ORIOLES NOTES

- The Orioles defeated the Guardians, 8-5, in game two of the three-game set and will compete in a rubber match tomorrow...Have gone 11-4 against the AL Central this season.
- RHP Kyle Gibson** earned his seventh win and third in a row after allowing three runs on seven hits with one walk and three strikeouts in 5.2 innings...Retired the first 10 batters in order before allowing a one-out single to Amed Rosario in the fourth...Threw 95 pitches, 60 strikes
- RF Anthony Santander** went 3-for-4 with two doubles, a triple, two runs scored, and three RBI; has recorded at least three hits in back-to-back games for the second time in his career (also: 8/24-25/21)...Tied his career-high with three extra-base hits (5x, last: 9/27/22 at BOS)...Knocked a three-RBI triple in the in the second inning, the fourth triple of his career (last: 8/6/20 vs. MIA); is the first O's batter to hit a bases-loaded triple since Jace Peterson on May 2, 2018 at Los Angeles-AL in the top of the ninth inning...Has reached base safely in 23 of 26 games this month; has a hit in 19 of those games, including 11 multi-hit efforts; slashing .344/.432/.625 (33-for-96) in May compared to .213/.280/.362 (20-for-94) in March/April.
- C Adley Rutschman** walked in the first and second innings...As of the end of tonight's game, he leads the AL and is second in MLB with 43 walks; is fourth in the AL with a .402 on-base percentage.
- 2B Adam Frazier** went 2-for-5 with two runs scored in his second start as the leadoff batter this season (also: 5/25 at NYY)...Has reached base safely in 20 of 23 games since May 6 and in 24 of 26 starts since April 26; has hit in 12 of 15 starts since May 13.
- DH Gunnar Henderson** recorded a season-high three RBI...Has slashed .280/.321/.520 (14-for-50) with seven extra-base hits (4-2B, 3B 2 HR), seven runs, and seven RBI in his last 16 games since May 13; has hit safely in 11 of them...Eight of his 14 RBI this season have come with two outs.

GUARDIANS NOTES

- The Guardians dropped the second game of this three-game set, 8-5, setting up a rubber match tomorrow...Move to 10-15 in games following a win and to 10-18 in games when the opposition scores first.
- RHP Cal Quantrill** took his fourth loss of the season after pitching 4.1 innings and allowing a career-high-tying eight runs (4x, last: 9/9/19 vs. CHC w/SD) on a season-high-tying eight hits (3x, last: 4/24 vs. COL) with two walks and three strikeouts...Has now lost consecutive starts for the first time with Cleveland and for the first time since losing five consecutive starts for the Padres from August 20 to September 15, 2019...Threw 85 pitches, 56 strikes.
- DH Josh Bell** drove in two runs today, giving him his third multi-RBI game of the season and first since May 17 at Chicago-AL.
- CF Myles Straw** has hit safely in six consecutive games after doubling in the fifth inning; six of his nine doubles have come in the month of May...Recorded his seventh multi-hit game of the season and for the first time since May 3 at New York-AL.
- 1B Josh Naylor** has recorded four of his six doubles in the month of May after doubling in the sixth inning...Smacked a two-run single in the seventh inning; now has 15 RBI in his last 14 games, 25 in his last 26, and 19 RBI after the sixth inning on the season; has also recorded an RBI in 20 of his 42 starts this season.
- 2B Andrés Giménez** recorded his 13th multi-hit game of the season and picked up his first double in May after hitting an RBI double in the sixth inning.
- RF Will Brennan** posted consecutive multi-hit games for the first time this season and for the first time since doing so in three straight games from October 2-5, 2022...Is now 5-for-8 in the series with two doubles and two runs scored.
