TODAY'S GAME: The Giants can win the series and the road trip with a win this afternoon after taking yesterday's game 9-5... through the first six games of this seven-game trip, the Giants have gone 1-0 in Atlanta, 1-2 in Pittsburgh and 1-1 here in NYC.

- ▶ The Giants are trying to win their first road series of at least 2+ games since taking what turned out to be an abbreviated two-game series in Atlanta June 16-17 (Game 3 was rained out).
- ▶ If the Giants can win today it would mark their first winning multi-city road trip of the entire season...SF's only trip with a winning record was its 2-1 trip from March 30-April 1 when they visited San Diego for a three-game series.
- ▶ Lastly, SF needs to win four of its final 19 games to avoid the second 100-loss season in franchise history (the club went 62-100 in 1985).

TODAY'S STARTER: LHP Cesar Perdomo will make his first Major League start and his second overall MLB appearance this afternoon...the lefty was called up from Triple-A Sacramento on Tuesday in Pittsburgh when rosters expanded.

- ▶ Perdomo made his Major League debut later that night, keeping SF in the game with 4.0 innings of one-run ball in relief...it allowed SF to later come back and tie the game at 12 before losing on a walk-off error in the 9th inning.
- ▶ Prior to his promotion, Perdomo was 6-0 with a 3.89 ERA (16er, 37.0ip), 24 strikeouts and a 1.38 WHIP over his final six starts (since July 30) with the River Cats.

THAT RAFAEL DEVERS, SO HOT RIGHT NOW: IF Rafael Devers logged 24th career multi-homer game and third this season in yesterday's win...Devers is 21-for-50 (.420) over his last 13 games with a .517 OBP, .1020 SLG and a 1.537 OPS...he has nine homers, three doubles, 21 RBI, 16 runs scored and nine walks in this 13-game span.

- ▶ The last Giant with nine homers in a 13-game span prior to Devers was **Barry Bonds** in April 2004.
- ▶ Since May 1, Devers ranks among the MLB leaders in doubles (30, T-1st), extra-base hits (64, 2nd), homers (33, 2nd), RBI (80, 3rd), SLG (.586, 3rd) and OPS (.949, 3rd).
- ▶ Devers has 19 more games to try and hit five more homers to reach 40, something no Giant has done since Bonds hit 45 in 2004...the Giants own the second-longest active drought since the club's last 40-homer season behind only the Pirates, who last had a 40-homer season from Willie Stargell in 1973.
- ▶ He's also trying to chase down the 100-RBI mark, something no Giant has done since **Buster Posey** drove in 103 runs in 2012...the last Giants infielder to do it was **Jeff Kent** in 2002 (108 RBI).
- ▶ As it stands now, Devers' 91 RBI entering today are the most in 11 seasons since Posey drove in 95 in 2015.
- ▶ Lastly, Devers logged his 29th go-ahead RBI of the year yesterday with his 1st inning homer...his 29 go-ahead RBI are most by a Giant since Posey in 2012 (31).

UPS AND DOWNS: Since the start of SF's last homestand on August 24, the Giants are averaging 6.00 runs per game, second-best in MLB in that time behind only the Cubs (6.75)...the club's .810 OPS in this stretch is third-best in MLB (Cubs - .875, A's - .824).

- ▶ Scoring five typically has been a recipe for success for SF in 2026 as they are 42-12 in such games.
- ▶ The Giants, however, are 7-6 in this 13-game stretch because they are permitting an average of 5.46 runs/game, fifth-highest in the Majors.

AIN'T NO REST FOR THE WICKED: Following today's game the Giants fly back to the West Coast to open a series with the St. Louis Cardinals tomorrow evening at Oracle Park.

- ▶ These two teams have yet to meet in 2026 and the entire season series will take place over the span of two weeks as SF travels to St. Louis the following Monday-Wednesday.
- ▶ The Giants have lost the season series to St. Louis in nine of the last 10 seasons they've played (excl. 2020) dating to 2015...SF's only season series win came in 2023 (6-1).

WHAT'S UP, ROOK?: The 24-year-old from San Juan de los Morros, VZ is in his debut MLB season...this is Perdomo's third level this season (also Double-A and Triple-A).

WELCOME TO THE SHOW: Made his MLB debut his last time out on September 1 at Pittsburgh, becoming the 15th Giants player to make their MLB debut this season...he became just the seventh Giants left-handed pitcher since 1899 to throw at least 4.0 innings of relief in their MLB debut as shown in the chart below.

LAST TIME OUT: Made his MLB debut on September 1 at Pittsburgh...struck out four while allowing one run on three hits (one homer) and one walk across 4.0 innings of relief...Pirates batters were 1-for-6 in at-bats ending with Perdomo's slider, 2-for-6 vs. his four-seamer and 0-for-2 vs. his changeup.

WITH THE KITTIES: Was 7-2 with a 5.10 ERA (27er, 47.2ip) in nine games for Triple-A Sacramento prior to is promotion...he was in excellent form prior to his call-up...after starting 1-2 in his first three Triple-A starts, Perdomo went 6-0 with a 3.89 ERA (16er, 37.0ip), 24 strikeouts and a 1.38 WHIP over his final six Triple-A starts since July 30.

WITH THE SQUIRRELS: Went 2-4 with a 3.98 ERA (32er, 72.1ip), 89 strikeouts and a 1.11 WHIP in 13 starts for Double-A Richmond prior to his promotion...at the time of his promotion to Double-A, Perdomo's 89 strikeouts were ninth-most in all of Double-A.

SPLITS: Was burned by left-handed hitters in Triple-A, with them holding a .348/.434/.576 slash line compared to a .264/.319/.424 slash line against right-handed hitters...in his lone MLB outing vs. Pittsburgh, righties were 0-for-7 while lefties were 3-for-7 with two extra-base hits (one homer).

LAST SEASON: Spent the entire 2025 season with High-A Eugene...led the NWL in innings pitched (127.1)...he ranked inside the league's top-5 in games started (26, T-1st), WHIP (1.24, 2nd), wins (8, T-3rd), ERA (3.96, 4th) and strikeouts (118, 4th).

AWARD SZN: Perdomo was named an Northwest League Pitcher of the Week for the week of September 8, 2024 while pitching for High-A Eugene, and was a California League Post-Season All-Star in 2024 with Single-A San Jose.
