PITTSBURGH PIRATES (24-24) vs. ST. LOUIS CARDINALS (28-19)
May 20, 2026 - Busch Stadium - St. Louis, MO - 6:45 CDT - Game #49/Road #23
RHP Carmen Mlodzinski (3-3, 4.40 ERA) vs. RHP Michael McGreevy (3-2, 2.10 ERA)

THE PIRATES: began this six-game road trip to St. Louis (Tuesday-Thursday) and Toronto (Friday-Sunday) with a 9-6, 10-inning loss last night at Busch Stadium...Have lost four consecutive games (since May 15 vs. Philadelphia)...Went 2-4 on their recent six-game homestand vs. Colorado (2-1, May 12-14) and Philadelphia (0-3, May 15-17)...Are in the penultimate game of a stretch of 25 consecutive games against the National League (their last game against an American League opponent came on April 23 at Texas)...Have the sixth-most runs scored (235) among all teams in Major League Baseball.

LEADING THE WAY: Oneil Cruz is the only Major Leaguer leading his team in hits (51), RBI (33), steals (16) and runs (35) this season...Per OptaStats, the last Pirate to lead the Pirates in all four categories over a full season was Andrew McCutchen in 2012.

CENTRAL PERK: Pittsburgh is making its first of two trips to St. Louis this year (also August 28-30)...The Pirates went 2-5 at Busch Stadium in 2025 (were swept in a three-game series from May 5-7 and split a four-game series from August 25-28)...Pittsburgh has won each of its first three road series vs. the National League Central (won two of three games from March 30-April 1 at Cincinnati, two of three games from April 10-12 at Chicago and two of three games from April 24-26 at Milwaukee)...The only other time the Pirates won each of their first three road series vs. the division in a season (division formed in 1994) came in 2011 (won two of three from April 1-3 at Chicago, two of three from April 4-6 at St. Louis & three of four from April 15-18 at Cincinnati).

TRI TIMES THREE: Jared Triolo went 3-for-4 with a run scored on Tuesday at St. Louis and is now hitting .389 (7-for-18) in his last six games (since May 13 vs. Colorado)...He has gone 9-for-31 (.290) in his 13 games since returning from the injured list on May 2.

PASSWORD UNLOCKED: Jhostynxon Garcia went 1-for-4 in his season/team debut on Tuesday at St. Louis...He became the 34th different Pirate (player or pitcher) to appear in a game this season (Pittsburgh has used 16 different players/18 different pitchers).

DON'T PICK ON ME: Henry Davis picked off St. Louis' Thomas Saggese at third base in Tuesday's seventh inning, marking his second pickoff in his last four games (he recorded the first pickoff of his Major League career when he picked off Colorado's Mickey Moniak on May 13 at PNC Park)...Davis and Cleveland's Austin Hedges are the only two Major League catchers with two pickoffs...The last Pirates catcher to pick off a runner before Davis was Jason Delay (picked off Joey Wendle on October 1, 2023 vs. Miami).

UNDER THE ARCH: Marcell Ozuna's 28 career home runs at Busch Stadium are his third-most at any Major League stadium, trailing only Truist Park (81) and loanDepot park (58)...Billy Cook hit his first career home run with a three-run blast (off Matthew Liberatore) here in St. Louis on September 18, 2024...Bryan Reynolds' 94 hits against the Cardinals since making his Major League debut on April 20, 2019 are the most against St. Louis during that stretch (Chicago-NL's Ian Happ, 76 hits, is second on that list).

INDISPENCEABLE: Spencer Horwitz delivered a game-tying, pinch-hit single (scored Konnor Griffin) in the ninth inning on Tuesday at St. Louis...He has gone 3-for-7 (.429) with a home run and three RBI as a pinch hitter this season...Horwitz is hitting .357 (15-for-42) with five doubles, 10 RBI, six walks, four runs and a .962 OPS over his last 13 games (since May 2 vs. Cincinnati).

SO(TO) GOOD: Gregory Soto struck out the side (Thomas Saggese, Pedro Pagés and Victor Scott II) in the ninth inning on Tuesday at St. Louis...Soto's 29 strikeouts this season are tied with New York (NL)'s Sean Manaea and San Diego's Adrian Morejon for the third-most among left-handed relievers throughout Major League Baseball, behind only Milwaukee's Aaron Ashby (42) & Cleveland's Erik Sabrowski (38).

EXTRA! EXTRA! Bryan Reynolds delivered a two-run double (scored Jared Triolo and Nick Gonzales) in the fifth inning (off Matthew Liberatore) on Tuesday at St. Louis...Pittsburgh has recorded at least one extra-base hit in 21 consecutive games (since April 26 at Milwaukee), trailing only Baltimore (41 games, since April 5 at Pittsburgh) and San Francisco (24 games, since April 24 vs. Miami) for the longest active streak in Major League Baseball...The Pirates have collected 58 extra-base hits since the streak began (they have recorded 34 doubles, four triples and 20 home runs during that stretch).

ON THIS DATE IN PIRATES HISTORY

May 20, 2004: Pittsburgh erased two separate six-run deficits en route to a 9-7 win over San Diego at PNC Park. The Pirates trailed, 6-0, entering the bottom of the first inning, while also falling behind, 7-1, heading into the bottom of the second inning before scoring eight unanswered runs. It was their largest comeback victory since erasing a six-run deficit in a 9-8 walkoff on July 28 (G1), 2001 vs. Houston.

HOW ACQUIRED: Selected in Comp. Balance A round (No. 31) of the 2020 Draft.

LAST TIME OUT: Mlodzinski won a 7-2 decision after allowing two runs over 5.0 innings of relief on May 14 vs. Colorado...He became the first Pirate to have multiple relief outings of at least 5.0 innings where he earned the win in both outings (also April 15 vs. Washington) since Bob Johnson also did that twice during the 1972 campaign.

AGAINST THE CARDINALS: Mlodzinski is 2-0 with a 2.18 ERA (20.2ip/5er) and 24 strikeouts in 10 career appearances (three starts) against St. Louis...Each of his three starts against the Cardinals came last season...Mlodzinski has a 2.84 ERA (12.2ip/4er) against St. Louis as a starter and a 1.13 ERA (8.0ip/1er) as a reliever...He has posted a 2.77 ERA (13.0ip/4er) and 14 strikeouts over six games (two starts) at Busch Stadium.

A BIT OF BOTH: Mlodzinski has gone 1-3 with a 5.29 ERA (34.0ip/20er) in his seven starts and 2-0 with a 1.64 ERA (11.0ip/2er) in two relief appearances so far this season.

AND THE WHIFF: Mlodzinski won a 17-7 decision after allowing five runs and striking out a career-high 10 batters over 5.2 innings on May 2 vs. Cincinnati...His only other 10-strikeout game in his professional career came last season on May 23 with Triple-A Indianapolis at Toledo...His 101 pitches were his most in any professional outing, surpassing the previous high of 96 (September 10, 2022 w/Double-A Altoona at Erie).

LIMITING THE LONG BALL: Mlodzinski allowed a home run in back-to-back outings on May 2 and May 8 following his 76.0-inning homerless streak that spanned from last year on July 6 at Seattle to May 2 vs. Cincinnati...Per the Elias Sports Bureau, the only other Pittsburgh pitcher in the Wild Card Era (since 1995) with a homerless streak of 75.0-plus innings was Mark Melancon (86.0 innings, April 17, 2013-May 24, 2014).

PROVIDING RELIEF: Mlodzinski earned his first win of the season after relieving starter Mason Montgomery in the second inning and proceeding to toss a career-high 6.0 innings without allowing a run in Pittsburgh's 2-0 win on April 15 vs. Washington... He was the first Pirates reliever to pitch at least 6.0 innings in a game since Quinn Priester (also 6.0ip) on July 9, 2024 at Milwaukee...Mlodzinski was also the first Pittsburgh reliever to pitch at least 6.0 scoreless innings in a game since Steve Cooke pitched 7.0 scoreless innings in the team's 3-0 win on September 21, 1992 vs. St. Louis.

HISTORIC OUTING: Mlodzinski allowed two hits and struck out five batters over 6.0 scoreless innings of relief on April 15 vs. Washington...He became one of nine Pirates relievers during the Modern Era (since 1901) to pitch at least 6.0 scoreless innings while allowing two or fewer hits and striking out at least five batters...He joined Mike Lynch (1906), Erv Kantlehner (1915), Bill Swift (1935), Mace Brown (1937), Dick Littlefield (1954), Harvey Haddix (1961), Al McBean (1963) and Bob Johnson (1972) on that list.

2026 DEBUT: Mlodzinski had a no-decision after allowing two runs and striking out a career-high eight batters (did not issue a walk) over 4.1 innings on March 29 at Citi Field (the Pirates defeated the Mets, 4-3, in 10 innings)...He became the second Pirates pitcher (first starter) during the Modern Era to have at least eight strikeouts while issuing zero walks in an outing of 4.1 innings pitched or fewer, joining Rich Gossage, who did so across 3.0 innings in his relief appearance on May 19, 1977 vs. Los Angeles.
