RAYS REPORT—The Rays continue a nine-game, 10-day homestand against the Astros (2-1), Blue Jays (3-0) and Twins (1-0, two to play) tonight at Steinbrenner Field...have won a season-high six straight games, the longest active streak in the majors and their longest since June 3 (G2)-9, 2023 (7G)...are 8-3 in their last 11 games, 11-5 in their last 16, 13-8 in their last 21 and 18-12 in their last 30...have gone 9-4 on a stretch of 19 games in 20 days (May 13-June 1) and 6-1 over a span in which 15 of 19 games will take place at home (May 19-June 8)...following the latter stretch, 59 of their remaining 97 games (60.8%) will be on the road...have already played a majors-most 35 home games...are 8-2 in their last 10 games at Steinbrenner Field on the heels of a 1-11 stretch (April 15-May 8)...are above .500 for the first time since entering play on April 5 (4-3)...are second in the AL East, 6.0 GB the first-place Yankees (33-20)...have spent two days in first, six in second, 18 in third, 30 in fourth and four in fifth.

- ✦ The Rays won their sixth straight game last night, 7-2, thanks to homers by **Jonathan Aranda** (3R) and **Danny Jansen** (2R) and a two-run double by **José Caballero**.
- ✦ Tampa Bay has tallied 28 hits over its last two games, its most in a two-game span since June 20-21, 2024 (28H)...all nine members of the starting lineup have hit safely in back-to-back games for the fifth time in franchise history, first since May 9-10, 2017 vs. KC (also: Sept. 2-3, 2012; Sept. 28-29, 2004; May 30-31, 1999).
- ✦ The club's pitching staff has allowed four runs in their last 37 innings, six in their last 44 and eight in their last 51.
- ✦ The Rays not trailed since falling behind, 2-0, in the top of the 1st on Wednesday vs. HOU, going 44 innings since their last deficit, their longest streak since June 3 (G2)-8, 2023 (48 inn.)...according to Stats Perform, the longest streak in franchise history is 57 consecutive innings, set from May 14-20, 2018.
- ✦ The Rays have scored first in four straight, six of nine and 10 of their last 14 games...they played the opening run in only 12 of their first 39 games.
- ✦ The Rays are 22-for-24 (91.7%) on stolen base attempts over their last 11 games...their 71 SB on the season are tied with the Brewers for the major league lead.

RECENT TRANSACTIONS—Earlier today, the Rays acquired **C Matt Thaiss** (thicc) from the White Sox for minor league **OF Dru Baker**...to make room on the 40-man roster, **OF Jonny Deluca** (right shoulder strain) was transferred to the 60-day IL...Thaiss, 30, has hit .212/.382/.294 (18-for-85) with 4 2B, 1 HR, 8 RBI, 23 BB and 21 SO over 35 games this season...min. 100 PA, he leads MLB in walk rate (20.9%) and ranks third in chase rate (15.9%).

WHAT'S AT STAKE—With a win tonight, the Rays would:

- ✦ Move multiple games above .500 for the first time since entering play on April 4 (4-2).
- ✦ Win a season-high three straight, five of six and eight of their last 11 series.
- ✦ Claim their fourth straight series win at Steinbrenner Field on the heels of a four-series skid at home from April 14-May 8.
- ✦ Improve to 4-0-1 in their last five series vs. the Twins since June 6-8, 2023.
- ✦ Record seven wins or more on a nine-game homestand for the fifth time in club history, first since going 8-1 from June 22-July 1, 2018 (Stats Perform).

STREAK SZN—In addition to their six-game winning streak, the Rays carry several other notable streaks into tonight's game:

- ✦ **Brandon Lowe** has a nine-game hitting streak (12-for-31/.387), his longest since a 10-game run from Aug. 9-19, 2020 and tied for the third-longest of his career.
- ✦ **Chandler Simpson** is riding an 11-game hitting streak, tied for the third-longest active streak in the majors and the longest by a Rays rookie since **Randy Arozarena** (11G) from Aug. 2-19, 2021...Arozarena also owns the most recent longer streak (12G from June 3-17, 2021)...Simpson is two games shy of the longest streak by a rookie in club history (13G), a mark shared by **Rocco Baldelli** (2003) and **Delmon Young** (2007).
- ✦ **Curtis Mead** has a career-high eight-game hitting streak (9-for-23/.391).
- ✦ **Junior Caminero** has tallied an extra-base hit in a career-high four straight games, tied for the third-longest active streak in MLB.
- ✦ Rays starters have earned a win in five straight outings for the first time since July 12-25, 2014 (8GS)...the rotation had five wins in their previous 26 starts (April 27-May 20).
- ✦ Tampa Bay has gone a season-high seven straight games without committing an error, its longest streak since June 19-26, 2024 (8G).

BRINGING THE BATS—The Rays have outscored opponents, 37-10 (+27), during their six-game winning streak, plating seven runs or more three times while tallying three wins with exactly three runs...their 37 runs and 11 HR since the streak began on May 20 are both tied with the Angels for the most in the AL...they also lead the AL in OPS (.864), slugging pct. (.515) and stolen bases (10) during the streak...the Rays have homered in five straight games, matching their longest streak this season (also: April 11-15)...going back to May 13, the Rays have recorded 19 HR in their last 13 games, tied with the Diamondbacks for third most in the majors behind the Angels (23HR) and Dodgers (20HR)...they had 32 HR in 40 games entering that stretch, fifth fewest in the majors.

- ✦ The Rays have scored seven runs or more 12 times this season, tied with the Red Sox for third most in the AL behind the Tigers (16G) and Yankees (16G).
- ✦ **Brandon Lowe** has hit safely in 12 of his last 13 games, batting .396/.442/.771 (19-for-48) with 3 2B, 5 HR and 11 RBI...over that span (since May 13), his 1.213 OPS ranks second in the majors behind **CHC Seiya Suzuki** (1.222), while his .396 average is third behind **BOS Carlos Narváez** (.436) and **BAL Ryan O'Hearn** (.407).
- ✦ Since his April 19 MLB debut, **Chandler Simpson** leads the majors in infield hits (13) and ranks second in steals behind **CWS Luis Robert Jr.** (14SB)...his 33 total hits in that span are second most among rookies behind **ATH Jacob Wilson** (45).

PITCHING IN—During their six-game winning streak, the Rays staff has recorded a 1.67 ERA (54.0IP, 10ER) and 0.96 WHIP while holding opponents to a .188/.267/.301 (35-for-186) line...the six-game stretch has lowered their team ERA from a season-high 3.92 down to 3.66, 10th in the majors...they have allowed a total of four runs in their last four games, their fewest in any four-game span since Sept. 18-21, 2024 (4R)...the staff threw only 103 pitches last night, their second fewest this season behind April 4 at TEX (95)...Tampa Bay averages 139.3 pitches per game, second fewest in the AL (TEX - 137.8).

- ✦ The Rays starting rotation has allowed only two runs in their last 30 innings...they have a 1.50 ERA (36.0IP, 6ER) during the team's six-game winning streak and have allowed one or zero runs in four straight starts (0.72 ERA/.25.0IP, 2ER).
- ✦ The bullpen has a 1.73 ERA (26.0IP, 5ER) over the last nine games, holding opponents to a .178 (16-for-90) average...the 'pen has a 2.87 ERA (131.2IP, 42ER) over their last 39 games since April 13, third in MLB behind the Astros (2.45) and Giants (2.72).

TWINNING—The Rays and Twins continue a six-game season series tonight...the clubs will meet in Minneapolis from July 4-6...the Rays went 4-3 against them last season, claiming back-to-back season series wins (2023-24) for the first time since 2016-18 to improve to 11-3-3 in season series since 2007...six of the seven meetings were one-run games, and all three road games were decided in the final at-bat...eight of the last 10 matchups overall have been decided by one run dating back to Sept. 12, 2023. Tampa Bay's most one-run affairs vs. any opponent in that span...the Rays are 11-4 in the last 15 meetings dating back to June 12, 2022 and 7-2 in their last nine home games against the Twins...they went 3-0-1 in series play vs. Minnesota from 2023-24 after losing six of eight sets from 2018-22.



- ✦ **Josh Lowe** is a career .304 (17-for-56) hitter in 15 games against the Twins...**Yandy Diaz** is batting .375 (15-for-40) with 4 2B, 3 HR, 9 RBI and a 1.105 OPS in his last nine games against Minnesota dating back to Sept. 11, 2023.
- ✦ Twins manager **Rocco Baldelli** was Tampa Bay's first-round selection (No. 6 overall) in 2000 and spent six of his seven MLB seasons with the club...he joined the Rays front office in 2011 and was a member of **Kevin Cash**'s coaching staff from 2015-18.
- ✦ Minnesota starter **Joe Ryan** was a Rays draftee in 2018 and remained in the organization until being dealt to the Twins along with **RHP Drew Stotman** ahead of the 2021 trade deadline for **DH Nelson Cruz** and **RHP Calvin Faucher**.

REHAB UPDATES—**INF Ha-Seong Kim** (recovery from right shoulder surgery) made his first rehab appearance with Triple-A Durham last night, going 2-for-2 with a pair of singles, a hit-by-pitch and a stolen base...**OF Jake Mangum** (left groin strain) is 4-for-11 (.364) with 1 2B, 2 RBI and 3 BB through three games of his rehab assignment with the Bulls, while **RHP Kevin Kelly** (left gluteal strain) worked 1.1 scoreless frames last night in his second appearance with Durham.

TONIGHT’S START—Taj Bradley takes the mound today for his 11th start of the campaign and seventh at Steinbrenner Field...marks his 57th career start (59th appearance) and fourth against the Twins...is searching for wins in back-to-back starts for the first time since Sept. 21-27, 2024...is 0.2 IP shy of 300.0 innings for his career...was selected by the Rays in the fifth round (150th overall) of the 2018 First-Year Player Draft.

LAST TIME OUT—Bradley earned the win after matching a season high with seven strikeouts over 6.0 innings pitched in an 8-4 win over the Astros on May 21 at Steinbrenner Field (W, 6.0IP, 4H, 2ER, 2BB, HBP, 7SO, HR)...hit his first batter faced (**Jeremy Peña**) in the 1st inning and then allowed his only two runs of the day on a two-run homer from **Isaac Paredes**...walked the next batter, **Jose Altuve**, before retiring 10 of his next 11 batters (1B)...surrendered three singles along with the 1st-inning home run...his only other baserunner (**Mauricio Dubón**) reached base via walk in the 5th inning...was his eighth straight start throwing 80 or more pitches with at least 50 strikes.

- ✦ His seven strikeouts were his most since he fanned seven in three straight starts from March 30–April 11.
- ✦ He has yielded two earned runs or fewer in each of his last three home starts...in that span, he is 1-1 with a 2.84 ERA (19.0IP, 6ER), 14 strikeouts and a .203 (13-for-64) opp. average.

TAJ AND THE TWINS—In three career starts opposite Minnesota, Bradley is 0-1 with a 5.09 ERA (17.2IP, 10ER)...in his last start vs. the Twins on Sept. 5, 2024 at Tropicana Field, he worked 7.0 innings, struck out 10 and allowed four earned runs on six hits (2HR) and a walk.

- ✦ Despite going 1-3, he owns a 2.93 ERA (46.0IP, 15ER) with 49 strikeouts and a .214 (36-for-168) opp. average in eight career starts vs. AL Central teams...he has not given up more than two runs in six of those eight starts.

SETTLED IN—Bradley has gone 6.0 IP or more with two runs or fewer allowed in five of his six starts at Steinbrenner Field...excluding his outing on April 17 vs. NYY (5.1IP, 6ER), he has turned in a 2.61 ERA (31.0IP, 9ER) in his other five home outings...tonight, he looks to throw four consecutive quality starts at home for the first time in his career.

- ✦ He carries a 3.72 ERA (36.1IP, 15ER) in home starts (6GS) this season, compared to a 6.20 ERA (20.1IP, 14ER) on the road (4GS).

HEART-STOPPING—Opposing 3-4-5 hitters have batted .153 (11-for-72) with 1 HR against Bradley, the third-lowest mark among qualified major league pitchers behind NYM **Kodai Senga** (.134) and LAD **Yoshinobu Yamamoto** (.145)...all other batters have gone a combined 39-for-135 (.289) with 7 HR against him.

STRETCH TIME—Bradley has held opponents to a .198 (19-for-96) average with runners on base, including .169 (10-for-59) in his last six starts...his .198 (19-for-96) opp. average with runners in scoring position is sixth lowest among AL pitchers (min. 100PA)...with the bases empty, opponents are batting .279 (31-for-111) with five of his eight home runs allowed.

FALTERED IN THE FIRST—11 of the 29 runs (37.9%) and 14 of the 50 hits (28.0%) Bradley has allowed have come in the opening frame, both of which are his most in any inning...he has permitted 1st-inning baserunners in nine of 10 starts this season—the lone exception was May 10 vs. MIL...Bradley has yielded a run in the opening frame in seven of his last nine starts, but has held opponents scoreless in two of his last four...on the season he has recorded a 9.90 ERA (10.0IP, 11ER) and a .333 (14-for-42) opp. average in the 1st frame compared to a 3.47 ERA (46.2IP, 18ER) and .218 (36-for-165) opp. average from the 2nd inning on.

- ✦ He has limited opponents to a .198 (16-for-81) opp. AVG in his second time through the lineup...min. 90BF, that ranks ninth among AL pitchers.

MAY FLOWERS—In 11 career starts during May, Bradley has held opposing batters to a .221/.286/.382 (48-for-217) slash line...he has limited opponents to a .668 OPS in May, lowest of any calendar month in his career (min. 2GS)...he has worked to a 3.81 ERA (59.0IP, 25ER) with 67 strikeouts and has surrendered 2 ER or fewer in eight of the 11 starts.

HOMEGROWN—Bradley is one of 15 pitchers drafted by Tampa Bay to make at least 50 starts for the club, including one of four drafted since the team became the Rays in 2008 along with **Shane McClanahan** (2018), **Ryne Stanek** (2013) and **Blake Snell** (2011)...the fifth-round selection is one of six Rays draftees to make at least 50 starts with the club after being selected in the fifth round or later, joining **Matt Moore** (8th rd., 2007), **Andy Sonnanstine** (13th rd., 2004), **James Shields** (16th rd., 2000), **Joe Kennedy** (8th rd., 1998) and **Ryan Rupe** (6th rd., 1998).

HIGHS AND LOWS—Bradley’s 2024 season, his second in the majors, was defined by several distinct stretches throughout the campaign:

- ✦ **May 8–June 1:** After being reinstated from the 15-day IL (right pectoral strain), he tossed a quality start in his season debut on May 10 vs. NYY, but went 1-3 with a 5.81 ERA (26.1IP, 17ER) in five starts...this period culminated in a career-high 9 ER and a career-high-tying 4 HR on June 1 at BAL.
- ✦ **June 8–July 25:** Bradley spun one of the most prolific stretches in franchise history, going 5-1 with a 0.82 ERA (55.0IP, 5ER), 65 strikeouts, 18 walks and a 0.89 WHIP over his next nine starts...it marked the lowest ERA over any nine-start span in Rays history (excl. openers)...he led the majors in ERA and opp. average (.162) while also ranking highly in strikeouts (2nd), wins (T4th), innings (T4th) and WHIP (6th).
- ✦ **July 31–Sept. 10:** He went 0-6 with an 8.27 ERA (41.1IP, 38ER), 40 strikeouts, 14 walks and a 1.62 WHIP over eight starts—the ERA and WHIP were the highest in MLB...he yielded 12 HR (2.61 HR/9.0IP) on the heels of a career-best five-start homerless streak (June 30–July 25).
- ✦ **Sept. 15–season’s end:** Bradley bounced back to the tune of a 2-1 mark and 1.76 ERA (15.1IP, 3ER) over his final three starts, allowing only one run across his final two outings (11.0IP).
