HAPPY OPENING DAY: The Orioles begin their 72nd season this afternoon against the Toronto Blue Jays at Rogers Centre.

👉 This is the first time the O's have opened the year outside of the United States.

👉 2025 marks the second time Baltimore and Toronto have met on Opening Day, along with April 3, 2017 at Oriole Park at Camden Yards; the Orioles won that game in 11 innings as Mark Trumbo hit a two-out solo home run off Jason Grilli for a 3-2 victory.

👉 The Birds are 46-25 in the first game of the season since the franchise moved to Baltimore prior to 1954; the .648 Opening Day winning percentage in that time is the best in the AL and second best in baseball behind the New York Mets (.651, 41-22), who joined MLB as an expansion team in 1962.

2024 RECAP: Baltimore went 91-71, securing the first Wild Card spot in the AL and finishing 3.0 games behind New York in the AL East...The O's have made the Postseason in back-to-back seasons for the fourth time in franchise history and for the first time since 1996-97...With another playoff trip this season, they would match the longest streak in franchise history set from 1969-71...The Orioles were swept in two games in the AL Wild Card Series with Kansas City.

OPENING DAY DÉJÀ VU: Zach Eflin gets his second straight Opening Day nod and first with the Orioles after getting the ball in game one for the Tampa Bay Rays on March 28, 2024 against the Toronto Blue Jays at Tropicana Field.

👉 Eflin will become the second pitcher since 1939 to start back-to-back Opening Days against the same opponent with different teams, per the *Elias Sports Bureau*; Madison Bumgarner faced the San Diego Padres with the Arizona Diamondbacks on July 24, 2020 and with the San Francisco Giants on March 28, 2019, both on the road.

👉 José Berríos is scheduled to start for Toronto opposite Eflin, which was the exact Opening Day pitching matchup last year in St. Petersburg; this will be the sixth time since 2000 that the same starting pitchers face each other on Opening Day in two straight seasons, along with Yu Darvish (SD) and Bumgarner (ARI) in 2021-22, Aaron Nola (PHI) and Julio Teheran (ATL) in 2018-19, Jered Weaver (LAA) and Félix Hernández (SEA) in 2014-15, Carlos Zambrano (CHC) and Aaron Harang (CIN) in 2006-07, and Ben Sheets (MIL) and Matt Morris (STL) in 2003-04.

ROSTER BREAKDOWN: The Orioles will start the season with 13 position players and 13 pitchers on the active roster...Five players have made their first career Opening Day roster: **Heston Kjerstad**, **Jackson Holliday**, **Cade Povich**, **Albert Suárez**, and **Tomoyuki Sugano**...Twelve of the 26 players were on Baltimore's Opening Day roster in 2024, while five players will be making their O's debut: **Ramón Laureano**, **Charlie Morton**, **Tyler O'Neill**, **Gary Sánchez**, and **Sugano**...Seven players will begin the year on the Injured List: **Gunnar Henderson** (right intercostal strain) on the 10-day, **Andrew Kittredge** (left knee debridement), **Chayce McDermott** (right lat strain), **Grayson Rodriguez** (right elbow inflammation), and **Trevor Rogers** (right knee subluxation) on the 15-day, and **Kyle Bradish** (right elbow UCL surgery) and **Tyler Wells** (right elbow UCL surgery) on the 60-day.

OPENING STATEMENTS: The starting rotation for the O's finished with a 3.77 ERA (369 ER/881.1 IP) in 2024, ranking fifth in MLB behind the Mariners (3.38), Royals (3.55), Braves (3.58), and Tigers (3.69)...That marked the second-best rotation ERA by the Birds since 1985, behind 2014 (3.61).

👉 O's starting pitchers compiled a 3.64 ERA (177 ER/437.1 IP) away from Oriole Park last year, the best road mark by the team's starters since 1976 (3.23).

ROAD WARRIORS: Baltimore finished last season 47-34 on the road (.580), the third-best winning percentage away from home in the majors behind the New York Yankees (.617, 50-31) and San Diego Padres (.593, 48-33)...Since the start of 2023, the Orioles are 99-63 (.611) in road games, the best mark in MLB.

BATTLE OF THE BIRDS: The O's and Blue Jays meet at Rogers Centre for a four-game series to open the 2025 campaign...Baltimore won't return to Toronto until September 12-14, while the clubs meet in a pair of three-game sets at Oriole Park at Camden Yards from April 11-13 and July 28-30.

👉 The O's went 7-6 against the Blue Jays last season, their second consecutive winning season against Toronto...Baltimore has won back-to-back season series against the Jays for only the second time since 1997, joining 2012 (11-7), 2013 (10-9), and 2014 (11-8).

👉 **Adley Rutschman's** .983 OPS and **Ryan Mountcastle's** .962 OPS against the Blue Jays rank third and fourth among active players, respectively (min. 150 PA); the only active players with a better OPS against Toronto are Los Angeles-AL's Mike Trout (1.032) and New York-AL's Aaron Judge (1.007).

THE SKIPPER: Manager **Brandon Hyde** enters his seventh season in Baltimore...The 2023 AL Manager of the Year earned his 400th career win on September 19 last season...His 406 wins at the helm of the Orioles rank fifth in team history behind **Earl Weaver** (1,480), **Buck Showalter** (669), **Paul Richards** (517), and **Hank Bauer** (407).

GRAPEFRUIT LEAGUE RECAP: Baltimore finished the Grapefruit League season 13-14-2, including 5-8-1 at home and 8-6-1 on the road...The club's exhibition game on Monday in Washington, DC was canceled due to inclement weather...The team drew 100,156 fans during 14 dates at Ed Smith Stadium, which does not include 6,680 people who attended the Spring Breakout game on March 15...The 7,154 average spring attendance was the team's best since 2017 (7,223).

👉 In the penultimate Spring Training game on March 22 at Pittsburgh, seven pitchers combined to throw the first spring no-hitter by the O's since the team moved to Baltimore in 1954; it was the second spring no-hitter in MLB since 2018, along with the Chicago Cubs on March 3, 2023 at San Diego.

OPENING DAY: Eflin is scheduled to become the 44th Opening Day starter in Orioles history (since 1954)...Marks his second career Opening Day, having faced Toronto to begin the 2024 season as a member of Tampa Bay...Facing José Berríos at Tropicana Field on March 28, 2024, he was dealt the loss after allowing six runs on six hits (3 HR), one walk, and one hit batter with three strikeouts in 5.2 innings.

⚡ According to *Elias*, Eflin will become one of six starting pitchers since 1882 to make back-to-back Opening Day starts against the same opponent as a member of two different teams, joining Madison Bumgarner (2019 w/SF & 2020 w/AZ vs. SD), Wes Ferrell (1937 w/BSA & 1938 w/WAS vs. PHA), Sad Sam Jones (1921 w/BSA & 1922 w/NYY vs. WAS), Duke Esper (1894 w/WAS & 1895 w/BAL vs. PHI), and George Derby (1882 w/DET & 1883 w/BUF vs. CLE).

CLIPPED WINGS: In nine career appearances (8 GS) opposite Toronto, Eflin is 3-3 with a 5.72 ERA (29 ER/45.2 IP) on 60 hits (9 HR), 32 total runs, nine walks, and 39 strikeouts...he last faced the Blue Jays in his Orioles debut on July 29-G1, 2024, and earned the win (6.0 IP, 10 H, 3 ER, 0 BB, 7 K, 1 HR)...in that outing, Eflin became the first Orioles pitcher to earn a victory and produce a quality start while surrendering 10+ hits since Alex Cobb on May 18, 2018, at Boston (W, 6.1 IP, 10 H, 3ER, 1 BB, 3 K).

⚡ In three career starts at Rogers Centre, he is 0-1 with an 8.79 ERA (14 ER/14.1 IP) on 24 hits (4 HR), 15 total runs, and three walks against nine strikeouts...Eflin made his MLB debut in Toronto on June 14, 2016, and allowed a career-high-tying eight earned runs (2x, also 5/23/17 vs. COL) across 2.2 innings.

⚡ Is 13-10 with a 3.89 ERA (78 ER/180.1 IP) in 33 career outings (31 GS) vs. the AL East.

WE'RE GOING STREAKING: Eflin has conceded three runs or fewer in a career-best 10 straight starts overall since July 24, 2024...excluding openers, it is the second-longest active streak in the AL behind Toronto's Bowden Francis (11 GS) and tied for the seventh-longest run in the majors.

IN CONTROL: Eflin produced a 3.51 pct. walk rate in 2024, fourth lowest among all qualified MLB pitchers behind SEA George Kirby (2.96%), CIN Nick Martinez (3.16%), and STL Miles Mikolas (3.47%).

⚡ From June 14, 2022-July 10, 2024, Eflin issued two walks or fewer in 51 consecutive starts, the eighth-longest such streak in MLB since 1901 behind MIN/PHI Carlos Silva (99), BOS Cy Young (85), SEA George Kirby (64, active), MIN Phil Hughes (64), MIN Brad Radke (62), NYG Carl Hubbell (61), and BOS/SD David Wells (59).

⚡ Eflin has, however, allowed 1+ walk in five straight starts dating to September 1, 2024, including a career-high five walks in his final regular season start on September 25 at New York-AL...of his 24 walks last season, 10 came against the Yankees (41.7%).

PRETTY EFLIN GOOD: Following his acquisition last season from the Rays, Eflin joined Jack Harshman (1958) as the only pitchers in franchise history (since 1954) to earn a victory in each of his first five appearances with the club...He is the first to win each of his first five with all of them being starts, and the first Oriole to win each of his first five starts with the team since Ben McDonald (7/21-8/13/90).

CUTTING IT UP: Last season, Eflin utilized his cutter 28.2 pct. of the time and limited opponents to a .214 (36-for-168) average with 38 strikeouts, marking the punch outs on any of his offerings (28.6%)...in nine starts with the Orioles, he limited hitters to a .134 (9-for-67) clip with 23 strikeouts on the cutter, compared to .267 (27-for-101) with 15 strikeouts in 19 starts with Tampa Bay.

QUICK HITS: Made four Grapefruit League starts, going 0-1 with a 5.40 ERA (7 ER/11.2IP) on 13 hits, nine total runs, and five walks with nine strikeouts...Was acquired by the O's from the Tampa Bay Rays in exchange for minor leaguers RHP Jackson Baumeister, INF/OF Mac Horvath, and OF Matthew Etzel on July 26, 2024...in his final start of 2024 on Sept. 25 at New York-AL, surpassed the 1,000.00 career inning mark (1002.1 IP)...Started Game 2 of the 2024 ALWCS vs. Kansas City and did not factor into the decision, allowing one run on four hits, one walk, and one hit batter with three strikeouts across 4.0 innings.
