THE TWINS: Have gone 0-3 on their six-game roadtrip, getting swept in Houston over the weekend...tonight, they will continue the trip with the first of three at Great American Ball Park and finish the series on Thursday afternoon.

◆ Twins have lost four-straight for the first time since April 29-May 2...they are looking to avoid losing five-straight for the first time since June 4-8, 2024 (also 5).

◆ Twins are looking to avoid falling back to .500 tonight for the first time since they were 20-20 through their game on May 10.

**ANOTHER LATE LOSS IN THE LONE STAR STATE:** The Twins were walked-off by the Astros on Sunday afternoon at Daikin Park by a score of 2-1 in 10 innings...they held a 1-0 lead until Houston tied the game in the ninth inning and walked it off in the 10th...it marked just the second loss this season when leading after eight innings (31-2)...Simeon Woods Richardson was the starter but did not factor into the decision, pitching 5.0 shutout innings, with one hit allowed, one walk and four strikeouts, while throwing just 53 pitches...Brooks Lee tied his season-high with three hits, extended his hitting streak to 15 games and homered for the second-straight game...marked his seventh home run of the season.

FROM MINNY TO QUEEN CITY: Minnesota and Cincinnati are playing each other for the 38th, 39th and 40th times in their history this weekend...the Twins are 18-19 all-time against the Reds, going 7-10 in Cincinnati (6-5 at Great American Ball Park and 1-5 at Cinergy Field) and 11-9 in Minnesota (4-7 at Target Field and 7-2 at the Metrodome).

♣ These two teams last met for three games at Target Field, from September 13-15, 2024, as the Twins lost the first two games and won the third.

♣ The last time the Twins played at Great American Ball Park was from September 18-20, 2023, as the Twins took the final two games of the three game series.

♣ Harrison Bader is hitting .293 (51-for-174) with seven doubles, nine home runs, 25 RBI, 30 runs scored, 26 walks, a .394 on-base percentage and an .883 OPS in 69 career games vs. Cincinnati...nine home runs and 26 walks are his most against any opponent...in his last 15 games at Great American Ball Park, he is hitting .347 (17-for-49) with four home runs, nine RBI and a 1.040 OPS.

♣ Willi Castro is hitting .364 (8-for-22) with one double, two home runs, five RBI and a 1.143 OPS in seven career games vs. the Reds...he homered in each of his last two games here on September 19 and 20, 2023.

♣ Ty France was traded to the Reds from Seattle at the deadline last season and played 52 games for Cincinnati down the stretch.

NATIONAL NEWS: Twins have gone 7-8 in Interleague Play this season, going 0-3 at St. Louis (March 27-30), 2-1 vs. New York-NL (April 14-16), 0-3 at Atlanta (April 18-20), 3-0 vs. San Francisco (May 9-11) and 2-1 at Milwaukee (May 16-18)...Twins are 5-1 vs. NL teams after starting the season 2-7...after this series, their next series against an NL opponent will be three against the Brewers at Target Field this weekend.

**BUCK NATIONAL:** In his last eight Interleague games, Byron Buxton is hitting .333 (11-for-33) with one double, two triples, one home run, four RBI and a .909 OPS...below are Buck's rankings in a few categories among Twins all-time in Interleague Play (since 1997):

**ONE RUN, NO FUN:** The Twins have gone 7-12 in one-run games this season, dropping each of their last five: two in Seattle (May 31 & June 1), one vs. Toronto (June 7) and the last two at Houston (Saturday and Sunday)...their last one-run win was on May 24 vs. Kansas City, a 5-4 victory at Target Field...they went 22-20 in one-run games in 2024.

LEFT SIDE STORY: Today marks the 13th time the Twins have faced a left-handed starter this season...Minnesota is 5-7 against lefty starters...they lost their last three games started by left-handers: May 25 vs. Kansas City (Kris Bubic), June 12 vs. Texas (Patrick Corbin) and Sunday at Houston (Brandon Walter)...their last win was on May 23 vs. Kansas City, a game started by Noah Cameron.

◆ Since April 19, Twins are slashing .254/.328/.398 (.727 OPS) against lefties...prior to that stretch, they slashed .118/.176/.205 (.381 OPS) vs. lefties...their .727 OPS since that date ranks ninth-best in baseball.

◆ Byron Buxton is hitting .306 (11-for-36) with a .937 OPS against left-handed pitchers this season...in his last 16 games vs. lefties, he is slashing .393/.471/.714 (1.185 OPS).

◆ Willi Castro is hitting .327 (18-for-55) with a .618 slugging percentage and a .969 OPS against lefties this season...over his last 10 games vs. lefties, he is hitting .524 (11-for-21) with two doubles, one triple, three home runs and a 1.688 OPS.

◆ Brooks Lee is hitting .364 (8-for-22) with an .864 OPS in his ast eight games against left-handed pitching.

GOTTA SEE IT TO BE-LEE-VE IT: Brooks Lee has hit safely in 15-straight games with an at-bat, extending his career-high...the streak is the longest by a Twin this season and the longest active streak in baseball...Minnesota's last streak as long was from Carlos Correa, who hit in 16-straight from June 26-September 18, 2024...the longest streak in baseball this season was 22 by Bobby Witt Jr., from April 8-May 1. 

◆ During the current streak, Lee is hitting .350 (21-for-60) with two doubles, three home runs, 10 RBI and a .904 OPS.

WILL POWER: In his last 26 games, Willi Castro is hitting .368 (32-for-87) with five doubles, one triple, six home runs, 12 RBI, 11 walks, 17 runs scored, two stolen bases, a .444 on-base percentage, a .655 slugging percentage and a 1.100 OPS.

◆ In his last 10 road games, since May 30, he is hitting .395 (15-for-38) with five home runs, seven RBI, an .842 slugging percentage and a 1.319 OPS.

ANDERSON 360: FCL Twins right-handed pitcher Anderson Ramos yesterday was named Florida Complex League Pitcher of the Week... the 19-year-old made two relief appearances for the FCL Twins last week, going 1-0, 0.00 ERA (5.2 IP), with one save, no hits allowed, one walk and six strikeouts...the San Francisco de Macorís, Dominican Republic native signed with the Twins in March of 2024.

VARSITY BLUES: The Minnesota Twins Community Fund and the Minnesota All Sports Alliance on Sunday announced the winners of the 2025 Mr. Baseball and Ms. Softball Awards, presented by the Minnesota Twins Community Fund...Mr. Baseball 2025 is Owen Marsolek, a left-handed pitcher from Duluth Marshall High School who has committed to Western Kentucky University...Ms. Softball 2025 is Carter Raymond, a right-handed pitcher from Randolph High School who has committed to the University of Minnesota...award winners and finalists, which represent the finest senior players in the state of Minnesota, were selected by a panel of high school and college coaches... athletic and character attributes, as well as season accomplishments, were considered...Marsolek and Raymond were recognized during a ceremony this afternoon at Target Field and will be honored by the Twins by throwing out a first pitch before an upcoming 2025 home game. ▼ Twins outfielder Matt Wallner earned the Mr. Baseball Award in 2016.

LAST TIME OUT: Last pitched on June 11 vs. the Rangers at Target Field, opposite Jack Leiter...earned the win, his first of the season, in Minnesota's 6-2 victory...allowed two runs on three hits (1 HR), with two walks and four strikeouts over a major league career-high-tying 6.0 innings...marked the second quality start of his career...surrendered a home run to Marcus Semien to start the second inning, Festa's fifth career home run allowed to the first batter of an inning...Jonah Heim hit a one-out ground-rule double in the third and scored on a double by Josh Smith...picked off Evan Carter in the fourth inning, who was tagged out in a rundown, the second pick off/pitcher caught stealing of

- Testa's career (first came on April 23 vs. Chicago-AL).
   The win marked his first since August 5, 2024...in that span, had eight no decisions and five losses, including four-straight from August 23-September 9, 2024.
   Four strikeouts snapped a professional career-high streak of seven consecutive starts with five-or-more strikeouts.

**TWO STARTS AGO:** Started on June 5 against the Athletics in Sacramento opposite Mitch Spence, his first major league outing since April 23...took the loss in Minnesota's 14-3 defeat...allowed a career-high eight runs on a season-high six hits, including a career-high-tying three home runs, with two walks and six strikeouts over 3.2 innings...allowed four runs in the first inning on two singles, a walk and a home run...five of first six outs recorded were strikeouts...gave up a solo home run, a base hit and a two-run home run to start the third inning...exited the game with two outs and a runner on (BB) in the fourth; runner scored on Tyler Soderstrom's grand slam, allowed by Jorge Alcala in relief.

SLIM REAPER STRIKES: No pitcher in Minnesota Twins history (1961-present) has recorded more strikeouts than Festa (102) through their first 19 career games...the next closest is Tyler Duffey, who recorded 100 strikeouts through his first 19 career games...below are some of his numbers compared to Twins pitchers with 95-or-more strikeouts through the first 19 games of their major

ADDITIONALLY: Of the 73 major league pitchers since 2000 who have recorded 102-or-more strikeouts in their first 19 career games, only four, including Festa, have done so in 89.2-or-fewer innings pitched.

**FACING CINCINNATI:** Is facing the Reds for the second time in his career...first outing came on September 15, 2024 at Target Field...did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's 9-2 win, allowing two runs on three hits, with three walks and four strikeouts over 3.2 innings...removed from the game after allowing two runs on two singles, a triple and two walks in the fourth inning...struck out the side in order in the third inning, the second such inning of his career; has not done so since.

• After tonight, the Reds will be the fourth team that Festa has faced more than once in his career (2x Texas, Detroit, New York-NL).

- ₱ In nine career Interleague appearances (8 starts), is 2-3 with a 3.92 ERA (41.1 IP, 18 ER), 14 walks and 51 strikeouts...opponents are hitting .229 (36-for-157) with a .303 on-base percentage and a .389 slugging percentage.

HOME/ROAD SPLITS: Is making his second road start of the season...in seven career starts on the road, is 2-3 with a 5.35 ERA (33.2 IP, 20 ER), five home runs, 10 walks and 42 strikeouts, compared to 1-4 with a 4.56 ERA (53.1 IP, 27 ER), eight home runs, 22 walks and 60 strikeouts in 12 career appearances (11 starts) at home...Twins are 4-3 in Festa's career road starts.

◆ Is making his first career start at Great American Ball Park...in three career starts at National League ballparks, all in 2024, is 2-1 with a 4.20 ERA (15.0 IP, 7 ER), two home runs, four walks and 17 strikeouts.

**LEFT/RIGHT SPLITS:** This season, lefties are hitting .211 (8-for-38) with three doubles, one home run, six walks, 11 strikeouts, a .348 on-base percentage and a .716 OPS when facing Festa, while righties are hitting .271 (13-for-48) with one double, three home runs, three walks, 14 strikeouts, a .314 on-base percentage and a .793 OPS...in his career, lefties are hitting .228 (36-for-158) with eight doubles, two triples, five home runs, 17 RBI, 19 walks and 49 strikeouts against Festa, while righties are hitting .263 (47-for-179) with 10 doubles, one triple, eight home runs, 26 RBI, 13 walks

a 5 strikeburs.
The bit one career start against the Reds, lefties went 1-for-5 (.200) with one walk and two strike-outs, while righties went 2-for-8 (.250) with one triple, two RBI, two walks and two strikeouts.

- Through his first five major league starts this year (390 pitches), Festa has a 26.0 percent chase rate, a 28.5 percent whiff rate and a 42.6 percent hard-hit rate and an average exit velocity of 91.7 mph...batters are striking out 25.8 percent of the time and walking 9.3 percent of the time.
- ♣ His 37.8 percent whiff rate in his last outing on June 11 was the second-best of his career (38.9 percent on August 5, 2024)...his 94.5 mph average exit velocity marked the fourth time this season that his exit velocity averaged 90-or-more mph.
