RAIN, RAIN, GO AWAY: The Orioles and Blue Jays were rained out yesterday...Marks Baltimore's first postponement of the year and fifth game impacted by weather...The game will be made up as part of a traditional (single-admission) doubleheader on Monday, July 29, at Oriole Park at Camden Yards...The first game will begin at 3:05 p.m. ET, followed by game two approximately 30 minutes after the first game concludes.

(b) In 2023, the Orioles had 18 games impacted by weather or other environmental

factors, with two postponements, 16 weather delays (one game had multiple delays), and one game delayed by bees

**BOUNCE BACK:** Baltimore has lost back-to-back games for the third time this season; after dropping two straight from April 6-7, they won three in a row, and after dropping two straight from April 12-13, they won four in a row...The O's, Cubs, and Phillies are the only teams in MLB this year without a losing streak of at least three games.

**WHAT'S TRENDING:** At 26-14 (.650), the Orioles have the second-best record in the AL and fifth-best in MLB...Since the start of 2022, Baltimore is 210-154 (.577), the second-best record in the AL and fourth-best in MLB behind the Astros (.582, 213-153), Braves (.636, 231-132), and Dodgers (.652, 240-128).

HOMER HAPPY: The Orioles lead MLB with 62 home runs, tied for the second-most homers

ough the first 40 games of a season in 0's history with 2012 and trailing 1987 (64)...The set through Baltimore's first 41 games of a season is 66 in 1987.

The Orioles have an MLB-best seven players with at least six homers: Gunnar Henderson (12), Adley Rutschman (8), Anthony Santander (7), and Colton Cowser, Ryan Mountcastle, Cedric Mullins, and Jordan Westburg (6); the Dodgers and Yankees rank second with four players with at least six long balls.

Henderson's 12 home runs are tied for second in MLB with Atlanta's Marcell Ozuna, Clayeland's least Navier and Least Angales N. Shebal Ottani, Irailing only Houston's

Cleveland's Josh Naylor, and Los Angeles-NL's Shohei Ohtani, trailing only Houston's Kyle Tucker (13).

BIG TIME RUTSCH: Adley Rutschman enters today ranked tied for fourth in the AL in hits (51) and sixth in batting average (.309)...He ranks fourth in the AL and tied for sixth in MLB in

BATTLE OF THE BIRDS: The 0's and Jays wrap up a two-game set in Charm City today (was originally a three-game series before yesterday's game was postponed due to inclement weather)...The Orioles will host the Jays for four games from July 29-31 and will travel to Toronto for a four-game set from June 3-6 and three games from August 6-8...The Orioles won the season series over the Blue Jays last year, 10-3...The 0's swept a three-game series at Rogers Centre from May 19-21, took two of three at Oriole Park from June 13-15, three of four at Rogers Centre from July 31 to August 3, and two of three at Oriole Park from August 22-24...Since the start of 2022, the 0's hold a 19-14 (.576) edge over the Blue Jays.

AL BEAST: The Orioles need a win today to extend their streak of consecutive series against ast opponents without a series loss...Entering the current series against the Blue Jays. AL East opponents without a series loss...Entering the current series against the Blue Jays, Baltimore had gone 16 straight sets against AL East opponents without a series loss, while going 12-0-4 in series during that time...That is the longest such streak in team history since divisions were introduced in 1969, per the *Elias Sports Bureau*...The Orioles are 36-18 overall against division opponents since the streak began on April 24, 2023...The 0's went 32-20 (.615) against the AL East last year, the second-best winning percentage against the division by the team since 1981 behind the .618 (47-29) mark in 2014...The Birds won the season series against the Blue Jays (10-3), Rays (8-5), Red Sox (7-6), and Yankees (7-6), the first time since 2014 that the Orioles won the season series against each of their division opponents.

SWEEPLESS IN BALTIMORE: The Orioles need a win today to extend their sweepless streak to 105 consecutive regular-season series of at least two decisions (no ties), which would tie the 1903-05 New York Giants for the third-longest such streak in MLB history...According to the Elias Sports Bureau, Baltimore's current streak of 104 series is the fourth-longest regular-season streak in MLB history, trailing the 1942-44 St. Louis Cardinals (124), 1906-09 Chicago Cubs (115), and 1903-05 New York Giants (105)...During this current stretch, the 0's have avoided being swept in the final game of a series 13 times: May 8, 2024 at Washington (2G), April 14, 2024 vs. Milwaukee (3G), August 10, 2023 vs. Houston (3G), July 19, 2023 vs. Los Angeles-NL (3G), July 2, 2023 vs. Minnesota (3G), June 18, 2023 at Chicago-NL (3G), June 8, 2023 at Milwaukee (3G), May 28, 2023 vs. Texas (3G), September 21, 2022 vs. Detroit (3G), September 18, 2022 at Toronto (3G), July 3, 2022 at Minnesota (3G), June 11, 2022 at Kansas City (3G), and May 19, 2022 vs. New York-AL (4G)...Baltimore's current streak is the longest in 0's history, ahead of 46 such series from 1971-72...The Birds have not been swept in a regular-season series of at least two games since August 27-29, 2021 vs. Tampa Bay (0-3)...The Orioles were swept by the Rangers in three games in the 2023 ALDS. <u>DOUBLE TROUBLE:</u> Gunnar Henderson and Colton Cowser were voted American League Player and Rookie of the Month, respectively, for March/April...It marks the first time in team history that the 0's claimed both awards in the same month.

ON THIS DATE: On this date in 1991, Queen Elizabeth II and Prince Philip, Duke of Edinburgh, as well as President George H.W. Bush and Mrs. Barbara Bush, attend the Orioles game at Memorial Stadium...The Orioles — who play in a city named after a British Lord — lose to Oakland, 6-3.

THE SKIPPER: Manager Brandon Hyde is in his sixth season in Baltimore...In 2023, he led the O's to an AL-best 101-61 record, their second straight winning campaign and the first time since 1997 that the Orioles claimed the top seed in the AL...He made his Postseason managerial debut in the ALDS, and was named the BBWAA AL Manager of the Year, becoming the fourth Orioles manager to win the award...He was also voted the Sporting News American League Manager of the Year by fellow AL managers for the second consecutive year...Hyde's 341 wins rank fifth all-time among Orioles managers, trailing Hank Bauer (407), Paul Richards (517), Buck Showalter (669), and Orioles Legend and National Baseball Hall of Famer Farl Weaver (1480)

QUICK HITS: Scheduled to make his third start of the season this afternoon against Toronto...Made his season debut last Thursday vs. New York-AL...Began the year on the 15-day Injured List (right UCL sprain)...Made three rehab starts, one with Double-A Bowie and two with Triple-A Norfolk, pitching to a 3.97 ERA (5 ER/11.1 IP) with 14 strikeouts and four walks...Earned the win in his final rehab appearance with the Tides on April 26 vs. Gwinnett; allowed one run on five hits and one walk with six strikeouts...Went 12-7 with a 2.83 ERA (53 ER/168.2 IP), 168 strikeouts, and a 1.04 WHIP in 30 starts (18 quality starts) for the 0's in 2023 and finished fourth for the AL Cy Young; became the first qualified 0's pitcher with a sub-3.00 ERA since Mike Mussina posted a 2.54 ERA (68 ER/241.0 IP) in 1992...Spent time on the Injured List with a right foot contusion from April 5-19 after being struck by a comebacker in the second inning of his season debut on April 3 at Texas...Acquired by the Orioles along with RHP Kyle Brnovich, RHP Zach Peek, and RHP Isaac Mattson from Los Angeles-AL in exchange for RHP Dylan Bundy on December 4, 2019...Originally drafted by the Angels in the fourth round of the 2018 First-Year Player Draft out of New Mexico State.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Did not factor into the decision in his last start on May 8 at Washington...Allowed one run on four hits, two walks, one hit batter, and one wild pitch with nine strikeouts in 5.0 innings...Struck out the side in his final inning of work...Threw 90 pitches. 56 strikes.

**AGAINST THE BLUE JAYS:** Owns a lifetime 1-3 record and a 5.25 ERA (21 ER/36.0 IP) across seven starts against the Blue Jays...Took the win in his last start against the division opponent on August 1, 2023 at Rogers Centre after allowing three runs on four hits (2 HR) and one walk with seven strikeouts in 7.0 innings.

**BEAST OF THE AL EAST:** Has gone 4-11 with a 5.70 ERA (77 ER/121.2 IP) across 25 career starts against the AL East; marks his highest ERA against any division... Opponents slashed .235/.289/.405(47-for-200) off him last season.

**HE'S A BRAD MAN:** Bradish led the 0's in nearly every pitching category last season, including ERA (2.83), strikeouts (168), opponent batting average (.215), on-base percentage (.275), OPS (.605), WHIP (1.04), and quality starts (18).

<u>COUNT 'EM UP:</u> Bradish finished the 2023 campaign with a career-high 168 strikeouts, the most by an O's hurler since Dylan Bundy fanned 184 batters in 2018.

**HIGH OUALITY:** Bradish logged five straight quality starts from August 6 to September 8, the longest such streak of his career...The last longer streak by an Oriole was Alex Cobb's six-gamer from July 26 to August 24, 2018...Bradish's 18 quality starts this year led the 0's and were a career high; the last 0's hurler with more than 18 such outings was Dylan Bundy, who logged 19 quality starts in 2017.

**2023 HIGHLIGHTS:** Appeared on his first career Opening Day roster...Finished fourth in the AL Cy Young voting, earning six, third-place, eight, fourth-place, and five, fifth-place votes; marked the highest finish by an Orioles hurler since Zack Britton finished fourth in 2016...Ended the campaign ranked among qualified MLB leaders in ERA and WHIP (4<sup>th</sup>), as well as opponent batting average (7<sup>th</sup>, .215), and among qualified AL leaders in opponent average (2<sup>nd</sup>), ERA (3<sup>rd</sup>), WHIP (4<sup>th</sup>), and winning percentage (T-8<sup>th</sup>, .632)...Had a 16.0-inning scoreless streak to end the regular season.

<u>POSTSEAON EXPERIENCE:</u> Made his Postseason debut as the starter in Game 1 of the ALDS vs. TEX; dealt the loss after allowing two runs on seven hits with one walk and nine strikeouts in 4.2 innings; became the third player in 0's history (since 1954) to strike out at least nine batters in his Postseason debut, joining Mike Boddicker (14, September 6, 1983 vs. CWS - ALCS G2) and Moe Drabowsky (11, September 5, 1966 at LAD - WS G1).
