BIRD WATCHING: The St. Louis Cardinals continue a three-game homestand against the San Diego Padres with the middle game of the three-game series tonight at Busch Stadium televised nationally on TBS. The Cardinals won the first game of the series by a 3-0 shutout, their 4th shutout of the season. So far this season, the Cardinals have two shutouts against the Padres and two against the Mets.

FLIGHT PATTERN: St. Louis enters today in 2nd place in the NL Central, 4.5 games back of Milwaukee. The Cardinals reside atop the National League Wild Card standings with Philadelphia and San Diego occupying the final two slots. Since June 3, the Cardinals and Miami Marlins have the best record in baseball at 8-3 (.727).

CODE RED: Cardinals starting pitcher **Dustin May** threw a one-hit shutout last night against the Padres, his first complete game and shutout with eight strikeouts and a 7th inning single to **Manny Machado**. It marked the first one-hit shutout by a Cardinals pitcher since **Sonny Gray** at Cleveland last June 27, 2025, and at home since **Jaime Garcia** vs. Milwaukee on April 14, 2016. May has carried a no-hitter into the 7th inning twice this season (5/27 at MIL) and **Michael McGreevy** also threw six no-hit innings vs. Tampa Bay (3/28).

ONE-HIT WONDERS: The Cardinals one-hit shutout of the Padres last night marked the second instance this season, complimenting a one-hit shutout at Petco Park on May 8. This marked the first time in Cardinals history (since 1900) they held the same team scoreless with one hit or less at home and on the road. The Houston Astros did it earlier this season to the Texas Rangers with a one-hit shutout in Houston and a no-hitter in Arlington. -Elias Sports Bureau

WE'RE GOING STREAKING!: **Alec Burleson** is riding a career high 15-game hitting streak (20-62, .323/.373/.694) since May 30, 2nd-longest active behind **Zack Gelof** (19) of the Athletics. During the streak, he also had a four-game home run streak (6/9-12) and a nine-game run streak (6/5-14). The run streak was the longest in MLB this season.

START A NEW STREAK: Without a home run last night, the Cardinals' season-long nine game home run streak came to a halt. The Cardinals rank T-3rd among National League teams hitting 20 HR over 13 games in the month of June, trailing Milwaukee (23) and Colorado (22). By comparison, St. Louis hit 22 home runs over 26 games in the month of May.

THREE HITS IN THE FOUNTAIN: Tonight's starter **Andre Pallante** has held his opposition to three hits or less in back-to-back starts of 5.2 innings or more. The last Cardinals pitcher to hold his opposition to three hits or less in three straight starts of 5.2 innings or more was **Jack Flaherty** (9/19-29/2019). Flaherty (8/5-22/2018) also holds the franchise record along with **Woody Williams** (9/5-30/2001) with four straight such starts.

WHO'S YOUR PADRE: The Cardinals all-time .663 (175-89) home win pct. in St. Louis over the Padres (1969-present) is the 3rd-best by one home team vs. any visitor in MLB history (min. 100 games). -Elias SB

• Since Busch Stadium III opened in 2006, the Cardinals .682 home win pct. (45-21) vs. the Friars is their 2nd-best against any visitor behind only Colorado (.716, 48-19). **see chart right**

Fernando Tatis, father of Padres outfielder, **Fernando Tatis Jr.**, played three seasons with St. Louis (1998-2000)...is famously remembered for hitting two grand slams in one inning (April 23, 1999 at Los Angeles), both off of **Chan Ho Park**.

Cardinals TV broadcaster **Mark Sweeney** played parts of four seasons in San Diego (1997-98, 2002, 2005) and appeared in the 1998 World Series...was a part of the Padres broadcasting team for 12 seasons (2012-23)...resides in San Diego.

Ramón Urías's younger brother, **Luis Urías**, played parts of two seasons in San Diego (2018-19), where he made his MLB debut.

Brant Brown (June 15, 1996 at Wrigley), **Daniel Descalso** (Sept. 18, 2010 at Busch III), **Dustin May** (Aug. 8, 2019 at Dodger Std.), and **Brad Thompson** May 8, 2005 at Busch II) made MLB debuts vs. the Padres.

Cardinals President of Baseball Operations **Chaim Bloom** began his baseball career as a Baseball Operations Intern with the San Diego Padres.

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Mark McGwire** was the Padres bench coach for three seasons (2016-18).

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Jim Edmonds** played 26 games for San Diego in 2008...traded by St. Louis to San Diego for **David Freese** (Dec. 14, 2007).

Hall of Famer **Ozzie Smith** was selected by San Diego in the 4th round of the 1977 MLB Draft...played four seasons with San Diego (1978-81)...traded by San Diego with Al Olmsted and Steve Mura to St. Louis for Luis DeLeon, Sixto Lezcano and Garry Templeton (Dec. 10, 1981).

Padres Asst. Hitting Coach **Mike McCoy** was selected by St. Louis in the 34th round of the 2002 MLB Draft...played six minor league seasons in the Cardinals organization.

Padres Baseball Operations Advisor **Allen Craig** played parts of five seasons (2010-14) with St. Louis, where he was a 2013 NL All-Star and member of 2011 World Series Champion Cardinals.

Padres Coach **Nick Punto** played 63 games for St. Louis in 2011 and was a member of the 2011 World Series Champions.

Jon Jay played the 2016 season with San Diego...traded by St. Louis to the Padres for **Jedd Gyorko** and cash (Dec. 8, 2015).

Padres Coach **Peter Summerville**'s brother, **Andrew**, was drafted by St. Louis in the 12th round in 2017...pitched two minor league seasons in the Cardinals organization.

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Ray Lankford** played parts of two seasons for San Diego (2001-02)...traded by St. Louis with cash to the Padres for **Woody Williams** (Aug. 2, 2001).

Padres broadcaster **Carlos Hernandez** played 17 games for St. Louis in 2000...traded (July 31, 2000) to St. Louis with **Nate Tebbbs** from the Padres for **Heathcliff Slocumb** and current Memphis (AAA) manager **Ben Johnson**.

St. Louis Post-Dispatch reporter **Daniel Guerrero** graduated from San Diego State Univ. in 2020...interned for NBC San Diego in 2019...also served as backup MLB.com reporter on-site at Petco Park.

Padres Special Asst. **Brian Esposito** played parts of two seasons for Memphis (AAA) in 2006-07 and one game for St. Louis in 2007.

Cardenales broadcaster **Polo Ascencio** was born in nearby Tijuana, Mexico...considers Padres Eduardo Ortega as a broadcasting mentor.

N.L. RANKINGS: Wins (7, T-8th)

TONIGHT'S STARTER:

- Making his 14th start of the 2026 season tonight & it's his 1st meeting this season with the Padres - it's his 75th career start (183rd career appearance).
- **Is seeking his 8th win of the season which would match his single-season high from 2024** when he was 8-8; the Cardinals have won each of his last four games started while Andre has a 3-game win streak, one shy of his career-high 4-gamer in 2022.
- Held his opposition to three hits or less in back-to-back starts of 5.2 innings or more. The last Cardinals pitcher to hold his opposition to three hits or less in three straight starts of 5.2 innings or more was **Jack Flaherty** (9/19-29/2019). Flaherty (8/5-22/2018) also holds the franchise record along with **Woody Williams** (9/5-30/2001) with four straight starts.
- Owns a 8.73 Run Support Average on the road and 2.95 at home; He's received 3 runs or less in 6 of his 7 Home starts, yet 5 runs or more in 5 of his 6 Road starts.
- His 183rd career appearance tonight ranks T-68th all-time among Cardinals pitchers with **Lon Warneke** (183, 1937-42). He has joined **Adam Wainwright** (478 starts), **Carlos Martinez** (274), **Lance Lynn** (206), **Miles Mikolas** (204) and **Chris Carpenter** (198) since 2000 to reach both 183 career games pitched for St. Louis while also making 70 or more starts.
- **Leads all current Cardinals pitchers in career starts (74), wins (31), innings pitched (529.2) and strikeouts (377).**
- The Cardinals have won each of his last 5 road games (5-1 overall); He recently snapped a 4-game losing streak at Busch Stadium in his most recent start (6/3 vs. TEX) snapping a losing streak that dated back to his 1st Home win on 3/31 vs. NYM.
- Had his streak of 10 consecutive starts of 5.0+ IP to begin the season end on 5/29 vs. CHC when he exited after 3.0 IP (75 pitches). His 10 starts of 5.0 innings or more to begin a season were the most since **Sonny Gray** ran off 10 straight such starts to begin 2024.
- Andre alternated Home & Road starts in his first 11 starts to begin the season, but that trend ended on May 29-June 7 homestand when he made consecutive Home starts.
- Made the Cardinals Opening Day Roster for the 5th time (2022-26), tied with **Lars Nootbaar** for most among active Cardinals.

LAST TIME OUT (Wednesday, June 10 at NY Mets): W, 9-2; 6.0 IP, 3 H, 2 R, 2 ER, 2 BB, 5 SO, 1 HR, 93 pitches.

- Surpassed his 2025 season total (6) with his team-high 7th win of the season.
- Improved to 5-0 in his six road starts of 2026 and stretched his season win streak to 3-straight games.

2026 NOTES:

VICTORY LAPS: Posted his team-leading 7th win (5-0 on road) in a 9-2 win against the Mets last Wed. (6/10) at Citi Field as the Cardinals came away victorious in his 4th consecutive game started.

SIX & THIRTY: Snapped a 4-game losing skid in games pitched at Busch Stadium as he matched his season total from 2025 with his 6th win of the season on 6/3 vs. TEX; It also marked his 30th career win.

ROAD HOUSE: Posted the lone Cardinals win on CIN/MIL road trip, winning the opening game of DH on 5/23 at CIN.

3 TURNS: Pitched into the 7th inning vs. KC (5/17) with a season-high 6.2 innings and 27 batters faced in a 2-0 loss.

THE STATE OF WINNING: With a win in Sacramento (5/12), earned his first MLB in his home state (CA).

SLIDE ON IN: Is holding opposing batters to a .182 BA (16-88) with his slider, and 29 of his 56 strikeouts this season have come via the slider.

COUNT ON ME: Has worked at least 5.0 IP in 12 of his 13 starts this season, allowing 2 runs or fewer in seven of those games.

IF AT FIRST: Has had issues with 1st inning, allowing a .909 OPS, 13 runs and 4 HRs in 1st inning; batters are hitting .367 (11-30) when contacting the 1st pitch of an 0-0 at-bat.

BITTER BREW: Allowed four 1st inning runs, including 3-run HR, in 6-2 loss to MIL (5/6), losing his 3rd straight decision at Busch Stadium.

AHOY MATEY: Pitched a then season-best 6.0 innings while allowing one run in the Cardinals 5-4 win at PNC Park (4/29) in game three of a four-game series sweep of Pittsburgh.

TRI-DENT: Fanned 8 Mariners on 4/24 in 5.1 IP, but took the 3-2 loss after Josh Naylor's solo HR in the 6th snapped a 2-2 tie.

SPACE TRAVELER: Earned his 1st road win since 5/16/25 (at KC) in a 7-5 Space City win over the Astros on 4/18 in Houston.

MARCH MADNESS: Made his 2026 season debut vs. NYM (3/31) and gained a 3-0 win as he worked 5.0 scoreless IP, allowing just 3 hits.

CAREER:

- Has made the Cardinals Opening Day Roster for five consecutive seasons (2022-26) after arriving at 2022 Spring Training as a non-roster invitee, his first official invite to Major League Spring Training.
- Is 13-16 in his 37 career games started at Busch Stadium while the Cardinals have gone 18-19 in those games.
- **Since his 2022 MLB debut, boasts the highest ground ball pct. (62.3%) in Major League Baseball among pitchers with 400.0+ IP.** As a starting pitcher (398.0IP), Pallante's 58.9 career groundball pct. currently is the 10th-best in MLB since the stat has been tracked since 1987 (min. 395.0 IP as starter).

- Started vs. San Francisco (June 20, 2024) at Rickwood Field in Birmingham, Ala., tossing 5.1 innings in the 6-5 Cardinals win. Was the first Cardinals starting pitcher to earn a win at a neutral site since Alan Benes vs. San Diego on April 19, 1997 at Aloha Stadium in Honolulu, Hawaii.

PALLANTE vs. SAN DIEGO:

- The SoCal native (San Clemente) is making his 3rd career start (8th appearance) against the Padres.
- Is 2-1 with a 2.95 ERA in seven career appearances (18.1 IP) against SD, with both wins coming in relief at Busch Stadium.
- Has allowed just one HR (Jake Cronenworth on 8/3/25 at Petco Park) in his 18.1 career IP vs. the Padres
- Struck out five Friars in 3.1 IP of relief on 5/20/22 and was credited with the 6-3 win.
- Threw a career high 104 pitches against the Padres on 8/28/24 (5.2 IP) in 1st career start vs. San Diego.
