BIRDLAND BITES: The Orioles continue a stretch of 15 games in 14 days tonight which started with an April 30 doubleheader vs. the Astros...The Birds will play each of the next eight days, including three-game sets against the Athletics and Yankees before enjoying an off-day on May 14.

⚾ Last night, Baltimore snapped a season-high five-game losing skid, preventing its first six-game losing skid since an eight-game stretch from May 14 (G1)-20, 2025.

⚾ **Pete Alonso** scored a career-high-tying four runs, going 2-for-3 with two doubles, two RBI, and two walks...The four runs matched his career-best output, also done against Miami, on September 27, 2023...He is one of four players in MLB history to have two career games with 4+ runs scored against the Marlins, joining Steve Finley, Carlos Peña, and Jimmy Rollins.

⚾ **Samuel Basallo** finished a homer shy of the cycle, going 3-for-4 with one run and a career-high four RBI...He became the first O's catcher with 3+ hits, including a double and triple, in the same game since **Caleb Joseph** on May 12, 2017 at Kansas City.

⚾ **Adley Rutschman** pinch-hit for Basallo in the ninth inning and broke a 7-7 tie with an RBI single...It marked his third-career go-ahead RBI while serving as a pinch-hitter, each of which have come in the eighth inning or later (5/24/24 at CWS, single, 8th inn. & 9/2/22 vs. OAK, walk, 8th inn.).

⚾ The Birds plated three runs in the opening frame, their most in a road game this season and second most overall in a first inning (4 R, 4/24 vs. BOS)...Their nine runs overall marked a season high on the road, surpassing the eight scored on April 22 at Kansas City.

⚾ Baltimore hitters recorded five walks yesterday and have 16 games this season with 5+ free passes, third most in MLB behind Chicago-NL (19) and Milwaukee (17).

SCORING CHANGE: Yesterday, MLB announced a scoring change from Game 2 of the doubleheader between Baltimore and Houston on April 30...In the first inning, HOU's Yainer Diaz reached on what was originally ruled a base hit, but has since been changed to an error on **Jeremiah Jackson**.

⚾ As a result, **Brandon Young** was charged with one fewer hit and three fewer earned runs...His pitching line from that afternoon is now 4.0 innings, nine hits, 10 runs (4 ER), two walks, and two strikeouts.

GARCIA'S GREATNESS: **Rico Garcia** has posted a 0.56 ERA (1 ER/16.0 IP) with 18 strikeouts across 17 appearances...His lone hit allowed is a home run by KC's Michael Massey on April 21.

⚾ His .020 (1-for-49) opponent average and 0.38 WHIP are the best among all MLB relievers, outpacing MIA's John King (.063, 3-for-48) and SEA's Matt Brash (0.44 WHIP), respectively.

⚾ Prior to Garcia's current run, the fewest number of hits allowed by an Oriole through their first 17 outings of a season was four (**Yennier Cano**, 2023 & **Jesse Orosco**, 1997).

⚾ He has yet to allow a hit in each of his eight home appearances to open the 2026 campaign, one of three Oriole pitchers in franchise history to accomplish the feat along with **Bryan Baker** (9 G, 2023) and **Shawn Armstrong** (8 G, 2019).

POLAR BEAR PETE: **Pete Alonso** has hit safely in a season-high six straight games, batting .400 (8-for-20) with four doubles, two home runs, nine runs, and five RBI during that stretch.

⚾ He has an extra-base hit in six of his last eight games, posting a 1.315 OPS in that time.

⚾ He has 56 extra-base hits opposite Miami since making his MLB debut in 2019, the most by any player in MLB against a single opponent during that period, outpacing CLE's José Ramírez's 55 extra-base hits against Detroit.

⚾ Alonso's 32 career home runs opposite the Marlins are third most among all active players, trailing LAD's Freddie Freeman (42) and PHI's Bryce Harper (39).

⚾ He has reached base safely in 24 of his last 25 games in Miami since July 31, 2022, slashing .300/.377/.550 (30-for-100) with 10 doubles, five home runs, 19 runs, 21 RBI, and 13 walks.

CAN'T WARD HIM OFF: **Taylor Ward** has reached base safely 69 times through his first 35 games with the O's (37 H, 31 BB, 1 HBP), the third-highest figure by an Oriole in franchise history (since 1954) behind **Frank Robinson** (72 TOB, 1966) and **Roberto Alomar** (71 TOB, 1996)...The record through 36 games is also held by Robinson (74 TOB).

⚾ Ward's .429 on-base percentage ranks fourth in MLB...According to *STATS Perform*, the last Oriole to finish a season top five in on-base percentage was **Eddie Murray** in 1984 (2nd, .410).

⚾ Ward has reached safely in 32 of the last 34 games since March 28 while slashing .298/.439/.427 (37-for-124) with 13 doubles, one homer, 22 runs scored, 12 RBI, 31 walks, one hit by pitch, and one stolen base during that time.

FASTBALL FOCUS: Baltimore hitters own a collective .470 slugging percentage off fastballs (4-seam, 2-seam, cutter), the best mark in the AL and sixth-highest in MLB behind Arizona (.523), Atlanta (.515), Chicago-NL (.502), Los Angeles-NL (.482), and St. Louis (.471).

⚾ The O's .300 slugging percentage on all other pitches is second lowest in the majors ahead of only the Twins (.295).

⚾ Tonight's opposing starter, Eury Pérez, has allowed opponents to slash .268/.375/.463 (22-for-82) with seven doubles, three home runs, and a 25.0 percent strikeout rate on his four-seamer, compared to a combined .211/.258/.439 (12-for-57) with four doubles, three homers, and a 24.2 percent strikeout rate on his four other offerings (slider, sweeper, changeup, curveball).

'PEN PALS: **Grant Wolfram** has not allowed a home run in 33.1 consecutive innings dating to July 21, 2025...He has allowed two long balls in 39.0 innings since his MLB debut on April 26 (G2) at Detroit, with both home runs coming on July 18, 2025 at Tampa Bay.

⚾ The O's 16.0 percent inherited runners scored rate (8 IRS/50 IR) is second lowest in the majors behind the Mariners (12.2%; 5 IRS/41 IR).

⚾ The O's had stranded the first 21 inherited runners to begin the season until the seventh inning on April 17 in Cleveland...It was the most inherited runners stranded to start a season in Orioles history (since 1954) and the most to begin a season by an MLB team since the 2016 Oakland Athletics (26), per the *Elias Sports Bureau*.

FIGURING OUT THE FISH: The O's and Marlins meet for their lone series of 2026 this week...Baltimore is 16-32 (.333) all-time opposite Miami, the second-lowest winning percentage against a single opponent in franchise history (since 1954), ahead of only Chicago-NL (8-17, .320).

May 6, 1984	- Cal Ripken, Jr. becomes the second Oriole to hit for the cycle, completing the feat with a ninth inning home run in a 6-1 win at Texas' Arlington Stadium. After a first-inning flyout, Ripken triples in the third, singles in the fifth and doubles in the seventh before going deep against the Rangers' Dave Tobik in his final at-bat to join Brooks Robinson as an Oriole cycler. Five others have done it since.

QUICK HITS: Young is set to make his fourth start of the season and the 16th of his career...Was recalled from Triple-A Norfolk for the second time this year on April 23 and made his second start of the season on April 24 vs. Boston...Was optioned to minor league camp on March 7 after making two Grapefruit League appearances... Signed with the Orioles as a non-drafted free agent on June 14, 2020.

LAST TIME OUT: Young suffered his first loss of the year on April 30 (G2) vs. Houston after throwing 4.0 innings, allowing a career-high 10 runs (4 ER) on a career-high-tying nine hits (3x, last: 8/21/25 at HOU) and two walks with two strikeouts...Threw 82 pitches, 51 strikes.

🏆 Was the first Oriole pitcher to permit 10+ runs since Andrew Cashner (10 R) on August 2, 2018 at Texas and the first to do so at Camden Yards since Daniel Cabrera (10 R) on September 12, 2007.

🏆 Has allowed two walks or fewer in each of his last eight starts dating back to July 29, 2025 (G2) vs. Toronto and in 12 of his 15 career starts.

FISH FRY: Young made his lone career start opposite Miami last season on July 13 and suffered the loss after allowing seven runs on nine hits (4 HR) with zero walks and four strikeouts across 4.1 innings.

🏆 Kyle Stowers was responsible for three of the four long balls and became the first player to hit three homers against the Orioles since TOR's Bo Bichette on September 5 (G2), 2022.

VELO UPTICK: Young's average fastball has climbed to 93.8 mph in 2026, up 1.3 miles per hour from last season (92.5 mph)...The 1.3 mph increase is the fifth-highest year-over-year increase by any pitcher in MLB this season behind LAA's Ryan Zeferjahn (+1.8 mph), SD's Adrian Morejon (+1.8 mph), ATH's Hogan Harris (+1.7 mph), and STL's Dustin May (+1.5 mph).

🏆 He has held opponents to a .200 (4-for-20) clip on his four-seam fastball, while the opposition is 4-for-9 (.444), all singles, off his sinker.

CLEAN SHEET: On July 8, 2025 vs. New York-NL, Young threw an immaculate inning in the fifth frame, becoming the fifth pitcher in Orioles history (since 1954) to accomplish the feat, joining Kevin Gausman (4/23/18 vs. CLE, 7th inn.), B.J. Ryan (9/5/99 vs. CLE, 6th inn.), Mike Mussina (5/9/98 vs. TB, 9th inn.), and Jimmy Key (4/14/98 vs. CWS, 2nd inn.).

HOMECOMING: On August 15, 2025 at Houston, the Lumberton, Texas native earned his first career win, tossing a career-high 8.0 scoreless innings, allowing one hit with zero walks and six strikeouts...He was perfect through 7.2 frames before Ramón Urías tallied an infield single, marking the longest perfect-game bid by an Oriole since Mike Mussina threw 7.2 perfect innings on August 4, 1998 vs. Detroit.

🏆 Young became the first Orioles rookie to throw 8.0 scoreless innings and allow one or zero hits since Chris Waters on August 5, 2008 at Los Angeles-AL (8.0 IP, 1 H, 0 R, 3 BB, 3 K).

🏆 The victory snapped a streak of 10 starts without a win to begin his career, marking the second-longest winless streak to begin a career in franchise history (since 1954), trailing Jimmy Yacabonis (11 GS, 6/28/18-8/4/19).
