THE HUNT FOR A RED OCTOBER: The Cardinals continue their final regular season road trip (4-0 at CHI, ARI-3) this evening, as they play the opening game of a three-game series at Chase Field...the Cardinals posted dramatic 5-4, 2-1, 9-8 & 3-2 wins last weekend in Chicago, recording their first four-game series sweep of the Cubs at Wrigley Field since May 27-29 [2], 1921...the Cardinals have won five-straight, one shy of matching their season high, and are a season-high 22 games over .500 with six games remaining...St. Louis entered play today in first place in the NL Central, 3.0 games ahead of the Brewers...they clinched their first postseason berth since 2015 with yesterday's win and their magic number for clinching the NL Central title stands at four over Milwaukee.

DIVISION DANDIES: The Cardinals are seeking their first NL Central title since 2015 and a share of their 12th overall (co-winners with Houston in 2001)...the Cardinals have won outright NL Central titles in 1996, 2000, 2002, 2004, 2005, 2006, 2009, 2013, 2014 & 2015 since the division was formed in 1995.

MONDAY FUNDAY: The Cardinals are a MLB best 13-2 (.867) on Mondays, their most wins to get the work week started since 2010 (14-5) & 2005 (14-2).

GOLDY'S CHASE: Former D-Back (2011-18) **Paul Goldschmidt** makes his return to Chase Field for the first time since last off-season's trade, and is just one homer shy of becoming the first player to hit 100 career homers at the desert diamond...Goldy is the all-time leader at Chase Field in home runs (99) and walks (360) and is tied for first in runs (380) with **Luis Gonzalez**.

HOLLIDAY SHOPPING LIST: Not since 2012 (**Matt Holliday**, 102), has a Cardinal collected 100+RBI...**Paul Goldschmidt** is leading the Cardinals with 92, including 55 since the All-Star break (2nd in NL) and 19 in September (2nd, NL).

NOT SINCE 1931: Saturday's 9th inning back-to-back game-tying and go-ahead homers by **Yadier Molina** & **Paul DeJong** marked just the second time in franchise history that the Cardinals hit back-to-back home runs to tie and go ahead in the final inning of a win according to the Elias Sports Bureau. The first time it happened was on June 16, 1931, when **George Watkins** and **Frankie Frisch** homered in the bottom of the 9th in a 2-1 win over the Phillies.

FIREMEN SAVE 51: Yesterday's save by **Andrew Miller** was the team's 51st of the season, with **Carlos Martinez** leading the way with 23, followed by **Jordan Hicks** (14), **Andrew Miller** (6), **John Gant** (3) and five others with one apiece...the Cardinals lead the majors with 51 rescues and have nine players with at least one save this season, just one shy of the club record of 10 players with saves which has been done four times (1966, 1965, 1964 and 1951)...the team's 51 saves are T5th in club history (club record 62 in 2015).

SNAKE CHARMERS: Since Arizona joined MLB as an expansion team in 1998, the Cardinals' .611 win pct. (91-58) vs. the D-Backs is their 2nd-highest vs. any opponent who play St. Louis each season (Padres, .623, 94-57)...the Cardinals have won or tied their road series at Arizona each of the last five seasons (2014-18), last dropping a series here when they opened the 2013 season (April 1-3) by going 1-2.

THE EDMAN EFFECT: Rookie **Tommy Edman** hit his team-leading 6th triple on Sat. and had two hits, his 14th stolen base and scored the go-ahead run in yesterday's win...Edman made his ML debut on June 8 at Wrigley Field as the Cardinals fell to 31-31 that night...since then, the Cardinals are 58-36...Edman has reached base safely in 12-staight games and has a 1.049 OPS and .671 SLG pct. in 21 September games.

TIME TO FLY: After going 0-5 during their West Coast trip to Oakland and Los Angeles-NL (August 3-7), the Cardinals are 31-12 since August 9, leading Major League Baseball in wins while boasting a MLB-best 2.95 ERA and eight shutouts in that span...the Cardinals lead the N.L. in winning pct. (.45-23; .662) since the All-Star break and are 2nd in the National League (Milwaukee, 17) in September wins (14).

TAKING CARE OF BUSINESS: The Cardinals are 45-28 (.616) in divisional play, including a 30-11 (.731) mark since the All-Star Break...their .616 divisional win pct. leads all NL Central clubs and is their 4th best all-time.

RUNNIN' REDBIRDS: The Cardinals (112-for-141) lead the NL in stolen bases this season, three more than 2nd place Washington (109). Their 79.4% SB success rate (6th in NL) currently stands as the highest all-time in franchise history since 1951 (*STATS LLC*)...19 different Cardinals have stolen at least one base, most in MLB and T5th-most in franchise history (record held by 1906 club with 21 Cardinals).

ARIZONA CONNECTIONS

Paul Goldschmidt was selected by Arizona in the 8th round of the 2009 MLB Draft and played eight seasons in a Diamondbacks uniform (2011-18), hitting .297/.398/.532 with 209 home runs and 710 RBI...selected to six All-Star squads (2013-18)...won four Silver Sluggers (2013, '15, '17-18) and three Gold Gloves (2013, '15, '17)...acquired by St. Louis from Arizona in exchange for catcher **Carson Kelly**, pitcher **Luke Weaver**, infielder **Andy Young**, and the 2019 Cardinals Compensation Round B selection (Dec. 5, 2018).

John Brebbia was selected by St. Louis from the Arizona in the Triple-A phase of the 2015 Rule 5 Draft.

Daniel Ponce de Leon pitched in four games for the University of Arizona as a freshman in 2011.

Dominic Leone pitched parts of two seasons (2015-16) with Arizona...originally traded by Seattle with catcher **Wellington Castillo** and infielder **Jack Reinheimer** to Arizona for pitcher **Vidal Nuno** and outfielder **Mark Trumbo** (June 3, 2015).

Cardinals coach **Willie McGee** rehabbed for four games with the Phoenix Firebirds (AAA) as a member of the San Francisco Giants organization in 1991.

David Peralta was originally signed by St. Louis as a non-drafted free agent pitcher (Sept. 26, 2004)...pitched three minor league seasons (2005-07) before transitioning to the outfield...underwent pair of left-shoulder surgeries...released in May 2009.

Carson Kelly played parts of three seasons with St. Louis (2016-18)...originally selected by the Cardinals as a third baseman in the 2nd round of the 2012 MLB Draft...2016 Cardinals Minor League Player of the Year...younger brother, **Parker Kelly**, pitches in the Cardinals organization.

Luke Weaver pitched parts of three seasons with St. Louis (2016-18)...selected by the Cardinals in the first round (27th overall) in 2014 MLB Draft...2016 Cardinals Minor League Pitcher of the Year.

Ildemaro Vargas signed by St. Louis as a non-drafted free agent (June 26, 2008) and played seven seasons in the Cardinals minor league organization (2008-14).

Diamondbacks First Base Coach **Dave McKay** served in the same position for the Cardinals for 16 seasons (1996-2011).

Diamondbacks hitting coach **Darnell Coles** played in 63 games for the Cardinals in 1995.

Diamondbacks coach **Luis "Pipe" Urueta** played in 24 games in the Cardinals minor league organization in 2003.

Sam Narron, uncle of Diamondbacks bench coach **Jerry Narron**, played parts of three seasons with the Cardinals (1935, '42-43).

Cardinals President of Operations **John Mozeliak** attended the University of Arizona before graduating from the University of Colorado at Boulder.

Cardinals Sr. Special Asst. to the GM **Bob Gebhard** worked for the Diamondbacks as VP & Special Asst. to the GM for 12 seasons (2005-16).

Cardinals Hall of Fame Manager **Tony La Russa** served as the Diamondbacks Chief Baseball Analyst for four seasons (2014-17).

Diamondbacks Vice President, Player Development **Mike Bell** is the younger brother of former Cardinals coach (2014-17) and infielder (1995-98) **David Bell**...Mike also played in eight games for the Memphis Redbirds (AAA) in 2005.

TONIGHT’S GAME

- Makes his 30th start of the season (315th career start) and his 382nd career appearance today, facing the Diamondbacks for the 2nd time this season.
- Is 4-0 with an 0.33 ERA in four September starts. Leads all MLB pitchers in wins and ERA in the month. Is the lowest September ERA by a Cardinals pitcher since Max Lanier set the club record with an 0.31 in 1941. Dwight Gooden (1985) and Orel Hershiser (1988) navigated the entire month without an ER for the MLB record in September.
- His career high is five wins in September, going 5-0 with a 1.38 ERA in 2014.
- Is 8-2 Post All-Star Break, T2nd-most wins in the National League behind teammate Dakota Hudson and his most since a career-best nine Post ASB wins (9-3) in 2009.
- Dropped ERA to 3.83, currently 17th in the NL and lowest its been since May 1 (3.73).
- His .738 career win pt. (31-11) in September is tops in Cardinals history (min. 40 decisions) and he ranks 3rd all-time in MLB behind Randy Johnson (.750; 45-15) & Clayton Kershaw (.762, 32-10).
- Is one of five Cardinals to win 30 or more career September games, joining Bob Gibson (44), Bill Sherdel (35), Jesse Haines (33) & Bob Forsch (32).
- Is the first Cardinal since Murray Dickson (13 wins in 1956 at age 39) to post 13+ wins at age 38 or older.
- He and Yadier Molina have been a starting battery for 263 games, 8th-most all-time in MLB history since 1908; will tie Cleveland’s Bob Lemon & Jim Hegan, 264 for 7th place tonight.
- Ranks 8th among active pitchers with a 3.36 ERA (min. 1,500 IP) and 14th in starts.
- Has a 66-35 (.653) career mark in post All-Star break games with a 3.35 ERA. He ranks 4th among active NL pitchers in career post All-Star winning pct.
- Passed Bill Sherdel (1918-30, ‘32) for 4th all-time in wins in franchise history in his July 14 start vs. ARI & is just two wins (161) back of Bob Forsch (163) for 3rd all-time.
- Is one of five Cardinal pitchers to make 300 or more career starts, joining Bob Gibson (482), Bob Forsch (401), Jesse Haines (387), and Bill Doak (320).
- Since 2016, St. Louis sports a 58-35 record (.624 win pct) in his games pitched.

LAST TIME OUT

- Pitched 7.0 innings allowing an unearned run while scattering eight hits opposing Max Scherzer for a 5-1 win at Busch Stadium to win the series. Ran his consecutive streak to 34.0 innings without allowing an earned run at home dating back to April 24 vs. MIL.
