JUMPIN' JUPITER: The St. Louis Cardinals welcome **Rob Butcher** and Team Nicaragua to Jupiter this afternoon as the team conducts their 29th Spring Training at Roger Dean Chevrolet Stadium (1998-2026) ... On Monday, March 23, the Cardinals break camp in Florida and fly to Springfield, Mo. to play an exhibition with the Double-A Cardinals at Hammons Field at 6:05 p.m. CT.

DAVID GREEN: 1982 World Series Champion **David Green** is the lone Nicaraguan-born player to appear with the Cardinals in franchise history ... Born in Managua, Nicaragua in 1960, Green played in 383 games over parts of five seasons in St. Louis (1981-84, '87), including all seven games of the 1982 World Series ... Green was famously part of two blockbuster trades in the 1980s, initially packaged by Milwaukee in 1980 for Hall of Famer **Ted Simmons** and later departing for San Francisco in another multi-player exchange involving All-Star **Jack Clark** before the 1985 season, **Brian Bartow's** first year with the Cardinals.

EL PRESIDENTE: Granada, Nicaragua native **Dennis Martínez** served as a pitching instructor in the Cardinals minor league system for six seasons between Gulf Coast (2007), Palm Beach (2008-09, '11-12), and Springfield (2010).

WORLD CLASS: The Cardinals have nine players, two coaches, and one athletic trainer on provisional rosters for the 2026 World Baseball Classic taking place from March 5-17 ... Among those in Major League camp include **Riley O'Brien** (Korea), **Leo Bernal** (Panama), **Gordon Graceffo** (Italy), **Thomas Saggese** (Italy), **Luis Gastelum** (Mexico), **Matt Koperniak** (Great Britain), **Bryan Torres** (Puerto Rico), coaches **Stubby Clapp** (Canada) and **Julio Rangel** (Panama), and Certified Asst. Athletic Trainer **Chris Conroy** (Puerto Rico).

OLI EXTENDED AS CARDS MANAGER: The Cardinals recently signed Manager **Oliver "Oli" Marmol** to a two-year contract extension through the 2028 season, with a club option for 2029 ... The 39-year-old Marmol has piloted the team over the past four seasons (2022-25) and enters 2026 ranked 11th on the franchise's all-time managerial wins list with 325 victories ... Oli is currently the 3rd-longest tenured manager in the National League ... 2026 is Oli's 20th year in the organization as a player, coach, instructor, and manager (2007-present).

SPRING EXHIBITIONS: Since 2007, St. Louis is a combined 16-1 in spring training exhibitions against Nicaragua (1-0), the Dominican Republic (1-0), Triple-A Memphis (6-0), Double-A Springfield (5-1), the Florida Atlantic Owls (2-0), and the St. Louis Billikens (1-0) ... It's lone defeat was a 10-3 defeat to Springfield at Hammons Field on March 29, 2008.

PREVIOUS WBC EXHIBITIONS: Today marks the third Cardinals exhibition against a World Baseball Classic Team since the international baseball tournament's inception in 2006:

- **March 5, 2009:** St. Louis faced off against the Dominican Republic in Jupiter, winning 4-1 over a Dominican lineup featuring **José Reyes**, **Robinson Canó**, **Miguel Tejada**, **David Ortiz**, **Moises Alou**, and **Nelson Cruz** ... Due to insurance issues revolving around his offseason surgery on his right elbow, reigning NL MVP and native Dominican **Albert Pujols** declined to play against his home country out of respect of teammates on both teams ...

- **March 9, 2023:** The Cardinals secured a 6-4 victory over Nicaragua in Jupiter, thanks to three runs in the bottom of the 8th inning to win.

CARDS TRIM 11 FROM ROSTER: The Cardinals reduced their Spring Training roster to 57 players Monday, optioning RHP **Tekoah Roby** to Memphis (AAA), and re-assigning SHP **Jurrangelo Cijntje**, LHP **Pete Hansen**, LHP **Ixan Henderson**, RHP **Austin Love**, RHP **Hancel Rincón**, RHP **Sem Robberse**, LHP **Jared Shuster**, LHP **Zack Thompson**, C **Grayson Tarlow**, and OF **Mike Antico** to minor league camp.

IN FULL BLOOM: The Cardinals introduced **Chaim Bloom** on Sept. 30 as the team's new President of Baseball Operations taking the post that had been held by **John Mozeliak** who headed the team's baseball operations since Oct. of 2007 ... Bloom, who worked previously with the Boston Red Sox (2020-23) and Tampa Bay Rays (2005-19) had served as an advisor for the Cardinals the past two seasons.

PARDON OUR DUST: St. Louis moved into its newly-renovated Cardinals Complex this spring, featuring a new performance center, conference center, clubhouse and "Birdfeeder" dining hall...the final phase of the three phase project that began back in 2023 is slated to be completed later this year.

TODAY'S PITCHERS

#32 MATTHEW LIBERATORE · LHP · 6-5 · 220 LBS · AGE 26

- Chose to switch to uniform No. 32 prior to 2026 season in honor of Hall of Fame left-handed pitcher Sandy Koufax, whom he grew up admiring.
- Made his Major League debut at Pittsburgh on May 21, 2022 at PNC Park, a day after childhood friend and Cardinals teammate Nolan Gorman did so at PNC Park.
- Made full-time transition to the starting rotation in 2025 and set single-season career highs in nearly every category.
- His 29 starts in 2025 were the most by a St. Louis southpaw since Jaime García (32 in 2011), and the most by any Cardinals left-hander age 25 or younger since the same 24-year-old García in 2011.
- Was acquired by the Cardinals from the Rays in a four-player trade in 2020, with a compensation pick that netted the Cardinals RHP Tink Hence.
- Is a career 13-21 with a 4.87 ERA (253.0 IP) in his 53 career starts opposed to 3-3 with a 3.89 ERA (81.0 IP) in 67 career relief appearances.

#59 JOJO ROMERO · LHP · 5-11 · 215 LBS · AGE 29

- Acquired at the 2022 trade deadline from the Philadelphia Phillies in exchange for infielder Edmundo Sosa on July 30.
- Set career highs in 2025 in innings pitched (61.0), strikeouts (55), saves (8)
- Has appeared in a career-high 65 games in each of the last two seasons, the first Cardinals pitcher with 65+ outings in back-to-back seasons since Kevin Siegrist from 2015-16, and his team-leading 130 outings in that span rank 13th in the National League.
- His 30 holds in 2024 ranked 2nd among Cardinals relief pitchers and T-5th all-time for single-season in franchise history with Kyle McClellan (2008). Only Ray King (31 in 2004) had more among Cardinals southpaws all-time. Also led all left-handed pitchers with 54 holds from 2024-25, ranking second, overall, in the NL (5th in MLB), behind Tyler Rogers (65). Ranks T-6th with Randy Flores in Cardinals history with 57 holds.
- Held left-handed batters to a .185 BA (48-259) with 4 HR in his career (Last: 8/8/24 to B. Lowe vs. TB). Since 2022, his .175 opp. BA (38-217) vs. LH batters ranks 4th in NL (min. 200 batters faced).

#35 RICHARD FITTS · RHP · 6-3 · 245 LBS · AGE 26

- Acquired by the Cardinals with LHP Brandon Clarke and a player to be named later in exchange for RHP Sonny Gray and cash considerations, November 25, 2025.
- Has been traded twice in his four year professional career. Originally drafted by the Yankees in 2021, but was packaged to the Red Sox in a four-player trade for OF Alex Verdugo in 2023.
- Pitched 18.2 consecutive innings without allowing an earned run (Sept. 8-20, 2024), longest to begin a career in Red Sox history. *Elias Sports Bureau*
- Tossed consecutive starts with 5.0 innings and zero earned runs in his first two starts, joining Tanner Houck (2020), Vaughn Eshelman (1995) and Dave Ferris (1945) as four Red Sox pitchers to accomplish the feat.
- Joined Cincinnati's Andrew Abbott (2023) as the only two pitchers in MLB history (since 1901) to throw 5.0+ innings and allow zero earned runs in each of their first three MLB starts.
- Became the 4th pitcher in Red Sox history to start at home and allow zero earned runs with 5.0 or more innings pitched in their Major League debut (Aaron Sele, 1993), Duane Wilson (1958) and Larry Pape (1909).

#55 RYNE STANEK · RHP · 6-3 · 235 LBS · AGE 34

- Signed as a free agent in January, returning to the city he was born. The Cardinals become his 6th Major League organization.
- Originally a 1st round draft pick (29th overall) by the Tampa Bay Rays out of the University of Arkansas in 2013.
- Member of the 2022 World Champion Houston Astros.
- Ranks 25th among active pitchers with 466 career appearances since 2017. Since his career began in 2017, ranks 15th among all pitchers in appearances.
- Is one of four pitchers in Major League history with a perfect fielding percentage (1.000) to have made 400 career appearances and pitched 400.0 career innings; joining Hector Rondon, Hunter Strickland and Luis Vizcaino.
- Appeared in 30 career postseason games, going 4-0 with a 2.89 ERA. Ranks 9th among active pitchers with 30 career postseason appearances and T-26th in MLB history.
