SNAKEBITES

OUR STARTING ALL-STAR: Ketel Marte was voted as the 2025 NL All-Star starting second baseman hosted at Truist Park, home of the Atlanta Braves, on July 15...it is his second consecutive All-Star starting selection at second base and third in career (also: 2024, 2019).

- First NL second baseman to win consecutive fan-elected starting assignments since Chase Utley with 5 straight from 2006-10.
- Led all NL players in Phase 2 voting.
- First-ever D-back with 3 All-Star fan elections.
- Second D-back to make 3 All-Star starts, joining Paul Goldschmidt (3).
- Third D-back to earn consecutive All-Star starts, joining Goldschmidt (2014-15) and Randy Johnson (2000-01).
- Sixth D-back to earn 3+ All-Star appearances, joining Goldschmidt (6), Luis Gonzalez (5), Johnson (5), Zack Greinke (3) and Brandon Webb (3).
- Ninth D-back fan-elected start for a position player and 32nd position player selection overall.

LAST GAME: The D-backs won 7-1 vs. Royals to even the series at 1-1.

- **Ryne Nelson** tossed a career-high 5.1 perfect innings...became the eighth D-back starting pitcher all-time to reach 5.1+ perfect frames and first since Zac Gallen on July 20, 2023 @ Braves.
- **Geraldo Perdomo's** 36 pitches seen in 5 PA tied a franchise high (also: Didi Gregorius on June 6, 2013 @ Cardinals)...the only other MLB player with more in 2025 is Jurickson Profar/ATL (37 P in 5 PA).
- **Randal Grichuk** hit the Majors' fourth inside-the-park homer this season (Top 9)...was the first D-back to do so since Corbin Carroll on Aug. 31, 2024 vs. Dodgers (Bot 1 off Gavin Stone)...was the 21st all-time occurrence by a D-back and 20th different D-back player all-time.
- **Corbin Carroll** made his first start since June 18 @ Toronto after being activated off the 10-day IL (fractured left wrist).
- **Eugenio Suárez** extended his hit streak to a 10-game day hitting streak and reached base in 12 of his last 13 home games.

VS. ROYALS: With a win, the D-backs would secure their third straight series vs. Royals (also: July 22-24, 2024 and April 24-26, 2023).

- The D-backs have won 8 of their last 12 games vs. Royals (since 2022), including 5 of their last 7 @ home...own a 22-17 (.564) record all-time.

COOKIN' VS. KC: Geraldo Perdomo has reached safely in 9 straight starts, hitting .323 (10-for-31)/.475 OBP/.927 OPS with 4 doubles, 2 RBI and 8 walks.

- **Ketel Marte** has homered in 3 of his last 4 starts vs. Royals with a combined 7 RBI...over his last 10 starts, is batting .302 (13-for-43)/.927 OPS with 1 double, 3 homers, 10 RBI, 6 walks and 1 hit-by-pitch.
- **Lourdes Gurriel Jr.** has hit safely in his last 6 starts, batting .308 (8-for-26) with 2 doubles, 1 triple, 2 RBI and 2 stolen bases.

POWER + ON BASE COMBO: The D-backs are 1 of 3 teams (also: Tigers and Mets) to have multiple players (2 - **Corbin Carroll** and **Eugenio Suárez**) with 20+ homers, 20+ walks and 40+ RBI...**Ketel Marte** is 1 homer shy of joining the club to bring the total to 3 players.

- The D-backs have never had more than 2 players reach the feat within the first 100 games of a season (6 seasons with 2 players all-time)...the last pair to reach within the first 100 games was Carroll and Christian Walker in 2023.

ON DECK - SAN DIEGO PADRES: Tomorrow, the D-backs begin their final trip and penultimate series of the first half with 4 games @ Padres (July 7-10).

- The D-backs won their first series 2-1 @ Chase Field from June 13-15.
- In their 7 games @ Petco Park in 2024, the D-backs went 4-3, with 9+ hits and 1+ homers in 6 of the 7.
- Among active players vs. Padres, **Ketel Marte** ranks in hits (1st, 104), extra-base hits (1st, 44), home runs (T-3rd, 17 - with Joc Pederson/TEX and Ryan McMahon/COL) and SLG (4th, .500).

NEXT STARTER: RHP ZAC GALLEN (0-0, 4.82)

- Earned his sixth win in his last start on July 1 vs. Giants (1 ER in 7.0 IP, 5 H, 0 BB, 10 K)...was his eighth career start of 6.0+ innings with no walks and 10+ strikeouts (previous: April 2 @ Yankees).
- In his last 4 starts vs. Padres, is 3-0 with a 1.75 ERA (5 ER in 25.2 IP), opponent .167 AVG (15-for-90)/.485 OPS, 6 walks and 28 strikeouts.

SNAKEBITES

AT A GLANCE: First season with the D-backs...signed as a Major League free agent on June 15.

- 12th season in the Majors along with Marlins (2014), Reds (2015-20, did not pitch in 2017), Giants (2021-23), Twins (2024, did not pitch in 2024).
- In 2024, acquired by the Twins on January 29, 2024, from the Mariners, but missed the entire season after suffering a right elbow strain in Spring Training that require forearm flexor tendon surgery.
- In 2021 with the Giants, set career bests with 13 wins, 3.17 ERA, .225 OPP AVG, .634 OPP AVG.

SNAKEBITES: First start for the D-backs.

- First Major League start since July 18, 2023 for the Giants @ Reds...in 2.0 innings, allowed 4 runs on 10 hits with 0 walks and 5 strikeouts.
- His last Major League season was 2023 with the Giants...in 19 games (18 starts), went 3-8 with a 4.88 ERA (59 R-54 ER), opponent .271 AVG (105-for-388)/.767 OPS, 20 walks and 79 strikeouts.

2025 OVERVIEW: Signed by the D-backs on June 15...released by the Yankees on June 12...signed by the Yankees on May 13.

- In 5 starts for Triple-A Scranton/Wilkes-Barre (NYY) from May 17-June 10, went 1-1 with a 4.50 ERA (11 R-10 ER in 20.0 IP), an opponent .300 AVG (24-for-80)/.796 OPS, 9 walks and 20 strikeouts.

AS A STARTER: Has worked primarily as a starting pitcher with 169 starts and 15 relief appearances in 184 career games.

- In 169 career starts, is 53-56 with a 4.18 ERA (470 R-430 ER in 925.2 IP), opponent .260 AVG (923-for-3,551)/.741 OPS, 248 walks and 817 strikeouts.
- Had a career-best 31 starts in 2015 (Reds), 2019 (Reds) and 2021 (Giants).
- Debut in 2014 with the Marlins with 5 starts from May 14-June 27 then was recalled and made 8 relief appearances the remainder of the season.

VS. ROYALS: Lone career outing was a start with the Giants on April 9, 2023 vs. Royals...had a quality start in the 3-1 win, working 6.1 innings with 1 run on 3 hits and 0 walks with 7 strikeouts.

VS. AL CENTRAL: In 15 career games (13 starts) vs. AL Central, is 3-3 with a 3.72 ERA (38 R-34 ER in 82.1 IP), an opponent .237 AVG (74-for-312)/.696 OPS, 16 walks and 67 strikeouts.

VS. AMERICAN LEAGUE: In 24 career games (21 starts) vs. American League, is 8-4 with a 3.63 ERA (58 R-52 ER in 129.0 IP), an opponent .245 AVG (119-for-486)/.716 OPS, 29 walks and 101 strikeouts.

- Most recently in 2023, in 6 starts vs. AL, went 2-2 with a 3.09 ERA (17 R-12 ER in 35.0 IP), an opponent .200 AVG (26-for-130)/.568 OPS, 5 walks and 27 strikeouts.

- Has scored a run in 10 of his last 11 interleague games, including 5 games with 2+ runs.
- Had his fifth career 3-walk game on June 17 @ Blue Jays.
- Has hit 20+-homers in 3 straight seasons...is the sixth D-back with 3+ straight seasons and first since Christian Walker from 2022-24.
