The Brewers need to go 11-11 in their last 22 games to break the franchise record for wins in a season, a mark set last season at 97-65.....the team needs to go 13-9 to secure the first 100-win season in franchise history.	
Climbing the Charts	
The Brewers (87-53) are looking to climb to a franchise-record-tying 35 games over .500 with a win tonight.....the team was 35 games over twice last season (94-59 and 95-60).	
Chicago Hope	
With a win tonight, the Brewers would clinch the season series vs. Chicago.	
In Murph We Trust	
The Brewers (277-187, .597) own the best record in the Major Leagues since Pat Murphy became manager in 2024.....the Dodgers (273-190, .590) rank second.	
Hulk Logan	
Logan Henderson has yet to allow more than 3 runs in a game through 19 career starts.....he has a 2.30 ERA (101.2ip, 26Er).....he has allowed 0 runs three times, 1 run eight times, 2 runs six times and 3 runs twice.	
Start Me Up	
Logan Henderson and Zac Gallen are the only pitchers in the Major Leagues since 1893 to allow 3 runs or less in at least each of their first 19 career starts.....Gallen accomplished the feat with the Marlins and Diamondbacks from 2019-20 (23 starts).....this does <i>not</i> include openers or pitchers who had relief appearances before and/or during these streaks.	
Fine 'Penmanship	
Trevor Megill today was named NL Reliever of the Month for August.....he is the first Brewer to earn the honors since Devin Williams in July 2023.	
It's Trevor Time!	
Trevor Megill has not allowed an earned run in his last 14 appearances (14.1ip, 4h, 1r, 0er, 3bb, 11K).....he is also unscored upon in 28 of his last 30 outings while posting a 0.30 ERA (30.1ip, 12h, 2r, 1er, 7bb, 30K).....he has converted his last 17 save chances.	
U Da Man!	
Abner Uribe is unscored on in his last 23 games (23.2ip, 11h, 7bb, 22K) and has a 0.53 ERA in his last 33 outings (34ip, 19h, 2r, 2er, 12bb, 34k, 1hr).	
Make Mine a Double	
Christian Yelich hit the 350th double of his career last night.....he is one of 13 active players with 350+ doubles.

IN THE TRAINER'S ROOM: LHP Brian Fitzpatrick (left elbow), RHP Quinn Priester (right thoracic outlet), RHP Bryse Wilson (low back), RHP Brandon Woodruff (right shoulder), LHP Rob Zastryzny (left trapezius) and LHP Angel Zerpa (left forearm) are on the injured list....Fitzpatrick, Priester, Woodruff, Zastryzny and Zerpa are on the 60-day IL.

MANAGER: Pat Murphy (464g, 277-187, .597) is in his third season as Brewers manager.....he was voted NL Manager of the Year in 2024 and 2025.....he is one of four managers ever to win Manager of the Year in consecutive seasons, joining the Braves' Bobby Cox (2004-05), Rays' Kevin Cash (2020-21) and Guardians' Stephen Vogt (2024-25).....Murphy was named the 20th manager in franchise history on 11/15/23, replacing Craig Counsell.....he signed a multi-year contract extension on 2/20/26.

COACHES: Offense & strategy coordinator **Jason Lane** (11th season/1st in current role), pitching coordinator **Jim Henderson** (5th season/1st in current role), field coordinator **Néstor Corredor** (4th season/3rd in current role), pitching coach **Chris Hook** (8th season), assistant pitching coach **Juan Sandoval** (1st season), bullpen coach **Charlie Greene** (3rd season), lead hitting coach **Eric Theisen** (2nd season/1st in current role), hitting coach **Guillermo Martinez** (1st season), hitting coach **Daniel Vogelbach** (1st season), first base coach **Spencer Allen** (1st season), third base coach **Matt Erickson** (3rd season/1st in current role).

IN THE STANDINGS (161 days): The team has spent the following number of days alone or tied at each spot in the NL Central standings: **FIRST:** 123, **SECOND:** 10, **THIRD:** 8, **FOURTH:** 13, **FIFTH:** 7.....the Brewers are currently in first place, leading the second-place Cubs by 9.0 games.....the team has held first place for the last 107 days.

AT HOME: The Brewers are 47-25 at home, going 18-4-1 in series play.....after a 7-7 start, the team has gone 40-18 (.690) at home.....the team has a pair of season-high 5-game winning streaks coming from 4/30-5/12 and 5/25-6/2.

ON THE ROAD: The Brewers are 40-28 on the road, going 13-7-1 in series play.....had season-high 5-game winning streaks from 5/31-6/8 and 6/21-7/3.

LET'S GO TO THE VIDEO TAPE: The Brewers have made 36 replay challenges this season, going 25-11.....their last challenge (lost) came on 8/27 at New York-NL as a safe call at home plate involving Jared Young stood.

BREWING SUCCESS: Entering 2026, the Brewers qualified for the postseason seven times in the last eight seasons and three seasons in a row.....the team was just two games away from making the postseason in nine straight seasons (2017-25), missing out in both 2017 and 2022 by only a single game.....entering 2026, Milwaukee won the NL Central in four of the last five seasons and three seasons in a row.

BREWING CONSISTENCY: The Brewers are the only Major League team with 86+ wins in each of the last nine full seasons (2017-26).....the Dodgers (82-57) need 4 wins to join the Brewers (Dodgers' streak is since 2012).....this does *not* include the shortened 2020 season.....the Brewers have 850 wins since 2017, which ranks fourth in the majors behind the Dodgers (935), Astros (877) and Yankees (868).

TONIGHT'S STARTER: #43 - RHP LOGAN HENDERSON (14gs, 9-2, 2.48)

2026 Arsenal: 4-Seam Fastball (45.8%) - Changeup (33.3%) - Cutter (17.9%) - Sweeper (3.1%)

HENDERSON AT A GLANCE: Logan Henderson, 24, will be making his 15th start of the season and first against the Cubs.....Henderson last started last Friday vs. Texas in a 6-1 win (7ip, 1h, 1r, 1er, 0bb, 7k, 1hr, 91 pitches).....his only baserunner allowed came on a solo homer by Danny Jansen.....the team is 11-3 in his starts.....he has 6 quality starts (5 in a row).....opponents are batting .181 (49-for-270, 11hr).....he has also gone 2-0 with a 1.50 ERA in 7 games/5 starts this season at Triple-A Nashville (24ip, 16h, 4r, 4er, 11bb, 37k, 0hr).....he was on the 15-day injured list from 5/26-7/8 with a low back strain, retroactive to 5/23.....Henderson entered the 2026 season as the sixth-best prospect in the organization according to *Baseball America*.

LAST SEASON: Henderson spent most of last season at Triple-A Nashville, where he went 10-4 with a 3.59 ERA in 16 games/15 starts.....he held International League opponents to a .218 batting average with 87 strikeouts in 77.2 innings.....Henderson also had three stints with the Brewers (4/15-4/20, 5/14-5/25 and 8/3-8/7) as he made his Major League debut and went 3-0 with a 1.78 ERA in 5 starts.....the team went 5-0 in his starts.....he had 1 quality start.....opponents batted .187 (17-for-91, 3hr).

CAREER: Is 12-2 with a 2.30 ERA in 19 starts with Milwaukee (101.2ip, 66h, 26r, 26er, 22bb, 119k, 14hr).....he and Zac Gallen (23gs, 2019-20) are the only pitchers in the majors since 1893 to allow 3 runs or less in at least each of their first 19 career starts (does not include openers or pitchers who had relief appearances).....Henderson was selected by Milwaukee in the fourth round of the 2021 First-Year Player Draft out of McLennan (TX) Community College.

CAREER AT AMERICAN FAMILY FIELD: Is 7-0 with a 1.80 ERA in 9 starts (50ip, 10er)....is 5-0 with a 2.08 ERA in 7 starts this season (39ip, 9er).

CAREER ON THE ROAD: Is 5-2 with a 2.79 ERA in 10 starts (51.2ip, 16er).....is 4-2 with a 2.89 ERA in 7 starts this season (37.1ip, 12er).

CAREER vs. CUBS: Henderson has not faced the Chicago, Illinois Cubs.

ODDS & ENDS: Henderson graduated from Cinco Ranch (TX) High School.....he enjoys golf, playing basketball and spending time with his family.

TOMORROW'S STARTER: LHP SHANE DROHAN [27g, 16gs, 7-5, 3.75]
LHP Shane Drohan will be making his 28th appearance and 17th start of the season.....Drohan last pitched last Saturday in a start vs. Texas and earned a 5-3 win (5ip, 6h, 1r, 1er, 2bb, 6k, 1hr, 2hbp, 99 pitches).....he is 5-5 with a 4.41 ERA as a starter (83.2ip, 41er) and 2-0 with a 1.69 ERA as a reliever (26.2ip, 5er).....the team is 9-7 in his starts.....he has 5 quality starts.....opponents are batting .253 (106-for-419, 10hr).....Drohan is 0-0 with a 1.80 ERA in 2 starts against the Reds (10ip, 11h, 2r, 2er, 4bb, 12k, 1hr).....the Brewers won both games.
