The Astros clubhouse will be open to approved media at Daikin Park from 10:50-11:40 a.m. CT...Astros General Manager **Dana Brown** will be made available in the Astros press conference room at approx. 11:40 a.m...he'll be followed in the press conference room by Manager **Joe Espada** at approx. 11:50 a.m. CT...the Astros position players will stretch at 11:50 a.m. and will take batting practice at 12:15 p.m.

**THIS DATE IN ASTROS HISTORY**  
**MARCH 26**  
**2026** - The Astros will open the 2026 season today in what is the earliest date the Astros have ever opened a regular season...prior to this year, the earliest date of an Astros regular season game was on March 27, which occurred last season.

**OPENING DAY!:** The Astros will open the 2026 season today in an Opening Day afternoon tilt against the Angels...this year marks the 65th season of Astros baseball and the 27th at Daikin Park.

**ON OPENING DAY:** The Astros are 34-30 all-time on Opening Day, including a 25-20 record in home games on Opening Day...the Astros are recently removed from an incredible, modern-day record, Opening Day streak of 10 consecutive wins from 2013-22...following the streak, they lost on Opening Day in 2023 and 2024 before bouncing back for a 3-1 win over the Mets on Opening Day last season.

**VS. THE ANGELS:** The Astros will open the season with a divisional series against the Angels, who the Astros went 8-5 against in 13 games last season...this marks the second time the Astros have played the Angels on Opening Day, which also happened in 2022, resulting in a 3-1 Astros win.

**TODAY'S PITCHING MATCHUP:** Today's Opening Day matchup of **RHP Hunter Brown vs. RHP José Soriano** features a pair of starters both making their first career Opening Day starts...Brown is coming off an All-Star season, in which he finished third in the AL Cy Young voting after going 12-9 with a 2.43 ERA (50ER/185.1IP) in a career high 31 starts.

**ON THE HUNT:** **RHP Hunter Brown**, a 2025 All-Star, finished third in the AL in Cy Young voting last season after turning in the best year of his career with a 12-9 record, a 2.43 ERA (50ER/185.1IP) and posting a 1.03 WHIP...he held opponents to a career-low .201 average and posted 206 strikeouts in 185.1 innings pitched...his 2.43 ERA ranked 10th all-time among Astros starters and was the second-lowest by an Astros starter in the last 20 seasons (since 2005).

**SUSTAINED SUCCESS:** Dating back to the 2015 season, the Astros have made nine postseason appearances in 11 seasons, winning seven division titles, four AL pennants (2017, 2019, 2021, 2022) and two WS titles (2017, 2022)...in that span, the Astros became the only team in history to advance to seven consecutive ALCS (2017-23) and have posted the second-most wins in the Majors (976), trailing only the Dodgers (1,036).

**AT THE HELM:** Manager **Joe Espada** is entering his third season as the Astros skipper...in 2025, for the second consecutive season, Espada and his staff were forced to deal with an extremely high number of injuries...despite an ever-changing roster that often was missing key players, to his credit, Espada managed to navigate his club to an 87-75 record, finishing in a tie for the final AL Wild Card berth (lost tiebreaker to DET).

**IN THE BOX:** Today is the fourth Opening Day for the Astros under GM **Dana Brown**, who was named the club's GM in January of 2023...it's the 15th Opening Day for Owner & Chairman **Jim Crane** since he purchased the club in November of 2011.

**MURAL WALL:** The Astros will reveal a new mural, presented by Apache, located in center field along Hall of Fame Alley at 11 a.m. today...EVP, Communications and Marketing **Anita Sehgal** and the mural artists will be available for comment at the reveal.

**TODAY'S FESTIVITIES:** Today is Opening Day, presented by Adobe, at Daikin Park...the day starts with Opening Day Street Fest, presented by Budweiser, which will take place from 12-3 p.m...the ceremonial first pitch will be a celebration of the WBC, which was won by Team Venezuela, who were managed by Astros bench coach **Omar López**...López will throw out the first pitch to **Javier Bracamonte**, the Astros longtime bullpen catcher who also served that same role for Team Venezuela...lastly, all fans in attendance will receive a 2026 Astros Schedule Magnet, courtesy of United.

**YESTERDAY'S ROSTER MOVES:** The Astros finalized their Opening Day roster yesterday by making several transactions:

- **RHP Christian Roa** and **C Christian Vázquez** were added to the 40-man roster.
- **OF Zach Dezeno** (right elbow sprain) was placed on the 10-day IL.
- **RHP Ronel Blanco** (recovery from right elbow surgery), **RHP Enyel De Los Santos** (right knee strain), **LHP Josh Hader** (left biceps tendinitis), **RHP Nate Pearson** (recovery from right elbow surgery), **LHP Bennett Sousa** (left oblique strain) and **RHP Hayden Wesneski** (recovery from right elbow surgery) were placed on the 15-day IL.
- **LHP Brandon Walter** (recovery from left elbow surgery) was placed on the 60-day IL.
- **C César Salazar** was designated for assignment.
- **OF Zach Cole** was optioned to Triple A Sugar Land.

**ABOUT THE ROSTER:** The Astros Opening Day roster includes 13 pitchers and 13 position players...nine players are making their first appearance on an active Opening Day roster: **RHP Mike Burrows**, **RHP AJ Blubaugh**, **RHP Tatsuya Imai**, **OF Joey Loperfido**, **IF/OF Brice Matthews**, **RHP Roddery Muñoz**, **RHP Christian Roa**, **RHP Kai-Wei Teng** and **RHP Ryan Weiss**.

**NEW FACES:** The Astros focused their offseason efforts on acquiring pitching, landing **RHP Mike Burrows** and **RHP Kai-Wei Teng** in trades and **RHP Tatsuya Imai** and **RHP Ryan Weiss** off the free agent market...they also added a Rule 5 pick in **RHP Roddery Muñoz**, the Astros first Rule 5 selection since the 2017 Rule 5 Draft.

**OPENING DAY CORNERSTONE:** **2B Jose Altuve**, who's under contract for the next four seasons (2026-29), will be making his 14th career Opening Day start today, which marks the third-most in franchise history...only **2B Craig Biggio** (19, 1989-2007) and **1B Jeff Bagwell** (15, 1991-2005) have more in Astros history.

**EXHIBITION SEASON OVER:** The Astros went 11-14-3 (.440) in Grapefruit League play, which does not include their three exhibition game victories, in which stats do not count...Astros starting pitchers were great all Spring, as their Opening Day rotation of **RHP Hunter Brown**, **RHP Mike Burrows**, **RHP Cristian Javier**, **RHP Tatsuya Imai** and **RHP Lance McCullers Jr.** combined for a 1.95 ERA (12ER/55.1IP) in official games...**OF Joey Loperfido** (.317, 13x41, 6 RBI) and **IF/OF Brice Matthews** (.250, 9x36, 10 RBI, 8 SB) had the best camps offensively with Loperfido leading the team in hits and Matthews leading the club in RBI and stolen bases.

**THE DIESEL:** a 2025 All-Star, Brown finished third in the AL in Cy Young voting last season after turning in the best year of his career with a 12-9 record, a 2.43 ERA (50ER/185.1IP) and posting a 1.03 WHIP...the hard-throwing right-hander has pitched in parts of 4 big league seasons (2022-25), spending most of the last 3 in the Astros rotation, while going 36-31 with a 3.49 ERA (206ER/531.1IP) in 100 games (92 starts).

**LAST START - 3/20 vs. MIA:** made his final outing of the Spring Training season on March 20 against the Marlins at the Astros Spring Training complex in West Palm Beach, FL...worked 4.0 innings, allowing 4 runs on 3 hits and 3 walks...struck out 6 in the appearances, while tossing a Spring-high 83 pitches.

**HISTORIC SEASON:** In 2026, Brown held opponents to a career-low .201 average and posted 206 strikeouts in 185.1 innings pitched...his 2.43 ERA ranked 10th all-time among Astros starters and was the second-lowest by an Astros starter in the last 20 seasons (since 2005)... among AL starters, he ranked first in opponent SLG (.318) and second in ERA (2.43)...lastly, by reaching 206 strikeouts, he became the 18th pitcher in club history to reach 200 strikeouts in a season.

**WHAT CAN BROWN DO FOR YOU:** By finishing third in the AL Cy Young voting in 2025, the Astros were granted a compensation pick immediately after the first round of the 2026 draft...the Astros earned the pick through the Prospect Promotion Incentive (PPI), which was ratified into the latest CBA...the PPI rewards teams for promoting their best prospects to the big leagues at the start of the season, having them accrue one full year of service time and then having them factor into a major award that season or prior to qualifying for arbitration.

**MIXING IT UP:** Has changed his repertoire over the course of his career, which resulted in a huge turnaround over the last 2 seasons...many coaches and teammates have worked with Brown, none more so than former teammate Alex Bregman, who suggested Brown incorporate a running sinker into his arsenal to keep right-handed hitters from leaning out over the plate... while the sinker does not grade out analytically as well as his other offerings, it compliments his offerings perfectly...prior to the change, Brown owned a 5.10 ERA in 41 games, since the change Brown has posted a 2.64 ERA in 59 games.

**FOLLOWING HIS FOOTSTEPS:** Born and raised in Detroit, Brown went to grade school, high school and college in his hometown...he grew up a Tigers fan and a fan of Justin Verlander, who he modeled his pitching delivery after...Brown met Verlander as a fifth-grader at St. Isaac Jogues Catholic School in Saint Clair Shores, MI, a suburb of Detroit...Verlander, fellow Tiger Carlos Guillén and others visited the school as part of a radio promotion, won by one of Brown's classmates...the two later were teammates for three years (2022-24) and became close friends...now Brown is the Astros Opening Day starter, a position Verlander held for three seasons (2018-20).

**SPRING TRAINING:** made 4 official Spring Training starts, working to a 2.84 ERA (4ER/12.2IP)...struck out 20 in his 12.2 innings, while allowing just 6 hits and 7 walks for a 1.03 WHIP...also pitched an intrasquad sim game, which did not factor into his Spring Training stats... turned heads on March 8 at WSH, fanning 9 hitters in 4.0 innings of hitless ball against the Nationals.

**VS. THE ANGELS:** has made five career starts against the Angels, posting a 1-2 record and a 2.63 ERA (8ER/27.1IP)...has gone 3 straight starts against the Angels in which he's allowed 1-or-fewer runs...has posted a .184 opponent average against the Angels, his lowest against any divisional opponent...twice faced the Angels in 2025, posting a 1.64 ERA (2ER/11IP) in those outings.

**OPENING DAY:** is on his 6<sup>th</sup> consecutive Opening Day roster (2021-26)...has two Opening Day appearance, the latest coming from the 2025 season on March 27 vs. NYM (0ER/1IP)...also tossed a scoreless 1.0 inning on March 20, 2023 vs. CWS.

**2025 SEASON:** was a workhorse out of the Astros 'pen in 2025, going 3-4-7 with a 2.28 ERA (18ER/71IP), .196 opponent batting average (51x260), 1.15 WHIP and 13.31 SO/9IP in a team-leading 70 appearances...led AL relievers with 105 strikeouts and moved into closer role over final two months of the regular season following an injury to LHP Josh Hader.

**SPRING TRAINING:** finished Spring Training with a 3.86 ERA (3ER/7.0IP), 7 walks and 5 strikeouts with a .200 opponent batting average.

**CAREER:** Has appeared in the Majors with Houston in each of the last seven seasons (2019-25)...owns a 16-12 record with 16 saves, a 2.65 ERA (97ER/329.2IP) and 448 strikeouts in 329.2 Major League innings...is creeping up the all-time lists among Astros relievers...among relievers in club history, ranks fourth in strikeouts (448), seventh in appearances (317) and 12th in innings (329.2).

**OPENING DAY:** made his 1<sup>st</sup> career Opening Day roster with Houston this season.

**2025 SEASON:** went 3-1 with a 1.69 ERA (6ER/32IP), a 0.88 WHIP, .152 opponent average and 9.84 SO/9IP through 11 Major League appearances (three starts)...his 1.69 ERA (6ER/32IP) is the lowest through a player's first 11 career appearances in Astros history (min. 30 IP)...made 22 total appearances (19 starts) with Triple A Sugar Land this season, going 5-8 with a 5.27 ERA (58ER/99IP).

**SPRING TRAINING:** had a powerful Spring Training, owning a 1-0 record with a 0.84 ERA (1ER/10.2IP) in 6 appearances...walked 3 and struck out 8 with a 0.94 WHIP and a .189 (7x37) opponent batting average.

**SHUT 'EM DOWN:** recorded a 21.0-inning scoreless streak from Aug. 23 through the end of the 2025 season...was the second-longest scoreless streak by an Astros pitcher this season...was also the longest active scoreless streak in the AL at the end of the season...was also the longest scoreless innings streak by an Astros rookie since RHP Alberto Arias tossed 21.1 consecutive scoreless innings from May 27-July 18, 2009...was the second-longest scoreless innings streak among MLB rookies, trailing only A's LHP Jacob Lopez (25.0 innings).

**OPENING DAY:** made his 2<sup>nd</sup> consecutive Opening Day roster (2025-26)...did not appear in last year's Opening Day vs. the Mets.
