SNAKEBITES

**RACE AGAINST CANCER 5K REGISTRATION NOW OPEN:** The D-backs’ 12th annual Race Against Cancer 5K presented by Dignity Health Cancer Institute and benefitting cancer research and patient care is on Sunday, September 28 at Chase Field...register at [dbacks.com/race](https://dbacks.com/race).

**SNAKE BITES:** Since August 1, the D-backs’ 21-16 (.568) record is the fifth-best record in the Majors, behind the Brewers (25-13, .658), Phillies (24-13, .649), Red Sox (22-14, .611) and Yankees (20-15, .571).

- On August 1, the D-backs were a season-high 13.0 games back in the division and 10.0 games back in the NL Wild Card...now the D-backs are 8.5 back in the division and 4.5 back in the NL Wild Card.
- The D-backs have won 8 of their last 13 games, since Aug. 27.
- The D-backs have won or split 6 of their last 7 series and 8 series wins in their last 12.

**LAST GAME:** The D-backs lost 5-3 @ Giants last night to fall in a series for the first time in 6 series, since Aug. 14-17 @ Rockies.

- Zac Gallen**, with his 3 strikeouts totaling 999 strikeouts with Arizona, surpassed opposing starter and former D-back Robbie Ray (998) for third on the D-backs’ all-time strikeouts leaderboard, behind only Randy Johnson (2,077), Brandon Webb (1,065).
- Geraldo Perdomo** went 1-for-2 with 2 walks...his 10+-pitch at-bat in the first inning was the fifth time he has reached base on 10+ pitches, tied for the most in MLB with Nolan Arenado/STL (5)...his 12 games of 1+ hits with 2+ walks are tied for second in MLB with Juan Soto/NYM and Cal Raleigh/SEA, behind Shohei Ohtani/LAD (15) and Aaron Judge/NYY (15).
- Blaze Alexander** went 2-for-4 and has hit safely in 3 straight games...has reached base safely in 11 of his last 13 games since Aug. 27, including 2+ times in 6 games.
- Tim Tawa** went 2-for-3 with his seventh double in his first game back since July 4.
- Jordan Lawlar** went 1-for-2 with a RBI double...has hit safely in 4 of his last 5 games with a double in 3 of his last 5 games and a RBI in 3 of his last 4.
- John Curtiss** made his third straight scoreless appearance with 1.1 perfect innings.

**VS. GIANTS:** The D-backs are 0-2 in a stretch of 6 games in 10 days vs. Giants (Sept. 8-10 on road, Sept. 15-17 at home).

- With a win, the D-backs will split the season series 5-5 with the Giants... the D-backs went 2-1 in their initial road series from May 12-14 before splitting their 4-game home series from June 30-July 3.
- The D-backs have won or split 4 of their 6 series vs. Giants overall (won 3, split 1).
- The D-backs (72-74) are tied for sixth in NL Wild Card) and sit 2.5 games back of the Giants (74-71), who are fourth in NL Wild Card.
- Blaze Alexander**, in 10 career games vs. Giants, is hitting .412 (14-for-34)/1.046 OPS with 4 doubles, 1 homer, 9 RBI and 1 walk...in his first career game @ Giants on April 19, 2024, he hit his first career grand slam (8th inning off Nick Avila) and had a career-high 5 RBI...became the fourth player ever in a game @ Oracle Park to record 2+ extra-base hits, 1+ home runs and 5+ RBI, joining Josh Donaldson/OAK (May 18, 2012), Paul Lo Duca/LAD (June 26, 2001) and Jeff Kent/SF (Aug. 3, 2000)...also was the youngest player ever to do so @ Oracle Park at age 24-313.
- Geraldo Perdomo**, since 2024, has reached base safely in 12 of his 14 games vs. Giants, hitting .327 (17-for-52)/.435 OBP with 1 double, 5 RBI and 10 walks (10 K).

**STRENGTH OF SCHEDULE:** The D-backs currently face the fourth-hardest remaining strength of schedule: Cardinals (.558), Rays (.531), Twins (.529), **D-backs (.527)** and Red Sox (.526).

**QUALITY STARTS:** D-backs’ starting pitchers have quality starts in 6 of their last 8 games, 8 of their last 11 and 9 of their last 13.

- D-backs starting pitchers’ streak of 6 straight quality starts from Sept. 1-7 tied their longest since 2017 (also: 6 from April 8-15, 2025), behind 8 straight from Sept. 9-16, 2017.

**VS. NL WEST:** The D-backs are 22-20 (.524) vs. NL West foes...their .524 interdivision win pct. is seventh among NL clubs, behind the Dodgers (.683, 28-13), Brewers (.628, 27-16), Padres (.578, 26-19), Phillies (.574, 27-20), Cubs (.571, 24-18) and Braves (.533, 24-21).

- Since August 1, **Ketel Marte** has reached base safely 2+ times in 10 of his last 12 games vs. NL West since Aug. 8, hitting .349 (15-for-43) with 5 doubles, 6 RBI, 7 walks and 7 strikeouts.

**TRENDING OFFENSE:** Since August 8, the D-backs’ 5.29 runs per game rank fourth in MLB, behind the Mets (6.20), Yankees (5.66) and Brewers (5.31).

- Since August 1, the D-backs’ 81 RBI with 2 outs rank third in MLB, behind the Phillies (90) and Mets (82).
- The D-backs lead the Majors with 45 homers this season in the 8th inning or later.

**CARROLL 2 SHY OF 100 RUNS:** **Corbin Carroll**, with 2 more runs scored, would become the third D-back all-time to collect 3+ straight seasons of 100+ runs (also: 121 in 2024, 116 in 2023), to join Luis Gonzalez (1999-2001) and Paul Goldschmidt (2015-17)...no D-back has ever done it 4 seasons in a row.

- Currently, Shohei Ohtani/LAD is the only MLB player to score 100+ runs each of the last 3 seasons (2023-25).
- Others that can reach the feat: Francisco Lindor (1 run shy, at 99) and Kyle Schwarber (1 run shy, at 99).

**CARROLL’S EXTRA BASES:** **Corbin Carroll** has a MLB second-best 75 extra-base hits, behind Shohei Ohtani/LAD (77)...no D-back has ever led a MLB season in the category.

- His 75 extra-base hits are tied for ninth in franchise history in a single season (with 4 others), behind Luis Gonzalez (100 in 2001), Gonzalez (80 in 2000), Ketel Marte (77 in 2019), Gonzalez (76 in 2003), Aaron Hill (76 in 2012), Stephen Drew (76 in 2008), Steve Finley (76 in 1999) and Jay Bell (76 in 1999).

**CARROLL NEARING A 30-30 SEASON:** **Corbin Carroll**, at 30 homers and 26 stolen bases, is looking to become the first-ever D-back to have a 30+-homer/30+-stolen base season...since his debut year in 2022, only 7 players have accomplished the feat: Juan Soto/NYM (2025), Bobby Witt Jr./KC (2x - 2023-24), José Ramírez/CLE (2024), Shohei Ohtani/LAD (2024), Ronald Acuña Jr./ATL (2023), Francisco Lindor/NYM (2023) and Julio Rodríguez/SEA (2023).

- Since 2022, he is 1 of 3 players with 2+ consecutive 20+-HR/30+-SB seasons: **Corbin Carroll** (2 - 2023-24), Bobby Witt Jr./KC (4 - 2022-25) and José Ramírez/CLE (2 - 2024-25).

**SPREADING THE SAVES:** The D-backs’ **8 pitchers with 2+ saves** are tied for the most all-time/since 1969 (*when saves became an official stat*) with the 2024 Rays, 2022 Rays, 2003 Tigers, 1979 Dodgers, 1973 Braves and 1970 Indians...the D-backs’ **6 pitchers with 3+ saves** are tied for second most all-time/since 1969 with the 2022 Rays, 2021 Reds, 1992 Braves, 1991 Brewers, 1991 Pirates, 1990 Pirates, 1984 Mariners, 1983 Athletics, 1973 Braves, 1980 Angels and 1970 Indians...the record is 7 pitchers set by the 2003 Tigers [source: Elias Sports Bureau]:

- 2+ SAVES:** Shelby Miller (10), Justin Martinez (5), A.J. Puk (4), Kevin Ginkel (3), Andrew Saalfrank (3), Jake Woodford (3), Anthony DeSclafani (2), Taylor Rashi (2).
- 3+SAVES:** Shelby Miller (10), Justin Martinez (5), A.J. Puk (4), Kevin Ginkel (3), Andrew Saalfrank (3), Jake Woodford (3).

**ON DECK - MINNESOTA TWINS:** The D-backs will head to Minnesota for their sixth-ever series @ Twins (last: Aug. 4-6, 2023, preceded by road series in 2017, 2014, 2008 and 2003).

- The D-backs’ last win @ Twins was on Sept. 22, 2014 and only won their first-ever series from June 13-15, 2003 (2-1).

NEXT STARTER: RHP BRANDON PFAADT (13-8, 5.18)

- Extended his career high to 13 wins in his quality start on Sept. 6 vs. Red Sox, allowing 1 run on 6 hits and 0 walks with 7 strikeouts over 6.0 innings.
- Will make his second career start vs. Twins and first @ Target Field...took a no-decision on June 25, 2024 vs. Twins (4 ER in 6.1 IP, 5 H, 2 BB, 2 K).

**AT A GLANCE:** Second season with the D-backs (10th overall in MLB; did not pitch in 2020).

- Signed a 4-year contract in December 2023 (2024-2027) with a conditional option for the fifth year.
- Was a member of the 2018 World Series Champion Red Sox.
- Finished tied for sixth in the 2019 AL Cy Young Award vote after going 19-6 with a 3.81 ERA (86 ER in 203.1 IP) and 213 strikeouts.
- Was a member of the 2018 World Series Champion Red Sox.
- From 2018-23, his 63 wins tied for third most in the AL (also: Justin Verlander), behind Gerrit Cole (86) and Jose Berrios (66).

**WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW:** Since 2015, his 92 wins are third among active lefty starters, behind Clayton Kershaw (124) and Chris Sale (99) while his 1,278 strikeouts rank eighth.

- In his last 2 starts, is 2-0 with a 0.75 ERA (1 ER in 12.0 IP), opponent .195 AVG (8-for-41), 6 walks and 8 strikeouts.
- Has 3 quality starts in his last 5 starts, going 3-1 (team is 4-1) with a 3.54 ERA (11 ER in 28.0 IP), opponent .238 AVG (25-for-105), 11 walks and 19 strikeouts.
- The D-backs have won and scored 6+ runs in 6 of his last 7 starts since Aug. 3 (vs. Athletics, vs. Rockies, @ Rockies, vs. Guardians, @ Dodgers, vs. Red Sox).
- In his last 5 starts (3 quality), is 3-1 (team is 4-1) with a 3.54 ERA (11 ER in 28.0 IP), opponent .238 AVG (25-for-105), 11 walks and 19 strikeouts.
- Celebrated 10 years of MLB service time on July 6.

**LAST START:** Tossed his second straight quality start for his first career win vs. Red Sox, allowing 1 run on 4 hits and 2 walks with 4 strikeouts over 6.0 innings.

**VS. GIANTS:** Second straight start @ Oracle Park (fourth overall).  
• Had a no decision in his last start on May 14 (4 ER in 4.0 IP, 4 K).  
• Had a quality start in his first career start vs. Giants on Sept. 19, 2019 with the Red Sox (W; 1 ER in 6.0, 3 H, 2 BB, 10 K).

**VS. NL WEST:** 20th career start (7-6, 5.07 ERA)...the team has gone 4-1 in his last 5 starts.  
• Earned the win in his last start on Aug. 30 @ Dodgers, tossing 6.0 scoreless innings with 4 hits, 4 walks and 4 strikeouts.  
• Had a 4-game win streak from July 12-Sept. 19, 2019 (1.80 ERA) while with the Red Sox.

**RANKINGS AMONG STARTERS:** Among lefty NL starters this season (min. 20 GS), his 8.52 strikeouts per 9.0 IP ranks seventh.  
• Among lefty NL starters this season (min. 15 GS), his 87.9 MPH AVG exit velocity ranks first.  
• Among all lefty starters this season, his 10 soft hits [hits under 60 MPH or grounders and pop ups under 70 MPH] are tied with Andrew Abbott/CIN for third fewest, behind Max Fried/NYY (11) and Kyle Freeland/COL (11).

**SNAKE SUPPORT:** Is 6-1 this season when the D-backs score 5+ runs...is 16-3 in 29 career starts with Arizona when they have scored 5+ runs.  
• Is 6-0 this season when the D-backs score 6+ runs...is 11-1 in 22 career starts with Arizona when they have scored 6+ runs.

**6.0+ INNINGS:** Has tossed 6.0+ innings in 6 of his last 9 starts...is 3-1 with a 2.61 ERA (11 ER in 38.0 IP) in those 6 starts.  
• In his 10 starts of 6.0+ innings (7 quality) in 2025, is 5-2 with a 2.70 ERA (20 R-19 ER in 63.1 IP), 21 walks and 49 strikeouts.

**DAYTIME STARTS:** In his last 4 day starts, has gone 2-0 with a 2.91 ERA (7 ER in 21.2 IP), 7 walks and 19 strikeouts.

- Has recorded 4 strikeouts over his last 2 outings (3.2 IP).
