



Los Angeles Dodgers (27-15) vs. San Francisco Giants (19-23) RHP Yoshinobu Yamamoto (4-1, 2.79) vs. RHP Jordan Hicks (3-1, 2.30)

ALL THE STARS: Fresh off their second consecutive series win, the Giants will kick off their first home series vs. the division-leading Dodgers tonight.

- ▶ SF is 5-8 in its last 13 games dating to April 30, yet is 4-2 in its last six contests.
- ▶ The Giants' .579 win % (11-8) at home is tied for 10th-best in MLB...they are 6-3 in their last nine home games since April 22, winning three consecutive home series vs. NYM (April 22-24), PIT (April 26-28) and CIN (May 10-12).
- ▶ This homestand will proceed with two more games against the Dodgers on Tuesday and Wednesday...it continues with an off day in San Francisco on Thursday and will end with a three-game series vs. Colorado over the weekend.

UNITED IN GRIEF: The Giants placed **OF Jung Hoo Lee** on the 10-day IL today with a left shoulder dislocation and recalled **C Jakson Reetz** (#50) from Triple-A Sacramento.

BAD BLOOD: The Dodgers make their first of two visits to Oracle Park starting with tonight's three-game series opener.

- ▶ It's been a tough go vs. LA at home since 2018 with the Giants going 17-29 in 46 games against the Dodgers here at Oracle Park...SF has a -101 run differential in that time.
- ▶ SF did not win a home series vs. LAD in 2024, going 2-4 overall...since August 1, 2022, SF is 2-11 vs. LAD.
- ▶ Four of SF's last seven meetings with LAD have been decided by one run...prior to that, only four of the previous 51 games in the matchup were settled by a single run (*Stats, LLC*).

WE CRY TOGETHER: In addition to Lee, **OF Michael Conforto** (right hamstring strain) was placed on the 10-day IL yesterday, making it seven Giants placed on the IL in the last 10 days.

- ▶ Others placed on the IL were **C Patrick Bailey** (May 4, concussion), **C Tom Murphy** (May 5, left knee sprain), **OF Jorge Soler** (May 8, right shoulder strain), **IF Nick Ahmed** (May 10, left wrist sprain) and **OF Austin Slater** (May 11, concussion).

MEET THE GIANTS: With the recent IL placements, SF has utilized its youth on the 40-man roster to fill the spots.

- ▶ **OF Luis Matos** (called up pregame yesterday) is the youngest of the crew, checking in at 22 years, 106 days.
- ▶ The others are **OF Heliot Ramos** (24 years, 249 days), **IF/OF Brett Wisely** (25 years, 5 days), **IF Casey Schmitt** (25 years, 73 days) and **C/OF Blake Sabol** (26 years, 127 days).
- ▶ According to *Baseball Reference*, SF's average batter's age (weighted by AB plus games played) is 29.8 years, third-oldest in MLB...only NYM (30.2) and LAD (30.5) are older.
- ▶ A total of 3,651 games of MLB experience have hit SF's IL between Ahmed, Conforto, Murphy, Slater and Soler.
- ▶ Matos, Ramos, Sabol, Schmitt & Wisely have combined to play in 379 career MLB games.

BIG SHOT: Yesterday's game-tying home run by **IF/OF LaMonte Wade Jr.** had a launch angle of 50 degrees, which is not only Wade's highest launch angle on a home run in his career, it tied for the highest launch angle on an over-the-wall home run in the *Statcast* era (2015) according to *Sarah Langs*.

- ▶ Wade has reached base in 13 consecutive games entering play today and has a .510 OBP with seven RBI in that span...he's also carrying a nine-game hitting streak into today's game where he's 11-for-28 (.393) with three runs, a double, a home run, six RBI and 10 walks over that span.
- ▶ His .480 on-base percentage and 20.3% walk rate are both tops in MLB (min. 110 PA), while his .340 average is tied for sixth-best.
- ▶ Wade's .533 (8-for-15) batting average with runners in scoring position is best in MLB (min. 20 plate appearances)...the next closest is KC's Salvador Pérez with a .486 average.

ALRIGHT: The Giants are slashing .227/.293/.343 over their last 17 games dating to April 24...they are averaging 3.18 runs/game in that span, scoring 54 runs.

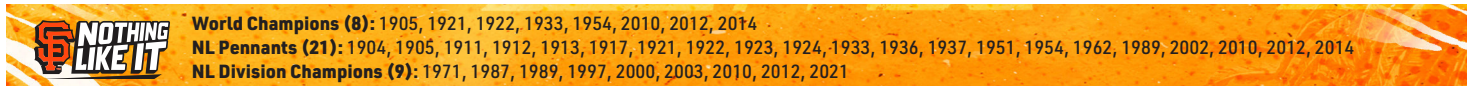
- ▶ SF's 3.18 runs/game in that time is third-worst in the Majors ahead of only the Reds (3.00 runs/game) and Pirates (2.82).
- ▶ In their last two games, however, the Giants have plated 11 combined runs (five and six, respectively), improving to a perfect 12-0 when scoring at least five runs in a game.

RICH SPIRIT: **RHP Jordan Hicks** has been dominant on the shores of McCovey Cove this season.

- ▶ His 1.50 ERA (4er, 24.0ip) at Oracle Park is the eighth-best home ERA in MLB, and fourth-best in the NL (min. 20ip).
- ▶ Hicks has just one earned run in each of his first four starts since joining SF, joining **RHP Ryan Vogelsong** (2011) as the only other Giant since 1913 to allow fewer than two earned runs and pitch at least 5.0 innings in each of the first four home starts of his Giants tenure (*Stats, LLC*).

BACKSEAT FREESTYLE: **LHP Blake Snell**, who has been on the 15-day IL since April 24 with a left adductor strain, made his first rehab start with Single-A San Jose yesterday, pitching 4.0 perfect innings while striking out seven of the first eight batters he faced on 46 pitches (34 strikes)...in the 1st inning, Snell threw an immaculate inning.

- ▶ Prior to injury, Snell made three starts for SF after signing near the end of Spring Training...he's given up 15 runs on 18 hits in 11.2 innings over those three starts.

Tom Murphy is currently in rehab mode only. Is expected to be out 4-6 weeks.
Robbie Ray continues to throw bullpens twice a week in Arizona and is mixing in all his pitches.
Austin Slater was placed on the 7-day IL on Saturday after suffering a concussion running into the CF wall on May 10.
Ethan Small is continuing his rehab in Arizona.
Blake Snell worked 4.0 innings (0h, 7k) yesterday for Single-A San Jose...threw 46 pitches in game and threw another 15 in the 'pen afterwards.
Jorge Soler was placed on the 10-day Injured List last Tuesday with a right shoulder strain. He started his hitting progression on Friday.
Austin Warren continues to throw bullpens twice a week in Arizona, mixing in all his pitches.

WELCOME TO SF: Hicks signed with San Francisco as a free agent on January 18, 2024 on a four-year deal worth \$44 million...he was originally drafted by the Cardinals in the supplemental third round (105th overall) of the 2015 First-Year Player Draft and spent his whole career with St. Louis before being traded to Toronto in July last season for RHP Sem Robberse and RHP Adam Kloffenstein.

PUSH TO START: Is transitioning from a relief role into a traditional starting role...has made 16 career starts entering today, eight of which have come this season...Hicks worked almost exclusively out of the rotation in the minor leagues, but the Cardinals ended up moving him to the bullpen to accelerate his path to the Majors.

THIRD TIME'S A CHARM: So far this season, he's done well when pitching longer into the game with opponents going 6-for-29 (.207) the third time through the lineup.

LAST OUTING: Logged his third win of the season, while allowing a season high seven hits in 5.0 innings with five strike outs...his three earned runs were the most he has allowed this season...he received eight runs of support from Giants' offense...his 4.88 average run support per game is the highest among SF's starting pitchers.

AMONG THE LEAGUE LEADERS: Has posted a 2.30 ERA over his first eight outings, which currently ranks as the fifth-best ERA in the National League.

VS. DODGERS: Is slated to make his ninth career appearance and second career start against the Dodgers...he's held Dodgers hitters to a .125 (4-for-32) average over his career with 17 strike outs...his only start against the Dodgers came on July 12, 2022...he allowed one hit, no runs and three walks in 1.2 innings pitched.

HOME IS WHERE THE HEAT IS: Opponents are hitting .188 against Hicks at Oracle Park this season...his 1.50 ERA ranks fourth in the National League and eighth in MLB among starting pitchers at home (min. 20.0ip).

LEFT, LEFT, LEFT, RIGHT, LEFT: Right-handed hitters have gone 18-for-91 (.198) versus Hicks thus far in 2024, which ranks seventh best in the National League (min. 90 AB)...however, right-handers are 14-for-42 (.333) over his last three games...lefties are just 3-for-26 (.115) in his last four starts.

GOTTA SPLIT: Opponents are hitting just .083 (3-for-36) with 16 strike outs off his splitter and .111 (3-for-27) off his sweeper, compared to a .279 (24-for-86) off his sinker...over his last two starts, Hicks hasn't allowed a hit on his splitter.

BANANA SLG: Opponents are slugging .277 vs. Hicks so far this season, which ranks sixth in the National League (min. 40 IP).

HIGH FIVE: Hicks has pitched 5.0+ innings in seven of his eight starts this season.

FEEL THE HEAT: Since entering the Majors in 2018, Hicks has consistently been one of the hardest throwing pitchers in the league... he has thrown 4,801 pitches in his Major League career, with 1,680 (35%) clocked at over 100 mph...so far this year he hasn't thrown a pitch above 100 with his fastest pitch logging in at 99.5 mph on March 30 at San Diego.

2023 SEASON: Made 65 relief appearances between the Cardinals (40 games) and Blue Jays (25 games), posting a combined 3.29 ERA (24er, 65.2ip) with 12 saves...his 81 strikeouts, 11.1 K/9.0ip, and 28.4 strikeout percentage were all career bests...threw 470 pitches at 100+ MPH (42.2% off his total pitches) and 24 pitches at 103+ MPH, both second in MLB to Jhoan Duran.

DIABETIC PHENOM: Was diagnosed with Type 1 diabetes at age 17 while in high school...he calls himself the "diabetic phenom", which was the Xbox identity he chose for himself... Diabetic phenom evolved into his brand and he now sells merchandise...he wears cleats that say "Type 1" on them when he pitches.

Last Game: 5/12 vs. CIN; 1.1ip, h, bb, 2k (23 pitches)

- ▶ Has worked in just four of SF's last 13 games.
- ▶ Is 2-0 with a 3.60 ERA and 6-for-6 in save chances in 15 games.
- ▶ Has struck out 19 batters over 15.0 innings of work (11.4 SO/9.0).
- ▶ 13 of his 19 strikeouts this year have come with his slider.
- ▶ Righties are 3-for-26 (.154) off him...lefties are 7-for-29 (.241).
- ▶ Has gone 6-for-6 in save chances this year and owns a 1.50 ERA (1er, 6.0ip) with four hits allowed, one walk and eight strikeouts.
- ▶ In eight non-save situations, he is 1-0 with a 5.00 ERA (5er, 9.0ip), seven hits allowed (two homers), 10 walks and 11 strikeouts.

- ▶ Over his last six games, Hjelle has a 2.08 ERA (2er, 8.2ip) with eight hits allowed, no walks allowed and 13 strikeouts.
