THE GRAPEFRUIT GANG: The defending Grapefruit League champion St. Louis Cardinals are preparing for their 133rd season of play in the National League and conducting their 27th Spring Training at Roger Dean Chevrolet Stadium (1998-2024) ... The Cardinals travel to West Palm Beach today to play their 5th of seven Spring matchups with the Washington Nationals ... St. Louis has gone 1-3 over its first four games vs. "Natitude" this Spring (1-1 in West Palm Beach) ... St. Louis travels to the District of Columbia for a four-game wrap-around series (July 5-8) and hosts the Nats for three games at Busch Stadium (July 26-28).

HIGH NOON: The Cardinals today are playing the first of two Spring games beginning at 12:05 p.m. ET.

- Their other 12:05 p.m. game is also at the CACTI Park of The Palm Beaches vs. the Astros on Sunday, March 24 when the Redbirds break camp in Florida to travel to Arizona for a pair of Spring Training games against the division-rival Chicago Cubs.
- The last Cardinals Spring game at 12:05 p.m. was the final day of 2021 Spring Training on March 28, 2021 vs. the Mets in Jupiter before the team broke camp and flew to Cincinnati for their 2021 season opener against the Reds.

WEST PALM BEACH BIRDS: The Cardinals are 19-16-4 all-time at the CACTI Park of The Palm Beaches since the stadium opened in 2017 (2-2 this season), 2nd-best record by a visiting team behind the Marlins (24-9-5 record)... Against "Natitude" in West Palm Beach, the Redbirds are 13-7-1.

IN THE TRAINING ROOM:

- RHP Sonny Gray, who suffered a mild right hamstring strain on March 4, will pitch in a simulated pregame situation at the Cardinals Complex tomorrow.
- OF **Lars Nootbaar** has two non-displaced fractured ribs on his left side from colliding with an outfield wall.
- OF Tommy Edman is continuing his recovery from offseason right wrist surgery and is expected to begin the season on the Injured List.

CARDINALS MANAGER OLIVER MARMOL SIGNED THRU 2026: The St. Louis Cardinals announced yesterday that the team has signed Manager **Oliver "Oli" Marmol** to a contract extension through the 2026 season.

- Marmol, 37, has piloted the team over the past two seasons (2022-23), earning an NL Central title in his first season with a Cardinals team that won 93 games.
- It was the team's first division title since 2019, and at age 36, Marmol became the youngest manager to lead his team to the postseason since 1948 when Lou Boudreau led Cleveland to a World Series title at age 31.
- Marmol has been a member of the Cardinals organization since 2007, first as a player, and then as a coach and manager at the minor league level.
