**THIS DATE IN ASTROS HISTORY
APRIL 17**
2002 - **Lance Berkman** goes deep off the Reds **RHP Jimmy Haynes** in an Astros 7-2 win over the homestanding Reds...the day prior, Berkman hit three homers, giving him four over a two-game span, which ties as the most in club history.

TONIGHT'S GAME: The homestanding Astros will open a three-game series with their former division rivals, the St. Louis Cardinals, tonight at Daikin Park...**RHP Peter Lambert**, selected from Triple A today, will make his first regular season appearance for the Astros tonight opposite the Cardinals and starter **RHP Kyle Leahy**.

TONIGHT'S STARTER: **RHP Peter Lambert** joined the Astros via free agency this offseason after pitching last year for the Tokyo Yakult Swallows in the NPB, posting a 3.98 ERA (55ER/124.1IP) with 111 strikeouts in 23 appearances in Japan...this season, Lambert made his case by getting off to a strong start at Triple A Sugar Land, where he posted a 1.84 ERA (3ER/14.2IP) in three games (two starts), while also impressing at Major League Spring Training as a non-roster invite (1-1, 2.92 ERA, 4ER/12.1IP)...a former Rockie, Lambert has 74 career MLB appearances, including 35 starts.

FAITH & FAMILY NIGHT: Tonight is Faith and Family Night at the ballpark...after the final out, fans are encouraged to stay for special postgame testimonials featuring **Spencer Arrighetti**, **Carlos Correa** and **Shay Whitcomb**...Friday Night Fireworks presented by ConocoPhillips, will also be part of Faith and Family Night, as they will feature the musical theme Faith and Family.

TONIGHT'S SPECIAL GUESTS: **SS Jeremy Peña** will host students from Raul C. Martinez Elementary School tonight for **Peña's Pals**...in its fourth year, Pena's Pals was developed by Jeremy in partnership with the Astros Foundation...the program celebrates kids and their development in academics, character building and making healthy choices.

THIS WEEKEND'S GIVEAWAYS: Tonight, 10,000 fans will receive a **Carlos Correa City Connect Jersey**, presented by Houston Methodist...tomorrow, 10,000 fans will receive an **Astros Ice Cream Bucket Hat**, presented by Texas Bay Credit Union.

HOME-COOKIN': Tonight is the fourth game of a six-game homestand for the Astros, in which they'll host a pair of NL opponents in the Rockies (2-1) and Cardinals...the Astros have been great at home in 2026, going 7-3, including a seven-game winning streak, which was snapped last night.

VS. THE CARDS: This series is a matchup of former division rivals, who spent 19 seasons together in the NL Central from 1994-2012...overall, the two teams have played each other 722 times, with the Astros going 336-384...these teams also have postseason history, with the Astros going 7-6 vs. the Cards in the playoffs...the two clubs faced off in back-to-back NLCS in 2004-05 with St. Louis taking the '04 NLCS in seven games and Houston winning the '05 NLCS in six games.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Astros scored two in the 1st inning last night but were unable to score again in their 3-2 loss to the Rockies...**RHP Ryan Weiss** (2ER/3.2IP) made his first Major League start last night and kept the Astros in the contest before running into a pitch count in the 4th (76 pitches)...**2B Jose Altuve** went 2x4 with a double and scored one of the Astros two runs in the 1st.

TODAY'S ROSTER MOVES: The Astros have selected **RHP Peter Lambert** (#38) to the Major League roster today...he takes the roster spot of **RHP Christian Roa**, who was optioned to Triple A Sugar Land after last night's game...in a corresponding move, the Astros transferred **LHP Josh Hader** to the 60-day IL.

HOT START: **LF Jordan Alvarez** ranks first in the AL in extra-base hits (13), total bases (49), OPS (1.214), SLG (.731) and OBP (.483), ranks tied for first in walks (18), tied for second in RBI (18), tied for third in doubles (6) and in runs scored (16), and fourth in batting average (.328).

MR. 2000: **2B Jose Altuve** has appeared in 1,995 career games and is looking to become the third player in franchise history to reach 2,000 career games, which would join him with **Craig Biggio** (2,850) and **Jeff Bagwell** (2,150)...only four active players have reached 2,000 career games: **Andrew McCutchen** (2,275), **Carlos Santana** (2,212), **Fredie Freeman** (2,197) and **Paul Goldschmidt** (2,081).

EXTRA! EXTRA!: **2B Jose Altuve** recorded his 750th career extra-base hit last night with his 461st career double...he also has 32 triples and 257 home runs, all coming as an Astro...only **Craig Biggio** (1,014) and **Jeff Bagwell** (969) have more extra-base hits than Altuve in franchise history.

AGENT SMITH: According to Baseball Savant, **RF Cam Smith** has played like one of the best all-around Major League players in 2026, ranking in the 98th percentile in fielding range (OAA), 98th percentile in bat speed, 96th percentile in sprint speed and 94th percentile in barrel percentage...on the season, Smith is hitting .271 (19x70) with three homers, 10 RBI and an .821 OPS in 20 games.

GETTING ON : **IF Isaac Paredes** has an active on-base streak of 13 games, which ties as the longest active streak in the AL...during the run, which dates back to March 28, Paredes has posted a .375 OBP.

HARD TO HIT: **RHP Kai-Wei Teng**, just the second Taiwanese-born player to appear with the Astros in their history, has held opponents to 6x41 on the season for a .146 opponent average...overall, Teng has gone 1-0 with a 2.31 ERA (3ER/11.2IP), a 0.86 WHIP and 11 strikeouts in 11.2 innings in relief.

ON THE MEND: **OF Zach Dezenzo** (right elbow sprain) will begin a rehab assignment with Double A Corpus Christi tonight...additionally, **LHP Bennett Sousa** (left oblique strain) is scheduled to make another rehab appearance at Corpus Christi tonight.

LAST START - 4/10 vs. TAC (AAA): Recorded a quality start in his last start for Triple A Sugar Land...in his outing, he allowed 1 run on 4 hits and 1 walk with eight strikeouts in 6.0 innings...didn't factor into the decision but the Space Cowboys went on to beat the Rainers, 5-2.

ROSTER MOVE: Was selected to Major League roster today...took the place of RHP Christian Roa on the active roster, who was optioned to Triple A Sugar Land following last night's game.

WITH THE SPACE COWBOYS: Made 3 appearances, including 2 starts for Triple A Sugar Land to begin the 2026 season...in those 3 appearances, he recorded a 1.84 ERA (3ER/14.2IP) with 12 strikeouts, a 0.95 WHIP and a .208 opponent batting average.

2025 SEASON: Spent the 2025 season with the Tokyo Yakult Swallows in the Nippon Professional Baseball League...made 23 appearances for the Swallows, recording a 3.98 ERA (55ER/124.1IP) with 111 strikeouts, 54 walks and a 1.44 WHIP.

AGAINST THE CARDS: Has faced the Cardinals once in his career, on Aug. 23, 2019 at Busch Stadium...in his start, he allowed 4 runs (2ER) on 6 hits and 4 walks in 4.1 innings.

GRAPEFRUIT LEAGUE: Made 5 appearances, including two starts with the Astros in Major League Spring Training...recorded a 2.92 ERA (4ER/12.1IP) with 8 strikeouts.

ABOUT LAMBERT: Right-handed pitcher joined the Astros on a minor league deal this offseason...has appeared at the Major League level in four seasons with the Colorado Rockies (2019, 2021, 2023-24)...in 74 career Major League appearances, including 35 starts, he's recorded a 6.28 ERA (170ER/243.2IP) with 181 strikeouts...was selected by the Rockies in the 2nd round of the 2015 MLB Draft out of San Dimas High School, was committed play baseball at UCLA before signing with the Rockies...was signed by Rockies scout Jon Lukens...as a senior at San Dimas HS in 2015, he went 13-0 with a 0.34 ERA...was also named the Los Angeles Times Baseball Player of the Year.

FAMILY TIES: Has an older brother, Jimmy Lambert, who pitched in parts of four seasons (2020-23) in the Majors with the Chicago White Sox...in 83 career appearances, he recorded a 4.33 ERA (48ER/99.2IP) with 98 strikeouts.
