CAREER

Tall right-hander from the University of Oklahoma developed into a reliable member of Washington's starting rotation and a leader in the clubhouse.

- After making 33 starts in 2024 and 2025, he joined **Max Scherzer** (2015-16) as the only two pitchers in Nationals history to start at least 33 games in back-to-back seasons.
- Had the "Best Control" in Washington's system, per *Baseball America*, entering the 2023 season.

LAST START

Irvin tossed 5.1 innings of two-run ball on three hits and no walks with eight strikeouts against the St. Louis Cardinals at Busch Stadium on September 20...He took the no-decision in the 5-3 loss.

vs. NEW YORK

Irvin is set to make his 11th career start against the New York Mets...He has pitched to a 4.83 ERA (32 ER/59.2 IP) with 18 walks and 49 strikeouts.

JAKE...EMPHASIZE THE K

In his last start, Irvin struck out eight batters without issuing a walk, his most strikeouts without a walk since April 25 at Chicago (AL) when he fanned nine batters with no free passes.

- Over his last five starts, irvin has struck out 28 batters in 24.1 innings pitched (10.36 SO/9.0 IP).
- Irvin has improved both his strikeout rate (23.3%) and strikeouts per 9.0 IP (9.21) as compared to his 2025 numbers (15.8 SO% and 6.20 SO/9.0 IP).

CURVIN' IRVIN

Opponents are batting .143 (13-for-91) against Irvin's curveball...He has given up just three extra-base hits on his curveball this season.

REHAB APPEARANCES

Irvin allowed just two hits (2-for-38) with 12 strikeouts and one walk in 11.1 innings across three rehab outings with the FCL Nationals and Double-A Harrisburg Senators...In two outings with Harrisburg, he allowed one hit in 8.1 innings with nine strikeouts and one walk.
