**THE WORD ON THE BIRDS:** The St. Louis Cardinals continue their longest homestand of the first half playing nine games over 10 days. Last night, the Cardinals rallied from a 3-0 deficit to a 6-5 win behind three home runs. They continued the series tonight against the Cubs and another game tomorrow night. The remaining opponents on the homestand include the Texas Rangers (June 1-3) and Cincinnati Reds (June 5-7).

**FLIGHT PATTERN:** St. Louis jumped Chicago last night in the N.L. Central standings with their win and enter today in second place in the National League Central 4.5 games behind first place Milwaukee. The Cardinals have the best winning pct. (.545) among teams with a negative run differential (-9) this season.

**UNDER THE BRIGHT LIGHTS:** The Cardinals are playing the second of a string of seven straight night games. St. Louis is 20-10 (.667) in night games this season, 3rd-best record in MLB behind Atlanta (.714, 30-12) and Tampa Bay (.677, 21-10). The Chicago Cubs, owners of the most home day games in MLB each season, are 18-12 (.600) for the 7th-best record in night games this season.

**GAMES OF THE WEEK:** Tonight marks the Cardinals 9th appearance on a National Television broadcast through their first 56 games with their appearance on FOX. Tomorrow, they will be broadcast on NBC for 10-of-57 (18%). St. Louis has posted a 5-3 record in national broadcasts this season including 1-3 on FOX (L vs. BOS 4/11; W vs. LAD 5/2; L at SD 5/9; L at CIN 5/23) and 1-0 on FS1 (W vs. MIL 5/4), playing 4-of-5 Saturday broadcasts in the month of May.

**FREE TV:** Tonight's game is the second of three straight that will be broadcast on free, over-the-air television (KMOV 4-CBS, KTVI 2-FOX, KSDK 5-NBC), marking the first instance that three Cardinals regular season telecasts will be accessible on over-the-air local channels since August 10-12, 2007 when the team's three-game weekend series versus the Los Angeles Dodgers was televised on KSDK (Friday, Sunday) and KTVI (Saturday).

**LUCKY 7:** The Cardinals used seven pitchers last night in their 6-5 win, marking only the second time in franchise history, St. Louis defeated the Cubs using 7 or more pitchers in a regulation nine-inning game. The only other time was Sept. 21, 2019 when the Cardinals rallied to win 9-8 behind back-to-back 9th inning home runs by **Yadier Molina** and **Paul DeJong** off **Craig Kimbrel** en route to a four-game Cardinals sweep at Wrigley Field.

**NEW YEAR, NEW TEAM, NEW ME:** Cardinals OF **Nelson Velázquez** homered on the first pitch upon being promoted from Memphis (AAA) last night, a three-run game-tying blast against his former club. He became the first player to hit a home run on the first pitch of his Cardinals debut since **Chris Richard** against the Minnesota Twins at the Metrodome on July 17, 2000. Pitchers **Adam Wainwright** (5/24/2006 at SF) and **Gene Stechschulte** (4/17/2001 vs. ARI) each homered on the first pitch of their first plate appearance, but had appeared in prior games as a pitcher.

**COMEBACK CARDS:** St. Louis erased a 3-0 1st inning deficit last night for their 16th come-from-behind win, 4th-most in MLB behind Arizona (19), Atlanta (19) and Los Angeles-NL (18). The Cardinals began their comeback run on Opening Day when they rallied from a 7-1 deficit vs. Tampa Bay for a 9-7 win; the six-run comeback is tied for the biggest in MLB this season.

**NOOT NEWS:** Cardinals OF **Lars Nootbaar** continued his injury rehabilitation assignment last night in Springfield (AA) with his first game playing all nine innings in left field. Nootbaar was 0-for-2 with two walks. Through eight games with stops in Springfield (AA), Memphis (AAA) and Palm Beach (A), the lefty slugger is batting .286 (6-21) with 2 HR, 4 RBI, 4 walks and a 1.019 OPS.

**Iván Herrera** tallied his first MLB hit vs. the Cubs with a single on June 26, 2022. **José Fermín** notched his first career MLB hit at the Cubs on July 21, 2023 with a bunt single and **Pedro Pagés** swatted his first MLB home run on June 14, 2024 at the Cubs.

**JoJo Romero** recorded his first MLB save on July 30, 2023 vs. the Cubs.

**George Soriano's** first cousin is former Cubs OF **Alfonso Soriano** (2007-13).

**Carson Kelly** was drafted by St. Louis in 2012 and played three seasons (2016-18) for the Cardinals.

**Phil Maton** pitched in 40 games as a reliever for the Cardinals in 2025 after he signed a one-year deal as a free agent in March 2025.

**Shelby Miller** was a 1st round selection (19th overall) by the Cardinals in 2009 and pitched in 69 games (63 starts) for St. Louis from 2012-14.

**Brant Brown** was the Cubs 3rd round draft pick in 1992 and played parts of four seasons (1996-98 & 2000) with the North Siders.

**Jon Jay** played in 141 games for the Cubs in 2017 and was part of their playoff run to the NLCS.

**Nelson Velázquez** played parts of two seasons with the Cubs (2022-23), where he made his MLB debut (May 30, 2022 vs. Milwaukee)...singled off Ethan Small in his first career plate appearance.

Cubs Scouting VP **Dan Kantrovitz** previously was Cardinals Scouting Director (2012-14)...2001 Cards 25th Rd. draft pick from Brown Univ...first MLB job was Cardinals Scouting Coordinator.

**Lars Nootbaar** and **Shota Imanaga** were teammates on Gold Medal winning Team Japan in the 2023 World Baseball Classic.

**Stubby Clapp** (June 18, 2001 at Busch II) made his MLB debut vs. the Cubs...was also a coach on Team Canada for the 2013 & 2026 WBC squads that featured **Jameson Taillon** on the pitching staff.

**Daniel Descalso** played his final MLB season with the Cubs in 2019.

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Jim Edmonds** played part of 2008 with the Cubs.

**Brant Brown** was the Cubs 3rd round draft pick in 1992 and played parts of four seasons (1996-98 & 2000) with the North Siders.

Marquee Sports Network Analyst **Rick Sutcliffe** played for St. Louis in 1994.

**Nolan Gorman** won the 2017 Under Armour High School All-America Game HR Derby at Wrigley Field.

Cubs Staff Assistant **AJ Lewis** played college baseball at the University of Missouri in 2017 and John A. Logan College (Carterville, IL) in 2018.

Cubs Major League Assistant Strength & Conditioning Coach **Mark Weisman** was the Director of Performance at Southeast Missouri State University (Gape Girardeau, Mo.) in 2020.

Cardinals VP & Sr. Advisor **Michael Girsch** is a Chicago native...graduated from the University of Notre Dame and the University of Chicago.

Cardinals.TV play-by-play announcer **Chip Caray** served as the Cubs play-by-play announcer for seven seasons (1998-2004) on WGN...his grandfather, **Harry Caray**, spent the final 16 years of his career broadcasting Cubs games (1982-97).

Cardinals.TV Analyst **Mark Sweeney** made his MLB debut with St. Louis vs. the Cubs on Aug. 4, 1995 at Busch Stadium II.

Hall of Fame manager **Tony La Russa** played in one game for the Cubs in 1973.

## TONIGHT'S STARTER:

- Tonight marks his 11th start of the season (12th career) and 109th career Major League appearance.
- Is making his 2nd career start vs. the Cubs; started the season finale in 2025 at Wrigley Field in his 1st career Major League start.**
- Is 2-0 with a no-decision in his three starts against NL Central opponents this season to improve to 4-1 in his career against divisional opponents.
- Currently riding a three-game win streak since April 28, while his five overall wins this season are a career high.
- Has won each of his last two Home starts (vs. MIL & KC) allowing just 2 runs in 11.1 IP for a 1.59 ERA.**
- Three of his team co-leading leading five wins this season have come on the road: April 5 at Detroit, April 17 at Houston and April 28 at Pittsburgh.
- Is making his 4th start in a nationally televised game having also done so on Easter Sunday on NBC/Peacock Sunday Night Baseball in Detroit, April 11 vs. Boston on FOX and May 23 -Game 2 at Cincinnati on FOX.**
- Limiting right-handed batters to .228/.304/.348 (21-92) slash with a .652 OPS this season.
- His first 97 career appearances were as a relief pitcher beginning with his Major League debut on July 7, 2023; First career start came at Chicago's Wrigley Field on Sept. 28, 2025.
- Previously started 72-of-89 games over his first four professional seasons (2018-19, 2021-22).
- Kyle's 97 career relief appearances before his 1st career Major League start (Sept. 28, 2025 at CHI) were the most by a Cardinal since **Jordan Hicks** (April 21, 2022 at Miami) who made his 1st career start after having made 114 career relief appearances.

**LAST TIME OUT (Saturday, May 23 - Game 2 at Cincinnati):** ND, L 7-6 in 11 inn.; 5.0 IP, 7 H, 5 R, 5 ER, 2 BB, 8 SO, 2 HR - 87 pitches.

- Fanned a career high 8 batters but also allowed a career high 5 runs, all coming in his 5th and final inning of work.

## 2026 HIGHLIGHTS:

**EN GARDE:** Ranks T-2nd among all MLB pitchers with his 17 Opponent's Sword Swings (Max Meyer-MIA, 22) and his 88.3 competitive swing pct. ranks 16th best among NL starters. A "sword" swing is an expression of the art of forcing a batter to take an uncomfortable, awkward swing.

**HIGHS & LOWS:** Struck out a career-high 8 batters in his 5/23 [2] start at CIN, but also allowed a career-high 5 runs - all coming in his 5th and final inning of work

**PARK PLACE:** Each of his first six road games have taken place at Parks ( Petco Park, Comerica Park, Daikin Park, loanDepot park, PNC Park, Great American Ball Park).

**CENTRAL FOCUS:** Earned wins in two of his three starts against NL Central opponents this season (April 28 at PIT & May 4 vs. MIL) to improve to 4-1 in his career against divisional opponents.

**DECISIVE STARTS:** Has earned the decision in seven of his nine starts; co-leads the team in wins (5) and is T-3rd in losses (3).

**STRETCHING OUT:** Pitched a career-high 6.0 innings in his 5/16 start vs. KC, and has worked at least 5.0 innings in nine of his 10 starts on the year.

**OH MOTHER:** Blanked the Padres over his 5.0 IP on just 2 hits on May 10 (Mother's Day), and was in line for the win before the Padres Nick Castellanos tied the game with a 2-out, 2-strike 2-run HR to tie the game at 2-2, and then SD won it in the 10th, 3-2.

**BROOM RIDE:** Gained the win in the middle game of the Cardinals three-game series sweep at HOU in a 9-4 win on 4/17; Struck out a season high 6, but allowed 3 solo HR's.

**ALL EYES ON US:** Drew back-to-back starting assignments in nationally televised games on Easter Sunday on NBC/Peacock Sunday Night Baseball in Detroit and April 11 vs. Boston on FOX. Made the start on 5/23 [2] at Cincinnati on FOX in national telecast Memorial Day weekend.

**EASTER DELIGHT:** Gained his 1st win of the season on April 5, allowing 2 runs over 5.0 IP in the Cardinals 5-3 Easter win over the Tigers. He threw a career-high 97 pitches as he earned the winning decision as a starter for the 1st time - all while helping to prevent a series sweep by Detroit.

**IT'S COLDER IN BOULDER:** The Colorado native worked in game time temps of 42 degrees on Easter Sunday in Detroit, his third career MLB appearance in temperatures 45 degrees and below, two shy of matching Cardinals announcer **Brad Thompson** (5) for T-3rd among Cardinals in the frosty temps.

## CAREER:

- Graduated from Erie (Colo.) High School. Named Boulder County Player of the Year and was selected to play at the High School Futures Game at Coors Field.
- Played college baseball at Colorado Mesa University in Grand Junction, Colo., going 22-2 with a 3.13 ERA (204.1 IP), 188 strikeouts and six complete games.
- Allowed nine home runs to 852 total batters faced while pitching in high altitude (Grand Junction is 4,583 ft above sea level).
- Posted a 13-0 record with a 1.41 ERA during his sophomore season, earning First Team All-American, First Team Academic All-American, and was the South Central Regional Tournament MVP.
- Pitched two summers for the Waterloo Bucks of the collegiate summer Northwoods League (2016-17).
- His father, Tim Leahy, played college basketball at Kansas State University and his uncle, Thomas Leahy, pitched in the Braves organization (1991-93) advancing to Durham (High-A).

**LEAHY VS. CHICAGO (N.L.):**

- Makes his 2nd career start and 10th career appearance against the Cubs tonight; Is 0-0 with a 3.55 ERA (12.2 IP) in previous 9 appearances.
- Made his 1st career MLB start in the 2025 season finale on Sept. 28, 2025 at Chicago's Wrigley Field and took a ND in the 2-0 defeat while blanking the Cubs on 1 hit over 3.0 IP.
- Seven of his previous nine appearances against the Cubs have taken place at Wrigley Field.

**LAST APPEARANCE VS. CUBS (Sept. 28, 2025 at Wrigley Field):** ND, L 2-0; 3,0 IP, 1 H, 0 R, 0 ER, 0 BB, 1 SO, 0 HR - 39 pitches

- Was his 1st career MLB start and came in the 2025 season finale.
