THE TWINS: After completing their 10-game roadtrip with a record of 4-6 (3-0 at Boston, 1-3 at Chicago-AL and 0-3 at Pittsburgh), the Twins began their seven-game homestand with consecutive wins over the White Sox...today, Minnesota will continue the homestand with the three-game series finale against the White Sox...starting tomorrow night, Minnesota will host the Royals for four games, from Thursday-Sunday.

☞ Twins have won five of their last six games at home...they have won three of their last four series' (May 12-14 vs. Miami, May 18-20 vs. Houston and this series vs. Chicago) in Minnesota.

☞ Twins are on day 13 of a 17 games in 17 consecutive days...next day off is Monday, June 8.

TWINS SECURE SERIES WITH SOX: The Twins beat the White Sox last night by a score of 6-4, securing their eighth series win of the season...Connor Prielipp (2-3) was the starter and winner, allowing four runs on six hits in 6.0 innings pitched, with two walks and seven strikeouts...Andrew Morris (0.2), Anthony Banda (1.0) and Yoendrys Gómez (1.1) combined to pitch 3.0 scoreless innings of relief, with seven strikeouts...the offense recorded 10 hits as the bottom three in the lineup (Luke Keaschall, Tristan Gray and Alex Jackson) combined to go 6-for-12 with five RBI...Minnesota also went 5-for-10 with runners in scoring position.

DEEP DISH: The Twins and White Sox are playing the seventh of 13 games this season...Twins are 3-3 vs. the Sox this season...their next meeting will be August 28-30 for three games at Target Field.

☞ Minnesota has gone 27-13 in its last 40 against the White Sox, dating back to May 4, 2023.

☞ Byron Buxton has 24 career home runs against the White Sox, tied with Tony Oliva for fifth-most in club history (since 1961), trailing Harmon Killebrew (61), Bob Allison (34), Torii Hunter (25) and Justin Morneau (25).

☞ Since 2020, nobody in baseball has homered more against the White Sox than Buxton (17).

☞ Luke Keaschall is hitting .367 (18-for-49) with four doubles, eight walks, five stolen bases, a .458 on-base percentage and an .907 OPS in 14 career games against the Sox.

DAAAAAAHH BUXTON: Byron Buxton is hitting .280 (101-for-361) with 31 doubles, three triples, 24 home runs, 57 RBI, 71 runs scored and a .926 OPS in 105 career games vs. the White Sox...below are his first 48 career games vs. the Sox (June 22, 2015-June 29, 2019), compared to his last 57 (June 30, 2019-present):

ALSO: Buxton's 24 career home runs, 101 hits, 31 doubles and 57 RBI against the Sox are his most against any opponent.

KEEP THEIR HEADS RINGIN': After going 1-for-2 last night, Josh Bell has now hit safely in a season-long six-straight games...during the streak, he is hitting .364 (8-for-22) with three doubles, three RBI and a .917 OPS...his career-best is 15, from April 28-May 19, 2019.

GRAY MATTERS: Over his last six games, since May 28, Tristan Gray is hitting .350 (7-for-20) with two doubles, one home run, 11 RBI, two stolen bases, a .600 slugging percentage and a .933 OPS...since May 28, his 11 RBI lead baseball.

TURN KEA, UNLOCK: Luke Keaschall went 2-for-4 last night, extending his on-base streak to nine games...over that span, he is hitting .364 (12-for-33) with two doubles and an .813 OPS...his career-high for an on-base streak is 14, from August 13-29, 2025.

SWEEP MUSIC: Twins are seeking their third sweep of the season today, their other two were a four-game sweep of the Tigers at Target Field from April 6-9 and a three-game sweep of the Red Sox at Fenway Park from May 22-24...they recorded four sweeps in 2025 — all in three games.

☞ Twins are looking to sweep the White Sox for the first time since August 2-4, 2024 in three games at Target Field.

☞ Since the start of 2023, the Twins and White Sox have played 13 series' with the Twins sweeping four of them.

☞ Since 2014, the Twins have swept the White Sox 12 times (65 series), their most of any opponent (next: Royals - 11 times and Tigers - 9 times).

☞ Twins have entered a finale with a chance to sweep three times this season, going 2-1...their one miss was April 15 vs. Boston at Target Field.

IT'S ALL IN THE RISP: Through two games this series, Twins have gone 10-for-20 with runners in scoring position...on the season, they have hit .283 (150-for-530) with RISP, the best in the AL and third-highest in baseball, trailing Milwaukee (.289) and Atlanta (.288).

☞ Notable individuals with RISP this season in chart in right margin.

☞ Among all AL players with a minimum of 50 RISP plate appearances: Brooks Lee ranks second and Luke Keaschall ranks fourth.

SAINT COLE: Cole Sands made his first appearance on rehab assignment last night with Triple-A St. Paul vs. Indy, pitching 1.0 scoreless inning with one strikeout, throwing 13 pitches...Sands was placed on the 15-day Injured List on May 2 with a right forearm strain.

TWINS MILB MONTHLYS: Twins have named Triple-A St. Paul outfielder Hendry Mendez and Low-A Fort Myers right-handed pitcher Justin Mitrovich their Player and Pitcher of the Month for May.

☞ Mendez, 22, played in 23 games between St. Paul and Double-A Wichita, combining to hit .344 (31-for-90) with four doubles, three home runs, 18 RBI, 17 runs scored, three stolen bases, a .449 on-base percentage and a .937 OPS...the Santo Domingo, DR native was acquired from Philadelphia by the Twins as part of the Harrison Bader trade at the 2025 deadline.

☞ Mitrovich, 22, made five starts for the Mighty Mussels last month, going 0-1, 1.15 ERA (15.2 IP, 2 ER) with six walks, 22 strikeouts and a 1.02 WHIP...the Trenton, New Jersey native was selected by the Twins in the ninth round of the 2025 MLB Draft out of Elon University.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 1967, Harmon Killebrew hit the longest home run by a Twin at an estimated 520 feet...Killebrew hit a three-run shot off California right-hander Lew Burdette, which landed in the sixth row of the upper deck at Metropolitan Stadium...the ball cracked the seat, and was later painted orange to commemorate the event...the seat is now located in the Mall of America — the former site of Met Stadium — bolted to a wall in the amusement park, marking the height and position where the ball would have landed in the upper deck.

- ⌘ Taj Bradley is slated to make his 11th start of the season and 84th start (86th game) of his career.
- ⌘ Bradley has made three career starts against the White Sox; 0-1, 11.57 ERA (11.2 IP, 15 ER) with five walks and eight strikeouts.
- ⌘ In his last outing on May 29 at Pittsburgh, Bradley did not factor into the decision, allowing four runs on five hits (1 HR), with two walks and six strikeouts, as the Twins fell to the Pirates in walk-off fashion by a score of 6-5 at PNC Park.

LAST TIME OUT: Taj made his 10th start of the season and second since returning from the Injured List on May 23...did not factor into the decision, allowing four runs on five hits - including a solo blast from Oneil Cruz - with two walks and six strikeouts, as the Twins fell to the Pirates 6-5 courtesy of a Bryan Reynolds two-run, walk-off homer in the ninth inning.

- ⌘ The home run to Oneil Cruz was the first surrendered by Bradley since April 29 vs. Seattle, and is just the sixth he has allowed all season, with four of those coming against the Rays on April 24 at Tropicana Field...six home runs are his fewest through his first 10 starts of a season since his debut season in 2023 with Tampa Bay, when he allowed five homers across his first 10 big league starts.

TWO STARTS AGO: Making his return from the 15-day Injured List (right pectoralis muscle inflammation), Bradley earned the win in his May 23 start against Boston at Fenway Park; Taj gave up one run on three hits with two walks and seven strikeouts in a 4-2 Twins win...threw an MLB season-low 73 pitches, 48 of them for strikes (65.8%)...improved his career numbers at Fenway Park to 4-0 with a 2.00 ERA (27.0 IP, 6 ER), 10 walks, 31 strikeouts, a .196 (18-for-92) BAA, .304 SLG against and a .587 OPS against in five career starts.

- ⌘ The win was his fifth in nine starts this season, which is the least amount of starts it has taken him to get to five wins in his career (previous low: 10 starts in 2023)...the win was also his fifth against the Boston Red Sox, the most he has against a single opponent in his career (next highest: three wins against Toronto).

DIRTY LAUNDRY: Taj is slated to make his fourth career start against Chicago-AL, with his first three coming during the 2025 season...he is 0-1 with an 11.57 ERA (11.2 IP, 15 ER), five walks, eight strikeouts, a 2.23 WHIP and a .396 (21-for-53) BAA.

- ⌘ In his most recent bout with the White Sox on September 4, 2025, Bradley did not factor into the decision, allowing four runs on eight hits in 5.0 innings pitched, with one walk and seven strikeouts, as the Twins fell 11-8 at Target Field.
- ⌘ Taj's team lost all three games that Taj pitched against the White Sox last season (Twins also lost 8-0 on August 24 at Rate Field and Rays lost 11-9 on July 23 at Tropicana Field).
- ⌘ He has faced 10 White Sox batters (including players on the Injured List); they are hitting a combined .415 (17-for-41) with three doubles, two home runs (both by Colson Montgomery), five walks and five strikeouts.

THERE'S THE CENTRAL...THEN THERE'S THE SOX: In his career, Taj is 4-5 with a 3.63 ERA (89.1 IP, 36 ER), 31 walks and 85 strikeouts against American League Central opponents...he has faced all five AL Central teams in his career (including the Twins during his time with Tampa Bay) and has pitched well against the majority, owning a sub-two ERA against three of them; his statline against our friends from the South Side, however, is the outlier...here are some numbers showing how Taj has fared against AL Central opponents:

HOME/ROAD SPLITS (CAREER): Over the course of his career, Bradley is 12-15 with a 4.85 ERA (213.1 IP, 115 ER), 68 walks, 240 strikeouts and a 1.25 WHIP in 40 career home starts compared to 12-13 with a 4.46 ERA (228.0 IP, 113 ER), 95 walks, 235 strikeouts and a 1.33 WHIP in 45 road appearances (43 starts).

- ⌘ **SO FAR IN 2026:** This year, he owns a 1-0 record with a 2.33 ERA (19.1 IP, 5 ER), four walks, 22 strikeouts and a 0.98 WHIP in three home starts compared to a 4-1 record with a 3.68 ERA (36.2 IP, 15 ER), 17 walks, 43 strikeouts and a 1.34 WHIP in seven road starts.

LEFT/RIGHT SPLITS: This season, left-handed hitters have slashed .190/.271/.353 (22-for-116) with seven doubles, four home runs, 13 walks and 41 strikeouts against Bradley, while righties are hitting .263/.330/.379 (25-for-95) with five doubles, two home runs, eight walks and 24 strikeouts.

THE ARSENAL: So far this season, Bradley has used a four-pitch mix, here are his numbers and results, per Baseball Savant.

⌘ **DEATH BY A THOUSAND CUTS:** His strikeout percentage of 32.1 with the cutter is the highest by a pitcher in baseball (min. 50 plate appearances)...he also ranks second with the cutter in whiff percentage (36.8) and third in BAA (.184).

ELITE COMPANY: Taj, age 25, has recorded 475 career strikeouts through his first 85 big league appearances...he is just the 30th pitcher in MLB history age 25-or-younger to record 475-or-more strikeouts through their first 85 career games, joining players like Dwight Gooden (646), Roger Clemens (544), Bob Feller (515), Clayton Kershaw (497) and Felix Hernández (487).

- ⌘ He is the first to reach the mark since current Tigers pitcher Jack Flaherty, who totaled 537 strikeouts through his first 85 career games with St. Louis from September 1, 2017-May 19, 2021 (age 21-25 seasons).
- ⌘ Of the 30 players on the list, none of them besides Bradley accomplished this feat while playing for the Senators/Twins (1901-).
