
- ♦ 8 of the D-backs' 13 games vs. Dodgers in 2021 have been decided by 3 runs or fewer, including 3 1-run games.
- ♦ **Zac Gallen** boasts a 2.19 ERA (6 ER in 24.2 IP), .187 opponent average (17-for-91), 7 walks and 27 strikeouts.

**ROSTER MOVES:** The D-backs made the following roster moves:

- ♦ Reinstated RHP **Tyler Clippard** from the injured list.
- ♦ Optioned LHP **Miguel Aguilar** to Triple-A Reno following yesterday's game.

**I'M BEING SERIES-OUS:** The D-backs are coming off their first road series win since April 23-25 @ Braves.

**I'LL HAVE ANOTHER:** Yesterday, **Seth Beer** joined Gerardo Parra as the only 2 D-backs to record a RBI in each of their first 3 Major League games.

- ♦ Parra owns the club record with a RBI in his first 5 games from May 13-20 [GM 1], 2009 (6 RBI total).

**GIVING A LITTLE EXTRA AWAY FROM HOME:** The D-backs have recorded an extra-base hit in 36 straight road games dating back to June 14, the longest single-season streak by the club since a 55-game stretch to end the 2018 campaign.

**RUNS ON THE ROAD:** Arizona has scored 4+ runs in 7 of its last 8 road games, including in each of its last 4 contests.

**NO RISP, NO REWARD:** The D-backs are hitting .342 (13-for-38) with runners in scoring positing in their last 6 games.

**ROOKIE CONTRIBUTIONS:** The D-backs have used 27 rookies this season, with rookie hitters totaling 892 plate appearances and rookie pitchers combining for 429.2 innings:

- ♦ **Hitters:** 892 plate appearances, 77 hits, 38 doubles, 4 triples, 20 home runs, 86 RBI, 93 runs scored (does not include pitchers batting).
- ♦ **Pitchers:** 32 wins, 14 saves, 429.2 innings, 314 strikeouts (does not include position players pitching).

- Cardinals' third-round pick in the 2016 draft out of the University of North Carolina.

**WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW:** Owns a 2.19 ERA (6 ER in 24.2 IP), .187 opp. average and 0.97 WHIP in his last 4 starts (3 quality).  
• Both victories have come on the road.

**LAST START:** Lost on Sept. 7 vs. Rangers, allowing 3 runs on 6 hits over 6.2 innings and 8 strikeouts...yielded all 3 runs in the fourth inning.

**VS. DODGERS:** Has gone 0-1 with a 2.45 ERA (8 ER in 29.1) in 5 career starts.

- Posted a no decision in his last start on July 30 (2 ER in 6.0 IP) @ Chase Field, surrendering just 2 runs in the sixth with 1 walk and 8 strikeouts.

**NUMBER CRUNCHING:** Is limiting right-handers to a .202 average (35-for-173) with 60 strikeouts.

- Has held all hitters to a .225 average (74-for-329) in his first 5.0 innings of work.

**FASTBALL FACTS:** Is averaging 93.0 mph. on his fastballs, up from 90.8 in 2020 [includes 4-seamers, cutters and sinkers].  
• His 2.2 mph. increase is seventh most in the Majors.

**DH DUO:** Tossed a 1-hit, 7.0-inning shutout on April 25 @ Braves in Game 1...Madison Bumgarner threw a 7.0-inning "no-hitter" in Game 2.

- The 1 hit allowed was the fewest in a doubleheader in baseball history.

**2020 REVIEW:** Set the Major League record by allowing 3 or fewer earned runs in each of his first 23 career games.
