THIS DATE IN ASTROS HISTORY
APRIL 8
1964 - Astros pitcher **Jim Umbricht** passes away at the age of 33 due to melanoma cancer...a well-respected teammate, Umbricht played two seasons (1962-63) for the Colt .45s...his number, 32, was officially retired by the club in April of 1965.

TODAY'S GAME: The Astros look to stop a three-game losing skid as they continue their 10-game road trip with the final game of a three-game series against the Colorado Rockies at Coors Field in Denver, CO...**RHP Cristian Javier** will be on the mound for the Astros opposite **RHP Michael Lorenzen** and the Rockies.

TODAY'S ASTROS STARTER: **RHP Cristian Javier** is set to make his third start of the season...in his last start on April 3 at ATH, he allowed six runs on six hits and five walks with two strikeouts in 3.2 innings...is coming off a strong Spring Training in which he posted 1.69 ERA (2ER/10.2IP) in three official appearances...Javier, who was limited to just eight starts in 2025 while recovering from Tommy John surgery, is 35-23 in his career with a 3.81 ERA (231ER/546.1IP).

SUSTAINED SUCCESS: Dating back to the 2015 season, the Astros have made nine postseason appearances in 12 seasons, winning seven division titles, four AL pennants (2017, 2019, 2021, 2022) and two WS titles (2017, 2022)...in that span, the Astros became the only team in history to advance to seven consecutive ALCS (2017-23) and posted the second-most wins in the Majors (982), trailing only the Dodgers (1,045).

NEW FACES: The Astros focused their offseason efforts on acquiring pitching, landing **RHP Mike Burrows** and **RHP Kai-Wei Teng** in trades and **RHP Tatsuya Imai** and **RHP Ryan Weiss** off the international free agent market.

AT THE HELM: Manager **Joe Espada** is in his third season as the Astros skipper...in 2025, for the second consecutive season, Espada and his staff were forced to deal with an extremely high number of injuries...despite an ever-changing roster that often was missing key players, to his credit, Espada managed to navigate his club to an 87-75 record, finishing in a tie for the final AL Wild Card berth (lost tiebreaker to DET).

ROAD TRIP: Today is the sixth game of a 10-game road trip for the Astros...after this three-game set at COL, the Astros will travel to Seattle for a four-game series at T-Mobile Park (Fri-Mon)...the Astros are 1-4 so far on this trip...Houston went 41-40 on the road last season.

AGAINST THE ROCKIES: The Astros and Rockies face each other today for the third of six scheduled matchups in 2026...the Astros went 4-2 against the Rockies in the in 2025, including a 2-1 record at Coors Field...the Astros own a 110-89 all-time record against the Rockies...the Rockies will travel to Daikin Park for a three-game series from April 14-16.

LAST NIGHT'S GAME: The Houston Astros were defeated by the Colorado Rockies, 1-5, last night at Coors Field in Denver, CO...**RHP Mike Burrows** (5.1 IP, 8 H, 3 ER, 1 BB, 3 K)...**1B Christian Walker** (1x4, HR, RBI), **3B Isaac Paredes** (1x4) and **RF Cam Smith** (1x3) led the way offensively for the Astros.

LEAGUE LEADERS: The Astros lead the Majors in runs (78), doubles (34) total bases (196), hits (114), walks (65) and OBP (.379)...individually, **LF Yordan Alvarez** leads the Majors in walks (13) and ranks second in OBP (.540)...**2B Jose Altuve** leads the Majors in runs (12) and **1B Christian Walker** ranks tied for first in the Majors in doubles (6) and third in RBI (13).

WALKER AT COORS: **1B Christian Walker** has batted .346 (66x191) with 12 doubles, 15 HR, 40 RBI and a 1.050 OPS in 49 career games at Coors Field...his 1.050 OPS at Coors Field is the highest among active players, directly ahead of **PHI IF Bryce Harper** (1.036 OPS).

MR. SMITH: **RF Cam Smith** has recorded a hit in eight consecutive games, which is the longest hitting streak of his career...he's batting .407 (11x27) with two doubles, six RBI, four walks, two stolen bases and a 1.299 OPS during the streak.. it is also tied for the longest active hitting streak in the Majors.

HOT START: The Astros have scored 78 runs this season, which is the most in the Majors...the 78 runs are also the second-most in the first 12 games to begin a season in franchise history, directly behind the 2004 season, where the Astros scored 84 runs in the first 12 games of the season.

AL PLAYER OF THE WEEK: On Monday, **LF Yordan Alvarez** was named the American League Player of the Week for the week of March 30-April 5...Alvarez batted .471 (8x17) with two doubles, three home runs, eight RBI, seven walks and a 1.733 OPS for the week...marked the fourth time that Alvarez has been named the AL Player of the Week.

FUTURE HALL OF FAMER: **2B Jose Altuve** recorded his 2,400th career hit on Mon. night at COL on a double in the first inning...became the second active player to record at least 2,400 hits, joining **LAD IF Freddie Freeman**...also joins **IF Craig Biggio** as the only two players in franchise history with at least 2,400 hits.

THE AIRCRAFT CARRIER: **RF Cam Smith** went 2x4 with a home run, double and two runs scored on Mon. night vs. COL...the home run was launched 462 feet, making it the longest home run by any player in the Majors this season...the second longest home run this season was 460 feet by **PHI OF Kyle Schwarber**.

YORDAN'S UPCOMING MILESTONES: **LF Yordan Alvarez** recorded his 174th career home run on Sunday at ATH...the home run tied him with franchise icon **OF George Springer** for seventh on the Astros all-time list...next up on the Astros all-time list is **3B Alex Bregman** (191 HR).

LAST START (4/3 at ATH): Surrendered 6 runs on 6 hits and 5 walks in 3.2 innings last Friday in Sacramento, striking out 2...suffered his 1st loss of the season...ended the night with 601 strikeouts for his career.

NO. 600: His 2nd inning strikeout of **ATH Lawrence Butler** last Friday was his 600th for his career...became the 27th pitcher in Astros history to record 600 strikeouts with the club...is 8 strikeouts from matching **RHP Bob Bruce** (609) for the 26th-most strikeouts in Astros history...he became just the 10th player in Astros history (for a player who began his career with the club) to record 600 strikeouts within their first 126 career appearances...also become the 56th Dominican-born pitcher in MLB history to record 600 career strikeouts.

VS. COL: set to appear in his 1st game against the Rockies since 2021...has pitched twice against COL (1 start) and holds a 4.76 ERA (3ER/8IP) with 7 strikeouts and 4 walks...last appeared against the Rockies in relief on Aug 10, 2021 and pitched 2.0 shutout innings, allowing only 1 hit with 2 walks and 2 strikeouts...his first and most recent start at Coors Field was on Aug. 20, 2020, where he went 3.2 frames, giving up 7 hits and 3 runs with 2 walks and 5 strikeouts.

EL REPTIL: The Dominican pitcher is in his 7th MLB season with the Astros and has gone 35-23 with a 3.81 ERA (231ER/546.1IP) and 601 strikeouts in 126 appearances, including 92 starts...among AL pitchers since 2022 (min. 300 IP), he ranks 4th in opponent batting average (.212), behind only **DET LHP Tarik Skubal** (.209), **SEA RHP Bryan Woo** (.207) and **NY Y RHP Gerrit Cole** (.210)...also ranks 15th among AL pitchers in strikeouts per 9.0 innings at 9.61...including his time as a reliever, has held opponents to a .205 opponent batting average (407x1987) throughout his career (2020-26)...it's the lowest opponent batting average in the AL over that stretch (min 500 IP)...among Astros pitchers with at least 500 innings pitched with the club, his .205 career opponent batting average ranks 3rd, behind only **LHP Billy Wagner** (.186) and **RHP Justin Verlander** (.199)...was signed by the Astros as a non-drafted free agent from the Dominican Republic on March 19, 2015...signed a 5-year contract extension in Feb. 2023 that will keep him in Houston through the 2027 season.

SPRING TRAINING: Made 3 official Spring Training starts, recording a 1.69 ERA (2ER/10.2IP)...also recorded 10 strikeouts and a .184 opponent batting average in his 3 starts.

2025 RECAP: Returned from Tommy John surgery in early August...went 2-4 with a 4.62 ERA (19ER/37IP)...also recorded 34 strikeouts, a .230 opponent batting average and a 1.27 WHIP in eight starts...made five rehab starts on his way back from surgery...in the five starts, had a 5.14 ERA (8ER/14IP) with 15 strikeouts and a .208 opponent average.

POSTSEASON CAREER: Has been a strong postseason performer in his career, posting a 6-2 record with a 2.68 ERA (13ER/43.2IP) with 4 holds in 17 appearances, including 5 starts...has allowed just 22 hits in his 43.2 innings of work for a .146 opponent average, while striking out 60 hitters...his opponent batting average is the lowest opponent batting average in MLB history (min. 40 IP).

CAREER: has appeared in the Majors with Houston in each of the last seven seasons (2019-25)...owns a 16-13 record with 17 saves, a 2.82 ERA (104ER/332.1IP) and 454 strikeouts in 332.1 Major League innings...among relievers in club history, ranks 4th in strikeouts (454), 7th in appearances (321) and 12th in innings (332.1).

OPENING DAY: made his 1st career Opening Day roster this season and pitched that day vs. LAA, tossing 2.1 innings of 1-run ball...tossed a 98.8 mph 4-seam fastball on a strikeout of **IF Yoán Moncada**, the hardest pitch thrown in his career.

ABOUT BLUBAUGH: entered the 2026 season as the Astros No. 4 prospect and as having the "Best Slider" according to *Baseball America*.
