**METSCELLANEOUS:** The Mets fell to the Reds, 12-0, yesterday... The Mets are 10-7 over their last 17 games and 22-19 over their last 41 games...The Mets are on a six-game, seven-day road trip (0-1) against the Reds (0-1) and Phillies (three games).

**ROSTER MOVES:** Prior to today's game, the Mets announced the following roster moves - RHP Kodai Senga has been returned from rehab assignment and reinstated from the 15-Day Injured List...RHP Jonathan Pintaro was optioned to Triple-A Syracuse following last night's game...INF Zack Short (#40) has reported to the Major League team...INF Vidal Brujan has been designated for assignment.

**HIGH FIVE:** The Mets have scored five or more runs in each of their last nine wins dating back to May 29 vs. Miami...Their nine games with five or more runs during that span are tied for the fifth-most in the majors...Held the opposition to one or zero runs 11 times this season and five times since May 30...Are tied with Milwaukee for the most such games in the majors since May 30.

**THIS ONE GOES TO II:** Over the last 11 games, Bo Bichette is batting .413 (19-46) with eight runs, five doubles, one triple, three homers, 12 RBI, a .396 OBP and a .761 SLG...He has recorded multiple hits over each of his last four games, batting .529 (9-17) with five runs, three doubles, two homers, six RBI, a .500 OBP, a 1.059 SLG and a 1.559 OPS in that span.

**A.J. STYLES:** A.J. Ewing is batting .317/.370/.488 with one home run, four doubles, three RBI, six runs and four walks and an .857 OPS over his last 12 games dating back to June 2...Mookie Wilson (1981) owns the Mets rookie record for most steals with 24...Lee Mazilli (1977) is second on the list with 22, and Gree Jefferies (1989) is third with 21.

**JUAN OF A KIND:** Juan Soto has 259 career home runs...That is the 11th-most in Major League history prior to turning 28 (next: Frank Robinson, 262)...His 259 homers are 24th among active players...It is 21st all-time amongst players born in the Dominican Republic...George Bell is next with 265...Soto has reached base safely in eight straight games, batting .360 (9-25) with four runs, two doubles, two homers, five RBI, nine walks, a .529 OBP and a .680 SLG.

**THE HUSASCAR GOES TO:** As a relief pitcher, Huascar Brazobán has pitched to a 1.26 ERA (4 ER/28.2 IP) across 24 appearances...He ranks eighth in majors and sixth the NL in relief pitcher ERA (min. 20.0 IP).

**METS-REDS NOTES:** The Mets are 42-28 all-time at GABP... The team has hit .263/.333/.448 all-time since the yard opened up in 2003.

**ON THE ROAD AGAIN:** The Mets are 14-22 on the road in 2026... They have won three of their last five road games...Last season, the Mets went 34-47 on the road...The team has posted a 3.67 ERA on the road, which is fourth in the majors and third in the National League.

**POWER OF THE PEN:** The Mets bullpen has posted a 3.38 ERA (118 ER/314.2 IP) as a group...That ranks tied for fifth in the majors and third in the National League...They have struck out 316 this season, the most in the NL and the most in The Show.

**STRIKE THAT:** Mets pitchers have tallied 650 strikeouts this season, that is the fourth-most in the National League and the fifth-most in the majors...Their 650 punchouts are the fifth-most in franchise history through the team's first 72 games of a season.

**WILL I AM:** On Friday, Devin Williams picked his sixth career save of four or more outs and his first since May 28, 2023...He is unscored upon in 15 of his last 17 appearances dating back to April 26 and has 24 strikeouts during that span...His 37 strikeouts this season are tied for eighth among NL relief pitchers.

**DREAM WEAVER:** Luke Weaver has not allowed a run over his last 16 appearances...He has tossed 18.0 scoreless innings, allowing 10 hits, four walks and has struck out 19 in that span...He is now 2-1 with a 2.40 ERA (8 ER/30.0 IP) this season with eight walks and 27 strikeouts in 27 appearances...He has recorded six appearances of at least four outs this season and each of those appearances have been scoreless.

**THIS DAY IN 1986:** The Mets won their seventh straight game, defeating the Expos, 4-1, in Montreal...Ron Darling made the start and allowed four hits, six walks and struck out eight over 7.0 scoreless innings...Wally Backman recorded three hits including two doubles in the victory...This season, the Mets will celebrate the 40th anniversary of the 1986 World Series Champions...The Mets will also host a 1986 World Series Reunion and Celebration to celebrate the 1986 title on Saturday, August 1 prior to the 4:10 p.m. game against the Miami Marlins...Additional information for the 1986 World Series Reunion and Celebration is available at Mets.com/1986.

**RETURN OF THE KODAI:** Is slated to make his first start since April 26 against Colorado...Prior to going on the Injured List, he made five starts and was 0-4 while pitching to a 9.00 ERA (20 ER/20.0 IP)....In his first two starts of the season, he threw at least 5.0 innings and allowed two or fewer runs while striking out at least seven batters...In his last three starts, he failed to complete more than 3.1 innings and allowed 17 runs over the three starts.

**REHAB STINT:** He made four rehab appearances between St. Lucie, Syracuse and Binghamton...Over those starts, he went 0-1 with a 4.00 ERA (8 ER/18.0 IP) with 17 strikeouts...His last rehab appearance came on June 11 with Binghamton and he allowed one earned run over 6.0 innings while striking out five...He threw 75 pitches...He threw a rehab stint-high 91 pitches on June 3 while pitching for Syracuse...He recorded at least five strikeouts in each of his last three rehab starts from May 28-June 11.

**VS. CINCINNATI/NL CENTRAL:** Has made one career start against the Reds and it came in Cincinnati on May 11, 2023...He allowed five runs on eight hits and one walk while striking out seven at Great American Ballpark (5.0 IP, 8 H, 5 ER, BB, 7 K, HR)...In his career, he has made 12 appearances against NL Central opponents, and he is 4-6 with a 3.51 ERA (26 ER/66.2 IP) and has recorded 71 strikeouts lifetime against the division.

**KODAI THE FRIENDLY GHOST:** Through five starts this season, Senga had thrown his "ghost" forkball 23.4% of the time and generated a 41.0% whiff rate on the pitch...His 41.0% whiff rate on the pitch is the 13th-best among all Major Leaguers who have thrown their split finger pitch at least 50 times this season...Last season, Senga picked up 71 of his 109 strikeouts on the ghost fork...Held batters to a .130 average with his ghost fork this season, which was the second-lowest opponents' batting average among any qualified pitcher throwing a split-finger pitch and the seventh-lowest opponent batting average among any qualified pitcher throwing any pitch...His 41.8% whiff rate was the fourth highest on a qualified split finger pitch...In his rookie year (2023), Senga's "ghost fork" accounted for 110 of his 202 strikeouts...The pitch had a 59.5% whiff rate and a 28.2% put away rate...Opponents managed just 18 hits in 163 at-bats, ending with the forkball, a .110 batting average.

**2025 SEASON RECAP:** Senga finished last season going 7-6 with a 3.02 ERA (38 ER/60.2 IP), 55 walks and 109 strikeouts in 22 starts...Started the season going 7-3 through June 12, with a 1.47 ERA (12 ER/73.2 IP) over 13 starts...He had thrown at least 5.0 innings in all 13 starts and allowed three earned runs or fewer in all of those starts...Following his return from the IL, posted a 5.90 ERA (26 ER/39.0 IP) in nine starts...Allowed three or more earned runs in three consecutive games before being sent to Triple-A.

**GOOD THINGS COME IN THREES:** Has allowed three or fewer runs in 47 of his first 57 career starts...His 47 such starts are tied with Noah Syndergaard for the fourth-most in franchise history through a starter's first 57 career games...He trails Jacob DeGrom's 50 games and Dwight Gooden/Matt Harvey's 48 games...He had allowed three earned runs or less in 31 consecutive starts from June 23, 2023 to July 11, 2025, which tied with deGrom (from 4/16/18-4/3/19) for the second-longest such streak in franchise history...At the time, it was the longest active such streak in the majors...He trailed only Jacob deGrom's 40 starts (from 9/9/19-9/18/22).

**SENGA GENESIS:** Through Senga's first 57 career starts he has posted 343 strikeouts...His 343 strikeouts through his first 57 Major League games are the fifth-most in Mets history behind Dwight Gooden (468), Noah Syndergaard (400), Matt Harvey (392) and Jacob deGrom (369)....His 343 strikeouts are also the fifth-most among Japanese-born pitchers through their first 54 starts, trailing only Yu Darvish (467), Hideo Nomo (446), Shohei Ohtani (398) and Yoshinobu Yamamoto (362).

**2024 REWIND:** He missed nearly the first four months of the 2024 season with a right shoulder capsule strain...Returned and made one regular season start on July 26 vs. Atlanta, throwing 5.1 innings and allowing two runs on two hits with nine strikeouts and one walk before exiting with an injury...Missed the rest of the regular season with a strained left calf...He made it back for the Postseason and he made his first career Postseason start on October 5 in Game 1 of the NLDS against the Phillies...Threw 2.0 innings allowing one run, a home run in the first inning, and recorded one walk and three strikeouts...Finished the Postseason making three appearances and pitching 5.0 innings while striking out four.

**REMARKABLE ROOKIE:** During his rookie campaign in 2023, Kodai Senga recorded 202 strikeouts and became the 18th rookie pitcher in the Modern Era (Since 1900) to have 200 or more strikeouts in a season...Senga's 202 punch outs were the second-most by a Mets pitcher behind only Dwight Gooden's 276 strikeouts in 1984...He joined Hideo Nomo (236), Yu Darvish (221) and Daisuke Matsusaka (201) as the only Japanese-born rookie hurlers to reach 200 strikeouts...Senga's 12 wins were tied with Ron Darling (1984) for the seventh-most wins in a single season by a Mets rookie and was the first Mets rookie to reach double-digit wins since Dillon Gee (13, 2011)...His 2.98 ERA (55 ER/166.1 IP) was the fifth-lowest in a single season by a Mets rookie behind only Jerry Koosman (2.08, 1968), Jon Matlack (2.32, 1972), Dwight Gooden (2.60, 1984) and Tom Seaver (2.76, 1967)...He finished seventh in NL Cy Young voting.

**HEY NOW YOU'RE AN ALL-STAR:** In 2023 Senga joined Pete Alonso (2019), Dwight Gooden (1984), Jerry Koosman (1968) and Tom Seaver (1967) as the only Mets rookies selected to an All-Star Game...He was the eighth Japanese-Born rookie ever to be selected to an All-Star Game joining Masahiro Tanaka (2014), Yu Darvish (2012), Kosuke Fukudome (2008), Hideki Okajima (2007), Hideki Matsui (2003), Ichiro Suzuki (2001) and Hideo Nomo (1995).

**METS-JAPAN CONNECTION:** Senga is the 14th Japanese-born player to appear in at least one game for the Mets, the most by any major league team...Prior to Senga, the last Japanese-born player to appear in a game for the Mets was OF Norichika Aoki in 2017.
