**TONIGHT'S GAME:** The Braves and Giants open a three-game set tonight with the fifth of seven meetings between the clubs this season...The teams will not meet again until next April 17-19, when the Giants will return for three games here at SunTrust Park.

*A* The Braves took three-of-four games in San Francisco, May 20-23, outscoring the Giants 21-11...The Braves have won six of the last seven games with the Giants, all of which have come at San Francisco.

*A* The Giants swept all three games in their last trip to SunTrust Park, May 4-6, 2018.

*A* RHP Mike Foltynewicz is 3-3 with a 4.47 ERA (22 ER/44.1 IP) in seven career games, all starts, against the Giants...The righty tossed a six-hitter in his last start against them, a 4-1 win on September 11 of last season at San Francisco.

*A* RHP Tyler Beede is set to face the Braves for the first time in his career...The righty has won consecutive 1-0 decisions, beating the Dodgers on September 7 and then Miami on September 13... These two wins snapped a skid of eight straight starts of his that San Francisco lost...He went 0-6 with a 7.05 ERA (29 ER/37.0 IP) during the streak.

**CLINCH?:** The Braves lowered their magic number to clinch the National League East to one yesterday with a 5-4 win over Philadelphia...With another win or a Washington loss, the Braves will earn their second consecutive division title.

*A* The Braves are looking for their 19th division title in franchise history, and they are currently one behind New York (AL) for the most in MLB history...The Yankees collected their 19th last night.

*A* The Braves clinched at least a share of the NL East yesterday, as Washington has three more games left than Atlanta...The Nationals can finish with no more than 94 wins.

*A* Another Braves win in the club's final eight games will also guarantee them home-field advantage in the National League Division Series...The most wins St. Louis can finish with is 95, and the Braves won the season series with the Cardinals, 4-2.

*A* Today is game No. 155 and Mike Foltynewicz is scheduled to start...The Braves clinched the division last season in game No. 155 with starter Mike Foltynewicz earning the win.

*A* If the Braves clinch tonight, it would mark the third straight division title clinched in game No. 155...They also took the East in 2013 in the same amount of games as last season.

*A* The quickest by games the Braves ever clinched the division in a full season was in 2002, when they earned the title in game No. 142.

*A* The Braves sit 4.5 games behind Los Angeles (NL) for the top seed in the league.

**40 HOMERS:** OF Ronald Acuña Jr. became just the third player in baseball history to hit 40 home runs in a single season prior to his 22nd birthday after he drove an 0-2, third-inning pitch from Aaron Nola over the wall in left field yesterday...Acuña Jr. joined two Hall of Famers in Eddie Mathews, who hit 47 in 1953 as a 21-year-old, and Mel Ott, who had 42 as a 20-year-old in 1929.

*A* Only Ott was younger than Acuña Jr at the time of his 40th...Acuña Jr. was 21 years, 275 days, yesterday, while Mathews hit his when he 21 years, 316 days.

*A* Acuña Jr. became the 12th Braves player (23rd time overall) to hit 40 home runs in a season and the first since Andruw Jones hit 41 in 2006.

*A* Hank Aaron hit 40 home runs a National League record-tying eight different times...Only Babe Ruth reached the mark more, hitting 40 homers 11 different times

**40-40?:** OF Ronald Acuña Jr. needs three steals to become the fifth player in baseball history to collect a 40-homer, 40-steal season.

*A* OF José Canseco was the first player to go 40-40, reaching 42 home runs and 40 steals in 1988...Barry Bonds then matched those numbers in 1996, while Alex Rodríguez had 42 homers and 46 steals in 1998...Alfonso Soriano then had 46 and 41 in 2006.

*A* Prior to Acuña Jr., those four players were the only ones to go 40/35...Bonds did it twice, going 40/37 in 1997, a year after his 42/40 season.

**FOLTYNEWICZ WINS:** Atlanta has won each of RHP Mike Foltynewicz's last 11 starts dating to June 11 vs. Pittsburgh, including each of his eight turns since returning from his option to Gwinnett...Foltynewicz is 6-0 with a 4.01 ERA (27 ER/60.2 IP) during the stretch.

*A* The run of team wins in his starts is the longest such streak of his career, and the longest by any Atlanta pitcher since the Braves won an MLB-record 23 straight starts by Kris Medlen from 2010 to 2012.

*A* Foltynewicz's 11-game run is tied for the longest by a starter in baseball this season...Houston has won each of Gerrit Cole's last 11 starts dating to July, while the Twins won 11 straight by Jake Odorizzi from April to June.

*A* Foltynewicz is 6-0 during the stretch, which ties the longest winning streak of his career...He also won six straight from June 7 to July 25, 2017.

**FINISHING UP AT HOME:** The Braves will finish their regular season home schedule on Sunday, and if they win this series, they will have their first 50-win season at home since 2013...They currently are 48-30 at SunTrust Park.

*A* The Braves went 56-25 that season, tying the single-season record for most home wins...They also won 56 games in 1996, 1998, and 1999.

#### Tonight's Game

- A* Makes his 20th start of the season and the 116th of his career...Set for his 136th career appearance.
- A* Atlanta has won each of his last 11 starts dating to June 11 vs. Pittsburgh, including each of his eight turns since returning from his option to Gwinnett...Foltyniewicz is 6-0 with a 4.01 ERA (27 ER/60.2 IP) during the stretch.
- A* The run of team wins in his starts is the longest such streak of his career, and the longest by any Atlanta pitcher since the Braves won an MLB-record 23 straight starts by Kris Medlen from 2010 to 2012.
- A* Foltyniewicz's 11-game run is tied for the longest by a starter in baseball this season...Houston has won each of Gerrit Cole's last 11 starts dating to July, while the Twins won 11 straight by Jake Odorizzi from April to June.
- A* Foltyniewicz is 6-0 during the stretch, which ties the longest winning streak of his career...He also won six straight from June 7 to July 25, 2017.
- A* Set for his eighth career start against the Giants, and his first this season...Is 3-3 with a 4.47 ERA (22 ER/44.1 IP) over his first seven games.
- A* Made two starts against them last season and went 1-1 with a 4.50 ERA (7 ER/14.0 IP).
- A* Last pitched against them September 11 of last season at San Francisco, and tossed the second complete game of his career...Allowed six hits and one run.
- A* Allowed just four hits and one run over 6.0 innings in his last start, September 14 at San Francisco...Has a 1.83 ERA (7 ER/34.1 IP) in his last six starts.
- A* Is 5-0 with a 2.76 ERA (14 ER/45.2 IP) over eight starts since being recalled from Triple-A Gwinnett, August 5.
- A* Had a 6.37 ERA (42 ER/59.1 IP) in his first 11 starts of the season before being optioned.
- A* Has made eight starts this season following an Atlanta win, and is 3-2 with a 3.65 ERA (18 ER/44.1 IP)...The Braves beat the Phillies, 5-4, yesterday.
- A* In 11 starts following a Braves loss, has a 5.64 ERA (38 ER/60.2 IP).

#### 2019 Recap

- A* Was recalled by Atlanta, 8/5, and started at Minnesota the following day...Allowed five hits (two homers) and three runs in 5.1 innings.
- A* All three runs scored in the sixth inning, after Atlanta sent 10 men to the plate and scored six runs in the top of the frame...Allowed just four baserunners through the first five innings.
- A* Made six starts with the Stripers following his option on 6/22, and went 4-0 with a 2.67 ERA (10 ER/33.2 IP) and 31 strikeouts...Opponents batted .254/.299/.325 against him.
- A* Pitched to a 1.13 ERA (2 ER/16.0 IP) over his last three turns, and allowed opponents to hit just .179.
- A* Started for Atlanta in Washington, 6/22, and allowed a career high-tying eight runs over 4.0 innings...Was optioned to Gwinnett postgame.
- A* In his previous six starts, had gone 2-2 with a 3.97 ERA.
- A* Earned his first win of the season, 5/24 at STL, after allowing five hits and one unearned run over 6.0 innings.
- A* The win stopped a seven-game losing streak for the Braves in Foltyniewicz's starts, dating to his final regular-season start of 2018...Atlanta lost each of Foltyniewicz's two playoff starts last season, and his first five turns this year.
- A* Started, 5/14 vs. STL, for his 100th career start, all of which have come for Atlanta.
- A* Became the 20th pitcher to make 100 starts for the Braves since the team moved to Atlanta in 1966...Of the 20 pitchers to make 100 such starts, Foltyniewicz's 8.61 SO/9.0 IP at the time were most, and he stood as one of just two starters to strike out at least eight batters per 9.0 innings for Atlanta.
- A* Took his second loss of the season, 5/8 at LAD, after allowing five hits and five runs over 6.0 innings of work...Struck out just two.
- A* The start was his first at Dodger Stadium since Game 1 of the 2018 National League Division Series.
- A* Went 6.0+ innings in his season debut, 4/27 vs. COL, and allowed six hits and four runs with a walk and five strikeouts...Two of the four runs scored before he recorded an out in the seventh.
- A* Was in line for the win before Colorado scored five runs in the ninth...The Braves are 0-9 in Foltyniewicz's nine career appearances against the Rockies.
- A* Was activated off the 10-day injured list, 4/27, and made his first major league start of the season...Missed Atlanta's first 25 games.
- A* Placed on the injured list with a right elbow bone spur on March 28, retroactive to March 25.

#### Career Recap

- A* Acquired by the Atlanta Braves along with RHP Andrew Thurman and INF Rio Ruiz from the Houston Astros in exchange for C/OF Evan Gattis and RHP James Hoyt on 1/14/15.

- Is 1-2 with a 3.96 ERA (16 ER/36.1 IP) in 40 appearances with the Braves, and 3-4 with a 4.32 ERA (24 ER/50.0 IP) over 55 games on the season...Atlanta acquired him from the Seattle Mariners, 5/20, in exchange for LHP Jesse Biddle and RHP Arodys Vizcaino.
- Since returning from the injured list on 7/12, is 1-2 with a 7.11 ERA (15 ER/19.0 IP) in 23 games...In 17 games with Atlanta prior to the stint, had a 0.52 ERA (1 ER/17.1 IP).
- Is a perfect 16-for-16 in hold chances with Atlanta, and has converted his only save opportunity.
