**YESTERDAY'S NEWS:** The Orioles defeated the Red Sox, 11-3, in the first game of the three-game set in Baltimore to push their winning streak to a season-high five games...The 11 runs are tied for their second-most in a game this season behind the 13 they scored on March 30 vs. Los Angeles-AL...The last time the Orioles scored 11+ runs in a game while hitting zero home runs was April 4, 2021 at Boston (also 11)...The O's scored five runs in the fourth inning, marking the seventh time they have scored at least five runs in an inning this year...Marked Baltimore's 18<sup>th</sup> game with double-digit hits; the O's are 17-1 when recording 10+ hits...Improved to 28-0 when outhitting their opponent; the O's and Twins (20-0) are the only undefeated teams when recording more hits than their opponent this year.

Ø In his return to the rotation following two relief outings, **Cole Irvin** earned the win after working 5.0 scoreless innings with four hits, three walks, and a season-high-tying six strikeouts (also: 5/10 vs. ARI); in his last six starts he has gone 5-0 with a 1.02 ERA (4 ER/35.1 IP), with the O's winning all six games.

Ø **Kyle Stowers** went 3-for-4 with two doubles, one run scored, and a career-high four RBI; tied a career high in hits (also: 9/26/22 at BOS) and recorded his first career multi-XBH game.

**BOUNCED BACK:** After being swept by the Cardinals in three games from May 20-22 in St. Louis — Baltimore's longest losing streak of the season — the O's have won a season-high five straight games...The last two times the O's had lost at least three in a row, they also bounced back with at least four straight wins: dropped three straight from September 20-22, 2023, then won five straight from September 23-28; dropped four in a row from September 12-15, 2023, then won four straight from September 16-19.

**HOW SWEEP IT IS:** The Orioles completed a four-game sweep of the White Sox over the weekend, their fourth sweep of the season...It was their first four-game sweep since July 7-10, 2022 vs. Los Angeles-AL and first four-game sweep on the road since August 22-25, 2011 at Minnesota...Marked Baltimore's first sweep of the White Sox since a three-game set from May 5-7, 2017, first sweep of the White Sox in Chicago since a three-game set from August 18-20, 2014, and first four-game sweep of the Sox since July 6-9, 1995 at Guaranteed Rate Field (then New Comiskey Park).

**NEED FOR SPEED:** **Cedric Mullins** ranks eighth in Orioles history with 104 career stolen bases; next on the list is **Don Baylor** (118)...**Jorge Mateo** is tied with **Melvin Mora** for 13<sup>th</sup> in team history with 82 stolen bases as an Oriole; next on the list is **Don Buford** (85).

Ø The Orioles are one of five teams with multiple players with double-digit stolen bases this year, along with the Nationals, Phillies, and Royals (3), and the Reds (2).

Ø Since the start of the 2022 season, the Orioles are the only team in MLB with multiple players with 60+ stolen bases; Mateo has 77 and Mullins has 64.

**START ME UP:** Orioles starters have worked 17.0 consecutive scoreless innings dating back to May 24, the rotation's longest stretch since 22.0 shutout innings from May 2-7...On the season, O's starters have a 3.04 ERA (97 ER/287.0 IP), the second-best rotation ERA in the AL and third-best in MLB, behind the Phillies (2.78) and Yankees (2.72).

**THE ERAS TOUR:** The O's have a 2.70 ERA (68 ER/227.0 IP) in their last 25 games since April 29, the second-best mark in MLB behind the Yankees (2.41)...During that time, the Birds have surrendered an MLB-low 158 hits while holding opponents to an MLB-low .194 batting average (158-for-814).

**TOP GUNN:** **Gunnar Henderson's** 17 home runs are tied with New York-AL's Aaron Judge for second in MLB, trailing Houston's Kyle Tucker (18)...Henderson ranks among the leaders in a variety of statistical categories (see box at right)...Homered in four straight games from May 17-20, the first Oriole to do since **DJ Stewart** from September 5-9, 2020; is one of six MLB players to homer in at least four straight games this year, along with Boston's Rafael Devers (6 G), Chicago-NL's Michael Busch (5 G), Los Angeles-NL's Mookie Betts (4 G), New York-AL's Aaron Judge (4 G), and Texas' Corey Seager (4 G).

**HOMER HAPPY:** The Orioles rank second in MLB with 77 home runs, the third-most homers through the first 52 games of a season in O's history behind 1987 (84) and 1996 (82); the most homers through Baltimore's first 53 games of a season is 84 by the 1987 team.

Ø The Orioles have four players with at least eight homers, tied with the Dodgers for the most in MLB: **Gunnar Henderson** (17), **Adley Rutschman** (10), **Anthony Santander** (9), and **Jordan Westburg** (8).

**LEADING ACTORS:** Baltimore leads MLB with six leadoff homers this season...**Gunnar Henderson** has hit five of those, the most in MLB and tied for the fifth-most in a single season in O's history...**Jordan Westburg** has the other for the O's...Since the start of 2021, the Orioles have 23 leadoff blasts, ranked fourth in the AL and tied for eighth in MLB.

**FEELS GOOD TO BE HOME:** The Orioles began a six-game homestand yesterday with the first of three games against the Red Sox (1-0)...The Orioles have a scheduled off day on Thursday, May 30, before hosting the Rays for three games over the weekend...The O's are 18-10 (.643) at home, the fourth-best home winning percentage in the AL and fifth-best in MLB.

**AGAINST THE RED SOX:** The O's and Red Sox are meeting for the second of four series in 2024 with three games in Baltimore...The O's swept a three-game set in Boston from April 9-11, the first matchup between the teams this year...The Birds have won each of their first four games against the Red Sox to start the season for the first time since 1967; the club record to begin a season against Boston is eight in 1960...The O's will host the Sox at Oriole Park again for a four-game set from August 15-18...The Birds and BoSox complete their regular-season series with three games at Fenway Park from September 9-11...The Orioles went 7-6 against the Red Sox last year and have gone 20-16 against them since the start of 2022.

**AL BEAST:** Entering the current series, the Orioles had gone 17 straight sets against AL East opponents without a series loss, while going 12-0-5 in series during that time...That is the longest such streak in team history since divisions were introduced in 1969, per the *Elias Sports Bureau*...A win tonight or tomorrow would extend Baltimore's streak to 18 consecutive sets against AL East foes without a series loss...The Orioles are 38-18 overall against division opponents since the streak began on April 24, 2023...The O's went 32-20 (.615) against the AL East last year, the second-best winning percentage against the division by the team since 1981 behind the .618 (47-29) mark in 2014...The Birds won the season series against the Blue Jays (10-3), Rays (8-5), Red Sox (7-6), and Yankees (7-6), the first time since 2014 that the Orioles won the season series against each of their division opponents.

**THE SKIPPER:** Manager **Brandon Hyde** is in his sixth season in Baltimore...In 2023, he led the O's to an AL-best 101-61 record, their second straight winning campaign and the first time since 1997 that the Orioles claimed the top seed in the AL...He made his Postseason managerial debut in the ALDS, and was named the BBWAA AL Manager of the Year, becoming the fourth Orioles manager to win the award...He was also voted the *Sporting News* American League Manager of the Year by fellow AL managers for the second consecutive year...Hyde's 349 wins rank fifth all-time among Orioles managers, trailing **Hank Bauer** (407), **Paul Richards** (517), **Buck Showalter** (689), and Orioles Legend and National Baseball Hall of Famer **Earl Weaver** (1,480).

**QUICK HITS:** Scheduled to make his ninth start of the season tonight against the Red Sox...Activated from the 15-day Injured List prior to the game on May 18 vs. Seattle (right shoulder inflammation), retroactive to April 30...Posted a 7-4 record and 4.35 ERA (59 ER/122.0 IP) across 23 starts in his rookie campaign last year...Began last season with Triple-A Norfolk before being promoted and making his MLB debut on April 5 at Texas...Optioned to Norfolk on May 27...Recalled on July 17 for the remainder of the season...Originally selected by the Orioles in the first round (No. 11 overall) of the 2018 First-Year Player Draft.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Earned the win on May 23 at Chicago-AL after allowing two runs on three hits, one hit batter, and a career-high five walks with seven strikeouts across 5.0 innings...Recorded 14 swing and misses...Threw 94 pitches, 58 strikes.

**SPILL THE TEA:** Making his third career start against the Red Sox and second of the season...Owns a lifetime 0-1 record with a 3.60 ERA (4 ER/10.0 IP) in his two prior starts against Boston...Did not factor into the decision in his last start against the Sox on April 11 at Fenway Park, allowing two runs on six hits and two walks with five strikeouts in 5.2 innings.

**BEAST OF THE AL EAST:** Owns a 3-2 record with a 2.48 ERA (16 ER/58.0 IP) across 10 career starts against the AL East...Opponents are slashing .234/.295/.353 (51-for-218) off him in his previous starts...Has allowed just two runs to AL East teams in his last three starts against the division dating back to last season (19.1 IP).

**HOME SWEET HOME:** Owns a 3-0 record with a 1.14 ERA (3 ER/23.2 IP) across his four home starts this season...Opponents are slashing .173/.272/.259 (14-for-81) in his home outings compared to .292/.370/.483 (26-for-89) in four starts on the road.

**DAY 'N NITE:** Owns a 3-1 record with a 4.39 ERA (13 ER/26.2 IP) across his five night starts this season compared to a 2-0 record with a 1.47 ERA (3 ER/18.1 IP) in his three afternoon starts.

**GAME OF ADJUSTMENTS:** In Rodriguez's 10 starts in his initial stint with the club in 2023, he notched a 7.35 ERA (37 ER/45.1 IP)...After being optioned to Norfolk, he returned to Baltimore on July 17 and posted a 2.58 ERA (22 ER/76.2 IP) across his remaining 13 starts...Has posted 11 quality starts in his last 19 outings, dating back to July 28, 2023...Did not register a quality start in his first 12 outings to begin his career.

**GAS 'EM UP:** Punched out 129 batters for the O's last season, the most for an Orioles rookie since 2012 (Wei-Yin Chen, 154)...His mark ranks sixth among rookies in team history (since 1954)...He became the 20<sup>th</sup> rookie pitcher in Orioles history to strike out at least 100 batters.

**2023 HIGHLIGHTS:** Rodriguez opened last season with the Norfolk Tides, earning the nod as their Opening Day starter...Recalled by the Orioles on April 5, making his MLB debut in a start at Texas...Marked the first of six Orioles to make their big-league debut last year...Earned his first career win on April 29 (G2) at Detroit, throwing 5.0 shutout innings and striking out nine...Tossed a career-high 8.0 scoreless innings on September 16 vs. Tampa Bay, tied for the longest outing by an Oriole in 2023; at 23 years old, 304 days old, became the youngest O's starter to work 8.0 scoreless frames since Zack Britton (23-141) tossed a shutout on May 12, 2011 vs. Seattle, and the youngest rookie right-hander to do since Brad Bergesen (23-257) worked 8.0 scoreless on June 9, 2009 vs. Seattle.

**POSTSEASON EXPERIENCE:** Made his Postseason debut last season, taking the loss in Game 2 of the ALDS against the Rangers on October 8...Allowed five runs on six hits and four walks across 1.2 innings...Marked the most runs that Rodriguez had surrendered since May 26 when he allowed eight, also against the Rangers.
