RAY REPORT—The Rays begin a six-game road trip to California against the Angels (three to play) and the Dodgers (three to play) tonight at Angel Stadium...have won three straight games for the first time since May 17-22 (5-0)...are 4-2 in their last six games, but have dropped 10 of their last 16 (May 24-pres.) on the heels of a 22-4 stretch (April 22-May 23)...are 27-15 (.643) vs. clubs currently below .500, second in the AL to the Yankees (30-14/.682)...have owned the AL's best record for each of the last 34 days (May 9-pres.), including eight consecutive days leading the majors from May 18-25...have the best winning pct. in the AL East (.615), slightly ahead of the Yankees (.612), and have spent 40 days leading the division, 25 in second, six in third, four in fourth, and three in fifth...with a loss tonight and a Yankees win in Toronto, the Rays would fall to second for the first time since May 8 (25-13).

- ★ The Rays completed a sweep of the Red Sox on Wednesday, 7-5...marked their MLB-best seventh sweep, tying the club record for most sweeps before the end of June (also: 2023, 2021, 2008).
- ★ Became the fifth team in the divisional era (since 1969) to start 12-0 at home against division rivals and the first since the 2009 Dodgers began 12-0 against the NL West.
- ★ **Drew Rasmussen** spun 7.0 scoreless innings with two hits, one walk, one hit-by-pitch, and a career-high 13 strikeouts (see more in "All Ras, No Brakes" note below).
- ★ **Nick Fortes** tied a career high with four hits (also: Sept. 17, 2023 vs. ATL), recording a pair of singles and a pair of doubles...marked the second time in his career he had multiple extra-base hits in a contest (also: Sept. 13, 2025 at CHC - 2B, HR).
- ★ The Rays are an MLB-best 15-4 (.789) in games vs. left-handed starting pitchers (see more in "Southpaw Success" note below).
- ★ They tallied their 40th win in their 65th game, the sixth-fewest games to the mark in franchise history behind 2023 (58th), 2020 (60th), 2010 (63rd), 2021 (64th), and 2019 (64th).
- ★ The Rays committed zero errors last series, their fifth series of three games or more with no errors...they have not committed an error in their last six games at Tropicana Field (June 1-pres.).
- ★ In the three-game set, they hit .330 (32-for-97), their second-best average over a series in 2026 behind March 26-29 at STL (.339/41-for-121).
- ★ The Rays staff has allowed 17 runs over the last six games (2.8 R/G) after permitting 72 runs across their previous nine contests (8.0 R/G, May 25-June 3).
- ★ Tonight's probable starter, **Shane McClanahan**, is looking to become the 11th pitcher in team history to record 40 wins in a Rays uniform...with a win tonight, he would tie **Jeremy Hellickson**, **Jeff Niemann**, **Jake Odorizzi**, and **Ryan Yarbrough** (each 40) for seventh most in club history.

ALL RAS, NO BRAKES—**Drew Rasmussen** tallied a career-high 13 strikeouts in his start Wednesday vs. BOS...he joined **PHI Christopher Sánchez** (May 16 at PIT - 9.OIP, 13SO) as the only pitchers to throw 7.0 scoreless innings with 13 strikeouts or more in a start this season and is the fifth Ray (6x) to turn the trick in franchise history (see table on right)...in June, he has made two starts (also: June 5 at MIA - 7.OIP, H, OR, 9SO) and thrown 14.0 scoreless innings...it is the second time in franchise history a pitcher has tossed 14.0 scoreless innings or more with three hits allowed or fewer across any two consecutive starts, joining **Chris Archer** (April 11-16, 2015 - 14.OIP, 3H)...the last pitcher to do so in the majors was **ATL Spencer Schwellenbach** (March 29-April 4, 2025 - 14.OIP, 3H).

- ★ Rasmussen fanned **Jarren Duran**, **Ceddanne Rafaela**, and **Wilyer Abreu** in each of their first three plate appearances...per NESN, it is the first time since 1901 a team's 1-2-3 hitters in the order have struck out in each of their first three trips to the plate...he struck out the trio in order in the 1st and 4th innings, becoming the 12th Ray in team history to strike out the side in order multiple times in a single game (last: **Shane Baz**, April 14, 2025 vs. BOS - 2nd, 5th)...he has struck out the side in order nine times in his career, three of which have come this season (also: April 1 at MIL - 4th).
- ★ His 13 strikeouts are tied for the third most in a game in the majors this year (also: Sánchez) and are the most by a Ray since **Tyler Glasnow** on Sept. 6, 2023 vs. BOS (14SO)...he generated 20 whiffs, tied for the second most in his career (also: May 18, 2022 vs. DET), behind only Sept. 9, 2022 at NYY (22 whiffs)...he has a team-best 77 strikeouts in 2026, tied for 14th in the AL.
- ★ Rasmussen and **TEX Jacob deGrom** (11.OIP) are the only two MLB arms with double-digit innings pitched this month and no runs allowed.
- ★ He needs 10 strikeouts over his remaining starts in June to tie his total from March/April (32SO) for his most in a month in 2026 and 12 more strikeouts to match his best in a month over his career (March/April 2023 - 34SO).
- ★ With his strikeout of Rafaela in the 6th inning, he reached 500.0 innings pitched in his career with the Rays, becoming the 14th hurler to reach that mark in team history.

SOUTHPAW SUCCESS—The Rays improved to a major league-best 15-4 (.789) against left-handed starters on Wednesday and have won six of their last eight (May 10-pres.) against lefty starters...including the Angels probable starter tonight, **Sam Aldegheri**, they will have faced a southpaw starter in four straight games for the second time this season, joining May 6-10 (1G vs. TOR, 3G at BOS).

- ★ Against southpaws this season, they are batting .256 (176-for-688), including an AL-best .276 (107-for-388) average against left-handed starters...their .276 average against left-handed starters is the fifth best in franchise history and the best since the 2023 Rays hit .292 (198-for-678).
- ★ **Yandy Díaz** is slashing .338/400/569 (22-for-65) against lefties this season, the seventh-best average in the AL and 12th best in the majors...he has also hit .545 (6-for-11) with a 1.315 OPS with runners in scoring position against left-handers.

ALWAYS ON—AL batting average leader **Yandy Díaz** (.331) is slashing .372/.439/.670 (35-for-94) with 7 2B, 7 HR (three leadoff HR), 23 RBI, 11 BB, 14 R, and a 1.109 OPS during a 24-game on-base streak, the longest active run in the majors, longest by a Ray since his 27-game streak between June 3-July 4, 2025, and five game shy of his career-best 29-game stretch from May 26-June 28, 2024...during his 29-game streak, he set a franchise record with a 20-game hitting streak (June 7-28, 2024) that was later tied by **Brandon Lowe** (June 11-July 5, 2025)...it marks Díaz's fifth on-base streak of 20 games or more in his career, second most in franchise history to **Evan Longoria** (6)...it is also tied for the majors' sixth-longest streak this season and marks the AL's third longest, trailing runs by **ATH Nick Kurtz** (48G, April 3-May 25) and **DET Riley Greene** (26G, April 18-May 16)...since the streak began on May 12, he ranks second in the majors in average to **LAD Shohei Ohtani** (.412), third in slugging pct., third in OPS, and fourth in on-base pct.

- ★ During his active streak, he has reached base multiple times in 15 games, including 10 multi-hit games...since the start of June, he has had four contests with three hits or more, most in the majors.
- ★ Díaz's four leadoff homers are tied with Ohtani and **WSH James Wood** for second most in the majors to **MIN Byron Buxton** (6)...three of those blasts have come during his on-base streak...he needs two more leadoff homers over the Rays final 97 games to match **Corey Dickerson's** club record set in 2017 (6).

CALIFORNIA DREAMIN'—The Rays are set to play six straight in Southern California against the Angels and Dodgers beginning tonight...the Rays hosted the Angels between May 29-31 and claimed the series, 2-1...the club has won or split seven of eight (6-1-1) and 15 of its last 17 sets (12-2-3) against the Angels (May 22, 2017-pres.), including back-to-back series wins (Aug. 4, 2025-pres.)...since the start of the 2010 season, the Rays are 39-17 at Angel Stadium.

- ★ **Yandy Díaz** launched leadoff home runs in back-to-back games from May 29-30 vs. LAA, the second time in his career he has done so (also: April 13-14, 2025)--he is the only Ray to turn the trick in team history...on May 29, he hit a pair of home runs, his fifth career multi-home run game (last: Aug. 2, 2025 vs. LAD - 2HR), including a postseason effort on Oct. 2, 2019 at OAK.
- ★ In nine career games against the Angels, **Junior Caminero** has hit .419 (13-for-31) with 4 2B, 3 HR, 6 RBI, an .839 slugging pct., and a 1.339 OPS...Caminero has multiple hits in each of his last four games opposite the Angels (Aug. 6, 2025-pres.)...one shy of the longest multi-hit streak vs. LAA in team history behind **Vinny Castilla** (5G, April 27-June 13, 2000)...in his last game at Angel Stadium on Aug. 6, 2025, he launched a pair of home runs, with the latter marking his 30th of the campaign and making him the youngest Ray with a 30-home run season.

THIS DAY IN RAYS HISTORY—**Carlos Peña** homered in a sixth straight game (June 6-12, 2010), setting a franchise record...he passed **José Canseco**, (5G, May 16-21, 1999)...Peña became the first player to accomplish the feat since **Frank Thomas** did it with the Athletics from Sept. 5-11, 2006...the feat has only been accomplished nine times since Peña, most recently by **BOS Rafael Devers** (6G, May 15-20, 2024).

TONIGHT'S START—Shane McClanahan will toe the rubber for his 13th start of the season and seventh on the road...will be making his 87th career start and 41st on the road...missed the last two years after his second Tommy John surgery wiped out his 2024 season and nerve-related issues sidelined him for 2025...selected by the Rays in the Compensatory Round (31st overall) of the 2018 First-Year Player Draft out of the University of South Florida.

- ✦ Min. 50.0 IP, his 0.45 HR per 9.0 IP ranks fourth in the AL to NYY Max Fried (0.15), CWS Davis Martin (0.34), and NYY Cam Schlichter (0.44) and seventh in the majors...has allowed 2 HR his last 46.1 IP.
- ✦ Ranks sixth in the AL with a .202 (45-for-223) opp. average (min. 50.0IP).
- ✦ Through six road starts, McClanahan is 1-3 with a 3.68 ERA (29.1IP, 12ER) and a .214 opp. average (24-for-112).

LAST TIME OUT—Was dealt his third loss of the season on June 6 at MIA after tying season highs in runs and hits (5.0IP, 8H, 4ER, 2BB, 6SO, HBP), matching his totals from April 19 at PIT...retired his first five batters faced before allowing a single to Javier Sanoja in the 2nd inning, followed by a full-count walk to Esteyru Ruiz...sat down his next seven hitters until allowing a homer to Sanoja in the 5th frame...allowed hits to six of his final eight batters before being pulled from the game with no outs in the 6th.

- ✦ After issuing 11 walks over his first three starts (March 31–April 14), he has permitted only 10 over his last nine outings (April 19–pres.) with 46 strikeouts...recorded 3.43 walks per 9.0 IP over his first three starts compared to 1.94 in his last nine outings.

GOT ANGELS ALL AROUND ME—The 29-year-old southpaw will make his sixth career start against the Angels tonight...he is 2-0 with a 1.29 ERA (28.0IP, 1ER), 6 BB, 35 SO, a 0.82 WHIP, and a .170 (17-for-100) opp. AVG in his five starts...tonight marks his first start at Angel Stadium in 1,493 days (May 11, 2022), the day following LAA Reid Detmers no-hitter against the Rays.

- ✦ Last took the mound against the club on May 31 at Tropicana Field, earning his sixth win of the year after yielding one earned run on four hits across 5.0 innings with three strikeouts.
- ✦ Has not allowed a run across two starts at Angel Stadium, posting a .135 (5-for-37) opp. average and striking out batters at a 43.2 pct. clip (16-of-37) in those starts.
- ✦ Across five outings against the Angels, he has yet to surrender a homer.

AMERICAN NIGHTS—In seven starts against AL opponents this season, McClanahan is 5-0 with a 1.75 ERA (36.0IP, 7ER), the lowest ERA in the majors (min. 30.0IP) opposite AL foes...also boasts a .160 (21-for-131) opp. average, the second-lowest mark in the majors under the same parameters behind MIL Jacob Misiorowski (.149).

- ✦ He joins HOU Spencer Arrighetti (5-0) as the only MLB arms with five wins or more without a loss against the AL in 2026...the Rays are 6-1 against AL clubs in McClanahan's starts.
- ✦ His 1.75 ERA (36.0IP, 7ER) against the AL this season would be the lowest mark in franchise history (min. 30.0IP) by a traditional starter, ahead of Tyler Glasnow's 1.98 (54.2IP, 12ER) clip in 2019.
- ✦ His .160 (21-for-131) opp. average opposite the AL in 2026 would be the lowest clip in franchise history (min. 30.0IP) by a traditional starter.

MASTERPIECE OF A MONTH—During May, McClanahan went 4-0 with a 1.41 ERA (32.0IP, 5ER) across six starts, the lowest ERA among AL pitchers (min. 30.0IP), while also ranking among AL starters in WHIP (4th, 0.84), opp. on-base pct. (5th, .231), and run support average (6th, 7.03).

- ✦ Was one of three MLB starters and the lone AL starter to post four starts or more of 5.0 scoreless innings or more in May, alongside MIL Jacob Misiorowski (5GS) and PHI Christopher Sánchez (5GS).
- ✦ McClanahan's 1.41 ERA in May joined teammate Nick Martinez (1.52ERA/29.2IP, 5ER) as the only Rays duo in franchise history to turn in a 1.55s or lower during May (min. 25.0IP).
- ✦ Posted the fourth-lowest May ERA in franchise history by a traditional starter (min. 30.0IP), trailing Rich Hill (0.78, 2021), Scott Kazmir (1.15, 2008), and Jeremy Hellickson (1.36, 2011).
- ✦ The southpaw has posted his best career numbers in May, going 13-1 with a 1.84 ERA (122.2IP, 25ER) and 134 strikeouts...his 13 wins in the month are nearly double his next-highest total in any month, with seven victories in both April and June... McClanahan's career 1.84 ERA (122.1IP, 25ER) in May is the lowest by a traditional starter (min. 50.0IP) in franchise history...since 2021, his 13 wins in May are tied for the sixth most in the majors.

SUPPORTING OUR STARTER—McClanahan has received three runs of support or more in 44 of his 86 career appearances...in those 44 outings, he holds a 34-1 record, 2.74 ERA (246.1IP, 75ER), .212 (194-for-915) opp. average, 1.07 WHIP, and 271 strikeouts to 69 walks...in games where he receives three runs of support or more, the Rays are 40-4 and have won 20 of the last 21 (Aug.13, 2022–pres.).

- ✦ Since his rookie season in 2021, McClanahan has the fourth-best run support average (5.37) among AL southpaws (min. 250.0IP), behind NYY Max Fried (6.69), CLE Logan Allen (5.72), and NYY Carlos Rodón (5.68).

THE ACE OF K'S—He has recorded four strikeouts or more in 10 of his 12 starts this year...his 515 career strikeouts are ninth most in franchise history, 11 shy of eighth-ranked Tyler Glasnow (526SO)...he ranks fourth among Tampa Bay left-handers behind David Price (1,065SO), Scott Kazmir (874SO), and Blake Snell (648SO).

- ✦ With three strikeouts on May 25 at BAL, McClanahan reached 50 strikeouts through his first 10 starts to a season for the fourth season in a row (2021-23, 2026)...the last Ray to collect 50 strikeouts or more in his first 10 starts was Shane Baz in 2025, fanning 52 in that span.
- ✦ During his first three seasons (2021-23), McClanahan's 10.14 strikeouts per 9.0 IP ranked second among MLB left-handers (min. 400.0IP) behind Blake Snell (11.85)...under the same parameter, it was the second-highest mark by a southpaw through his first three major league campaigns, trailing SD/PIT Oliver Pérez (10.34)...his 456 career strikeouts were sixth most by a left-hander in franchise history and were the most by any Ray through his first three seasons, regardless of handedness, outpacing James Shields (448, 2006-08), despite McClanahan (404.2IP) throwing 150 fewer innings than Shields (554.2IP).
