MLB Record

Atlanta yesterday logged five hits off Brewers starter Jacob Misiorowski, all of which came on pitches that exceeded 100 mph.

The Braves became the first team in the pitch-tracking era (since 2008) to record at least five hits in a game on pitches 100 mph-or-faster.

Before last night, a team had logged at least four hits on 100 mph-plus pitches just twice. (Miami; 2022, '24)

TODAY'S GAME: The Atlanta Braves and Milwaukee Brewers today continue a three-game weekend series with the second of six scheduled games between the clubs this season...The Braves will travel to Milwaukee as part of a three-city road trip from August 17-23... Atlanta will play three games in Minnesota and one game on the south side of Chicago before departing for Milwaukee.

- A* Left fielder Eli White yesterday cut down the tying run at home plate in the ninth inning to safeguard a Braves victory, 3-2...Center fielder Mauricio Dubón gave Atlanta the lead with a bases-loaded single in the sixth.
- A* The Braves last night snapped a six-game home losing streak to the Brewers...Since July 30, 2023, Baltimore is the only team Atlanta hasn't beaten at home.
- A* LH Kyle Harrison is slated to take his second career turn against Atlanta, facing the Braves for the first time since August 13, 2024, when he took a no-decision as a San Francisco Giant...He tossed 5.0 innings and surrendered three runs in an extra-inning Braves win, 4-3...The left-handed native of San Jose, CA, is 8-1 with a 2.47 ERA (18 ER/65.2 IP) this season.

CHRIS SALE: Will make his sixth career start against Milwaukee with a 2-0 record and a 1.89 ERA (7 ER/33.1 IP) against the club...He has struck out double-digit Brewers in three of his previous five turns... The left-handed native of Lakeland, FL, has limited the Brewers to two earned runs-or-fewer every time.

- A* Sale enters play with an 8-5 record and a 2.30 ERA (20 ER/78.1 IP), currently the fifth-best mark among MLB qualifiers behind Jacob Misiorowski (MIL, 1.45), Cam Schlichter (NYY, 1.71), Cristopher Sánchez (PHI, 1.82) and Chase Burns (CIN, 2.01).
- A* The 6-foot-6, 180-pound left-hander has held opponents to a .215 batting average, the second-best mark by a qualified southpaw behind Los Angeles-AL's Reid Detmers (.199)
- A* Sale's 11.1 strikeouts per 9.0 innings (2,671 K/2,162.1 IP) are the most in modern MLB history (since 1901) among pitchers with at least 1,500.0 career innings.

DOWN, BUT NOT OUT: After trailing, 1-0, following the top of the sixth inning, Atlanta scored three straight runs to ultimately beat Milwaukee, 3-2... The Braves scored two of those runs off Brewers starter Jacob Misiorowski, the first time he allowed multiple runs in an outing since April 25.

- A* The Braves' 24 comeback victories and .649 comeback winning percentage (24-13) both rank second in MLB behind the Arizona Diamondbacks (26-14, .650).
- A* Atlanta is 24-26 when it trails a game at any point, the best winning percentage (.480) in MLB.

MAURICIO DUBÓN: Gave Atlanta the lead yesterday with a bases-loaded, two-out, two-RBI single in the sixth inning...His 23 two-out RBI are tied for second in the National League and for fifth in MLB.

- A* Of Dubón's 42 RBI this season, 54.8% of them have come with two outs and runners in scoring position, the highest percentage in MLB (min. 40 total RBI)...Throughout a full season, the last Brave to drive in more than half of his RBI in such situations was Kelly Johnson, who did so in 2007... That year, 34 of his 68 RBI occurred with two outs and RISP.
- A* Dubón is batting .750 (6-for-8) with the bases loaded this season, the second-best batting average in MLB in such circumstances (min. 8 PA)...His 13 bases-loaded RBI are tied for fourth in the NL and for sixth in MLB.

ELI WHITE: In last night's ninth inning, left fielder Eli White cut down the tying run at home plate for his 11th career outfield assist...White's throw was clocked at 95.3 mph, his fastest outfield assist as a professional.

- A* The last time the Braves threw out the tying run at home plate in the ninth inning-or-later was July 7, 2019 versus Miami...Left fielder Charlie Culberson caught Neil Walker's fly ball and threw out Jorge Alfaro at the dish to preserve an Atlanta win, 4-3.
- A* Two innings prior to his outfield assist, White made a sprinting catch in the left field corner to rob Christian Yelich of extra bases...According to Statcast, the ball had a catch probability of just five percent, tied for the most improbable out conversion of White's career (also September 16, 2025 at WSH).
- A* Atlanta has logged six outfield assists to home plate this season, second most in the National League and tied for fourth in MLB behind Houston (7), Los Angeles-NL (7) and Minnesota (7)...Ronald Acuña Jr. and White each have a pair, while Mike Yastrzemski and Mauricio Dubón each have one.

FACING LEFTIES: The Braves are set to face left-hander Kyle Harrison this afternoon...The team enters play 21-10 (.677) against opposing left-handed starters this season...Those are the most wins in such games in the majors this year.

- A* Dating even further to 2019, no team in MLB has been better against lefties...The Braves have gone 187-109 (.632) versus left-handers in that span...The Dodgers rank second at .620 (206-126).
- A* Since the start of May, Atlanta has faced 21 left-handed starting pitchers...The club has played to a 14-7 record (.667) in those games.
- A* The Braves have alternated wins and losses in their last 12 games against left-handed starters, going 6-6 against southpaws since May 22.
- A* Both the Braves and their opponent will field a left-handed starting pitcher for the 10th time this season...The team enters play 6-3 when both starters are left-handed.

Today's Game

Makes his 14th start of the season and the 326th of his career in the second game of a three-game series against Milwaukee...Atlanta won the series opener, 3-2.

Has not lost in five career starts against the Brewers, going 2-0 with a 1.89 ERA (7 ER/33.1 IP) and 45 strikeouts.

Last faced Milwaukee on June 9, 2025, allowing one run on five hits over 7.0 innings with 11 strikeouts in a 7-1 win.

Pitches for the first time since June 10, his first start in 10 days...Took the loss at Chicago (AL), allowing two runs on six hits over 5.2 innings with one walk and six strikeouts on 103 pitches in the 2-1 defeat at Rate Field.

Is 8-5 with a 2.30 ERA (20 ER/78.1 IP), 92 strikeouts and 20 walks across 13 starts this season, with nine quality starts.

Ranks fifth among qualified major league pitchers with a 2.30 ERA, trailing Milwaukee's Jacob Misiorowski (1.45), New York's (AL) Cam Schlichter (1.71), Philadelphia's Cristopher Sánchez (1.82) and Cincinnati's Chase Burns (2.01).

His eight wins are tied for the most among National League starters.

Has held opponents to a .215 average, the second-lowest mark among qualified major league left-handers, trailing only the Los Angeles Angels' Reid Detmers (.199)...His 1.05 WHIP ranks 14th among qualified major league pitchers.

His 36.2% chase rate is the third-highest among qualified major league pitchers, behind only Sánchez (38.4%) and the Chicago Cubs' Shota Imanaga (37.3%).

Owens a 2.43 ERA (103 ER/381.2 IP) since joining the Braves in 2024, the third-lowest among major league starters with at least 50 starts over that span, trailing only Pittsburgh's Paul Skenes (2.15) and Detroit's Tarik Skubal (2.39)...Has compiled 482 strikeouts in 63 appearances (62 starts) in an Atlanta uniform.

Owens a 4-3 record with a 3.16 ERA (15 ER/42.2 IP) over seven road starts in 2026, compared to 4-2 with a 1.26 ERA (5 ER/35.2 IP) over six home outings.

Won eight of his first 11 starts to open the season (8-3)...Has now done so twice as a Brave, also going 8-1 over his first 11 in 2024, and is the only pitcher to win at least eight of his first 11 games to begin a season multiple times in the Atlanta era (since 1966)...Warren Spahn did so three times for the franchise (1947, 1953 and 1958), all in its Boston and Milwaukee years.

His 11.12 strikeouts per 9.0 innings (2,671 SO/2,162.1 IP) are the most in MLB history (since 1901) among pitchers with at least 1,500.0 career innings.

Since 1968, three pitchers have maintained a sub-3.00 career ERA while making at least 300 starts: Pedro Martínez (2.93 ERA, 409 starts), Clayton Kershaw (2.54 ERA, 451 starts) and Sale (2.98 ERA, 325 starts).

His 406 career appearances are the third-most among active starting pitchers (min. 60% starts), trailing only Detroit's Justin Verlander (556) and Toronto's Max Scherzer (489)...His 325 career starts rank seventh among active pitchers.

2026

Was dealt the loss on June 10 at Chicago (AL), allowing two runs on six hits over 5.2 innings with one walk and six strikeouts on 103 pitches in the 2-1 defeat at Rate Field.

Took the loss June 4 against Toronto, allowing three runs on a season-high 10 hits over 5.2 innings with two walks and six strikeouts on 108 pitches in the 7-2 defeat at Truist Park...Atlanta took the series 2-1.

Recorded his seventh victory May 20 at loanDepot park, allowing one run on four hits over 7.0 innings with no walks and eight strikeouts on 96 pitches in the 9-1 win...Notched his first career win against Miami after entering 0-2 in three prior starts.

Reached 150 career wins April 26 against Philadelphia, becoming the 265th pitcher in MLB history to do so...Allowed one hit over 6.0 scoreless innings with nine strikeouts in the 6-2 victory...Passed Chuck Finley (2,610) for 28th on the all-time strikeout list and seventh among left-handers.

Passed Tom Glavine (2,607) for 29th on the all-time strikeout list April 18 at Philadelphia.

Reached 400 career strikeouts with Atlanta on April 6, the 13th pitcher in franchise history to reach the mark.

Won his seventh career Opening Day start March 27, holding Kansas City to three hits over 6.0 scoreless innings with six strikeouts in the 6-0 win...Became the first Atlanta starter to throw 6.0-or-more innings on Opening Day since Michael Soroka (July 24, 2020).

Career Recap

Awards: NL Cy Young (2024), Rawlings Gold Glove (2024), NL Comeback Player of the Year (2024), AL All-Star (7x, 2012-18), NL All-Star (2024-25), and World Series Champion (2018).

In his 16th major league season, Sale was selected to seven consecutive AL All-Star teams from 2012-2018, was selected to the NL All-Star team in 2024 & 2025, and has eight career Top 10 finishes in Cy Young voting, winning the award with Atlanta in 2024.

In his first year with Atlanta and 14th major league season, Sale was named the National League Cy Young Award winner, a Rawlings Gold Glove Award recipient, a National League All-Star, a First-Team All-MLB Nomination and the National League Comeback Player of the Year, going 18-3 with a 2.38 ERA (47 ER/177.2 IP) and 225 strikeouts.

Led the National League in wins, strikeouts and ERA...Became the first pitcher in Braves franchise history to win the triple crown and first in the National League since Clayton Kershaw with Los Angeles in 2011.
