SAN DIEGO PADRES (8-4) vs. PITTSBURGH PIRATES (4-7)

April 14, 2021 at PNC Park, Pittsburgh, PA -- GAME #12/HOME #6 RHP JOE MUSGROVE (2-0, 0.00 ERA) vs. LHP TYLER ANDERSON (0-2, 5.23 ERA)

THE PIRATES... have won three of their last four games...Have scored 25 runs in their last four games after scoring a total of 19 in their first seven...Collected a season-high 14 hits on Sunday while beating the Cubs, 7-1...Snapped their six-game losing streak with Saturday's 8-2 win...Began

season with a 5-3 victory at Wrigley Field on 4/1...Were 2-9 after 11 games in 2020 (2-10 after 12).

MILITARY WEDNESDAY: Each Wednesday home game throughout the 2021 season will be designated a Military Wednesday. ..The Pirates will wear Nike camouflage accented uniforms and special New Era Pirates military caps in tribute...During one Military Wednesday game each month, the Pirates will honor and support a local non-profit that assists military members, veterans and their families...Members of each group will be guests of the Pirates in the Pirates Charities Suite, where they will be presented with a check from Pirates Charities in support of the non-profit's mission...Since the Club introduced the Military Appreciation Program in 2015, the Pirates and Pirates Charities have supported over 30 different military organizations through the initiative.

ON THE MOUND: Lefty Tyler Anderson is making his third start of the regular season and the 85th of his big league career tonight...He has punched out 12 batters in his first 10.1ip after leading the staff with 18 strikeouts during spring training action...In nine career games (eight starts) against San Diego, Anderson has posted a 2.61 ERA (51.2ip/15er) while surrendering two runs or fewer in six of the nine outings.

HOMECOMING WEEK CONTINUES: Three days after facing and beating former Bucco starter Trevor Williams (3.1ip/10h/5r) and the Cubs on Sunday, the Pirates tonight are facing Joe Musgrove, who went 18-26 in his three seasons with the Bucs from 2018-2020...Let's hope the trend continues with another Pittsburgh victory this evening.

PHILTHY: Phillip Evans has gone 13-for-34 (.382) with three homers and five RBI while reaching base safely in all nine of his starts this season (five at third base, two in right field, one at first base and one in left field)...In his 11 starts with the Pirates last season, Evans hit .359 (14-for-39) with a homer and nine RBI...Overall, Evans is hitting .370 (27-for-73) with four homers, 14 RBI, a .452 on-base percentage and a 1.041 OPS in his 20 career starts with the Bucs.

<u>THE MAN BEHIND THE MASK:</u> Jacob Stallings tied career highs with three hits and three RBI while starting his fifth straight game Tuesday night...He enters tonight's action with a five-game hitting streak (8-for-16, .500).

<u>FIRST THINGS FIRST:</u> Opposing teams have scored at least one run in the first inning in six of the last seven games and in eight of the 11 games overall, scoring 14 runs total...The opposition has not been retired in order in the opening frame this season.

<u>BUCS/FRIARS</u>: The Pirates posted a 6-1 record against the Padres in 2019 and have won seven of the last eight games played against the Friars...The clubs are scheduled to wrap up their season series with three games in San Diego May 3-5.

<u>CLEANING UP:</u> Colin Moran has produced six RBI while batting fourth in the lineup this season...He is tied with J.T. Realmuto and David Peralta for the second-most RBI from that position among N.L. batters; Eric Hosmer is first with nine RBI.

<u>WEST WORLD:</u> Entering tonight's action, **Jacob Stallings** holds a career average of .425 (17-for-40) against the N.L. West teams, **Kevin Newman** has gone 29-for-79 (.367) and **Bryan Reynolds** has gone 44-for-119 (.370).

ROOKIE WATCH: Phillip Evans shares the National League lead in home runs among rookies and ranks second among all Major League rookies in both OBP (.475) and slugging percentage (.706) behind Yermin Mercedes of the White Sox (.541 and .758 respectively)...Evans' 1.181 OPS is also tops among N.L. rookies.

RICH ROD: Dating back to June 1, 2019, Richard Rodríguez has produced a 2.29 ERA (70.2ip/18er) in his 75 games - that is the second-lowest ERA in the Majors among all relief pitchers with at least 75 appearances behind Liam Hendricks (2.06)... Rodríguez has allowed just one hit in his first five outings this season (14 at bats) and posted his sixth career save on Opening Day, preserving Pittsburgh's 5-3 win in Chicago.

PINCH ME: The Pirates have collected six pinch hits this season; tied with Arizona for the most among all Major League teams...**Wilmer Difo** tripled as a pinch hitter Monday night after homering in a pinch-hitting role on Sunday - the club's first pinch-hit homer since 8/24/19 (**Colin Moran**).

<u>SHELTY'S CREW:</u> Manager **Derek Shelton** and his entire 2020 coaching staff have returned for a second season in 2021... **Christian Marrero** has joined the staff as Assistant Hitting Coach...Returning coaches include **Tarrik Brock** (First Base), **Joey Cora** (Third Base), **Rick Eckstein** (Hitting), **Don Kelly** (Bench), **Oscar Marin** (Pitching), **Justin Meccage** (Bullpen), **Mike Rabelo** (Field Coordinator) and **Glenn Sherlock**...Catching coaches **Herbie Andrade** and **Jordan Comadena** have returned.

Paul Wagner started and earned the win after allowing one earned run in 7.0 innings of work while Jeff Ballard recorded his first career save by striking out Tony Gwynn to end the game.

MITCH KELLER: The 25-year-old righthander will be making his third start of the season tomorrow afternoon...His last start was a victory over Zach Davies and the Cubs at PNC Park Saturday (5.0ip/5h/1r/1er/1bb/7so). ...His first start was a 4-3 loss to Davies in Chicago on 4/4 (3.0ip/3er...Went 1-1 with an 11.91 ERA in five spring training starts (11.1ip/23h/16r/15er/8b/11so)...Posted a 1-1 record and a 2.91 ERA (21.2ip/7er) in five starts during the 2020 season...Finished the season pitching 11.0 consecutive no-hit innings over his last two starts; the first N.L. pitcher to have back-to-back no-hit outings of 5.0+ innings or more since Johnny Vander Meer had back-to-back no-hitters in 1938.


