TONIGHT'S TILT...the Mariners continue the 6-game homestand with the first of 3 games against the New York Mets...Seattle is coming off a 3-game sweep of the Arizona Diamondbacks on the homestand... following Thursday's off-day, Seattle will embark on its first 3-city road trip of the season at Detroit (3 G, June 5-7), at Baltimore (4 G, June 8-11) and at Washington (3 G, June 12-14)...tonight's game will be televised and streamed live on **Mariners TV** with **Aaron Goldsmith** and **Ryon Healy** on the call and **Angie Mentink** serving as field reporter...the game will be broadcast live on **Seattle Sports (710 AM)** with **Rick Rizzs** and **Gary Hill Jr.** on the call.

ODDS AND ENDS...the AL West Division-leading Mariners completed a 3-game sweep of the Diamondbacks yesterday with a 3-2 walk-off win in 10 innings...Seattle has won a season-high 6-consecutive games, the longest active winning streak in MLB.

- **Don't Look Back, You Can Never Look Back** - The Mariners (31-29) are a season-high 2 games above the .500 mark.
- **Sweep Tooth** - The Mariners completed their 4th sweep of the season yesterday against the D'Backs... they have also swept the Astros (4 G, 4/10-13), the Cardinals (3 G, 4/24-26) and the A's (3 G, 5/25-27).
- **Walk-Off!!! - Victor Robles** earned the first walk-off of his career in yesterday's game with a 10th-inning single to score **Randy Arozarena**...Arozarena became the first Mariners player to provide a walk-off hit in one game and score the walk-off run in another in the same series since Alvin Davis (8/15-16, 1986), when he hit walk-off homers in consecutive games.
- **Revenge Series - Dominic Canzone** went 4-for-10 with 1 double, 2 home runs, 2 RBI and a 1.555 OPS in 3 games against the Diamondbacks, his former team.
- **Seattle Metropolitan Recap** - the last time the Mariners faced the Mets at home, the game was featured on Sunday Night Baseball and the national audience saw Seattle complete a 3-game sweep with a 12-1 victory on the back of a **Cal Raleigh** multi-homer effort.

JULIO RODRÍGUEZ: AL PLAYER OF THE MONTH?...Mariners center fielder **Julio Rodríguez** finished May with having one of the best months in the big leagues...in 28 May games, Julio batted .274 (32x117) with 18 runs, 7 doubles, 10 home runs, 18 RBI and 6 walks, getting on base at a .309 clip, slugging .590 with an .899 OPS...Julio **leads the AL during the month** in home runs (10), the most homers he's hit in a calendar month...in the month among AL leaders, Julio also ranks 1st in total bases (69), 1st in extra-base hits (17), 2nd in slugging percentage (min. 100 PA), T-5th in hits, T-6th in runs scored and T-10th in RBI.

WWWNNNNWINNING STREAK...during the Mariners season-best 6-game winning streak, the offense is batting .312 (69x221) with 37 runs, 8 doubles, 1 triple and 16 home runs, slugging .575 with a .926 OPS and 127 total bases across 241 plate appearances...during the streak, the Mariners pitching staff has a 1.77 ERA (11 ER, 56.0 IP), 16 walks and 48 strikeouts.

RALEY GOOD HITTER...**Luke Raley** has been one of the best hitters in the American League this season, batting .280 (42x150), 22 runs, 5 doubles, 1 triple, 13 home runs, 31 RBI, a .345 OBP and slugging .587 for an .932 OPS in 54 games...among AL hitters with at least 150 PA in 2026, Raley ranks 3rd in slugging, 6th in OPS and 3rd in OPS+ (164), trailing only Ben Rice-NYY (192) and Yordan Alvarez (192) in OPS+.

THE MARVELOUS MOUND MEN OF THE PACIFIC NORTHWEST...the Mariners pitching staff has posted a combined 3.46 ERA (206 ER, 535.1 IP) with an MLB-fewest 155 walks, along with 510 strikeouts... among Major League pitching staffs they rank 2nd in strikeout-to-walk ratio (3.29), 1st in fewest walks-per-9 innings (2.61), 5th in ERA, 5th in WHIP (1.20) and 10th in strikeouts...Mariners starting pitching leads MLB with 341.2 innings pitched and ranks 4th in strikeouts (324) and T-4th in quality starts (26)...the Seattle bullpen ranks 3rd in the Majors in ERA (3.11).

BIG 'EM...starting pitcher **Emerson Hancock**, who turned 27 yesterday, is 4-2 with a 2.78 ERA (20 ER, 64.2 IP) with 63 strikeouts and 15 walks, posting a 1.01 WHIP and dialing up 7 quality starts in 11 outings.

LITTLE 'EM...through his first 13 games as a big leaguer, **Colt Emerson** is batting .244 (10x41) with 6 runs, 3 doubles, 1 triple, 2 homers, 7 RBI and 5 walks, posting a .340 OBP, slugging .512 with an .853 OPS across 47 plate appearances...his .853 OPS is the highest by a Mariners rookie across their first 13 games since

CAPTAIN CRAWFORD...**J.P. Crawford** has hit safely in 7-consecutive games (5/24-c), batting .323 (10x31) with 3 home runs, 6 RBI and an .966 OPS during the streak...on Friday, J.P. recorded his first career multi-HR game, which included his 16th career leadoff home run with the Mariners which ranks 2nd in franchise history behind only Ichiro Suzuki (37 HR)...Crawford's has a 112 OPS+ this season despite sporting a career low .231 BABIP that also ranks 12th-lowest among qualified hitters.

IN OUR AROZARENA ERA...in 59 games this season, **Randy Arozarena** is batting .290 (64x221) with 40 runs, 16 doubles, 1 triple, 6 home runs and 26 RBI, going 15-for-17 in stolen base attempts, getting on base at a .373 clip and slugging .452 for an .825 OPS...among qualified American League hitters, he ranks T-6th in hits, T-3rd in doubles, T-7th in runs, and 3rd in SB...Randy leads Mariners players with 2.3 WAR (*Baseball-Reference*).

AS YOU MAY KNOW...**Bryce Miller** (3 G, 2 GS, 1-0, 1.15 ERA) and **Luis Castillo** (3 G, 1 GS, 1-1, 2.38 ERA) have combined to go 2-1 with an 1.67 ERA (5 ER, 27.0 IP), 8 walks, 30 strikeouts and a 0.74 WHIP over their last 3 tandem starts, but...**DID YOU KNOW?**...that Miller and Castillo are the 1st pair of American League teammates since 1912 (ER official stat) to toss at least 5.0 innings while allowing 2-or-fewer hits and 1-or-fewer earned runs in the same game?...they are the 7th pair of teammates in MLB history and first since the Chicago Cubs (6/2/18 vs. NYM)...additionally, Miller and Castillo have turned in back-to-back tag-team efforts of 4.0+ innings and 2-or-fewer earned runs, and have not allowed more than 2 runs in any tandem outing.

- **1999** - Alex Rodriguez swipes his 100th career stolen base vs. Baltimore.
- **2003** - The Mariners set a club record with seven consecutive hits to start their game in Minnesota. The Mariners get six singles and a triple en route to a six-run first inning in the 9-5 win against the Twins.
- **2018** - Mitch Haniger hit a walk-off home run in the 13th inning to beat the Tampa Bay Rays 4-3, the first career walk-off hit for Haniger.
- **2025** - **Randy Arozarena** provides a walk-off single to secure a 2-1 win over the Twins and a walk-off win in back-to-back games.

ABOUT EMERSON HANCOCK...

- The 27-year-old right-handed pitcher is scheduled to make his 12th start of the season...
• Selected by Seattle in the 1st round (6th overall) of the 2020 MLB First-Year Player Draft...
• Spent 3 seasons at the University of Georgia, 2018-20...
• Was named to CoSIDA Academic All-America First Team in 2020.

HAPPY BIRTHDAY!...celebrated his 27th birthday yesterday (May 31).

LAST TIME OUT...W#4 on May 26 at Athletics, tossing 6.0 scoreless innings and allowing just 1 hit and 2 walks with 3 strikeouts...he threw 87 pitches (56 strikes) in his 11th start of the year...

MAY WRAPPED...his 2.70 ERA (9 ER, 30.0 IP) in May ranks 10th best among AL pitchers over that span (min. 30.0 IP)...recorded the 11th most strikeouts in the AL (min 30.0 IP) while ranking T-11th in K/BB (3.4) and 8th in WHIP (1.03)...

MEETING THE METS...tonight's start will mark Hancock's first career appearance against the Mets...they are 1-of-6 teams he has not faced, not including the Mariners...in 3 starts against NL teams this season, owns a 2.50 ERA (5 ER, 18.0 IP) with a 1.11 WHIP and a K/BB of 4.0...

HOME TURF...across 6 home starts this season, owns a 2.65 ERA (10 ER, 34.0 IP), 7 walks and 41 strikeouts for a 5.86 K/BB and a 1.00 WHIP...ranks 4th in WHIP among AL pitchers (min. 30.0 IP) and 8th in ERA...his 31.8 K% ranks 7th best while his K/BB ranks 5th best in home games in MLB this season (min. 30.0 IP)...

EARLY BIRD...throws a first pitch strike 65.9% of the time, tying for 9th highest among qualified AL pitchers...earns a first pitch swing from the batter 38.9% of the time, tied for the 4th highest in the league...in at-bats where the 1st pitch is swung at, Hancock has 25 strikeouts to 2 walks (12.50 K/BB) with a 0.732 WHIP.

CAN'T TOUCH THIS...has thrown 6.0+ innings with 1-or-fewer hits in 2 starts this season (5/26 at ATH and 3/29 vs. CLE)...is 1 of 7 players with multiple such starts this season, joining teammate Bryan Woo (5/6 vs. ATL, 4/3 at LAA)...the Mariners have combined for 5 such starts this season (also: Logan Gilbert, 1x on 5/10 vs. CWS), most in MLB.

CAREER STRETCH...over his 5 starts in May (5/2-5/26) he has struck out 31 batters and thrown 30.0 IP for a 2.70 ERA...his ERA over the span is the 2nd best mark over a 5 game stretch in his career, trailing his 2.48 ERA logged May 23 to May 26 of last season, while his 31 strikeouts are tied for 3rd best behind 32 K's done 2 times and his 30.0 IP are tied for the most over 5 games...is 1-of-6 pitchers this season to have 63+ strikeouts and 15-or-fewer walks through their first 10 starts, along with rotation-mate Logan Gilbert...owns a 1.005 WHIP and a 25.1 K% through his first 11 games of 2026, both marks outpacing his career-high 1.333 from 2023 and 16.6 K% recorded in 2025.

CROSS FIRE...owns a 1.01 WHIP against left-handed batters, ranking 6th best among AL pitchers (min. 30.0 IP) while ranking 8th in K/BB (4.0) and 9th in K% (25.9)...has thrown the cutter the 2nd most against left-handers (98 times), owning a .077 (1x13) opponent batting average on the pitch to rank T-4th lowest among pitchers with at least 50 cutters thrown to lefty batters...is also tied for the 4th lowest opponent average on any single type of pitch thrown by pitchers in MLB this season...his whiff rate (36.6) on his cutter to LHB ranks 5th and his K% (28.6) ranks 9th best among all pitches to lefties.

TRAFFIC CONTROL...his 68 base runners allowed over 64.2 innings in his first 11 starts, are T-7th fewest among pitchers in 2026 through their first 11 games (min. 60.0 IP)...owns a baserunners-per-9 of 9.46, ranking 6th in AL in 2026, (min. 60.0 IP)...ranks 14th in WHIP (1.01) with runners on base in the AL in 2026 (min. 20.0 IP) while tying for the 5th fewest runs (13) allowed in runners on situations among AL pitchers (min 20.0 IP).

QUALITY CONTROL...has recorded a quality start in 7 of his 11 starts this season...is 1-of-4 pitchers in 2026 to have 5 quality starts with 1-or-fewer walks and 5+ strikeouts...the Mariners are 10-6 when Hancock logs a quality start since 2023 and are 8-4 since the start of 2025...3-of-6 home starts this season have been quality starts with 1-or-fewer walks and 6+ Ks.

NO FREE PASSES...is 1-of-5 pitchers this season to have allowed 3-or-fewer walks over 5.0+ IP in each of their first 11 starts, along with George Kirby...his 2.1 BB/9 is T-9th best in the AL, matching George Kirby (min. 50.0 IP)...has contributed 7 starts with 6.0+ IP and 2-or-fewer walks to a Mariners pitching staff that leads the league in such games (30) in 2026.

UP TO BIG UNIT STANDARDS...on May 2, followed up Mariners legend Randy Johnson's Number Retirement Ceremony with a performance of his own, setting the MLB single-game high in strikeouts this season with 14 Ks, tied by Reid Detmers-LAA (5/24/26 vs. TEX), and becoming the 4th player with 14+ strikeouts and no walks allowed in Mariners franchise history, joining Randy Johnson (done 2x), George Kirby (done 2x) and Mark Langston...is 1-of-3 pitchers to record 13+ strikeouts in a game in 2026...4 of the last 7 pitchers in MLB to log 13+ strikeouts in a game are part of the Mariners rotation...George Kirby (14, 9/14/25 vs. LAA), Bryan Woo (13, 9/13/25 vs. LAA) and Logan Gilbert (13, 8/24/25 vs. ATH) each had 1 such outing in 2025.
